French Industry Figs Show Further Drops

Paris- Overall record/tape unit sales in France dropped a further 11% during the first four months of this year, according to trade organisation SNEP. The LP sector was hardest hit, 32.5% down on the same period of 1986 to 5.93 million units. But singles were also well

down at 15,97 million units, a dip of 14%, maxi-singles and EPs were down 8.3% to 1.27 million and cassettes 7.1% down to just over six million. As in most territories in Europe, CDs provided the one bright spot up 129.4% in unit sales to 3.3 million, the silver disc format accounting for 28.7% of total industry earnings in the January-April period.

ZDF To Promote Creativity

Mainz- Germany's second tv channel, ZDF, is to give DM 222 million to independent German producers next year. The announcement came from ZDF Programme Director Alois Schardt who said the idea was to give the independent producers more opportunities to make programmes and to stimulate creativity. UK's Metro Radio has been hitting the headlines in more ways than one. As part of a feature BBC TV is doing on British trade unions, the crew went up to Newcastle to film at the station since Metro has been playing ads for a union. A few days later Spagna was in Newcastle to do a promo for ty pop show 'The Roxy' and tuning into Metro, she heard Giles Squire announce that the station was the first ever to play Call Me. Laser To Return

London- Radio Laser, the off-shore American owned pirate radio station, is set to get back on air in October, following a complete re-fit and a 'substantial' injection of back-up finance.

The station's ship base, the MV Communicator, is moored off the coast of Dunkirk. It was impounded by the British government in November 1985 after its 120 foot radio mast was smashed by gales. The government authorised its sale, on the understanding that it would not be used for pirate radio purposes. Mid-Price CD Campaigns On The Increase

The recent success of CDs has resulted in a spate of mid-price campaigns by most of the major international record companies. M&M has compiled a list of the releases for the coming two months (September and October) based on information received. While the following list does not intend to be complete and all releases are subject to last minute change, it does give a picture of the most important pop releases. It is interesting to note that several companies have slowed down on their CD single releases since these are no longer eligible in the UK's Gallup chart.

BMG

BMG are to launch major mid-price campaigns on RCA and Arista for pop, Motown and classical product. Up to 50 titles will be included in the special price pop series to be launched in September. Merchandising for the campaign includes special booklets with a distinctive wraparound and point-of-sale material and leaflets. Both international and local repetoire will be featured including the Eurythmics, Blow Monkeys, Hall & Oates, Mr. Mister, and Elvis Presley (on RCA) and Aretha Franklin, Barry Mani-, low, Thompson Twins, Dionne Warwick and the Alan Parsons Project (on Arista). The campaign includes product which was previously on full-price CD as well as some not yet released on this format.

Some 40 Mowtown titles are planned between September and the end of the year with the first 15 to be issued in September. These include major artists such as Stevie Wonder.

This will come as no surprise: Michael Jackson's I Just Can't Stop Loving You is the best played single on the European radio stations this week. In three weeks, it has managed to put Madonna's two week Airplay chart topper Who's That Girl back to the no. 2 spot. The last time Michael Jackson hit the Airplay charts was in July 1984 when he and his brothers teamed up with Mick Jagger in the steamy 'State Of Shock'.

Three other noteworthy movers in the Airplay Top 10: Tex-Mex band Los Lobos spice up the European airwaves with La Bamba creeping up to no. 4; the King Of Designer Soul, Terence Trent d'Arby makes a significant move with Wishing Well landing at 6 (coming from 11); and the Stock/Aitken/Waterman produced I Heard A Rumour by Bananarama up to no. 7 with a bullet.

As you may have noticed, the productivity of these three producers has been enormous in the last year. After their successes with Dead Or Alive, Mel & Kim, Debbie Harry and Ferry Aid, the PWL production team (also comprising the talents of in-house mix masters Phil Harding and Pete Hammond), currently has four hit records in the European Airplay Top 50 and six in the UK Top 75 (of which five are in the first 25). Apart from Bananarama's 'I Heard A Rumour', Samantha Fox's Nothing's Gonna Stop Me Now, Mel & Kim's F.L.M. and their own first recording for A&M, Roadblock (all in the Airplay Top 50), the UK has, with the exception of Sam Fox, three more: Rick Astley's Never Gonna Give You Up, a very straightforward but ultra commercial pop/disco single for RCA (a definite hit for the continent as well!); Sinitta's Toy Boy; and (the flopped) Shattered Glass by Laura Branigan. In the Hot 100 Singles we find another, older, production by the same team; Mel & Kim's Showing Out.

And maybe yet another hit produced by Stock/Aitken/Waterman could be on its way: the new Precious Wilson single for Jive, Only The Strong Survive, once a (UK) hit for Billy 'Me & Mrs Jones' Paul in 1977. It's an effective and economic production, putting the mid 70s Philly soul sound into an 80s Euro-disco framework.

Back to the European Airplay Top 50, we find WAX, the enigmatic masters of pure pop, with the catchy Motownesque Bridge To Your Heart, shooting up from

most successful hard rock album. Songs like Women, Animal, Love Bites, Armageddon It and Hysteria prove the band is definitely back on the music map.

A romantic and lingering saxophone sets the right tone on the opening track, Spanish Eyes, of Van Morrison's latest album Poetic Champions Compose. It also ends on a jazzy tone (Allow Me) and the material in between is very atmospheric and intimate with lots of string and woodwind arrangements. Morrison is in very good form, both vocally and as a composer, and his idiosyncratic style is best exemplified on tracks like I Forgot That Love Existed, Sometimes I Feel Like A Motherless Child, the country style Give Me My Rapture and the swinging Did Ye Get Healed?

One Way Home, the second album by the American band Hooters, consists of nine conventional rock songs with harsh vocals in a basic Bryan Adams vein, but also folk undertones due partly to an accordion and pipes in the instrumentation which make the LP reminiscent of Dylan in places. Best tracks include Johnny B. Washington's Day, Gravevard Waltz and Satellite.

Classics Live II by veteran American rock band Aerosmith contains new live versions of eight of the band's classics. Don't miss the electrifying guitar work in Walk This Way.

for use by the BBC and Music Week. The BBC has two main outlets for the charts: 'The Top 40' countdown on Radio 1 on Sunday evenings and Thursday's 'Top Of The Pops'. Music Week gives October 4 as the start date for the new charts but this is not confirmed by the BPI who can only say it will be "sometime in autumn"

A spokesman for Radio 1 confirmed that a test chart would be in their hands in a few weeks time and trials would be held but could not confirm that they would be incorporating the changes in their programming. With weekend working in-

volved, the cost of creating the chart would be pushed up but this problem could be solved for 'Top Of The Pops' by the sponsorship cash hoped for from Pepsi (see M&M issue 31).

In the last available ratings figures, 'Top Of The Pops' is at number 31 in the national top 100 programmes (week ending July 12) with 7.2 million viewers, while ITV's 'The Roxy' is at 42 with 6.4 million and reportedly catching up very fast

UNITED KINGDOM Believe it or not, Michael Jackson's I Just

Can't Stop Loving You storms to the no. 1 spot in two weeks, replacing Los Lobos' La Bamba. At 3 is Italian CBS artist Spagna whose Call Me jumps from 8 in its fourth week. Stephen 'Pet Shop Boys' Hague's remix of New Order's True Faith has climbed to no. 4 while Def Leppard's Animal (9-16) and Sinitta's disco ditty Toy Boy (10-22) are new in the top 10. A remarkable move (11-23) for Somewhere Out There, the duet by Linda Ronstadt and James Ingram from the movie 'An American Tail'. Another good move for Wet Wet Wet's Sweet Little Mystery (12-31) while the Stock/Aitken/Waterman produced Never Gonna Give You Up by RCA artist Rick Astley is moving from 34 to 14, in just its second week. This producer trio have the greatest number of productions in the UK top 25 at the moment: apart from Rick Astley, they have four others: Sinitta's Toy Boy, their own Roadblock (no. 13), Bananarama's I Heard A Rumour (16) and Mel & Kim's FLM (23). New entries: Bon Jovi (Never Say Goodbye, 29), The Jesus & Mary Chain (Happy When It Rains, 30), Prince (U Got The Look, 38) and the rereleased version of the Temptation's classic Papa Was A Rolling Stone (45). Interesting to see the original version of La Bamba, by Richie Valens, moving up (49-56); it's the first time since 1959's 'Donna' that the US rocker has had a hit in the UK.

GERMANY

Pet Shop Boys stay on top for the fifth week but French singer Desireless creeps up to no. 2 from 3). A big move for Michael Jackson (4-15) while Tina Charles' I Love To Love is new in the top 10 (8-13). Highest entry is for Terence Trent d'Arby with Wishing Well debuting at 28. The Italian entry for the Eurovision Song Contest, Tozzi & Raff (the extra 'f' is added to avoid association with the German terrorist organisation RAF) have second best entry (40) with Gente Di Mare.

On the album front, d'Arby's album Introducing.. is very striking: it shoots up from 61 to 61 in its second week

Michael Jackson crashes the top 10 (6-17) and Billy Idol's wonderful Sweet Sixteen follows (7-10). Former UK no. 1 The Firm's Star Trekkin' is at 10 while Los Lobos are at no. 13. Highest entry is for local Phonogram act Frank Ashton with the happy Let Your Sun Shine (new at 25).

BELGIUM

France's best played and best selling single Joe Le Taxi by Vanessa Paradis is the new no. 1 in Belgium putting Pet Shop Boys' It's A Sin back to no. 2. Michael Jackson creeps to no. 3 (coming from 5) and Tony Esposito is new in the top 10 with Papa Chico (10-14). Good moves for Los Lobos' La Bamba (12-27) and Schultheis with Va Ti Faire Voir which moves up to 14 from 23. Other good moves are for Francesco Napoli's hit Balla...Balla! (15-22), Heart's Alone (18-25) and Johnny Logan's version of 10CC's I'm Not In Love (22-40).

SWITZERLAND

Highlights

Pet Shop Boys have already dominated the charts for three weeks, followed by Madonna and Whitney Houston. New in the Swiss top 10 arc Terence Trent D'Arby with Wishing Well (6-13) and Michael Jackson has highest entry with I Just Can't Stop Loving You, new at 13. Prince re-enters with If I Was Your Girlfriend at 15 and his current single U Got The Look has a good chance of entering the Swiss top 30 next week. Other entries are for Mel & Kim (19), Laura Branigan's Shattered Glass (27) and William Pitt's City Lights (29).

IRELAND

Tex-Mex rockers Los Lobos stay at the top for the second week with La Bamba although Michael Jackson is a serious competitor: his I Just Can't Stop Loving You storms to no. 2 in its second week.
