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



Antler Records, based in the small town of Aarscholt, is run by Maurice Engelen and is the label at the centre of this new phenomenon.

According to Engelen, new beat started when a Belgian DJ played Split Second by Flash at 33rpm+8%, instead of 45. There was an immediate response from the dancefloor - people liked the extra heavy bass frequencies and the slurred voices. Impressed by this reaction, Engelen asked local musicians if these effects could be reproduced. They could, and the result was new beat

As expected, Yazz reaches the top slot this week, continuing the Big Life versus PWL saga. Highest entries are Bam Bam at no. 10 and Fingers Inc. with Can You Feel It in at no. 21, both on the Desire label via Pacific. Good to see Pacific is finally directing its distribution efforts towards independent chart success. Other recent releases include 1,000 Violins' All Aboard The Lovemobile and a likely hit, Raymonde's Destination Breakdown.

Todd Terry, who is currently enjoying success as the man behind Royal House Can You Party, looks set to cross over into the indie dance and national charts with the UK release of his own hot single Weekend. The single is the first release on the Sleeping Bag

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Antler launched a new label, Subway Records, specifically for the new sound and now they have over 50 titles including big sellers like Erotic Dissidents, The Confetti's, Dirty Harry and Taste Of Sugar. In the Boston dance chart there are eight records in the top 10 which are on Antler and the first new beat compilation LP Take 1 is now at no. 16 in the Rockpool dance chart. And on a slightly different note, Jellybean Benitez, the New York-based producer who "discovered" Madonna, has asked for samples of Antler's catalogue.

Interest from the UK has also been intense. It seems that new beat arrived, thanks to DJs like Greater London Radio's Johnny Walker, just as audiences were getting tired of acid house. London has embraced the new sound with considerable enthusiasm, so much so that the Spectrum Club, previously a centre of the house scene, is to re-open this week under the name Newbeat.



Jill Furmanovsky

Throughout her 15 years in the business, rock photographer Jill Furmanovsky has produced vivid in the business when I started. images of many of the top names in the industry, including Mick Jagger, Sting and Stevie Wonder. Last year she won two awards, Music Photographer Of The Year and Best Photograph Of A Performer Off-Stage.

"Winning the awards meant more to my personal prestige, than anything to do with getting more work. I was thrilled to receive them, because I'd never won an award for my rock work, and also because I was heavily pregnant at the time and was beginning to feel that my career had ended. Winning was almost like a

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
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

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
