Sony Germany Splits **Marketina Units**

by Machgiel Bakker

In order to cope with the increasing volume of releases, Sony Music Germany will separate its artist marketing operation into five independent departments. Focusing on distinct repertoire, the units are to act as individual profit centres with specialized A&R and marketing staff. A centralized promotion force (CP), headed by Manfred Haller, will supply specialized staff to the different units as needed.

PRS-Style Agreement **Emerging At UK Tribunal**

Closed talks are underway between UK record companies and commercial radio stations at the Copyright Tribunal, which started June 29, in an attempt to solve continuing disagreements over broadcast royalties. At presstime an agreement had yet to be reached.

Sources close to the negotiations say the pact which is near agreement will be closely based on the existing five-year contract between the commercial radio industry and the Performing Rights Society (PRS), which is the collecting agency for artists, (continues on page 14)

Antena 3 Tops SER In News/Talk

SER's Los 40 Principales may still be top of the league in Spanish radio despite its 7% audience loss, but network Antena 3 Convencional has managed to inch ahead in the news/talk rankings for the first time in years, registering 3.068.000 listeners-4.000 more than SER Convencional. That is according to the first 1992 quarterly findings from the media research group Estudio General de Medios

The biggest increase in ratings was registered by Onda Cero Convencional, up 38% on the last figures to 1.471.000 listeners. Meanwhile, SER's

all-Spanish music net Cadena Dial continues to rise, up 26% to 934.000 listeners.

News/talk radio in general gained more listeners during period, is reaching 12.748.000 people—6% more than the October-November study, FM music nets together lost 12.000 listeners, posting a total of 7.149.000.

Antena 3 PD Jose Ramon Pardo attributes the news/talk net's success to the tighter control on the news service by news programming director Herrero, assumed his post last January. He was also pleased about the continuing audience increase of Radio 80 (Gold), which regis-(continues on page 14)

NY New Music Seminar Attracts Int'l Interest

The New Music Seminar (NMS), the annual American music and radio convention held in New York, has become one of the major world events in the industry, as international registration broke the 30% mark for the first

The most important delegations came from Canada, UK. Japan and Spain. The latter was the most high-profile, celebrating the 500th anniversary of Columbus' voyage to America, which included various musical events coordinated by the Spanish Performing Right Society (SGAE).

NMS joint director Tom Silverman believes the NMS was "possibly one of the best seminars we ever had," and explains that this year it was "deliberately smaller, more focused, more business-oriented and more international." Meanwhile, the number of shows remained as impressive as the previous years, with 500 acts playing in 32 different locations during the New Music Nights.

The overall attendance was just over 7.000 participants, compared to almost 8.000 during the last two years—a little bit below target, but more in keeping with the new focussed line-up, says Silverman, who believes this downturn is also a direct consequence of the economical situa-

He reports, "Last year, we lost about US\$70.000, and it seems likely that this year we are going to lose significantly more. We have to cut more costs next year and hope that the trend will turn

Nevertheless, the power of

attraction of the NMS for international labels and acts remains solid. Niall Stokes of Irish magazine Hot Press claims that "the US is more open to Irish music than the UK and offers more business options." One of the newcomers to have a stand was a representative for the Danish music industry. Mikael Hojris of the Danish music export organization believes that despite the expense. "it is important for professionals to attend these types of conventions to learn how different markets operate." Hojris says that there is a good chance the Danes will renew the operation next year, claiming that "it would be stupid to come just once; you have to let things grow."

This view is echoed by Finnish rock label Poko Records MD Kari Helenius. "It is the first time we have a stand at NMS because we thought it was time to do something visible. We organized a showcase with four of our bands [Barbie Bones, Poverty Stinks, 22 Pisterpirkko and Leningrad Cowboys]. We don't expect record deals immediately. This initial effort is to help us gain international credibility. investment is worth the trial," he

French indie label Bondage's Eric Daugu-Debris is less positive however, saying that sending a band to perform creates a lot of logistic problems. "I don't have the feeling that it works as well as the previous years. A lot of people in the US industry don't attend the convention any more and there are more and more foreign companies trying to sell their products. Competition is heating up and you have to be very patient.'

CSA Awards Frequencies For Paris & The Ile-De-France Region

The long-awaited allocation of frequencies for Paris and the Ilede-France region was announced on June 15.

Of the 194 applications sub-

mitted to the CSA, 123 stations and/or networks have retained their frequency and four new stations received licences. BFM, Radio Plurielle, La Vie and Africa No. 1. Fifty of the licences awarded are in Paris and 77 are in

the Ile-de-France.

There were no great surprises. but already the CSA is being criticized for its decisions, especially from Category A stations (nonprofit local stations). Although FM in Paris has undergone little change, the protests are likely to mount over the next few weeks.

This is the first major rearrangement of the capital's airwaves since 1987, and the 127 stations were selected by the CSA to "improve the ease of listening." The criteria used to select candidates were the format, the economic viability of the station's business plans and whether the station follows radio legislation. In Paris, only 40 frequencies were available, with the result that for

the next five years, eight stations will be obliged to share frequen-

With the exception of L'Onde Latine (95% French music), which had submitted an application for Paris for the first time, all the musical networks received a frequency, as did all the generalist stations. Amusement park Park Asterix received a frequency as well, although competitor Euro Disney's application was denied. Radio Asie lost the frequency it shared with Radio Courtoisie, despite the fact that the former claims to serve a community of 200.000 people. Four Marketing, Promotion Staffers Let Go At MCA

Four marketing and promotions staff members at MCA Records have been ousted in the last two weeks as part of a restructuring of the division initiated by new general manager/marketing Joe

Let go were head of promotions Phil Smith, head of marketing David Bower, marketing assistant Melody Howard and senior press officer John Roy. Senior radio promotion manager Miranda Leckie resigned following the dismissal of her colleagues.

Smith's replacement is to be a RCA man, Damian Christian, while another ex-RCA staffer is joining MCA as senior product manager. Sally Edwards is being brought in as independent promoter to handle radio promotions. Bower is not to be replaced.

Formerly head of marketing at RCA Records, Cokell joined MCA last year, replacing promotion director Bob Fisher who left in September '91.

MCA MD Tony Powell comments, "Everything has to move forward. We are no different from any other business. I brought Jeff Young in to beef up the A&R department one year ago. John Pearson to handle sales and now I've brought in Joe Cokell to do the same with marketing." Powell says the redundancies were Cokell's decision.

Powell comments, "It's very

hard to see people like Smith going, who was not just a colleague, but a friend too. But as MD of a record company, it's something that I just have to bear.'

Smith, who has been with the company for 10 years, is accusing Cokell of behaving "like a football manager wanting to bring in his own men."

Smith says he is trying not to feel bitter about what has happened, but comments, "I've been very much part of the success of this company and I'm being replaced by a radio plugger with far less experience."

Chiltern Trims Losses, Eyes South West 'Regional' INR3 Franchises

The Chiltern Radio Network (CRN), operator of 10 independent local radio (ILR) stations, has trimmed its pre-tax losses to £179.000 (app. US\$304.000) in the six months to March 31 compared to £234.000 the same time

A modest boost in advertising revenue, increased market share and acquisitions led to an advance in turnover to £2.5million against £1.7million last time.

CRN's national revenue skyrocketed 83% from the previous period, while local advertising revenue rose 9%. Local revenue accounts for about three quarters of the group's total turnover.

In a statement, CRN chairman Peter Burton says he is optimistic the group would continue to recover. "Even with a flat economy, we will be moving ahead."

executives, Burton is cautious about the future with regard to advertising. "We have seen a lot of false dawns. A number of things have strengthened us. But we don't want to send out any over-optimistic signals."

Meanwhile, it has been hinted CRN will bid for the "regional" ILR franchise for the south-west area, for a service expected to reach about 1.5 million adults. CRN currently operates specialist format station Galaxy Radio/ Bristol in that region.

Chiltern is also said to be looking at the possibility of bidding for the country's speechbased formatted third independent national network, which has yet to be advertised by the Radio Authority. MMC

A&R Is Key To Sony's Future, Says De Bodinat

Sony Music France president Henri de Bodinat is increasing his focus on A&R in an effort to raise the company's share in the local

The first in a series of changes will be the appointment of a new MD at the Columbia label in September following the departure of Patrick Decam. Second on the agenda is the creation of a fourth imprint, Sony Music Associated Label, scheduled to come into operation in September. De Bodinat describes this as a "very specialized label which would serve as a nursery for acts that deserve special treatment. These acts, both local and international, would either come from Sony Music affiliates around the world or would be signed from independent labels." Asked why he decided to put more

strength into A&R and duplicate its sources, De Bodinat says, "Both the industry and CBS/Sony Music have overestimated the importance of marketing these past few years. But by far the key position in a record company is the A&R. Marketing and promotion should revolve around A&R. I believe that if Sony Music wants to expand its market share, it will be through its capacity to attract new acts and to develop careers.

To support this new policy De Bodinat has also decided to increase emphasis on sales. Under the supervision of MD Jan-Claude Gastineau and sales director Jean-François Loury, the sales force has been expanded in order to cover the different outlets selling pre-recorded music. A specific sales force for classical music has already been created.

Comments De Bodinat, "Our

priority is to have the best sales force possible. What's the use of having all the radio airplay you can imagine if records are not in the retailers' racks? The change in our commercial policy is meant to give Sony Music the tools to develop different types of artists in all types of reper-

toires."

The company's Ffr1.3 billion (app. US\$0.2 billion) turnover is split as follows: 45% from the three labels (Columbia 25%, Epic 15% and Squatt 5%), 30% from special marketing (compilations, special products and low-price back catalogue), distributed labels 15% and classical 10%.

De Bodinat also reports that he is considering establishing a fifth label which could be added "by acquisition." It is no secret that Sony Music has an eye on indie label Trema, rumoured to have been for sale for some time. He declined to comment any more than saying, "From an artistic point of view Trema is interesting."

De Bodinat says his ambition for Sony Music in 1992 is to have "at least the same market share [as in 1991], and to reach the same level of profitability." He remains cautious, however, saying, "In these troubled times, we have to carefully plan our expenses.

He forecasts a national market growth of only 3%-5% for 1992, but is anxious that the company consolidate its position in the market. Although he declined to reveal the company's profits, industry sources estimate that it has reached 15% turnover. "Our increase in turnover for the first months of the year was good compared with the market growth, so I am confident," comments De Bodinat. He points out that five of the Ton 10 albums and 10 of the first 20 albums charted at the end of May were Sony product, while the company had up to 35% of the charts positions in the singles chart. He also says out that Sony Music France has a 20% market share, one of the highest market penetration rates of all the national Sony Music affiliates.

Austrian Clubs Stick To U 96

While U 96 fever has faded in Germany, their techno hit *Das Boot* is still in the Austrian Top 10 singles chart after over two months. The song has disappeared from the Top 10 charts in every other country except Norway.

Das Boot (currently number 6 in the sales chart) has now gone gold in Austria with sales of 25.000, while I Wanna Be A Kennedy (number 7) has sold several thousand copies. Polydor Germany head of progressive music Tim Renner is bemused by the staying power of both U 96 singles in Austria. He*says,

"We knew that these records would chart later in Austria than in Germany because the market there moves slower. We didn't expect it to stay in the Top 10 for quite so long, though. What I find especially strange is that there haven't been any techno records in the singles chart before U 96. You don't really think of Austrians being into techno."

PolyGram Austria is just as puzzled by U 96 chart dominance as anyone else. International A&R manager Wulf Müller says, "I really can't explain why it has stayed there so long. It was bound to be a hit because of the great influence that German Hit Parade and German media have on sales in Austria Techno records like this do not get radio airplay here, so I think the main reason for U 96's success here is that the records are still getting very heavy play in all the discos. When people keep hearing a good record in a club, they go out and buy the 12" version.'

Müller's explanation is backed by Antenne Austria head of music Mario Weitzl. He says, "Das Boot and has stayed in the chart so long because the clubs keep on playing the record. Our station has never played it. Techno as a trend is out in Austria, but this record stirs up memories of the film Das Boot and makes it more accessible than the average techno record."

BLM Awards New Licence

The Bavarian Broadcasting Commission (BLM) has issued a licence for a new local radio station in Berchtesgaden and has allowed the reorganization of local stations in Kaufbeuren/Füssen and Bayreuth.

Radio Lindau will hook onto the regional network station BLR which will provide hourly national and international news coverage as well as the regular programmes, while prime time will be taken up with local broadcasts.

Meanwhile, the commission has also frozen the application of potential cable radio stations until a new revision of the present statewide rules and regulations is finished.

Berliner Rundfunk Names New PD

The former DDR public station Berliner Rundfunk, which became a private station earlier this year, has announced the appointment of Uwe Frigge as its new PD. Frigge was previously chief editor at Antenne Bayern, the statewide private station in Bavaria.

In addition, popular news and sports

TV reporter Günther Jauch will be joining the station as programme coordinator. A 25% share of the station has been acquired by the newspaper Berliner Zeitung. The station plans to open a new studio in Potsdam in addition to their Berlin headquarters, and will have permanent correspondents in the cities of Cottbus and Frankfurt/Oder. MS

Radio Aachen Increases Power

Local private radio station Radio Aachen has upped the power of its transmitters from 100 to 400 watts. Radio Aachen went on the air on

Radio Aachen went on the air on February I and carries five hours of local programming. The other hours are taken up by programmes from the regional network station Radio NRW/Oberhausen which also provides the hourly five-minute news broadcasts. Radio NRW will be carried by 43 local stations in the state of North Rhein-Westphalia by the Spring of 1993. The other three stations licensed in the state are the stations for the areas Aachen, Heinzberg and Düren. These have opted for the regional network broadcasts from Radio RTL/Stuttgart.

Mazzucato Launches Promotions Service

Cesare Mazzucato, former programme director at the private regional station Radio Padova/Padova, has launched Citizen Kane Communication, a firm which aims to provide record companies with a comprehensive inter-regional promotions service.

The company has a staff of three and currently operates in the northern area of Veneto, Friuli-Venezia Giulia and Trentino-Alto Adige. Says Mazzucato, "I discovered that there is little rapport between major record companies, local radio/TV stations and the press in these regions. My first task is to establish which are the important players. With radio stations it may not be the ones with the most listeners, but those with the right formats for certain product. With Citizen Kane Communication I hope to prove to the multinational record companies that they can sell more records by collaborating with us.

Mazzucato has discovered that product is often not stocked by local retailers. "There's little point in acts or artists getting radio airplay or local TV exposure if consumers can't find their product in the shops," he says. "Tve found that in a city like Padova, for example, only CD releases are available. These are no good for DJs who need vinyl to re-mix. Record companies need to know this."

Citizen Kane Communication's first client is **Polydor**, and the first act to be involved in interregional marketing and promotion package is UK band Candyland, (Suck It And See). The deal included a brief concert tour, a press conference for local newspapers/TV stations and radio airplay on Radio Dolomite/Bolzano, Radio Company/Treviso and Radio Padova/Padova. A similar exercise is slated for Chris De Burgh, although Mazzucato was unsure whether the artist will be available for tour dates.

Polydor marketing manager Giovanni Arcovito acknowledges the difficulty in breaking talent on the domestic market. "It's not enough to rely on national network stations like Rete 105, Radio Deejay and RTL 102.5 Hit Radio, however good those stations may be," he says. "The idea with Candyland is to see if we can get some regional success for a band like this."

Arcovito says Polydor supplies Citizen Kane Communication with soundcarriers, promotional displays and posters, plus the act or artist whenever possible. "Mazzucato will then get involved in radio promotion with stations that we do not work with, but which are more important than key network stations at a local cultural level," he explains. "He will also organize press conferences for local newspapers and magazines. Our collaboration with Citizen Kane Communication will be very selective, however. It wouldn't work with every act or artist."

Arcovito is optimistic about the deal with Citizen Kane. "Our Milan and Rome promotion offices operate excellently. But you have to have a presence in places to know the local rules and customs. The Veneto area, in particular, should be good saleswise because it is very rich."

De Anton Builds Battle Plan For Cadena Minuto

Jorge de Anton, 51, the new PD of SER's AC network Cadena Minuto, is no stranger to the company. He first worked in its PR and promotion department in 1965. He left a year later for stints with other stations including Madrid station Radio España and the defunct trend-setting Onda 2. In the mid-'80s, he divided his time between the US, Europe and South America, with studies and various music-related activities. In 1989, he returned to SER's Cadena Minuto as programming chief until October 1990 when he left to take up the post of PD at Radio 16/Madrid. A year later, he set out on his own until May of this year when SER asked him once more to manage Cadena Minuto's programming.

"I wouldn't have returned if I had not been given a free rein in re-designing the net's programming." he comments, defining the

format as "a wise mix of '70s, '80s and '90s music."

He admits that the inclusion of new releases "is probably the most radical change I'm introducing. Novelties are to be aired at once and not made to rise through

the rotation system as in the past," pointing out that the fundamental problem in AC radio lies in achieving a coherent sound. He is

presently selecting new voices, jingles and preparing for the real battle in September with rival networks Cadena 100 and Onda Cero Musica, which will be targeting similar audiences with an entirely different sound. "There is

no magic formula for success; the audience will determine the winner," he says.

Though there is a risk that this could lead to an overlap with the programming of sister net EHR Los 40 Principales, he is confident that the general sound will be distinct.

The ratio of Spanish music at Cadena Minuto-currently at 20%—has traditionally been low. De Anton attributes this to the fact that the great majority of local releases are directed at the teen end of the traditional Spanish folk market. De Anton criticized the quotas imposed in France, saying, "I don't want to turn my back on Spanish product, but there really isn't much to choose from. Any kind of limitation or regulation on programming choices is an assault on a station's freedom." AMdlF

Norway Radio Authority Monitors Syndication

Norwegian radio authority Nærkringkastingsnemnda (NKN) will intensify controls on the quantity of syndicated programming aired on Norwegian local and commercial radio stations. That is according to an announcement printed in the June issue of the Local Radio Association newsletter.

The NKN stipulates that at least 75% of the stations' programming should be produced in-house. An injunction sent from NKN to some 300 licensees on January 27 and March 18, has asked stations to report how airtime is spent. A total of 50 stations have not reported as vet. A source in NKN comments that it is not that stations have anything to hide, just that they forget to report. No stations have been taken off the air as of yet; they have only received strong warnings.

Oslo-based Radio Tango PD Sverre Bjornsen agrees with NKN, saying, "The principal behind local radio is that programming should be produced locally. I feel that 25% syndicated programming is too much." Bjornsen cites the example of a station based in Bardu, north Norway, which broadcasts Voice Of America's programmes 24 hours a day, saying, "That is wrong. The point of a local radio completely disappears." Radio Tango intends to devotes less than 10% of its airtime to syndicated programmes.

Radio Vest/Stavanger head of music Bjarte Tjostheim agrees with Bjornsen, "Local commitment has been our policy all the way. For us it is unthinkable to broadcast as much as 25% syndicated programming. The NKN statement will not affect Radio Vest, as the staffers produce most of their programmes themselves anyway. This industry needs a clean-up. In order to achieve more professional stations, there must be stricter rules."

Tango Takes Over Slots From Bankrupt Limelight

Oslo-based AOR Radio Tango took over Radio Limelight's 06.00-12.00 slot on June 22, one week after Radio Limelight—broadcasting on the same frequency—suddenly declared itself bankrupt.

Radio Tango Michael Breines Oredam has been working for one and a half years to get the morning slot, and has finally succeeded. "It is about time. But we are keeping a low profile and not marketing ourselves as yet," he says, explaining that the station is awaiting authorization from the local radio authority Nærkringkastingsnemnda (NKN) to broadcast under its own name. Tango now has 160 hours of airtime a week and is broadcasting up-tempo classic rock for the 20-44 age bracket in an attempt to become the market leader in its target group and to take over market shares from the current Oslo market leader, EHR-formatted Radio 1. Tango currently name, but is not carrying Limelight station IDs.

Limelight's trustee in bankruptcy and 63% shareholder Norsk Radioutvikling (NRU) was behind the move, and has been hired by one of the new Radio Tango shareholders, Fram Radioreklame, to develop the station's programming.

Oredam continues, "This is part of the format battle currently taking place in Oslo between rock [Radio Tango] and EHR [Radio 1]." Radio Tango has a weekly average of 125.800 listeners, against Radio 1's 260.000. Oredam plans to add three or four new people to its staff.

Uncertainly Surrounds Norwegian P4 Licence Date

Four months since the deadline for applications, the race for the fourth national Norwegian station stands between companies P4 A/S, previously known as the No.1 Radios, and Radio Hele Norge A/S (RHN), with Kinnevik as a major shareholder.

How long the selection process is likely to take, however, is less certain. The Ministry of Cultural Affairs (MoCA) is currently gathering details of programming and financing from the applicants, after which time it will grant one or possibly both of the applicants the rights to negotiate with Televerket (the Norwegian equivalent to AT&T) for a technical set-up. Consideration will be given to combination of format, size of bid and financial feasibility. The selected will then negotiate with Televerket for two or three months.

Some 20 programmers on BRTN and RTBF will work on the Capitol story over the summer, and De Cock is convinced that the comprehensive "Capitol-biography" will inspire press to follow.

Says BRTN's Radio 2/Antwerp producer Hilde Dewindt, "The contents of the six CDs is Radio 2-

oriented, with material ranging from Peggy Lee to the Beach Boys. The historical aspect is also very important; what we hear now is the nucleus of 50 years of music history; proven winners."

At Radio 2's Brabant channel, producer **Luc Mertens** kicks off a weekly "Capitol spotlight" in his Monday 08.00-10.00 show "De Muziekmakers" ("The Music Makers"), hosted by **Chris Jonckers**. "We will announce the specials in several programmes and will have a Capitol competition on during the summer," he says.

CNR Release Second Gert & Samson CD

What originally started as a children's programme on the Flemish state broadcaster-BRTN TV has become a real phenomenon in Flanders. "Gert & Samson," a show hosted by TV presenter Gert Verhulst and his dog character Samson, have generated a consumer value of over Bfrl.5 billion (app. US\$ 45 million) in sales of merchandising and licensing deals. Their album debut Gert & Samson Vol. 1 topped the 1991 Belgian year-end IFPI charts before international artists like Dire Straits, Queen

and Bryan Adams.

On June 21, the Belgian media were invited to witness the launch of Gert & Samson's second release. With sales of Gert & Samson Vol. 1 exceeding 150.000 in Flanders alone, record company CNR have set a new mark in domestic sales.

Says CNR Belgium MD Rik Blomme, "The figure only represents sales in Flanders--half the Belgian population. This is a top achievement, and certainly the Benelux's best-selling children's product."

Blomme added that, with quadruple platinum for *Vol. I* (52 weeks on the IFPI charts in Belgium) and 50.000 units in preorders of *Gert & Samson Vol. 2*, plans were finalized to cross the border to Holland, where **Veronica** will start broadcasting the children's TV show beginning September 29, followed by the release of the first volume of the CD.

The launch of the *Gert & Samson Vol.* 2 CD is planned for September 13-15 at the **Platentiendaagse** in Utrecht. *MM*

STATION OPERATIONS

13 Ways To Build A Better Breakfast Show

1. Get Help

Help is always available, and much of it doesn't cost a dime. Ask local actors, comics, teachers and experts to help expand your show out of its comfort zone.

2. Stay Local

Are there historic tours in your town? Call the historical society, which is a terrific source of local colour. Get in touch with your library, newsmakers and politicians, local sports figures. Regularly get your breakfast show personality or team for lunch with important people.

3. Networking

Establish dialogue with the PDs and personalities of other stations with successful morning shows. Get airchecks, trade content, borrow ideas. Never use an idea verbatim from someone else. That was their personality. Change it-make it yours and make sure it plays in your market.

4. Produced Sounds

Adding production to your show with music, competition sound effects and phone calls gives energy, flow and forward momentum. Production is only passe when it becomes cliched and predictable.

Don't be afraid to use dropins, bells, and horns-anything that adds theatre-of-the-mind and doesn't obscure your genuineness as a personality or the point of your content.

5. Read, Read, Read

Be a "culture vulture." Read newspapers, listen to other stations, watch TV-especially the popular programmes in your market. Videotape shows that you can't stay up or be home to see.

6. Character-ize

The best angle is always the local one. Use local public officials, TV personalities, news, sports and weather as character voices. Never write a bit without knowing the payoff first.

7. Pre-record & Edit

Listener phone bits, character voices, put-ons, impressions and mini-dramas should all be prepared in advance in production. Be certain the production and voices don't get in the way of what you are trying to say.

Never put callers on-air live. Record off-air and edit mercilessly, making sure everything is structured like this: set-up, reaction, punch line.

8. Find Other **Sources Of Comedy**

Cut out comics from the newspaper and ask yourself, "How can I do this on radio?" Read local papers and gossip columnists before going on the air. Don't try to get by with reading the paper while doing your show. Go in with too much material and use only the best stuff.

9. Keep it Simple

Use common sense, good judgment and keep your target listener in mind at all times

10. Mention Listener Birthdays

This is like a politician kissing a

baby or shaking a hand. He doesn't do it because he likes it, he does it because it works.

In politics, the person whose hand was shaken or the parent whose kid was kissed never forgets that "brush with greatness" and at least considers voting for that politician. In radio, mentions of birthdays and anniversaries have a similar effect. A listener has a better feeling for you and your station if you mention them or air their voice.

11. Keep A Diary

Write it down when you think of it! Partial ideas, phrases, thoughts, promotions, brain-storms all get committed to paper. Keep your diary with you at all times, especially when watching TV or reading the newspaper.

12. Do A New Thing **Every Day**

The more and different stimuli you have every day, the better writer/creative thinker you become. Expand your horizons. Read a magazine you'd never buy.

13. Step Out Of Your Box

To "step out of the box" means to think in unusual ways, twist ideas to new angles or to view subjects inside out. For example:

Do listeners really depend on your morning trivia at 7.20? If it wasn't on anymore would your station die? Would a fresh feature grab new ears and perk up old

demo-which went bankrupt three weeks ago-also lost its frequency. Meanwhile the two associative radio stations, Lucrece and Paris will disappear, and Electric FM, which began broadcasting the BBC French service at the end of last year, was also unplugged.

One of the most interesting developments is the confirmation of Frequence Paris Plurielle on the FM band. It will be, to all intents and purposes, an associative frequency which will allow any association to broadcast a programme for a set fee. Africa No. 1, the Gabonese station (40% of which is owned by Sofirad) which was given a temporary broadcasting authorization for two weeks last spring, received a permanent frequency as did La Vie/Telerama, a debate-show frequency owned by the press group La Vie which will take over frequencies from Superloustic.

One of the big surprises was that L'Onde Latine did not receive a frequency, given the CSA support for French music and the fact that 95% of that network's programming is French. Many of the stations in Category A were also not pleased. Radio Alfa, the Portuguese station, had mounted a protest outside the CSA offices within hours of the announcement of their exclusion from the



OFF THE RECORD

WONDER OF WOOLLIES: While the rest of British retailers are oohing and ahhing about the proposed Breakers Chart, retail chain Woolworths is currently reviewing a new in-house singles chart system in its stores. The system is only in the early stages of review at the moment, but Woolworths does reveal that it will be based on "what's best for the customer." If it all goes ahead, Woolworths will be the first retailer to use its own singles chart in the UK.

STEALING THE SHOW: EHR Antenne Bayern/Munich stole the glory somewhat from Michael Jackson tour sponsors Bayern 3 at last week's Munich concert. While the name Bayern 3 was only to be seen on the back of the concert tickets, Antenne Bayern had banners flying above the stadium and some 30-40 promotion people mingling with the crowds giving out leaflets. Apparently most of the people at the concert, when asked, thought that Antenne Bayern was the official sponsor!

WELL DONE DENMARK: The Danish Roskilde music festival altered its time schedule around the European Cup final on June 26. Groups performing that day had their slots moved forward or back one hour to allow the Danish fans to go and watch the match. Bands playing after the match report having never played to such an ecstatic audience.

NEW ITALIAN MINISTER OF POST AND TELECOMMUNICATIONS: Italian social democrat politician Maurizio Pagani has been appointed minister of post and telecommunications in a new government formed on June 28. Pagani takes over from Carlo Vizzini who is also a member of the Social Democrat Party. Is the radio sector optimistic that broadcast legislation, first approved in 1990, will now be implemented quickly? More next week.

MERCURY LONDON CELEBRATION: Mercury US president Ed Eckstine invited his UK PolyGram colleagues (and some media) to a champagne party in London, celebrating the recent successes with Billy Ray Cyrus and Ugly Kid Joe. Apart from many legal eagles, the Portobello Road bash proved that Mike Allen "knows" David Munns.

THE VERDICT PLEASE: Spanish parliament gave its official approval in mid-June of the modified intellectual property law specifying the amounts manufacturers and importers have to pay. (See M&M April 4 issue.)

PRIOR RESIGNS FROM ARISTA: Tim Prior has resigned from Arista Records as marketing director following a policy disagreement with MD Diana Graham. Prior, who joined the company four years ago, announced his decision to leave last week. Until a permanent replacement is planned, Graham will temporarily assume day-to-day operations and marketing responsibilities.

DANISH DEAL: Parent company of Radio Uptown, Egmont, has merged with Nordisk Film.

Group network owner **SER** captured 41.7% of the total radio audience between February and April with 7.599.000 listeners.

Antena 3 was in second place with 21% and a total 3.827.000

listeners. The rest of the audience cake was divided between pubcaster RNE (20%), Onda Cero (10%) and church-backed Cadena Cope FM—renamed Cadena 100—(11.6%).

The results also reveal an overall increase of 773.000 listeners against the October-November survey.

lang, for German-language, MOR repertoire. All units will report to director artist marketing **Hubert Wandjo**, who in turn reports to MD **Jochen Leuschner**. Twelve new people will be hired to staff the new departments.

Says Leuschner, "The record company of today is operating on generalist principles—one product manager dealing with different genres of music, which inevitably leads to a compromise. But as an A&R person, you have to know the repertoire 100%, especially in the dance, heavy metal and local repertoire scenes—all little worlds on their own. We've looked at our organization and felt that these different repertoire segments should be reflected in our organization.

"Apart from increasing capacity and competence in handling repertoire, the new set-up enables each unit head to work as an independent entrepreneur. It opens up possibilities to develop talents and skills "

Wandjo says the restructuring

provides more flexibility. "Obviously, we like each unit to have its own promotional force, but that would create too big a company," he comments. "For the Hard & Heavy/Alternative section press is essential, so CP will give them that. But also on the marketing and sales side, there are people who will work with specialized retailers. In this way, we create little record companies that have the know-how and credibility of the music they represent."

Mike Heisel will head the Pop/Rock International department, handling artists such as Bruce Springsteen, Mariah Carey, Michael Bolton and George Michael. Heisel will also oversee Dance Pool—which was created three years ago—together with label manager Stefan Bentz.

Markus Linde is responsible for Hard & Heavy/Alternative, dealing with artists such as Alice Cooper, Ozzy Osbourne and Pearl Jam, and also with national talents such as Nationalgalarie and the Slags.

National schlager and MOR artists like Edward Simoni and

Peter Kraus will continue to be managed by the Herzklang label, under the direction of label manager Uwe Kanthak. In the area of Pop/Rock National, A&R group manager Gerhard Braum and marketing manager Klaus Pomykaj will work with acts such as Peter Hoffmann, Rio Reiser, Nena, Andreas Vollenweider and Münchener Freiheit.

The German affiliate is so far the only Sony company in Europe to split its artist marketing operations into distinct repertoire units. In Italy and Spain, the Epic and Columbia labels have been separated, while France also created a third repertoire source with Squatt. In the UK, Sony has five independent units—Epic, Columbia, Sony Soho Square, Sony Music Publishing and the Licensed Repertoire Division.

Sony Music Germany recently reported a 1991 turnover of DM328 million (app. US\$205 million), an increase of 17% over 1990's DM280 million (M&M, May 16). Worldwide, the turnover of Sony's record division was US\$4 billion.

music creators and publishers. The agreement is set to expire at the end of September.

Under the terms of that agreement, stations that use PRS copyright music do so for 25%-80% of their transmission hours. Royalty payment is calculated as a percentage of net advertising revenue (NAR) on a six-band sliding scale. The low band of the scale is 5% of the first £1 million of NAR with the highest band being 9% above £8 million of NAR. The bands are adjusted annually according to inflation as measured by the Retail Prices Index (RPI). Stations using copyright music for more than 80% of their transmission hours pay an additional sum calculated at 15% of the amount produced by the sliding scale.

The hearing opened with the

Association of Independent Radio Companies (AIRC) leading counsel Christopher Clarke QC arguing that it is not just the music but what the station does with it which determines its success or failure.

"The cutting edge that one station enjoys over another arises from what it does with the repertoire as far as music is concerned and what it does in relation to the totality of the rest of its activities," he said. "In addition to access to the repertoire, a radio station needs highly talented people to select, present and match the music to the hour of the day and the audience. It is a travesty of analysis to treat a radio station as it was simply a juke box of the airwaves, an expression found in one of the records company's witness statements."

In his opening arguments, the record companies collecting society **Phonographic Performance**

Ltd.'s (PPL) leading counsel Sydney Kentridge QC charged that stations make money by playing music from the PPL's repertoire and therefore should pay accordingly. "Without the PPL repertoire, there would never have been any such thing as independent local radio," he said. The AIRC should not have existed. What happens now is that the station takes [PPL's] products, products to which it has not given a penny or hour of time to development, in relation to which they have taken none of the risk of recording. By playing these products hour after hour, it brings in income and profits it would never have been able to earn without this repertoire."

The BBC, which recently signed an agreement with PPL in which the corporation pays approximately £9 million a year in royalties, is testifying as an intervener on behalf of the AIRC.

station director **Claudio Astorri** with responsibilities being shared by other programming managers. This temporary situation will be reviewed in September.

Comments Benson, "Rancati has left the company because of differences of opinion. Her experience was from a different era of Italian radio when it was still very much improvised and run more on enthusiasm. Rancati is a very intelligent woman, but she had a different style when approaching the everyday problems of running a radio station."

Rancati declines to comment on the reasons for her departure. "I'm currently negotiating various things with station owner **Lorenzo Suraci**. When these are sorted out I'll talk." Astorri said of Rancati when first appointed, "She is possibly one of the most experienced programmers in the business and was artistic director at Rete 105 during its golden era."

Rancati is the second PD to

make a quick exit from the station in the space of a year. **Guido Monti** quit the position unexpectedly in June 1991 after only eight months of service. Differences of opinion were also cited as the reason for his departure.

material from his current album.

The stage production, lighting and pyrotechnics exceeded Jackson's previous tours; the synergy between video, dance routines and music was effectively achieved.

Jackson moved freely on three separate stages—each requiring three days to construct. The stages integrated three different laser shows, four camera crews, a 160.000-watt light show and 230 explosions.

The concert, promoted by Marcel Avram/Mama Concerts & Rau, was plagued by some technical hiccups, including the failure of the two Sony Jumbotron video screens and a malfunctioning microphone.

Over 1.200 media people were flown in by **Sony Music** to enjoy the show and a spectacular pre-concert carnival modeled after the cover art to Jackson's new album.



Carey Is Infecting Europe

Elton John keeps on beating his own records; the total number of stations playing *The One* has grown to 99, representing close to 80% of M&M's EHR roster. Airplay is impressive across the board, although there is relative room for improvement in Sweden and Germany. Although stabilizing somewhat, *The One* is still far advanced compared to

Although stabilizing somewhat, *The One* is still far advanced compared to the frontrunner, George Michael's *Too Funky*. The latter song's penetration has been expanded to 88 stations and airplay is best in Norway, Belgium, Denmark, the UK and Italy.
Following a two-week stint at Billboard's Hot 100 Singles, Mariah

Following a two-week stint at Billboard's Hot 100 Singles, Mariah Carey's cover of the 1971 hit I'll Be There by the Jackson 5--recorded on MTV's "Unplugged,"--is now infecting European programmers. Backed by solid airplay in Norway, Holland, the UK and Denmark, the track moves to the fifth position in its third week. Carey's best performing single on the EHR Top 40 so far has been Someday that peaked at number 2 in November of last year.

As expected, the B-52's move into top 10 with Good Stuff, the title track of the trio's new Don Was/Nile Rodgers-produced album. UK programmers are most keen on the track, but Scandinavia and the Benelux are quickly cashing in, too.

Patience pays off. It took Columbia some time, but European hit

Patience pays off. It took Columbia some time, but European hit programmers are now fully convinced about the impact of new artist Sophie B. Hawkins's Damn I Wish I Was Your Lover. The track moves to number 11 and with airplay mounting in Italy, the UK, Holland and Norway, it is a good contender for the too 10.

Norway, it is a good contender for the top 10.

Another new artist breaking into the EHR Top 40 is east west UK-signing Tori Amos. Backed by a very solid base in the UK and further supported by promising airplay in Sweden, Austria and Switzerland, Crucify is this week's highest entry at number 33.




