The controversy and uncertainty surrounding Michel Droit, one of the 13 members of France's CNCL (National Commission For Communications & Freedom) continues (see M&M issue 44). On Friday October 30, Droit appeared before magistrate Claude Grellier who had three days earlier charged him with abuse of authority for having allegedly favoured one of the FM radios. Any decision is still pending, but Droit's lawver points out that, "nothing in

the CNCL are escalating and, whatever the outcome, the future of the media in France will be affected. Long term plans, such as the go-ahead for a French music channel, will inevitably face delays and there is speculation that the reallocation of FM frequencies may be reviewed.

Former President Giscard D'Estaing is the latest to join in the stream of attacks on the Commission. In an interview on TF1, he suggested the CNCL should be replaced by a regulatory body composed of people chosen without political intervention.

pansion of Britain's copyright industries into the 21st century, this decision seems to have been taken for mistaken reasons of short-term political expediency. It ignores the most recent public opinion surveys in Britain which show that a majority of all age groups who use tape recorders accept the equity of the royalty solution to the home taping problem."



Continuing our regular features on major European studios, this week M&M presents London's SARM STUDIOS, Next month we visit the Marcadet Studios in Paris.

Sarm Began Where Music Begins - In The Studio

he rapidly growing Sarm group of companies began tomation more appealing when where music begins, in the recording studio. From humble beginnings in London's East End, Sarm has

grown into a vast empire which currently incorporates five recording facilities. That first studio is the eastern arm of today's Sarm empire and is now known as Sarm East. Designed in cool classic blacks and grevs the facilities here bear witness to Jill Sinclair and Trevor Horn's break with the 70s tradition of studio browns, oranges, bricks and wood.

This turns out to be nothing in Her whirlwind approach left no employed. comparison with what Sinclair and Horn planned for their newly acquired Sarm West Studios in 1982 - the building team virtually staged a walk-out at some of the design requests. Formerly Island Records' Basing Street

Studios, the building was steeped in history and tradition. "It was a bit of a struggle

getting the builders to accept all our ideas and we had some terrific arguments," comments interior designer Gary Knibbs of XL, commissioned to work on several Sarm projects. "When we started staining and spraving eventhing the carpenters were disgusted. There we were with these industrial finishes that people are more used to seeing in toilets."

Jill Sinclair's claim to have succeeded with the studios through simple honest hard work rather ignores the fact that she turned the image of the recording studio on its head.

team, which included acoustician Eddie Veale, to open their minds to new concepts. The result was a large studio 1 complete with swimming pool effect (visually as opposed to acoustically) and incorporating a temple facade to the control room by way of a visual joke. XL were somewhat unorthodox in their approach but there is no denying it was effective. Studio 2 was designed to look like a spraying all their woodwork ship featuring helm-like wheels to dim the lights; Studio 3.

designed for Trevor Horn's blossoming electronic music projects, was again a break with tradition - not only in its interior design but because the mixing console was placed practically up against the wall and only nearfield monitoring was it comes to mixing. Sarm's Synclavier started its life in Studio 4 but is now hardwired throughout the facility. Jill Sinclair was guided by a fundamental principle which

she learnt very early on from her brother John, "Anyone can buy a desk and the studio gear.

recent months as engineers and producers finally realise the precious nature of their ears and the importance of preserving this most important asset. At the time, however, it was a very unusual thing to do. Horn requested a 'spaceship' feel and that is exactly what he got. A black room, the walls spattered with Linelit plastic tubing which flouresces under ultraviolet light.

Studio 4 came last and has been running for just over a year. At the time Sarm was not alone in perceiving a market need for pre-programming suites to enable more cost-effective use of studio time. More recently, as the technology gains an even tighter hold on recording methods these facilities are becoming fully-fledged recording studios. A Trident Series 80 console is popular for recording on although most producers at Sarm find the SSL computer au-

been increasingly common in but recording is organic; making music is organic. Atmosphere is much more important. Little things mean a lot. The people mean a lot. Everybody who works here is very nice; they are nice people.

We concentrate on getting the little things right," continued Sinclair. "For example at Sarm East the kitchen is stocked with food because there are not many restaurants in the area. Attention to detail is backed

up by a staff willing to muck in and help with whatever needs doing. "We don't have job roles here. If the cups need washing up I'll do it. There is a Japanese saying: if you see a nail sticking out, knock it in. If something needs doing, do it. Sarm has built its good reputation through hard work. Good people trying their hardest and caring. It is the team of people that works in a studio that makes all the difference."

Success Is Where Sinclair Is

by Janet Angus

r ill Sinclair is almost a household name within the UK music industry, playing an active managerial role in some 13 companies including Sarm Recording Studios and ZTT Records. The press has made much of her success over the last decade. Much of this can be put down to the fact that she operates in a very male-dominated industry in which any successful female will stand out. She is constantly asked how she can possibly run a business and a family. Sinclair ignores the prejudice and simply gets on with her work. Hard work. The demands on her time are colossal and, yes, she does fit in her children too.

Jill Sinclair's music industry career began in 1977 when brother and producer (now turned actor) John Sinclair invited her to join his East End recording studio - Sarm East. It was here that she met her husband. record producer Trevor Horn. whose 1979 success with the single Video Killed The Radio Star set him on the music map. Sinclair started to manage him in 1981 when he left Yes. This was the embryo of her now highly successful producer management operation, Sarm Productions, which currently

has nine producers on its books. Later, when Island decided to sell off its Basing Street Studios in West London, Sinclair stepped in. Steeped in history, the studios provided an ideal base for Horn and Sinclair's new label ZTT Records.

Having acquired the building, the studios were stripped and renovated in 1983. That Goes To Hollywood on their label which today features over 10 acts: the now independent members of Frankie Goes To

Hollywood (Holly Johnson, Paul Rutherford): The Lads (Mark O'Toole, Ped Gill and Brian Nash); Nasty Rox; Act (Claudia Brucken and Thomas Lear); the Pogues; Mint Juleps; Feelgoods; and Joie Favier as well as new signings in the pipeline. The company bought Stiff Records last year and the recent resignation of Stiff's Dave Robinson has facilitated the incorporation of Stiff into the ZTT set-up.

Full Grown Talent From Baby Producers Hole Records, Italy Address: Via Don Minzoni 4

There is a growing trend today, especially on the disco scene, for producers to operate as multi-purpose music men - responsible for finding the talent, composing the songs, producing the singles and, hopefully, making the hits. This is certainly true of Roberto Turatti and Michele Chieregato, the producers who have an exclusive contract with one of Italy's leading companies, Baby Records.

Turatti and Chieregato met in 1979 while working as club DJs in Milan. In the beginning, they wrote songs and made demo tapes more for fun than anything else, but a couple of years later they knew they had discovered talent when they saw Boston born Den Harrow at a local disco. In 1983 Turatti and Chieregato wrote and produced To Meet Me by Harrow. The song was released by Lombardoni and became quite a success, not only in Italy but in other European territories too. Later in the same year Lover

To Lover by Joe Yellow was Turatti and Chieregato's second success, entering not only European charts but the disco listings in the UK and US too. This was followed by Happy Chil-

Tom Hooker writes the lyrics, Mario Natale is responsible for the arrangements and Silvio Melloni is the technician. It is this co-operation of talent that creates them into a successful production unit.

ot many artists can boast each new album to be better than the preceding one. The Eurythmics however continue a glorious pattern with Savage, their sixth studio album, not counting the '1984' film score and the Touch Dance remix.
