## **FEAR OF FLYING** US Acts Delay Euro Promo Dates

The war in the Persian Gulf is slowly affecting the international record business. Fear of terrorism has forced many US acts to cancel--or temporarily postpone--promo and concert dates. So far, M&M has received reports from 15 major US acts which have delayed their appearance in Europe.

## **Griffin Joins MCA**

The international expansion of **MCA Records** is going full steam ahead with the appointment of **Chris Griffin** this week to the newly created position of director of international marketing.

Griffin's appointment marks the latest in a series of moves following the label's new international distribution and licensing deal with the **Bertelsmann**  Music Group (BMG). The agreement is effective from April 1 on a worldwide basis, excluding North America, Japan, the UK and Germany. The **Geffen** label already moved to BMG on January 1.

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## **Home Taping Stimulates Music Sales, Says Timmer**

Home taping has benefited both the hardware and software sides of the music industry and helped increase sales of pre-recorded cassettes, says Philips president Jan Timmer.

Timmer estimates that during last year sales of blank cassettes totalled 1.6 billion, while pre-recorded sales reached one billion, commenting, "The copying feature stimulated sales of the cassette recorder. The sale of recorders, in turn, stimulated the sales of prerecorded cassettes. In this way, a cycle of music hardware and software was developed, each stimulating the other's sales.

To date, Timmer says only about 25% of the compact cassette hardware sold around the world is equipped with recording capability. The remainder consists of playback-only equipment.

Timmer made the remarks during his keynote address prior to a special dinner in Cannes where he received MIDEM's "Man of the Decade" award. His comments underscored a belief that the music industry needs dual carriers and that

both have a place in the market. He also predicts that the time is right for the introduction of digital compact cassettes.

"I am an ardent supporter of the 'Twin-Carrier Concept', an idea I first introduced in 1986 in Los Angeles. And I repeat here today that I firmly believe in equal rights for the compact cassette and the compact disc. Both have a place in the market," says Timmer. He explains that the CD and LP are both carriers for the home, while the compact cassette is the consumer's "mobile medium".

A key to promoting the twin-carrier concept and resolving the controversy surrounding copyright problems with home taping is a manufacturer's agreement reached in Athens in 1989. That agreement, which does not include the US. features a copying limitation called Solo Copy Management that prevents endless reproduction of material.

However, the emergence of competing digital cassette formats--the other being Japan's digital audio cassette (DAT)--could hinder future development in the short term.

## 'Serious Business' At MIDEM

Although Gulf war concerns reduced attendance by 21% from last year, the MIDEM conference in Cannes, January 20-24 attracted a total of 6.475 delegates. Revised estimates indicate US participation fell 60% in terms of individuals and 65% of American companies

While many artist-showcases were cancelled due to the war, including special tribute receptions for Quincy Jones and Ray Charles, some 350 artists appeared in 35 rock, jazz and classical concerts.

Summarised MIDEM CEO Xavier Roy, "Despite current events, MIDEM fully realised its role as the essential meeting-place for the international music industry. Serious business was the order of the day. I want to thank most warmly all those who took part.

The many thousands of participants placed their confidence in us, and I am proud of the way they--and we--rose to the challenge.

Among the highlights was an award ceremony for Philips president Jan Timmer, who received the Nesuhi Ertegun Award as MIDEM's "Man Of The Decade". Timmer, largely responsible for launching the compact disc, discussed details of the digital compact cassette system and other new technologies during a keynote address (see separate story).

The 15 conference panels during the conference included such radio sessions as "Expanding Into 1992", "Programming Europe", "Media Buying In Europe", "How Do You Choose The Music?", "Radio & Records: Partners & Protagonists", "A View Of The French Market", "Selling Radio On TV", and "Music In The

'90s.". There were also panels on promotions, audience research analysis, pan-European marketing, American investment in Europe, and technological issues, such as stereo AM.

There were several record business developments at MIDEM in addition to the Sony/ARS deal reported last week (see below).

• Frankfurt-based Bellaphone Records, reached an agreement covering the G/A/S territories with management company Grand H Music for a new album in August by Suzi Quatro - her first in 10 years. Motown Records and ABC Enterprizes are co-ordinating a multimedia co-production involving a soundtrack album and videos of a concert in Jamaica starring Stevie Wonder.

• After a three-year delay, Ronnie Scott's Jazz House label, formally debuted with five initial releases with Marion Montgomery, Chico Freeman, Arthur Blythe, Roy Aires, and the Ronnie

Scott Quintet. The world rights have been acquired by Teledisc, with distribution licensing deals now being sought.

• Mute Records and Intercord have renewed their longstanding distribution deal in G/A/S territories.

• Former A&M A&R manager, Patrick Conseil, now with his own production and management company Modus Operandi in New York, has completed a worldwide publishing deal with Warner Chappell Music for artist Denya Versaille, who is also signing a recording deal with Charisma. • Rod Stewart is reported to

switch to EMI in a new music publishing deal. His move, after a long association with Warner Chappell Music, is expected to be confirmed shortly. The deal is rumoured to have cost EMI US\$1 million but is likely to be worth US\$5 million over the next five years.

• Keyboard player Rick Wakeman's Ambient Music and Ambient Records have been licensed to Electra for Scandinavia. Other deals for France and the Benelux are now in negotiation. The Ambient labels have 10 releases scheduled for 1991, including an album based on next April's Anderson, Bruford, Wakeman & Howe world tour.

## Pollack Enters Italy; Three Privates Signed Next IM&MC

Jeff Pollack's US Pollack Media Group has signed an exclusive consultancy agreement with the three Italian private national stations: Rete 105, Radio Monte Carlo and 105 Classic. This is the first time a US consultancy firm has operated in Italy.

Alberto Hazan, who heads the three stations, confirms that the deal, which started on February 1, is initially for one year. The move, he says, is part of a strategy to improve efficiency.


Hazan comments, "I travel a lot and until today all new ideas have come from me. I have known Pollack for a couple of years, and now he is involved. I feel I have someone who can keep me informed on the international situation and can also keep a check on what I am doing. This will be much better, because the broadcast competition on national territory is getting stronger and stronger. I must be sure that what I am doing is right."

Hazan says Pollack has many skills to teach, and will introduce modern techniques which are currently unknown to Italy's broadcast sector. Those are expected to make improvements to Hazan's three stations.

Pollack will travel to the stations at least four times a year, and will remain in daily or weekly contact with Hazan the rest of the time.

Radio Monte Carlo, which Hazan bought out in 1987, has 1.06 million daily listeners (Audiradio), 1.39 million (Datamedia). 105 Classic was launched as a local station in March last year. It began broadcasting nationally in August to an average daily audience of 375.000 (Datamedia). Audiradio is currently regarded as the official statistics provider to the radio industry and produces results annually, Datamedia's research is published quarterly.

## Planned For '92

IM&MC, the International Music & Media Conference, will not take place in 1991. Organisers BPI Communications BV. the publishers of M&M, have decided not to stage the event this year because of the uncertain global economic and political situation affecting a number of conferences in the entertainment field.

However, it is still hoped to proceed with IM&MC in Amsterdam in 1992. In the meantime, the refocused M&M plans to organise a series of one-day seminars for the radio and music industries in various European cities. Look out for PΔ further details soon.

### New Talent Dominates Releases

"New talent" seems to be the key phrase when looking at the bulk of the pan-European releases this fortnight. Following two albums for Virgin, the Glaswegian band The Big Dish debut for the Warnerowned East West label with Satellites, of which the first single Miss America is one of this week's "new add leaders".

Canadian band Cowboy Junkies re-release their (independently produced) debut album from 1986, Whites Off Earth Now after two successful albums for RCA, The Trinity Sessions and The Caution Horses

More good news from Canada: Toronto-based swamp-rock band The Tragically Hip release their second full-length album, recorded in New Orleans and, again, produced by Don Smith (Travelling Wilburys, Keith Richards). In the spring they will go on tour with REM.

Despite their name, American Young Black Teenagers are an allwhite band, who claim to have a "black feeling" about their music. Even weirder are the Dream Warriors. Their hip-hop is a striking mix of big band, raggamuffin' and funk

Not just teenagers this week, as veteran rock band Chicago come up with their 21st LP, entitled (guess ... ) XXI, produced by Ron Nevison (Jefferson Starship, Europe, Heart)

Remarkable is the current revival of 70s hard rock. After the Led Zeppelin compilation box set, Thin Lizzy and The Free are next with "best of" albums. The latter is remixed by Bob Clearmountain.

## Incrementals Need More Research, Says Leo Burnett

Independent local radio lacks the specific audience research that could attract advertisers, says a report by the Leo Burnett agency. JICRAR's mass market data cannot provide the detailed information that smaller specialist stations need.

"Incremental Radio - The Facts" points out the 24 incremental stations, which have come onair in the last two years, will rely almost totally on local advertising. Only the larger London-based stations such as **Melody, Jazz FM** and **Kiss FM** attract any substantial national revenues.

Those stations intended to reach specific audiences within existing independent radio areas, offer advertisers a cost-effective means of targeting distinct groups of listeners. The report adds that they can provide tactical support to a major station campaign and they also allow an adventurous and innovative approach to sponsorships and promotions.

Says Leo Burnett media planner Giles Hadman, "Incremental stations serve a wide range of audiences from niche music through to ethnic groups. Only time will tell if commercial pressures will allow them to keep to their original programme remits. The first cracks seem to be emerging in, for example, Sunrise Radio. The South London Asian station already has a top 40-style breakfast programme as per independent radio.

"If these stations want to be taken seriously, they must provide data to prove they are reaching their target audiences. If that audience is what an advertiser is looking for then the station could be a very cost-effective medium to reach them."

The report says the situation is exacerbated by the fact that stations have to be members of the Association of Independent Radio Contractors (AIRC) in order to take part in JICRAR research. Some of the new stations have refused to join the AIRC for a variety of reasons, such as cost and suspicion from stations which previously operated as pirates.

#### **Radio Listening Up**

#### Radio listening--already at a record level in the fourth quarter of 1990 (M&M February 2)--has increased even more since the start of the Gulf War.

Forty per cent of men and 30% of women say they are listening to the radio more, based on a **JICRAR** telephone research study. The study was conducted during the weekend following the outbreak of war (January 19/20).

Of this group. some 75% of respondents have been listening more to their usual station, while the remaining quarter have been switching around the dial.

#### **Chiltern To MSM**

**Beacon Avoids Cutbacks** 

At **Belfast Community Radio**, the full-time staff has been reduced from 11 to eight. The station, which relaunched last October, recently carried out private audience research which showed their reach had increased from 5% to 18%. It has just joined the Association of Independent Radio Contractors and will be taking part in one of the JICRAR 1991 sweeps.

## Spectrum Debuts New Age

**Spectrum Radio** is claiming to be the first UK station to air New Age music programmes. The London multi-ethnic station is broadcasting a one-hour show on Saturdays from 11.00-12.00 and a four-and-a-half-hour show on Sundays from 14.00-18.30.

Programmes are being produced by Leap Entertainments. Says chairman David Rossmaur, "It's the first ripple of a tidal wave if the American experience is anything to go by. We expect the programmes to carve out a big and loyal audience in a very short time." The soft rock/light jazz/melodic instrumental style has provided several US stations with big audiences and some stations have completely converted to the, format. **HF**

## Westside Signs To Metronome

#### by Paul Andrews

Frankfurt-based dance-pop label Westside has signed an exclusive worldwide distribution and licensing deal with Hamburg-based Poly-Gram subsidiary Metronome Musik.

The two-year agreement, with an extension option, commits Westside to release at least five albums and 10 singles annually in Germany through Metronome. PolyGram companies elsewhere have first refusal on the product in their territories. The deal was signed in early January.

Financial details were not disclosed, but both parties stress the contract is intended to establish a longterm relationship.

Says Westside partner Horst Frey, "For the moment this is just a normal label deal, but we hope it include Deborah Sassoon, Celebrate The Nun and Moskva TV.

The label has previously had some success in both European and US dance charts through a two-year distribution deal with **EMI Electrola**, which expired in December: "We were unable to continue that deal when EMI changed its structure last year into three separate companies." says Frey. "We had some trouble fitting into the structure and were unable to reach a compromise. Metronome offered us a good alternative, so we took it."

Frey adds that the two companies have worked together previously, prior to the EMI deal, when Metronome successfully distributed the Westside group **Camouflage**, which had a number of international dance hits in 1987-88. Metronome head of A&R and

First releases under the new arrangement will be a single and 12" from Oh Well titled Quiet. That will be followed by the group's already finished album, Get Ready. Release dates are expected to be agreed this week. Other artists on the Westside roster with material in preparation the link with Westside. "They are well-established and we know that we will get good product. They have an excellent grasp of creative potential and get the most out of their artists."

The pact was agreed before the recent appointment of Metronome's new MD, Albert Stendebroek, who joins the company from Chrysalis in March.

## **More News Drives FFH Expansion**

#### by Mal Sondock

Increased news coverage heads the 1991 expansion plans of **Radio FFH**/Frankfurt, Hessen's only state-wide private station. The year-old hit AC/oldies service has also upped its own promotional budget, and has introduced a listener chart, new competitions and sports programming in a bid to build on its claimed one million audience.


Programme director Hans-Dieter Hillmoth says local news will spearhead the changes. "As of April 2, our news will cover the whole of Hessen, with four different local broadcasts daily from different parts of the region." These, he adds, will originate from studios in Kassel, Fulda, Giessen, Wiesbaden, Darmstadt, and a new facility in Erfurt (Thüringen), formerly part of the DDR.

"We've added 15 journalists to the staff and have invested an additional DM2 million (app. US\$1.34 million) in technical equipment," continues Hillmoth. "Overall, the station's budget has been increased to DM20 million from DM17.5 million, with the promotional budget upped 25% to DM2.5 million. Nevertheless, advertising income has been much higher than expected, and we hope to reach our breakeven mark by the end of the year."

FFH's new phone-in listener chart airs Monday evenings, 20.00-22.00, and is hosted by DJ Andre Rothe. The computer used to compile the hit parade can register more than 5.000 calls over 15 minutes.

Among new promotions is a competition called "Tens bring luck". Listeners matching the serial numbers on DM10 notes with those read out on air win DM100, 1.000 or 10.000. "The prizes are being brought to the winners by our FFH helicopter," says Hillmoth, "and a reporter on board broadcasts their reactions."

On the sports front, last November FFH became the first private station to garner the exclusive radio coverage rights to regional soccer games, in a deal with Hessen's "Oberliga". All other state leagues are still exclusively covered by public stations in their regions.



### Swiss Radio Rasps War Nettle

The fallout from the Gulf Crisis has now affected even a politically neutral country.

Swiss EHR private Radio Basilisk/Basel reports an initial swing to news/talk. Says head of music Nick Schulz, "When the war first broke, we were playing about two records an hour. For a few days we were very much news.

"We switched back to normal programming January 21; though current emphasis is on breaking news and bulletins twice an hour."

Schulz details two round-theclock staff reporters and news from CNN and Sky News. "I worked last weekend midnight-09.00 on simultaneous German translations."

He says Basilisk has a reputation for breaking local news. 'We've had a peace demonstration and are watching a story on whether this month's citywide carnival might be cancelled."

Schulz reports no problems with advertising. "We haven't lost or gained any clients." He says there is no evidence yet whether listening figures have changed, though the station sees its Gulf reportage as "beneficial in the ratings fight with national Swiss state network."

#### Westernhagen And Collins Go Platinum

Marius-Müller Westernhagen's double album, *Live*, recorded during his 1989-1990 German tour, has passed platinum status with Warner claiming over 750.000 sales already booked in Germany. Phil Collins's double LP, *Serious Hits*, on Virgin, has also gone platinum (500.000 sales), and Ariola's Belgian group. Vaya Con Dios. have picked their first German gold award (250.000 sales), for the album *Night Owls*.



Virgin Records Italy is taking on the specialist independent dance music labels by joining forces with Milan-based 101 Network to launch the new compilation LP series Danza.

Danza international A&R manager Gilberto Barantani comments, "Although Italy's indie dance labels are very efficient, they have a limited number of artists. Virgin has the best roster for this genre of music at the moment and we aim to make an extra inby shipping large wholesalers. But because of the excellent quality of dance singles coming from the UK, we decided to include some of them on the first two Danza compilation albums."

Barantani says radio is one of the most important outlets for promoting dance music. He adds Virgin chose to work with the 101 Network station because it is probably the most influential dance station on national territory. He details, "Its EHR music format consists of 80% dance music. That is more than Italia

## **Alaimo Joins High Tide**

Francesco Alaimo has quit his post as GM at key independent label Contempo to become a partner in High Tide, a new record company launched on February I. Alaimo puts the reason for his departure from Contempo down to differences of opinion and claims that while the label was becoming more national in its sales approach, High Tide aims to be a European contender.

Antonio Tasinato is a major shareholder in the new company. He is also a partner in the publishing company Franton Music, which holds the rights to material by artists including Lisa Stansfield and The Police.

The first product from High Tide will be a re-release of *Eneide* the debut album by rock band **Litfiba** who are now signed to the label **CSG**. Alaimo says that this will be followed by a couple of dance singles by as yet unnamed artists. High Tide aims to be selective with its output. "We are receiving a large number of demo tapes but will only sign one or two acts this year. The plan is to concentrate on both the national and international markets, something which Contempo seemed to lose sight of."

#### **40 Laser Discs**

**PolyGram Italy** launched the laser disc on February 1 with the release of 30 classical and 10 pop music titles.

Sony Music Italy released five titles late last year but PolyGram Italy's classical music division GM Bruno Fedetto says his company plans to release a total of 150 laser discs by the end of 1991. These will also include movies and ballet soundtracks.

Fedetto, who is in charge of the laser launch, believes that currently there are approximately 3.000 owners of laser disc players. Manufacturers Sony, Philips and Pioneer estimate that this number will increase to 15.000 by the end of 1991. **DS**

## DISCOPLAY BACKS LAUNCH 'Multi-Ethnic' Label Plans 3 Releases

Discoplay, Spain's largest record distributor and retailer, is backing the launch of the country's first new world label Musica Sin-Fin (Endless Music).

The label, launched on January 16, is releasing three LPs by Madrid-based multi-ethnic groups: Copa De Veneno by Clonicus, Amazonia by Finis Africae and Interface by Zyklus. A total of 5.000 records, CDs and cassettes have been issued. Musica Sin-Fin is published through Ediciones Cubicas, subsidiary of fast-expanding Discoplay, a retailer with outlets in many Spanish cities and plans to open stores in Europe and the Soviet Union.

Ediciones director Manuel Dominguez says each LP cost about Pta1.5 million (app.US\$ 15.000) to produce. "Our philosophy is to make original and avante garde music, assuming a


joint risk with the musicians through non-conventional channels.

Says Musica director Juan Alberto Arteche, "We soon hope to be jointly producing an album of pre-Columbian music with Jorge Reyes, a Mexican who is making big waves in his country.

Another of the label's directors is Juan Alberto Arteche, who



plays most instruments Amazonia, Finis Africae's third LP, and has been involved in the music business for 25 years as musician, producer and engineer. "Our costs are low because we use our own studios outside normal business hours. If the records don't sell, the economic losses will be minimal, although the cost in personal effort has been high.

## **Denmark Rocks At MIDEM**

The Danish music industry has launched a concerted effort to break into international markets. The campaign is spearheaded by a promotional CD, There's Something Rocking In The State Of Denmark, which was distributed from the Danish national stand at MIDEM.

ROSA, the state-funded Danish rock council, is also mailing the CD to major international industry figures who did not attend MIDEM. The Dkr30.000 (app. US\$5.800) cost of the project is being shared between ROSA, the Danish musicians' union DMF and the participating labels, with help from CD pres-DanDisc ser and cassette manufacturer Holm Cassette.

The disc features 15 tracks, all but one from bands signed to inde-

pendent labels such as Olafssongs, ZingZing and Right Tone. "The exception," says ROSA music export consultant Mikael Hoejris, "is Simcess, who have a deal with BMG. All the others are available for licensing and sub-publishing in all territories outside Scandinavia. sometimes even just Denmark.

"None of the labels is set on a particular kind of deal," explains Hoejris. "But they are inexperienced in doing business on a worldwide scale, so they're just looking to get themselves known and drum up some interest."

He adds that although many Americans did not attend MIDEM, there was considerable interest from other countries, especially France and Australia, for the Danish product. "People are genuinely interested. They have heard of other successful Danish acts such as Laid Back and Miss B Haven, and feel there is a new wave of talent coming from Denmark.

There is also interest in the Ulo label, from Greenland. It is considered as world music, mixing traditional local music with straightforward rock and jazz."

Hoejris also welcomes government support for the export drive. "Denmark is one of the few countries in Europe where the government does consider rock as an art form equivalent to jazz and socalled serious music," he explains. "A joint effort like this encourages our talent and can be a good catalyst for doing some valuable business. It's an example that could be followed by other small countries."

Official IFPI figures for the whole of 1989 give the equivalent figures as 4.07 million (MCs), 2.14 million (LPs), 2.04 million (CDs) and 670.000 (singles). Overall, 8.9 million records/tapes were sold during 1989.

The latest VG figures, which covered all areas of "cultural" spen-

#### Q&A

## Biting The Bullet: Antenne Bayern Fight All Obstacles

Mike Haas, programme director at German private radio station Antenne Bayern, discusses with Sydney Ann Prescott the challenges that face private broadcasters in Germany today.

Q: What sort of obstacles are private stations in Germany up against?

A: Generally, there are three to five areas in which German private stations face obstacles. These are: politics; the government's monopoly regarding technology and the use of resources, such as electricity and phone service; financial difficulties; a lack of understanding concerning sales and possible personnel; and future problems resulting from private stations' lack of security in the marketplace.

The primary obstacle is media politics. Every German state has the authority to determine its own broadcast regulations. This means bureaucracy is a big problem.

Another disadvantage is that public radio in Germany is a major force. Public stations in Germany are allowed to sell advertising time. They also charge user fees for every radio and TV set. These fees fund three quarters of their budget and another quarter of their budget comes from advertising. So they are after our market share and do not have to make a profit. They do not even have to cover the cost. If they come up a couple of million short they go to the politicians and they raise the rates.

Q: Has the reunification of East and West Germany helped Antenne Bayern in any way?

A: Yes, because Bavaria borders on the former East German states of Thüringen and Saxony. In these areas, we have an hourly reach of 130.000. Reunification has given us an excellent opportunity to access these listeners and use the numbers in our overall market totals.

If East Germany had remained a separate country, there would not have been any of those numbers in our media analysis. We could have surveyed it, but what good would it have done us? That is a market that does not exist. We are more popular than most East German stations so that gives us some healthy totals.

In terms of content, we are trying to serve the East German market better. A disadvantage is that Munich is in the South. East German listeners are way up at the top of the region. So it is not going to be easy to access these listeners over a longer period. If regional private radio develops locally there, like it developed here, and the product is good, we may eventually lose East German listeners.

Q: How do you view the German economy now that East and West have merged? A: Until reunification, West Germany was the world's thirdlargest economy with 65 million inhabitants. Now it is joined by a Q: What is the German philosophy when it comes to radio? How does it differ from radio in other countries, in terms of style and approach?

A: The Germans are into offering a full service. The feeling is that a station should be all things to all people, or at least as many things to as many people as possible. The reason is that niches do not sell like they do in the US is because sales departments aren't capable of selling them. To be number one, all you need is a 75% reach among 25-39 year-old males. But you will go broke because you do not have the widest reach. Widest reach drives down

A: Yes. Three years ago that was the case. But how long does it take a station to learn its lesson?

RSH (Antenne Bayern's direct competitor) went on air July 1, 1986. They immediately gained a 42% share and became the first commercial station to surpass a state network which had a 41% share. RSH's programme director has his problems today and is fighting, but he is not in a mature market where it is not as easy. The public station there took two years to learn its turn around.

They now sound much more polished than they ever did.

Names are similar on both public and private stations, the music is beginning to become the same, their jocks are beginning to show more personality. They also have production elements and employ a lot of staff. They can afford the best voices, the biggest news staff, and the biggest reports from the most expensive locations.

#### Q: What advice do you have for people interested in investing in the German radio market?

A: The world is becoming much smaller. And broadcasters are realising that they can have an impact worldwide. There is the world market and the European market. There is also the national market and the Bavarian market and our local market. A whole universe of activity. And I would say that anybody who has the ability, can decide how much time he wants to spend on any one of those universes.

## Q: Where do you see German private radio 10 years from now?

A: I see more stations. But many will go broke. Public radio will either switch to a fee system and will no longer be allowed to charge for advertising--the two will be separated like the UK system is--or it will not change, which will create a wave of bankruptcies. I think a number of privates will go bankrupt before the politicians re-examine everything.

fights for the separation of commercial and public broadcasting. I applaud them for that because it is the only logical solution if you really want a fair competitive sense. If you have the two mixed, as they are in Germany, you advantage some broadcasters and disadvantage others.


So I am going against public opinion and say I see the day when public broadcasting is based on the UK system and private broadcasting is pretty much based on the US system. At least I am hoping that it turns out that way.

Mike Haas was born in the US and graduated from the University of Winconsin at Oshkosh in 1978 with degrees in radio, TV and film and German culture and history. Having minored in military science, he then became a communications officer with the US Army Signal Corps, was stationed in Germany, and transferred to the American Forces Network (AFN).

In 1982, Haas left the service, but remained with AFN working as a civilian for the US Army Department Of Defence. In 1984 he began consulting on the side and in 1985 he co-founded Broadcast Consulting International (BCI), which is based in Nuremberg. Over the next three years he helped build 22 commercial radio stations in Germany.

Haas left BCI in 1988 to become programme director at Antenne Bayern, a private radio station located near Munich. Serving all of Bavaria, Antenne Bayern covers a listening area 400 miles long and 150-200 miles wide. The full service station plays 60% UStype AC mix as well as German, French, Italian and other European hits. News and information make up the other 40% of the station's programming content.

He is currently writing a book on radio management in German.

#### M. Walking On The Water Elysian - Polydor



### **SPOTLIGHT**



## Tanita Tikaram. It is the moment of truth for Tanita Tikaram. The release of her "diffi-

cult" third album, "Everybody's Angel", out on East West on February 4, marks the point of no return in a short, but highly successful, career. The debut album "Ancient Heart" stayed at no. 1 in the European Top 100 Albums for two consecutive weeks in March '89, while the followup, "The Sweet Keeper" reached no. 3 the same year.

The album's first single, *Only The Ones We Love* was released on January 21 and marks a fine preview of a more musically and lyrically diverse album. Gospel and soul-tinged arrangements go hand in hand with her well-known Celtic influences, and the result is a Van Morrison-inspired record--more rhythm and groove, more experiments and a wider choice of different instruments.

However one thing has not changed. The choice of producers--Peter van Hooke and keyboard player Rod Argent. Because of the duo's great expertise, Tikaram decided to continue the collaboration, although this time she played a more active role in the production process. Actually, the album, recorded at Bearsville Studios in Woodstock, NY, lists Tikaram as co-producer.

Richard Wootton Publicity handles all the PR for the new album. "It's not a change, but a progression," says Wootton. "She's a lot more confident, and much more involved."

Paul Charles of the Paul Asgard management company, who has been involved since the beginning, agrees, "While recording *The Sweet Keeper*, Tanita decided to try out another approach next time. Less overdubs, let's say a sort of 'live in the studio' atmosphere. And that worked out fine, thanks to the excellent musicians. You can feel the freshness about it."

Guest musicians include Mark Creswell (guitar), Nick France (drums) and Helen O'Hara (violin). Above all, there's a sparkling contribution by Jennifer Warnes on backing vocals, featured on the single and the track *Mud In Any Water*. The two, who are fans of each other, met at a club gig in LA and Warnes offered Tikaram her help.

It is a lot easier to become a successful artist than to stay at the top. But Tikaram proves that she has passed the stage of the always difficult third album gloriously. "People have asked her if she was worried about the third album, but she simply denies it," explains Wootton. "She's such a prolific songwriter with 60 songs waiting, ready to be recorded, she really didn't need to worry at all. And the initial response on the radio and in the printed media is very good."

Charles says there is no such thing as a 'third album anxiety', "Every new album is the most important thing for an artist, even if it's the 19th.".

The sleeves of both the single (her smiling face) and album (a bit 'mood shy') show a more self-conscious and mature artist. She has even got a new haircut. Says Wootton, "But that's not a deliberate new image, although record companies usually like such changes. She had her hair cut six months ago."

Together with forthcoming new albums by **Chris Rea** (*Auberge*) and **The Big Dish** (*Satellites*), Tikaram's new album is East West's major release of this year. TV spots are scheduled while an advertisement campaign will concentrate on full-page ads in the national UK press. Numerous TV appearances are planned, and radio-feedback from **BBC Radio 1, Capital** and **GLR** started this month.

A big promo tour will start in February, heavily concentrating on TV stations across Europe. Tikaram will appear on shows in G/A/S, Scandinavia, Holland, France, Italy and Spain, which are yet to be confirmed. Tikaram kicks off a world tour with UK and Irish dates in March. Wootton says, "A single, an album and a tour, well that's certainly a plan."

The single is already playlisted on Radio Forth/Edinburgh, Radio Clyde/ Glasgow, Chiltern Radio/ Northants Radio/Seven Sound, Downtown Radio/ Belfast, GWR/ Bristol/Swindon, Radio Broadland/ Norwich, Sky Radio/ Bussum, Holland, and Radio 21/Brussels.

## FRANCE

In France he's got an immense status, comparable to **Bruce Springsteen**. His seven previous albums, including two live albums, sold a combined seven million copies, good for one double gold, three double platinum and two diamond awards. The '87 album *Entre Gris Claire Et Gris Foncé* spent a record 70 consecutive weeks in the European Top 100 Albums and peaked at no. 10. The live double album *Traces* (1989) reached no. 12.

Goldman's sixth studio album is already double platinum in France (600.000 copies sold) after just two weeks. On this ambitious project, Goldman--looking for something new--is working with Welsh guitarist and singer Michael Jones and American voca-



list Carole Fredericks, sister of bluesman Taj Mahal. Also featured is Pino Paladino, star bass player with the Paul Young band. The result is a set of-well constructed, sophisticated pop songs.

Although Goldman has often openly stated his intention of not wanting to corrupt his music by translating his lyrics into English, the collaboration with Jones and Fredericks has presumably changed this. It is the first time that an album from Goldman has been released in the UK. According to **Annick Geisler**, international exploitation manager for Sony Music France, the English-language lyrics have not influenced the UK company to release the LP. "Things have changed considerably. The UK market is much more open-minded to non-Anglo-American material."

The comparison to Springsteen does not stop with sales figures and Goldman is planning a French stadium tour starting in May.

His sound is a melting pot of different styles, ranging from blues, funk and African-tinged rhythms. He is famous for his gifted guitar playing and IRS supremo Miles Copeland invited Daniele to join last year's Night Of The Guitar tour. Two years ago he appeared at the prestigious Montreux Jazz Festival.

Daniele often works with the crème de la crème of session musicians, such as bass player **Pino Palladino**, saxophonist **Mel Collins** and drummer **Jerry Marotta**. The new album features stand-up bass player **Harvey Schwarz** and guitarist **Mick Goodrich**.

## SYNDICATION

Concert promoters across Europe are currently scheduling tours for summer '91. And while artists intending to go on the road are traditionally unconfirmed in February, the radio syndication industry intends to be on the ball--just as it was throughout 1990.

n the past year, many radio stations have accumulated record totals of airtime given over to "first league" syndicated concerts, either live or on tape. These were almost always brought to EHR radio via a syndicator.

First-league artists touring in 1990 (with associated syndicator) included: the Rolling Stones and Paul McCartney (Radio Vision International); Sinead O'Connor (RVI/Unique Broadcasting); Phil Collins (MCM); David Bowie and Madonna (Westwood One); Eric Clapton and the Eurythmics (Unique), together with the so-called "super concerts" Knebworth 90 (Rock Over London), The Wall: Live In Berlin (RVI/MCM) and Nelson Mandela (ROL).

A major attraction in '91 for UK independent radio (IR) will be the third "Live Action Concert" series, syndicated by Unique Broadcasting. Taken predominantly by EHR FM stations, concerts in the past year included the Eurythmics, Fine Young Cannibals, Erasure, Eric Clapton, Don Henley, Tears For Fears and Anita Baker. It aired as a 13-part series.

Unique has also suggested a "Classic Concert" series for the burgeoning AM gold format, feat-

But a spokeswoman said no firm confirmation of Unique's intention to go ahead was available at press time.

#### Live Music Industry

Just how 1990 tour itineraries will schedule is not yet clear. At press time, the continuation of hostilities in the Gulf was seen as likely to have an adverse affect on the live music industry. Air travel is seen as hazardous.

Vanilla Ice, Neil Sedaka, Jennifer Rush and Phonogram heavy metal act Cinderella have all ditched European tour itineraries.

Putting these prolems aside, **Primary Talent International** (**PTI**)/London MD **Martin Hopewell** says it is "far too early to confirm actual artists" for a pan-European tour timetable, but he is nonetheless confident that, circumstances allowing, there will be no bucking of the touring growth trend of the past decade. PTI has 140 artists on its books.

"Recession and high interest rates do not appear to prevent huge numbers of people packing a stadium for a major artist," he says.

"I can't give you any names yet --artists don't know what they are doing three months from now, let alone for the whole summer--but major tours will definitely happen."

Research by M&M among various European (predominantly London-based) booking agents indicate tour itineraries from Paul Simon (UK only, May), Sting (UK only, April), AC/DC (Germany/UK, April), New Kids On The Block (Germany, May), Rod Stewart (Germany/UK, April/ May) and Gloria Estefan (tbc). No syndicators for these shows are yet confirmed.

#### Radio's Simulcast Bonus


Europe 2/France assistant programme director Laurence Crenn is clear on what her station wants of a concert, be it syndicated or not. "Exposure," she replies emphatically. Her views are typical of many CHR PDs.

"To simulcast a concert live on TV, for instance, is a good thing, because the channel speaks of us and we have our logo on television." About half the French station's live concerts are tied to television.

#### **Concerts On DAT**

Recorded concerts on Europe 2 use digital audio tape (DAT), schedule advertising and air earlier in the evening. According to Crenn, the station's closest working links with a syndicator are with US-based Westwood One.

Westwood One director international relations Bill Stolier offers an additional list of stations to which he has syndicated concerts "on a fairly consistent basis": RTL/France; NRJ Network/France; SPER Network/ Italy; Radio Ung/Oslo; OE3/Austria; Blue Danube Radio/Austria: SER Network/Spain; ARD affiliates/Germany; Radio City/ Helsinki; and Radio 957/Finland.

#### **Hours Per Week**

Just how much syndicated programming a station can air each week is mused over by Radio Aire/Leeds MD Phil Riley. He has averaged six or seven hours over a typical seven-day period on the FM service.

He says, "Syndication is fine if used sparingly and intelligently. These are programmes we couldn't afford to do ourselves and they feature presenters we wouldn't normally have but who really give the station profile a lift.

"The downside loss of station identity and localness can be balanced with IDs. I'd say eight hours maximum per week for any European CHR station.

It is against this background mirrored across most of Europe that syndicated programming is steadily building a presence on the Continent's airwayes.

## 'SIMUL-OPERATIONS' STRATEGY, PART 2

## **Flourishing Combos Of The Future**

In last week's article, we explained why applying a "simul-operation" can be beneficial in today's increasingly competitive climate. The collaboration of two or more stations in a single market can be the ideal way of staying competitive. This week we continue reporting on the wonderful effects simul-operation has had on stations around the world.

Examples of the potential success of simul-operating can be witnessed in parts of the world where licensing laws are less restrictive than the US. New Zealand broadcasting laws, for instance, allow multiple licences to be granted to one owner in a single market.

91FM retains its no. 1 ranking (10+ year olds) while Radio i maintains its appeal to an older audience. Radio Hauraki achieves a double-figure rating. The third CHR in the market, **89FM**, is knocked out of contention. In short, an admirable sales story for the **Independent Broadcasting Group** and one which will allow them to thrive,

In searching for a suitable simul-operations partner, the key should be demographic appeal in programming choices.

The owners of CHR station 91FM/Auckland purchased two additional major signals in the city. One, Radio Hauraki, was changed from CHR (reducing audience losses for 91FM) to AOR. which had never been tried in New Zealand before. The other, the AM/FM full-service MOR station Radio i, was split, with high-profile personalities re-maining on AM and a music intensive programme taking over the FM. The end result of these changes, as reflected in the most recent OTR survey, show how beneficial this co-operative programming planning can be.

despite the increasing number of signals in the Auckland market.

**Developing Niches** It is also important to note that this scenario has created a diversification of programming for the Auckland audience not previously available, namely an AOR station and a music intensive AC FM outlet. Without the

economies of scale the new joint ownership laws have permitted, it is doubtful the economic climate in New Zealand would have allowed broadcasters to take such a large programming risk. Likewise, in France, Europe 2 and Skyrock have developed individual programming niches in their respective AC and EHR formats.

The advantages speak for themselves: the concentration on older (25+) and younger (under 25) ends of the pop music spectrum allow the sales house to create package buys that blanket the market. The most recent **Mediametrie** survey results indicate that, for the second time running, the market leader (and their archrival) NRJ has been topped by the combined numbers of Europe 2 and Skyrock.

#### Practical Implications

In searching for a suitable simuloperations partner, the key aim should be demographic appeal in the programming choices. They should be distinctively different. to avoid unnecessary cannibalisation of existing audience. After all, the idea is to extend audiences as much as possible beyond that already attracted to one or both of the stations. At the same time, some kind of psychographic match between the two stations would be an easier sell for most advertisers. Thus, one avoids having to explain why a single buy could impact widely divergent audiences (say, both CHR and classical music listeners), even if their demographic make-up matches the buy.

From a sales standpoint, the synergy becomes more profitable

as the efficiency of each salesperson increases. By giving additional opportunities to a staff that has typically dealt with a soldout log, additional income can be generated. But the tactics of this different selling environment need careful consideration to maximise the positive impact. As long as the audiences of the two stations complement each other, the sponsors will benefit, and buys increase accordingly.

#### Forging Relationships

Ultimately, any successful simuloperation is based upon the need to forge a mutually beneficial agreement between the two operators. Using today's most sophisticated techniques for targeting audience through effective programming, marketing and promotions, the resultant combo is made stronger and more efficient. with weak ratings or sales performance in their market, as suitable partners. A format search establishes the viability of any open market niches or under-achieving formats. Once a simul-operation is agreed upon, a review of programming and sales staffing indicates possible ways of sharing workload and/or avoiding unnecessary duplication of manpower and facilities.

After fine-tuning both formats to eliminate audience duplication, the ongoing success of the project depends upon careful planning of all marketing, promotional and contesting efforts to ensure there is no overlap of effort.

Joint co-operative promotional efforts can be successful for station formats with completely different audience targets as they save the expense of having to do separate campaigns. For

Existing successful operators should start looking for stations with weak ratings or sales performance in their market, as suitable partners.

Not only can this lead to greater profitability, it may be necessary in many markets for mere survival. Certainly changes in FCC multiple ownership laws would help accelerate this process in the US. But even under current laws there are plenty of possibilities.

Existing successful operators should start looking for stations

those with the determination to work within the system and still achieve increased market share, simul-operation may be the way forward to flourishing in the radio business of the 1990s.

**Dealing With Portugal's Ever-Changing Audience**

for **Radiodiffusao Portuguesa** (RDP), the largest public radio station in Portugal. It was founded in August 1935. The channel features a broad mix of news, information and music, while our second public channel, **Antena 2** concentrates on classical music.

"There have been many changes within radio broadcasting in Portugal and there are more to come. We have had more competition from private radio stations, so during the last year we have had a radical rethink on policy to reflect the changing tastes of the public.

"Around 50% of the music played originates from Portuguese artists, not just pop and rock groups, but from other areas of music, like jazz and easy listening. At the moment, we do not have a chat show but it is possible that, from spring, there will be some kind of chart broadcast by the station, based on listeners' requests and a record's general popularity.

"Our target audience varies considerably according to the



time of day. Early-morning programmes carry a lot of news, weather and traffic information and are aimed more at those living in big cities. Mid-morning programmes carry a lot of pop music content and then between

14.00-17.00 there is a considerable emphasis on international pop and rock music with an element of Portuguese rock thrown in too.

"At the weekend we carry quite a lot of jazz music on Saturdays and there is a three-

hour pop segment in the afternoon. Then there is a switch in musical emphasis to easy-listening and golden oldies. Sunday programmes feature music mixed in with discussions and programmes on serious topics like the drug problem, ecology, the preservation of Portuguese monuments and the economy.

"Occasionally we broadcast live concerts from around the country, usually featuring domestic acts, but there is also a tiein with the national TV channel when we broadcast, in stereo, the music from concerts they are showing.

"Increasing competition has forced us to make various changes including better sound, improved programme formats and better presentations. It is important to have a more modern image and I believe that we are succeeding in this, and becoming much more competitive. It helps that we have five local production centres throughout Portugal which constantly feed through ideas."

Station reports include all new additions to the playlist, indicated by the abbrevia-tion "AD". Reports from certain stations will also include records on the "A" list records on the "A" list (heavy rotation) and, in some cases, on the "B" list (medium rotation). A number of stations feature a "Power Play" ("PP"), a track which receives special emphasis for the week. The "LP" designadesignation reflects the new album(s) added.

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



by Megadeth and Poison are currently being negotiated.

Comments Chrysalis international director Mike Allen, "The impact on us was most unfortunate. Three of our US acts, all travelling at the same time, have cancelled." Elisa Fiorello dropped a promo trip to Tokyo. Also, New York rap act Gangstarr decided to lay off their European promo trip. The band are due back in Europe in March.

Pop metal band Slaughter were forced to cancel their support slot with Mercury act Cinderella on their European tour but are also looking to reschedule.

"Since timing is of such importance in these matters, you'll inevitably lose some business," continues Allen. "We haven't really altered our spending levels nor have we been involved in the rescheduling of records. I do think that, if things don't get worse, the initial rush of cancellations will stop.

Similar sentiments are echoed by BMG International senior VP A&R/marketing Chris Stone. "It would be rather pointless if we were to allow the business to be paralysed. Although we're not travelling as much as we used to be, we do so when necessary. But we leave it up to the individuals whether they decide not to travel from A to B." Apart from Dionne Warwick, who cancelled a concert tour in Britain, no BMG artists have postponed European dates.

A spokesperson at Warner Music International says "four tours are planned for the immediate future of which only one is cancelled". It is believed these include AC/DC, Rod Stewart and Paul Simon and that the Dwight Yoakam tour is temporarily off.

Sony Music International had one cancellation--Harry Connick Jr.--while two other promo trips were cut back: Susanna Hoffs and C&C Music Factory. Sony acts on tour in Europe include Bob Dylan, Darden Smith and Warrant. At MCA and Virgin, no cancel-

lations have been reported. The only PolyGram act to have cancelled at press time are Cinderella

When M&M went to press, the list of US acts cancelling European dates was steadily growing. Latest additions include LL Cool J, En Vogue and Winger.

Dire Straits are believed to have put back their world tour from summer to autumn.

plementation of MCA artist campaigns in all territories outside the UK and North America. Senior VP international Stuart Watson says to move will give the label greater control over the marketing and promotion at local levels.

Griffin will join MCA on February 11. He will co-ordinate marketing activities in Germany, where MCA is starting a fullyfledged company, and Japan, where the label will be establishing a new company, MCA-Victor.

Currently, two executives are in place, Jörg Eiben, at BMG Hamburg, and Fred Schreuder, at BMG Ariola in Hilversum, Holland. Both are MCA/Geffen marketing managers. New appointments, including an MD at the Hamburg office, are expected soon.

"I will not be waving the big stick from London," comments Griffin, "but do an overall co-ordinating job. Generally, I want the input to come from the label managers, who know their local markets best."

Germany is an obvious spot for MCA to open up new offices. The label has enjoyed its biggest turnover in Germany and the MCA and Geffen labels combined are expected to generate US\$ 25 million in 1991.

Although ARD still has 12 regular shows which offer music slots--mainly within broader variety, talk or quiz formats--and ZDF has seven such opportunities, label executives report these to be very specialised, with pop and rock taking a back seat to volksmusik and schlager.

Germany's private stations have also given music a minor role in schedules. Sat 1 and RTL Plus each offer slots on their weekly personality shows. RTL Plus also has a weekly youth magazine, "Ragazzi", which includes artist interviews and video clips.

However, Tele 5, which formerly featured clips extensively, now airs most after midnight. The channel still offers an hour-long Saturday slot, "POP"

Phonogram head of TV promotion Peter Angemeer sums up the reaction of most executives M&M surveyed, "The TV scene has got much worse in the past two to three years. We feel the loss of 'Formel Eins' and the drastic reduction of videos on Tele 5 particularly acutely."

"TV is still the most important medium for exposure," adds Angemeer. WEA Germany marketing manager Bernd Dopp comments, "It has become very difficult to break new artists on TV, although the power of TV cannot be generalised. Other elements, such as timing, are important too".

Dopp cites MTV Europe as "the only viable music station now".

Sony Music Germany marketing manager Hubert Wandio says. "The big programmes that are left will only feature such established celebrities as Jennifer Rush, Julio Iglesias or Phil Collins. There are very few programmes for young artists, and these are banished to impossible time slots.

Metronome head of A&R and marketing Oliver Helwig agrees that only "big-name MOR acts" are

accompanying table). RTL's rating grew 5.9%, giving it a liste-ning share of 25.3%, up from 23.9%. That's more than double that of the next station Europe 1, which had a small decrease to 12.1% listening share from 12.7%

Overall, FM grabbed a 38.1% share, up 3.3% from 36.9%, while AM listening share dropped to 38.8% from 39.6%. Listening share for Radio France--the public network which comprises France Inter, France Musique, France Culture, France Info, FIP and RFI--grew only 1.1%.

On a station-per-station basis, Europe 2 was a big winner during the quarter. Its listening share increased to 5.8% from 4.5%.
