

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Supertramp Breakfasts In Paris

PARIS - Supertramp has reformed and cut a long-term recording deal with EMI France, writes Emmanuel Legrand.

The deal was announced by EMI France president Gilbert Ohayon on September 6. "Supertramp's roots run deep in Europe" he says. "France is consistently one of the band's most receptive and successful sales territories. It was their expressed wish to be close to the European market and thus signed

to EMI France." Ohayon tells Music & Media that the signing was made with the "full support" of EMI International. All international marketing and promotion will be coordinated from Paris.

Adds Ohayon, "When they decided to reform the band, they looked at the global market and at the places where they had a solid base, and thought it would make sense to concentrate on a market such as France.

High Price Hikes Are No Help To Italian Music Industry

MILAN - Italy's troubled music market continued to shrink in the first six months of this year according to statistics released by the country's IFPI recognised trade federation FIMI whose members claim to represent a 90% market share.

Despite an almost 10% increase in CD prices to a recommended retail price of L 37.000 (app. US\$24) at the beginning of this year, turnover on total shipments in the first semester fell 0.2% against the

same period last year to US\$186.39 million. Total units shipped dropped 7.1%.

FIMI president Gerolamo Caccia warns that if the industry doesn't take decisive action it could get trapped in a downward spiral of reduced investment in creative talent and a continual slow decline. "A positive first two months of this year was followed by four consecutive negative months with units shipped down 41% in June. We are confronting a prolonged recession and in order to survive the industry we will

have to become more professional and serious," comments Caccia.

Despite criticism in the Italian press and amongst some industry insiders that the price of top range new releases in Italy is too expensive Caccia states, "We need to protect the perception of the value of a CD. We reinvest 15% of our turnover in new talent. This is much higher than advanced technology companies invest in research, but we need to sustain this level of investment in new artists if the industry is to survive." He also points to increased competition from computer hardware and software products, and the devaluation of the Italian lire in the past two years as additional problems for the Italian music industry.

HIStory Starts In Prague

PRAGUE - With the launch of Michael Jackson's HIStory World Tour 1996-97, tipped as "the greatest music production of the century", in the capital of the Czech Republic on September 7, Sony Music expects to push worldwide sales of the double CD to the next plateau. The new show also aims to restore Jackson's status as a leading performer, damaged after the abrupt cancellation of his 1993 tour.


Proposed as "part of history", the huge 70-metre stage set reproduces the shape of the Brandenburg Gate in Berlin. The show starts with a science-fiction video in which Captain Jackson invites the audience to meet him on planet Earth. The spaceship lands as the first notes of *Scream* start and Jackson enters the stage wearing a

black metal spacesuit, his band dressed as robots. The set list is a "best of" Jackson's songs, including Jackson 5 nostalgia, an *Off The Wall* medley and the

Thriller trilogy with Thriller, Billie Jean and Beat It combining complex choreography and video excerpts.

A Question Of Quotas

The Lines

Between I guess you have to applaud the French for doing things in their own peculiar way and being successful at it. You may know I'm not an advocate of implementing quotas to regulate the airplay of national talent. However, trust the French to get the damn thing mov-

The president of the French performing rights society Sacem, Jean-Loup Tournier, is making a pretty clear link between the increased sales of new national talent and the introduction of radio quotas in January of this year (see page 4).

A new generation of artists seems to have surfaced: following the Baby Boomers, the

yuppies and Generation X, may we introduce to you the "quota generation". It's a special breed of artists raised on a steady diet of radio airplay and record company investments. It's a generation that has a high likelihood of becoming spoiled brats: no matter what their qualities are, they have every chance of being signed by a pragmatic A&R manager and finding a willing ear on radio. Welcome to a brave new world where artists are being signed for the sake of it and where radio is only too eager to comply.

Of course I'm being too cynical, but isn't it alarming that the old (and maybe too romantic) notion of the A&R manager finding tomorrow's talent is eroding? That A&R becomes the fine art of signing artists just to satisfy the needs of radio?

I also wonder whether the job of radio plugger has changed a lot in France. A good radio promotor, in my mind, should be able to tell a station why a particular act, that at first glance won't fit the station's format, is still eligible for the playlist. But hasn't it now become almost too easy to promote national talent to radio? Radio is so desperate to fill the quota levels that anything that's thrown at them will stick.

And what about non-French acts? It surely must be frightening times for Anglo-American record companies wanting to break new artists into the all-important French marketplace. It's not as easy to think that the remaining 60% of the playlist will be the exclusive preserve of Anglo-American artists. If you study the top 20 national airplay lists, there's isn't that much non-French material that breaks the mould. What does fill up the 60% remainder is some clearly hit-proven Anglo-Saxon material (Spice Girls, Fugees etc.) plus a handful of European Border Breakers (Robert Miles, Ramazzotti, Los Del Rio) and, yes, more French talent.

France has successfully warded off foreign language influences, non-French music seems to be next on the agenda.

Local Repertoire Boosts German Business

MCA In Aggressive **Expansion Mode**

HAMBURG - MCA Music GSA plans to grow three times as fast as the German music market. At the company's annual meeting in Hamburg on August 29-30, MCA financial director GSA Wolfgang Praetz described a turnover of DM230 million (app. US\$144 million) by the year 2000 as a realis-

To reach this target MCA will have to maintain an annual growth rate of 15-20% until the end of the millennium, according to a financial spokesman. At present the GSA region's biggest market Germany is growing at a rate of 6%

MCA vice president GSA Heinz Canibol underlined the contribution of domestic repertoire to MCA GSA's fast development over the past four years.

According to Canibol the Sep-Heinz tember 1 launch of an own MCA Canibol sales force in Germany opens the possibility of concentrating fully and without compromises on our own priorities.

In the near future the company plans to expand its dance label Hysteria and to develop MOR oriented domestic repertoire on the MCA

Important domestic album releases for the rest of the year include Alarm by Illegal 2001 and Stephan Remmler's Amnesia. International priorities includes Counting Crows' Recovering The Satellites and Weezer's Pinkerton. An electric live set by Nirvana is scheduled for release later this year to complement their acoustic million seller MTV Unplugged.

BMG Doubles Turnover In 10 Years

MUNICH - At the annual group meeting on August 28-30 in Munich BMG Entertainment GSA president Thomas M. Stein announced a turnover of DM 775 million (app. US\$485 million) for the business year 1995/96. This equals 2.7% growth compared to the previous business year and a 100% increase since the launch of BMG in 1986.

Stein underlined the success of BMG's domestic repertoire which accounts for 55% of the group's turnover. Local signings like Peter Maffay, La Bouche, Real Mc Coy and Scatman John

keep the lion's share of 1995/96 profits in Germany. Stein revealed that BMG Entertainment GSA finished the business year with "a profit margin of more than 10%.

BMG Entertainment Internapresident/CEO tional Thomas Gassner acknowledged the contribution of the GSA region to BMG's

worldwide performance. Addressing his audience in Munich, Gassner said, "BMG has grown from a respected marketing arm for international repertoire to one of the leading A&R oriented companies in the GSA region.'

BMG Entertainment GSA accounts for roughly 10% of BMG's worldwide turnover. Stein seems determined to raise the group's contribution further. BMG Ariola Munich recently signed Florida based act 'N Sync, the latest contender on the boy group scene. Deniz Pop, the Swedish writer and producer partially responsible for the success of the Backstreet Boys, has already penned a number of songs for the newcomers. The first 'N Sync single is scheduled for release in

Sony Debuts CD Extra Compilation

With a CD Extra version of a compilation album based on the Flemish broadcaster BRT-N's Studio Brussel programme "De Afrekening" (The settlement), Sony Music Belgium is releasing the first-ever compilation CD Extra in the Belgian marketplace. Sony Music's strategic marketing director Henk Penseel prepared the release of this project almost one year ago. Penseel says he picked the "Afrekening" compilation, featuring tracks by Nick Cave, Spin Doctors, Primal Scream and Buckshot Lefonque, because of its specific target buyers."People who listen to (alternative rock formatted) Studio Brussel are those who go for CD Rom and InterNet—we wanted to reach them. We had 11 audio-volumes of this series to date, each selling between 15.000 and 25.000 units in Flanders alone, which is very good for alternative rock, making it the best scoring compilation of its genre here." The CD Extra will be shipped as one disc, compatible for audio, Mac, Windows 3.1 and Windows 95 users.

■ SPAIN

Reggae On The River Some 5.000 fans attended Spain's largest ever reggae festival at Mostoles on September 7 with ten groups, five from Jamaica and five from Spain, playing in the ten hour openair "Reggae on the River 96" event. The festival featured stars such as Jamaica's Twinkle Brothers and Freddie McGregor, and was organized by Madrid's reggae fan Julio Velasco and was sponsored by, among others, Cadena COPE's full service Cadena 100.

Big Names For Spanish News/Talk Nets

MADRID - Former Spanish government ministers are being snapped up by news/talk radio nets for 1996-97 as participants in popular 'tertulia' or intellectual chat shows.

Sector leader Cadena SER has signed no fewer than four ex-ministers for its 16:00-19:00 programme La Ventana (The Window). They are José Borrell of the last socialist government which was voted out of office in March, and Rodolfo Martín Villa, Iñigo Cavero and Ernest Lluch from earlier administrations.

Rival net Cadena COPE is to incorporate another minister from the last socialist government, Juan Alberto Belloch, to take part in La Tarde (The Afternoon). He will occasionally be joined by current environment minister in the conservative government, Isabel Tocino.

Two other key signings by SER for its midnight soccer programme El Larguero (The

Crossbar) are former agers of Real Madrid and Barcelona, Argentine Jorge Valdano and Dutchman Johan Cruyff respectively. Their comments should boost the audience of El Larguero, which is already the leader in its field. The new programming for SER's five music nets and COPE's full service Cadena

100 will be announced within a month. Pubnet Radio Nacional de España (RNE) also revealed its new programming, and as expected its alternative music net Radio 3 retains its largely musical flavour although with an increase in cultural information including cinema and literature, and public service information.

Face To Face With Europe's Newsmakers

MTV Networks International president Bill Roedy

The split into three European programme regions, the expansion of VH-1 into Scandinavia and Eastern Europe as well as a marketing alliance with Heineken, C&A and Konica: MTV Europe has certainly made the headlines over the past

Q: Will MTV Europe's role change with the development of the digital TV market?

month.

A: Digital TV is a means to get MTV across to as many viewers as possible. We have always maintained that satellite TV needs two sources of income to survive—advertising and subscriptions. The advertising base is smaller than that of conventional TV. Further programme and target group fragmentation as introduced by digital TV reduces this base even more.

Q: Will clubs, bars and hotels eventually replace private households as MTV subscribers?

A: Absolutely not, private homes will continue to be our main target group. But if the performance rights are cleared, public outlets can contribute a positive emotional element to the perception of MTV because people watch in a group setting.

Q: Can MTV Europe survive in the long run on advertising income?

A: We will continue to lean more heavily on advertising than other forms of income. Our aim is to win clients by adding value to the medium of TV. It is not enough to put a spot on air, you have to be

more creative. MTV's objective is to work together with advertising clients on a strategic level. Integrated marketing campaigns featuring spots, off-air events and programme coverage are part of our commit-

ment to servicing advertisers optimally.

Q: Would you consider launching further music channels, for instance M2, in Europe?

A: We are not entertaining plans to introduce our new US channel M2 on an international level at the moment. Technically speaking we are able to take the recent regionalisation of our programme further. Three programme regions are not the limit, but this decision will be entirely market driven.

Q: Can we expect further alliances between MTV and digital TV operators? A: I would not rule out further alliances at this stage. My aim is to bring MTV into every household in Europe, regard-

less of the way we get there.

Tournier Hails New "Quota Generation"

PARIS - The quotas of French content on radio stations, in place since January of this year, have resulted in the rise of what performing rights society Sacem president Jean-Loup Tournier has termed a "quota generation" of artists.

According to Tournier, there is a direct connection between the increasing airplay of French content and the surge of new acts. Tournier reveals that the percentage of French songs on radio has reached 58% of the total music played, the best level since 1989. He adds that record sales of national products have passed the 52% mark

during the first semester of 1996, against 44% in 1992 (see Music & Media, August 31).

"This growth cannot be separated from the implementation of quotas two years ago, which everyone agrees has stimulated the production of music", says Tournier. "We can even talk about a 'boom' in 1996. The five majors have produced more than 60 first albums by new French acts during the first nine months of 1996 compared to less than 40 a year since 1992."

Tournier lists among the new acts that have emerged these past two years Daran, Miosseec, Dominique A, Axelle Renoir, Lilicub, Hugo, Marka, Mathieu Bogaerts, Melaaz, and says the success of artists such as Obispo, Zazie, De Palmas, Didier Sustrac, Blondin, Mano Solo has been confirmed. But he points out that this new wave has been pushed forward by rap acts such as NTM, Menelik, Alliance Ethnik, Reciprok, among others.

"The explosion of rap has been a heaven for the programmers of nets targeting the youth", says Tournier who points out that during the first semester on Fun Radio, nine new acts were played and they were mostly rap.

Tournier says that recent ratings proved that the quotas have "not affected the audience of the main FM networks" and remarks that "NRJ has made a jump forward recently despite, or thanks to, more than 40 % French programming". He says that "in general, radio stations respect the 40% quota". "Let's hope it will continue" says Tournier.

Virgin Plays That Beat!

BRUSSELS - With the release of Flemish singer Luc Steeno's new single, Virgin Belgium has announced the take-over of independent label Play That

Play That Beat!, founded in 1988 by Theo Linder and former Virgin employee Marc Debouvier, has established a strong local artist roster featuring Get Ready, Jo Lemaire and Peter Van Laet. With Virgin Belgium acquiring 100% of Play That Beat!, the company is to become a division of Virgin. "It took us six months of friendly negotiations to strike the deal," explains Virgin Belgium general manager Firmin Michiels, "and the bottom line is that Play That Beat! will continue to work as an independent unit. They will take

care of promotion, marketing and A&R, backed by the logistics offered by Virgin."

Virgin Belgium, with artists like Axelle Red, Arno, Gorki, Wigbert and Belgian Asociality, wants to broaden its local artist roster, and although he was reticent to disclose the takeover sum, Michiels revealed that the deal will allow Virgin to cross the US\$ one million mark in Belgian product this year.

Under the agreement, Theo Linder and Marc Debouvier will continue for at least 3 years as co-MD's of the new division which will remain artistically independent. "As an independent company you remain (financially) limited when it comes to signing new artists" says Linder, "and we felt Virgin would be the right choice for us."

Radio Stations Move Into On-Line Retailing

Four UK commercial radio stations—2CR FM/Bournemouth, LBC 1152/London, Hallam FM/Sheffield and Metro FM/Newcastle—have linked up with the Internet Music Shop (IMS) to enable listeners to buy music via the Internet. The station's own web sites will have a facility enabling listeners to purchase material from the IMS Top 200 album chart simply by inputting their credit card details and delivery address. IMS and the

stations concerned will operate a revenue share on all on-line sales derived from the radio station's own site, and IMS will also supply radio stations with their customers' details.

Licence Award Heralds New Dawn For Student Radio

LONDON - For the first time in its history, the Radio Authority has awarded a fully-fledged local FM licence to a studentbased radio station, in a move that will also give encouragement to groups hoping to run alternative music formats in the

Oxygen FM, founded two years ago by university students Philip Weiss and Nick Molden, beat off two challengers to win an eight year licence to broadcast to the city of Oxford. Backed by Chris Carnegy's The Local Radio Company, the new station will be staffed mainly by student volunteers, and will provide a service of "youth/alternative" music and "challenging" speech.

"This is the most significant event to have happened in British student radio since it began," says station director Philip Weiss, who will be one of just five full-time staffers at Oxygen. "We will hope to set the standard for a new generation of


student FM listeners in Britain and across Europe.

Oxygen, set to launch next February, will be staffed from a pool of around 200 local and student volunteers, and will play a variety of alternative music from hard-core dance to indie rock during daytimes, with specialist music shows and discusprogrammes during evenings and weekends. "The idea is to break new bands, and to find new talent, as student stations do in the US," says Weiss. "As the UK's first [freeradiating] student station we will hope to be a focus for new bands and independent labels.

Weiss says that there will be at least one recruitment drive by the station every term in order to attract volunteer presenters, journalists and production staff. Responding to suggestions that the station's output will lack consistency because of the turnover and limited availability of student volunteers, Weiss explains, "The station will have a very strong format, and its programmes will be team-driven

rather than personality driven." Oxygen has also negotiated a special clause within its promise of performance to provide an automated music-orientated service during university vaca-

Apart from the ill-fated KFM/Stockport at the start of the decade, the licence award also marks the first time the Radio Authority has given a permanent licence to a station which will feature alternative rock as a key component of its music output. Xfm programme director Sammy Jacob, hoping the Radio Authority will award his alternative rock station an FM licence for London (Music & Media, July 20), describes Oxygen's victory as "a very encouraging development. It shows that this type of music format is at last getting some recognition from the Authority; it certainly shows they are being more openminded. If people can see the demand for this kind of service in a small market like Oxford, they must surely see that it is bound to work in London.'





Brussels Looks For More Localness

CITY PROFILE



One might expect that Brussels, as Belgium's capital, would be a key battlefield between the country's public and commercial broadcasters. Yet apart from a few specialist stations catering for specific minority audiences (such as the Turkish and Islamic population, or lesbians and students) only RTBF's Bruxelles Capitale and BFM (a speechonly outlet offering stock exchange bulletins, news and cultural information for EC-staffers and business people) are clearly targetting the Brussels-only audience. Both (Flemish) BRTN and French language RTBF transmit their national/regional stations to (and indeed from) the city, resulting in a choice of over 30 outlets for the Brussells listener.

However, impending renewal of Belgian's radio plan frequency could well affect the

current Brussels radioscape—rumours are currently circulating that only six commercial networks will be allowed to operate in (French-speaking) southern Belgium alongside the state broadcasters and the purely local outlets.

Healthy Competition

"The problem with Brussels is the difference in transmitter power between the public and commercial broadcasters," says Radio Contact programme director Jean-Lou Bertin, "I'm convinced that today, most stations offer quality programmes. The competition



in the south of the country has been a good thing for all broadcasters, and has resulted in increased overall audiences for radio

Most Belgian commercial networks such as Radio Contact, Bel RTL, Fun and NRJ have their headquarters in Brussels, and most programmes are produced in the capital (affiliate stations in the regions usually provide their own opted-out local news and information services). "The interesting thing about Brussels is that the city plays a key-role for stations wanting to become national networks," explains Steve Van den Audenaerde, product manager with IP Radio. "They all want

Smaller Brussells-only community stations, such as Radio Judaãca (Jewish), Radio Panik (hard Action rock), FM (funk) or Radio Crystal (house/techno) all have a small but loyal following.

problem is that they never appear in audience surveys," says Jean-François Rigot, communications

manager with Fun Radio. "Although their approach is not always professional, I think these stations are excellent talent pools where bigger stations can pick up new on-air staffers. People are always complaining that they hear the same voices in programmes and radio and TV commercials-new and fresh presenters could solve the prob-

In the public broadcasting sector, BRTN's rock formatted Studio Brussel serves an area well beyond the city limits, despite its name. Whereas in its early days it was aimed at commuters in the capital, the station now forms

It goes without saying that both BRTN and RTBF's other radio stations enjoy considerable success in the Brussels market (see ratings table). programmes family-orientated full-service radio. Its programming offers a wide range of news and conversation topics, plus a music mix which features


at least 50% French repertoire. "As a dynamic urban radio station we also switch presenter and type of programme at least every 90 minutes, adds Vossen.



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

Bizarre Breakfast On The 13th Floor

Italy's commercial radio networks have tried everything at breakfast from the classic jokey DJ and his metaphorical dog to the morning zoo team or a straight music and news mix. Until recently one network maintained a particularly manic DJ who sounded as if he'd sprinkled cocaine instead of sugar on his morning bowl of cereal!

Milan-based EHR network Radio 105, which entered a period of "slow but ongoing evolution" when Guido Monti became station manager almost two years ago, last year extended its "concept

programming" formula to the breakfast slot. Developed in the afternoon slot with the "Happy Days" show, "concept programming" involves permanently situating a show and its presenters outside the conventional radio studio setting.

Although in reality the shows actually derive from Radio 105's studios on the edge of Milan's business district, the presenters of "Happy Days" try to recreate the atmosphere of a trendy bar. And, in the case of the new breakfast show "I Due Del Tredicesimo" ("Those Two From The 13th Floor") the presenters are flatmates in an imaginary apartment on the 13th floor of Radio 105's mid-town tower block.

Radio Sitcom

"It's like a radio sitcom, in which we have put a microphone in every room of the apartment," explains Radio 105 station manager Guido Monti. "We listen in on the conversation between the two flatmates and the visitors who regularly drop in, each of whom has their own particular catch-phrase." The presenters do not announce the music, but just drop in between the records with satirical conversations about the day's news, chats with the postman on the apartment intercom or perhaps a phone call from

the dirty old man who always dials the wrong number when trying to call an erotic telephone service. Adds Monti, "There are also various neighbours, including an aspiring actress who has ended up doing pornographic movies."

Comic Cuts

The comic scenarios vary in length between short quips and lengthier sequences in which several of the regular "guests" (played by professional actors Claudio Batta and Fabrizio Maccone) all turn up at once. They slip in and out surprisingly easily between the music, with main presenters Paolo Cavallone and Tony Severo bouncing off each other as if they have been flatmates ever since they left school. Listen-

ers looking for regular time checks have to rely on their own watches.


The morning
Clockwatch tuned in
coincided with the

air defences. After a newsflash

and a record, Cavallone and Severo quipped that perhaps Saddam Hussein was being paid by Bill Clinton, "It's strange how Saddam helps the President by stirring up trouble during an election campaign, giving Clinton a chance to increase his lead in the polls." The two suggested that they polished up their war skills by playing the board game Risk.

Following a music break, the show returned from the realms of improvised satire on breaking news to everyday conversation and the gossip pages in the newspapers. One of the flatmates admired a newspaper photo of one of the actresses appearing at the Venice Film Festival, and the conversation soon turned to the amount of models in town for the Milan fashion trade show. The show's shy and misogynist neighbour, who is terrified of women, made his excuses and left. "Women ruined me, I'm going," is invariably his departing catchphrase.

Perhaps inevitably, sexual innuendo makes up a significant part of the programme's sketches. Anyone surprised that an imaginary pornographic movie actress should be one of the show's main characters should know that whilst porno videos are widely available in Continental Europe, they are sold most openly in Italy, where street newsstands display them alongside fitness videos and the usual range of newspa-

pers and magazines. Italy is also the country where the Hungarian-born pornographic actress Cicciolina was elected to parliament 10 years ago.

"The Setolina character is a Polish actress who never actually admits that she's in porno films, but normally gives it away when she reveals the dubious title of her latest film project," explains Monti. "The most she actually reveals on the air is that whilst she is talking to Paolo and Tony from the street via the apartment block intercom, she is prone to open her shirt and show her ample assets, for which she receives tumultuous applause from passers by."

As the late British DJ Kenny Everett (another expert in the art of the double-entendre) would have said, "It's all done in the best possible taste." With their innocent and friendly manner, presen-

ters Cavallone and Severo ride close to the edge of vulgarity and offensiveness without falling into the abyss.

Cartoon Hero

Other less controversial visitors to the flat include a baby with an infectious giggle, and a grandfather who strolls in from time to time. "Nobody knows whose grandfather he is—he just shows up and stays," says Monti. There is also the film critic who raves about obscure movies but has never heard of the latest Hollywood blockbuster, and a cartoon super-hero "Saw Man," who possesses a chainsaw instead of a hand, and appears from nowhere whenever someone utters the phrase "Cut It Out."

The latest visitor to the apartment is a pet dolphin who has taken up residency in the bath. A possible promotional tie-in with the imminent release of the Hollywood movie "Flipper" is strongly suspected.

These often absurd and surreal situations fit easily between news breaks, commercials and Radio 105's trademark jingles. The station's latest jingle package includes 30 second, one minute and two minute stings produced to sound like contemporary dance, reggae or pophits with a vocal chorus building up to the latest station slogan and ID—a little like Coca-Cola's advertising jingles, in

With its innovative format, "I Due Del Tredicesimi" is an original, cheerful and entertaining way to start the day. In just one year, it is already compulsive listening for the many who have become familiar with its regular characters and their particular idiosyncrasies. This adventurous show has helped turn around a downward listening trend, and has pushed Radio 105 back up the ratings table. It has also created some interesting talking points for Italians grabbing their Espresso or Cappuccino coffee at the bar on the way to work..."Have you heard what the title of Setalina's latest movie is?



Question Mr. Answer Man

For the benefit of radio programme directors, producers and presenters, research consultant Kurt Hanson has created an alter ego, Mr. Answer Man, to give useful tips and answer questions. Ask him for advice at AtSingDot@aol.com. The first column in the series looks at the value of ratings and how to use research to evaluate your show.

■ RESEARCH

Q: My ratings just plummeted. Could it be the ratings firm's mistake?

A: Conceivably. But rather than a technical screw-up on the ratings firm's part, it's more likely that your decline could be simply a margin-of-error wobble. That's not exactly a "mistake" on the ratings firm's part—it's just that the laws of probability don't allow perfectly accurate results without an incredibly large sample size, which would cost more than you or any other research customer would want to pay.

Use this simple bit of maths to find out if your decline might be within the margin of error of your ratings service. Take the rating or share or cume percentage you believe you really have. Let's say you believe you generally have a 4% share. Multiply that number by 100 minus that number. In this case, 4x96 is 384. Divide by the sample size of the ratings service. If the ratings are based on 1.000 interviews, you

would now be at 0.384. Take the square root of that number. This comes to about 0.6 and is called the "standard error" of the survey.

Based solely on the ratings firm's sample size, and ignoring any additional errors or biases that might come into play, your ratings could easily be off by an amount equal to the standard error. In fact, a third of the ratings estimates in the book are off (either too high or too low) by that much or more. Even more discouraging is that if you're trying to use the ratings as a guide to your performance, there's a chance (not a big chance, but a 1-in-20 chance) that the ratings could be off by double the standard error!

Q: That means I can ignore the down book and tell my general manager that it's probably wrong?

A: No, sorry. If your ratings have gone down, there's a greater probability that you're losing audience than that you're gaining it. So take them seriously. Yes, they could be wrong—but consider the possibility that they could be right.

Q: I'm developing a morning programme. How can I evaluate how it's doing? Am I moving in the right direction, or should I blow it up and try something else?

A: The first step you should take is to look at existing behavioural, data on how your listeners are using the radio. You have a group of "core listeners"—people for whom yours is their primary radio station. If your ratings service has tools to allow you to do so, take a look at what they're listening to in morning drive.

In most markets, a certain percentage of each station's audience switches to a full-service or news/talk station in morning drive because of the importance of news, traffic, and weather information. Are you losing listeners at a greater-than-the-market-average rate?

Similarly, most markets have one or two legendary (or at least currently super-popular) air personalities that attract listeners from all radio stations. In Madrid, it's Luis del Olmo. In New York, it's Howard Stern. You can expect to lose some of your listeners to that individual—but, again, are you losing them at an above-average rate?

Next, look at trends. In doing so, primarily look at the relative performance of your morning show compared to the rest of your programmes.

Here's an example of what I mean. Let's say last spring your station had a 5% audience share overall, but only a 4% share in mornings. That means your mornings were performing at 80% of your overall performance—not bad, in my opinion, if you have a low-cost or new-and-developing morning show.

Now, say that your just-released ratings show that the station is down to a 4.5% share and that mornings are down to a 3.8% share. As you know, your overall decline is probably within the margin of error of your ratings service. Nonetheless, you can derive some useful information: although mornings are in fact down, they're now performing at 84% of your full-week performance. In such a case, you should not be discouraged. Your morning show is actually holding its own a little better!

The only exception to this interpretation would be if you think your morning show is so bad and inappropriate that it's pulling down the rest of the station's dayparts.

Q: Okay, that's what I could do with ratings. Any other suggestions?

A: The second step you could take is to commission some research questions about your morning show. These questions could be added to your music research programme, if you have one. Alternatively, they could be included as part of a more comprehensive "Strategic And Perceptual Study," which might also examine other issues like your music mix, the effectiveness of your marketing, and your competitors' strengths and weaknesses.

You might ask your listeners to rate your morning show overall on, for example, a five-point scale (where 5 means they think it's great and 1 means they hate it), and also to rate each of the individual participants (including the traffic reporter, the newsperson, etc.) on the same scale.

You might also ask respondents an open-ended question such as, "What do you like most (or dislike most) about the morning programme on our station?" If your research firm is a good one, the "verbatim" transcript of comments received will be very helpful, certainly to you and perhaps even to the air personalities themselves, if you choose to share the results with them.

If you learn that your personalities have low familiarity but are reasonably popular among those who do know them, then you have a morning show that perhaps just needs more time to develop (and more promotion once you think listeners are ready for it).

On the other hand, if you learn that your listeners have listened to the show and don't like it, then it's time for a change.

> Broken Angel - EMI PRODUCERS: Hansen, Bruun With Broken Angel Danish female singer Hanne Boel possibly recorded her international breakthrough single. This remarkable song, mixed by Bob Clearmountain, has a clever use of a choir. It will fill all Celine Dion-fans with warm feelings.

ALEX PARTY

Read My Lips - Ala Bianca hr/d PRODUĆER: Visnadi Some of those catchy Italo-tunes are just irresistible. After one play you can't get them out of your head and this is definitely one. Originally made by Italian producers, and now remixed by the Dutch BT&T-production-team, this single contains two excellent radio edits.

CROWDED HOUSE

Not The Girl You Think You Are - Capitol ace PRODUCER: Mitchell Froom Crowded House are not going quietly. Froom is obviously the hottest producer of the moment (see Suzanne Vega review) and he's done a great job with Crowded House too. This slow, swirling waltz with the trademark harmonies is a beauty.

GHETTO PEOPLE FEAT. L-VIZ

In The Ghetto - Dance Pool ehr/d PRODUCER: Robert Bartha Nothing is sacred. Even the famous Presley tune is plundered by inposing a '90s hip hop facelift. The results, however, are very commercial and are firmly within the Fugees camp: dry and casual beats, gang-style yells and a great Presleyimpersonator. EHR radio will love it.

GRASS-SHOW

Out Of The Void - EMI ehr/r/a PRODUCER: Ronald Bood Swedes are the champions of Britpop (Wannadies, Naked), but Grass-Show take the cake. This single is an uptempo, Blur-ry track with mock Cockney acccents and cheerful guitars. It will sound great on radio.

HEAVEN 17

Designing Heaven - Wea PRODUCERS: Anzilotti, Münzing A charmingly old-fashioned track performed by seminal synthesizer pop pioneers Marsh, Ware and Gregory. German hit writers Anzilotti and Münzing do not deliver a strong hook this time but Heaven captures that classic 1980's pop glamour. Reaching even further back, Giorgio Moroder contributes an extended remix built around the bass sequence he used on Donna Summer's disco anthem Love To Love You.

THE KELLY FAMILY

I Can't Help Myself - Kellife ehr/ace PRODUCERS: Kelly Family Big sellers in the GSA, the Kelly Family is a self-made succes. Enclosed within this single is even a coupon to order The Kelly Family-puzzle. This ballad sounds like it's written for The Eurovision Song Contest: music for the millions.

LIPSTICK

I'm A Raver - Cyberspace/Van ehr/d PRODUCERS: Daimy, Du Browski You can complain about Eurohouse as much as you want, but this fast paced techno hit will hook you instantly. The fast breakbeats and catchy melodies are inescapable. Definitely a notch up from the standard rave fare.

CHARLY LOWNOISE & MENTAL THEO

Hardcore Feelings - Urban/Polydor ehr/d PRODUCERS: Charly Lownoise, Mental Theo Hardcore-house is difficult for radio. But acts like Charly Lownoise & Mental Theo, extremely popular among Dutch ravers, translate the idea into a radiofriendly mix. This new single is again utterly melodic and embedded in nice female vocals.

There Will Never Be Another Me - Polydor r/a PRODUCER: The Boilerhouse Boys A wall of grunge-y guitars is set against a power-pop Buzzcocks-like tune that's over before you know it. Very effective and a must for alternative and rock formats. The other three tracks on this EP are equally infectious. Especially Thinkshake and Top Trumps offer foottapping fun.

TEN SHARP

Old Town - Columbia r/ace PRODUCER: Niels Hermes The Dutch duo which conquered the world with You is now back with an album of highly entertaining live covers (Roots) and Phil Lynott's anthem is its first single. They add well-crafted arrangements and a powerful live energy.

12 ROUNDS

Personally - Polydor a/r PRODUCERS: 12 Rounds Atmospheric and brooding pop with a slow-moving trip hop beat with psychedelic guitars. It slowly crawls closer and evokes an intimate and rather spooky mood. Sounds like Portishead on a bad

SPICE

Together Again - SPV ehr/ace/d Producer: Yak Bondy Think John Travolta and Car Wash. Think bellbottom trousers. The soulful vocals evoke the heydays of Philly Soul. Add to that the tight horn section and an uptempo, happy beat, and you have the perfect cheesy radio tune.

DESCENDENTS

Everything Sucks - Epitaph PRODUCERS: Stevenson, Egerton Old punks never die. In the case of the Descendents that is certainly true. And they still sing that Everything Sucks and that You Don't Get Played On the Radio, but adventurous programmers will know how to handle this great collection of fifteen new melodic punk tracks!

New Adventures In Hi-Fi - Wamer PRODUCERS: R.E.M. Another quality product from R.E.M, but with less radio appeal. Many of the tracks are far too long for daytime EHR or ACE and will certainly need a radio edit. Although musically adventurous, there's no Losing My Religion or Man On The Moon here. Instead, the album largely carries on the harder, rawer sound developed on Monster. Dramatic exceptions are the almost Dire Straits-esque How The West Was Won, while the pleasant Zither strays into the realms easy-listening mood-music. Well worth a spin at EHR and ACE is the album's typically R.E.M closing track, *Elektrolite*.

REVEREND HORTON HEAT

It's Martini Time - Interscope/MCA a/r/ehr PRODUCER: Thom Panunzio The Texas power trio bursts into action with their own kerosene fuelled brand of psychobilly. Razor sharp guitar riffs, high speed rhythms and loads of attitude update good old rockabilly for the Offspring generation. Songs like Slow, Generation Why and Big Red Rocket Of Love will certainly appeal to a large number of young, alternative rock and punk fans

Mish Mash - Downbeat/WEA a/d PRODUCERS: G. Bush, R. Whittingham A landmark for dub music in the '90s. Mish Mash balances elegantly between ambient soundscapes and the dancefloor. Bush and Whittingham's tracks sound raw and direct. Samples held together by sellotape. Music for moderns. Could do for contemporary dub what David Byrne & Brian Eno's Life In The Bush Of Ghosts did for the popularisation of tape loops and dance rhythms among white pop buyers in 1981. Mish Mash is already a classic, no doubt about it.

CHARLOTTE ROEL

Generation Love - Happy One Records ehr/ace PRODUCERS: F. Adams III, T. East, A. Holtti Spans the styles of soul, R&B, pop and dance. Opening track My Love establishes the right mood: upbeat, snappy-produced '70s pop dance. Although the direction of the album does not really put the world on fire, the execution is flawless and very radio-friendly. Roel's affectionate vocals are coupled with a slick, contemporary production sound and the album boasts an abundance of hit material. Best: Ain't No Getting Over You, Generation Love and The Woman In Your

SUZANNE VEGA

Nine Objects Of Desire - A&M a/ehr PRODUCER: Mitchell Froom Suzanne Vega has managed to transcend her folkie base into an eclectic singer/songwriter style, not in the least thanks to husband and producer Mitchell Froom, She first showed that new direction on the album 99.9F. Nine Objects Of Desire (twelve tracks) takes her distinct, cinematic style even further. All songs get the famous Froom treatment: elaborate but subtle background noises, sudden slight tempo changes and an overall, transparent production. With Vega's songwriting at its strongest, the album is a true pop feast with highlights like Caramel, Headshots, No Cheap Thrill and Honeymoon Suite.

TRISHA YEARWOOD

Everybody Knows - MCA country/ace PRODUCER: Garth Fundis Her impressing 1994 album The Song Remembers When was still full with country ballads as Nightingale and Mr. Radio. With its successor Thinkin' About You, Yearwood already moved in a direction of more up-tempo country, a mission fullfilled on her last effort. Picked as one of New Country Music's spearheads, Yearwood is one of the best candidates to crossover to other formats. Hello I'm Gone has ACE written all over it. In the US, this new album will surely prove to be another fruitful source of hits. In Europe, it could break her in the mainstream.

The Number To Call Is...BR5-49 - Arista c/a/ace PRODUCERS: J.Nuyens, M. Janas Rockabilly has never been sexier. The rhythm section sucks you in with their rock & roll energy. Chuck Mead lets his tough guy vocals break just at the right moments. BR5-49 take no prisoners, they just leave their victims exhausted on the dancefloor-and that includes the trendy cynics. There's plenty of crossover potential, which is why the Black Crowes must have asked them to join their US tour. First single Cherokee Boogie mixes radio-friendly melodies with a spine-chilling steel guitar and powerful shuffles, enhanced by the slap bass. MILAN - Along with Eros Ramazzotti, Zucchero and Luciano Pavarotti, Laura Pausini has become one of Italy's most popular musical exports. Her third international fame having already registered over one million sales in world-wide pre-release shipments.

Pausini has sold over six million albums enchanting a world-wide audience with her natural stage

> presence and simple Italian melodies. CGD/East West MD Gerolamo Caccia, also president of Warner Music Italy, says that Laura Pausini has been Warner Music's selective list of worldwide priorities for over a year now. "Laura is now a real international superstar. This is a great new album and our expectations are very high, not just in terms of sales, but also in terms of critical reaction."

Whilst I feel that I have not changed as a person, travelling has given me insights into the diversity of cultures and the disparity of social conditions" says Pausini, adding, "I cowrote the lyrics for three of the songs on the album, which reflect a personal view of my relationships with friends and family and also the aspirations of my generation. In Italy, young people are especially disillusioned with politics and the empty promises of politicians. We should not believe that someone else will change things for us, but it is up to us to do something."

The promotional campaign for the new album began with the August 26 radio release of *Incancellabile*. CGD/East West marketing manager Luciano Linzi says that they are already reaping the rewards. "Since September 5, we have run advertising campaigns on four national radio

networks, which will continue until the end of the month. TV spots have been booked for the pre-Christmas season and Laura will be making guest TV appearances on top rated prime time shows throughout the fall. We were targeting initial shipments in Italy of 100.000 copies (platinum) but have already surpassed that by 50.000 copies prior to the album's release date," says Linzi.

Spanish Sales Barriers

In Spain, Pausini is not only the last artist, international or domestic to have sold over a million copies, but was also the first international artist ever to have broken the one million sales barrier. The Spanish album version entitled Las Cosas Que Vivas is released on September 17 in the Spanish speaking markets, whilst a version with three songs in Portuguese and the rest Spanish is being released simultaneously for Brazil and Portugal. As CDG/East West international exploitation manager Alda Gandini explains, "The Spanish album sold half a million copies in Brazil before Laura did any promotion there, so we decided to record three tracks on the new release in Portuguese."

hour of airplay on a New York-based PBS affiliated station. "In a way, we're re-introducing American culture to the Americans, which is a very difficult task for a European label. We were lucky to find an enthusiastic label manager at Koch."


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



Breakin' & Entering

A weekly Eurochart analysis by Machgiel Bakker



While Killing Me Softly remains firmly locked in at number 2 in the Eurochart (and sold an amazing two million-plus copies in the process), the Fugees' follow-up Ready Or Not crashes into the chart at number 5 this week. It marks the second highest entry of the year, following George Michael's Jesus To A Child (new in at 3).

Just like "Killing" (Lori Liebermann) and $Fu\ Gee\text{-}La$ (the Ooh La La La bit in the chorus is borrowed from Teena Marie), "Ready" is

inspired by other people's work. As the album liner notes put it, the song contains a "replayed sample" from Bell and Hart's $Ready\ Or\ Not\ Here\ I$ Come, originally a top 40 US hit for the Delfonics in 1969 (hitting the UK chart two years later). According to an article in Music & Media's sister publication $Music\ Monitor\ (June\ 28)$, the track also makes unauthorised use of Enya's Boadicea, a track taken from the Irish singer's debut album $The\ Celts$.

The Sales Breaker award goes to **B.B.E.** with the dream house-influenced tune *Seven Days And One Week*. Produced by Frenchman Emmanuel Top and released on his own imprint Triangle in March of this year, *Seven Days* was a big hit on the Ibiza club scene this summer and is now climbing the scales in the GSA region (number 3 in Germany), Belgium, Italy and France. If the UK also starts picking up on this instrumental track (released this week on the Positiva label and already heavily endorsed by London-based Kiss 100 FM), *Seven Days* is bound for bigger things.

Fuelled by the single *Trash*, UK glam rockers **Suede** now register the biggest increase in chart points with their third album for UK indie Nude (marketed via Sony Music's Licensed Repertoire Division in the rest of Europe), *Coming Up*. It's performing remarkably well in the Scandinavian territories (number 1 in Denmark, 3 in Norway, 5 in Finland and number one in the Swedish chart of next week), while also making good inroads in Germany and home market the UK. Although only in its second chart week, the band's current position at number 7 is already an improvement on the performance of the previous two albums. While Suede's 1993 self-titled album peaked at number 8 (and stayed on the chart for 16 consecutive weeks), the follow-up *Dog Man Star* enjoyed a peak at number 10, but with a week total of only six.

As expected, **R.E.M.** have entered the Top 100 with the highest debut of the week, *New Adventures In Hi-Fi*. Debuting at number 9, it is, together with recent releases by Ocean Colour Scene and Neil Young, the second-highest entry of the year, following the entry of Tina Turner's *Wildest Dreams* at number 7 in April.

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Pulp Takes Mercury Music Prize



LONDON - Pulp were once again the focus of an awards ceremony. This time it was for winning the 1996 Mercury Music Prize, a rather more traditional route than when singer Jarvis Cocker stole the Brit Awards show by crashing into Michael Jackson's performance.

After the announcement by the judging panel's chairman Simon Frith, the sophisticated Britpop group lived up to its winning album's title of Different Class when Pulp took the stage to accept the trophy. Cocker said, "We've had our award already because people

The Mercury Music Prize once again attracted scepticism regarding the validity of comparing such a wide range of genres. Its emphasis on promoting the entire shortlist of ten albums equally, however, defuses much of this criticism especially as its credibility and value as a marketing tool increase. The prize is sponsored by the telecommunications company Mercury Communications and is supported by both the British Phonographic Industry and the British Association Of Record Dealers.

I think the fact that we have been very successful with acts such as Tina Turner and Pink Floyd in France was also an element in their decision,' states Ofayon.

"Original founding member, author and composer Rick Davies, will be at the heart of the band's comeback", he adds. It is not clear if the other original co-founder Roger Hodgson will be part of the new line-up.

Work has started on a new album due out in 1997 to be released on Chrysalis in the UK and on EMI in the rest of the world. The option for the North American market is open and Ohayon doesn't rule out that EMI could well be the band's label there.

Formed in 1969 by Davies and Hodgson, the band quickly signed to A&M. Their first eponymous LP failed to make it in the charts and they rose to fame with their 1974 album Crime Of The Century, produced by Ken Scott. Supertramp's 1979 album Breakfast In America was a major breakthrough for the band and they subsequently became one of the biggest bands of the late

'70s. The album landed five hit singles, Goodbye Stranger, Breakfast In America, Dreamer, Take The Long Way Home and The Logical Song.

Further efforts 1982's Famous Last Words, Brother Where You Bound (1985) and Free As A Bird (1987), the two last ones without Hodgson who went solo. But none reached the same level of popularity as Breakfast In America.

MTV Awards Line Up Announced

LONDON - The 1996 MTV Europe Music Awards, to take place in London's Alexandra Palace on 14 November, is to include star performances from Bryan Adams, Metallica and the Fugees. London will be playing host to the event for the first time which will be broadcast to a potential European audience of 123 million viewers. More major artists are to be announced in the run-up to the show, and MTV promises surprises on the night.

Daily newspaper Liberation called the show "an open-air CD-ROM". The Jackson symbols are not forgotten-the glove during Billie Jean, the red jacket for Beat It.

At the end of the show, a city is torn down and Michael Jackson surges from the ruins, stopping a tank in its tracks, finishing with Earth Song and Heal The World in which Jackson is surrounded by dozens of young people. Over 100.000 people attended the show, including Czech president Vaclav Havel, and 40.000 Germans who drove to Prague, creating a huge traffic jam at the border.

After the Prague show, during a brief ceremony, Sony Music executives, including Epic president Dave Glew, Sony Music International president Bob Bowlin, SMI senior VP Richard Denekamp and Sony Music Europe president Paul Russell handed Jackson a series of platinum and gold albums for total sales in excess of 12 million units, including five million in

In France HIStory passed the million mark and has become the best selling double CD ever. Epic France general manager Christophe Lameignere says the sales of the album will be boosted by "the biggest advertising campaign we've made so far with this album", with the release of a video compilation of Jackson's clips.

During an international meeting prior to the concert, a new 30 minute video shot by Jackson was presented to Sony Music executives. Sony Music France president Paul-René Albertini called this video "the Thriller of the Nineties".

Sony Music used the concert to stage a major promotional coup by flying journalists and music programmers from all around Europe to Prague. The French delegation comprised 60 people, including representatives from radio stations RTL, NRJ, Fun Radio, Voltage, and RMC. The HIStory tour will take Jackson first to eastern Europe (Budapest, Moscow, Warsaw) and after a gig in Saragosse (Spain) will move in October to South East Asia and Australia. In December, Jackson's roadshow will hit New Zealand and Japan. South Africa is on the map for January and the European leg of the tour is expected to resume during spring and summer 1997.

While his collaboration with his 3T nephews is still positioned in the top 10. Michael Jackson's single for Epic, Stranger In Moscow, grabs the highest entry new European Hit Radio

at number 22. The dramatic rock song, the fifth single to be taken from HIStory, marks Jackson's 15th hit on the format since the inception of the chart in December 1990. It is remarkable that all four previous singles from the IFPI-Europe five-million certified album hit number 1, and it will be interesting to see if the new single can live up to that. The entry coincides with Jackson's current HIStory tour (see front page).

Here is a chronological overview of the mega-star's impressive track record on EHR, which includes no less than seven chart toppers. Following each title is its peak position and the week and year of chart entrance. Numbers shown between brackets refer to the number of weeks spent at the top slot. All singles were issued by Epic.

At this stage, Jackson's new single is embraced by a relatively small roster, measuring only 31 EHR stations in 10 European countries. The calibre of this roster, however, is very high, as it includes a formidable proportion of Platinum-ranked reporters (52%). The support for Stranger In Moscow is strongest in Holland (83% national EHR penetration), while Italy and Denmark form the second league (42%).

The most added single on the format this week, is Dance Into The Light, the radio-friendly new single by Phil Collins. No fewer than 28 stations have reported it for the first time this week. Dance Into The Light is the lead single and title track of Collins' seventh solo album, his label debut for East West. The African-flavoured album is due for release in October.

The single enters the EHR Top 40 at number 33, backed by 30 stations in 11 countries. The UK, Ireland, Italy, Spain, Austria and Denmark are most supportive. Dance Into The Light is the sixth solo single by Collins that hits the chart, including a duet with David Crosby. He once hit number 1-with Both Sides Of The Story, which occupied the top slot for five consecutive weeks in 1993.

Border Breakers commentary by Raúl Cairo.

For the second week in row Eros Ramazzotti's Stella Gemella holds on to the number one position in this week's chart. The song is losing some of its momentum however, and whether it will last as long as its predecessor remains to be seen. Più Bella Cosa, holding on at position 15 after an astounding 24 week chart run, is still a programmers favourite across Europe. The unabated popularity with radio also helps bolster the performance of the album Dove C'E Musica, which can be found at position number four in the European Top 100 Albums chart this week.

This week's Road Runner award winner **Zucchero** is no stranger to this chart either as *Il* Volo vaults to position number 6 thanks to a widely spread reporter roster, now reinforced by Spanish rock leaning EHR network Cadena 40 Principales.

Another fast mover this week is B.B.E., whose Seven Days And One Week was first released this spring. The track did very well in Spain where it became one of the great club anthems of the summer. Now, the brainchild of French producer Emmauel Top is rapidly earning the respect of radio makers across Europe as well. The song, which has been doing very well in Spain and

UK should only serve to strengthen the song's visibility. The highest new entry this week is by Danish pop outfit Axel Boys Quartet. A cover of Me & My's Dub-I-Dub, the song is taking Poland by storm, and making inroads in Netherlands.

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The other entry this week Khadja Nin's Sambolera Mayii Son. Many programmers consider this West African

flavoured tune perfect late summer material and expect it to be on their playlist for some weeks to come. ACE outlets such as Hundert.6/Berlin as well as Radio Megapol/Stockholm are among its staunchest supporters.

The charts on this page track the border-crossing movement of product. The Border Breakers chart ranks the 25 most successful Continental European records making airplay impact outside their country of signing (airplay achieved in the original country is excluded from the calculations).

The second chart, Channel Crossovers, registers the airplay penetration of UK-signed artists in mainland Europe, while the third Top 25, the Atlantic Crossover chart, ranks the most successful. Non-European artists seconding to airplay impact, in

All three charts are non-format specific. "Country Of Signing" is not necessarily an Indication of where the artist comes from but, more significantly, where he/she is signed. 

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
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

A blissed-out cover of Lee 'Scratch' Perry's 'Curly Locks' gives a clue to where The Fox are coming from, while 'Ladybird' floats in on an ethergal piano riff and rubs a sultry shoulder with the Bristol posse.

However, Baby Fox are not simply (trip) hopping onto the bandwagon, Songs like 'Alienway', 'In Your Dreams', and the sublimely beautiful 'Gloria Grahame... Rain' may slink their way through an opiated blues jam, but the likes of 'Girl' [one-minute.long] and 'Black Twister' [three lines of bewildering growling) aren't âfraid of fucking with your head.

For Baby Fox, a "normal" family buting would presumably involve Nightmares On Wax meeting Massive Attack for a large spliff in a Jamaican ghost town. sam steele

After three independent singles lazily spaced over the last few years, this trio of long-time friends finally release their jazz-flavoured, trip hop debut album.



The upside of this is that some of the interesting and inventive music that is always out there becomes more visible. Such is the case with Baby Fox. Every week, at least half a dozen albums arrive vainly trying to do what A Normal Family does —
meld all manner of modern rhythms
with older forms (such as jazz,
funk and dub) and choral elements of traditional songwriting with the linear conventions of club music, then give the whole a unifying pop gloss. If there is a dominant flavour, it is dub with an ambient tint, which singer Christine Ann Leach's unfussed, yet soulful, voice suits to a tee. Records that have immediate

appeal and staying power are rare, but A Normal Family is just such a thing. AS

When a band kicks off their debut album with the sound of someone spewing up their dinner, you know it's not going to be your average trip-pop affair. After all, the legion of female-fronted blunted beaters that followed Portishead aut of trip-hop's 'quite-fancy-the-look-of-the-Top 40' closet almost all failed because they copied the Bristolians' songs, but ignored the murky atmospheres that made 'Dummy' such a triumph. Thankfully, London-based Baby Fox haven't fallen into that trap. Instead, they've taken the smoky torch song to new lengths and, if it weren't for the odd sub-Saint Etienne bland-aut, it'd be damn near perfect. 7 (BW)


BABY FOX A NORMAL FAMILY

Malawi (13tks/41mins) ANYONE who's spent Christmas at home knows there's no such thing.

Nineties technology has liberated musicians in the way that lighter cameras freed up the French new wave directors. Baby Fox, a trio who include the singularly-named Blur and Radiohead video-maker Dwight are the Eric Rohmers to Portishead's Godard - more human and less self-conscious than most of the Tom, Dick and Harriets currently being compared to Bristol's best.

"A Normal Family" is trip hop in essence if not in execution. Instead, despite a sample heavy landscape that features lovers rock, ambient, Radalamenti via Cruise, static lost radio transmissions, and copious flashes of inspired inter-track strangeness to link the whole lot together, Baby Fox take their main musical cue

from the galaxy-sized spaces of dub reggae - a music form that historically makes none-toofrequent appearances in MM (You lie! We shall lick you with the rod of correckshun-shun-shun -Ed). For something this good,

"A Normal Family" is dream-like in the extreme. Piano chords sound like they're being beamed in rather than struck, quitar lines are surrounded in so much echo it's impossible to detect where one starts and another ends. Singer Christine Ann Leach was bounced on Jimi Hendrix's knee as a baby, and maybe his notion that music should sound like it's actually coming from within rubbed off on her.

BPM-ED INTO oblivion? Desirous of sultry dub heroes with sub-zero chile? Well, look no further than Baby Fox, whose frosty fronds of polyrhythmic percusion, slo-ma concismouldering, and lounge lizar lovers' rock will soothingly shiver you spineless. 'A Normal Family', the three-year-old threesome's dazzling debut, is the dub-soaked aural equivalent of flaking out in a flotation tank whilst a myriad of mantra-mumbling marshmallows administer a mind-mellowing mental massage. Mmm, marvellous. More primal sigh than primal Scream, space-pop's premier dub shave concocted an irresistible potion of passion from such disparate

sonic sources as Gregory Isaacs, Marc Bolan, Lee Perry and Cole Porter. Slow-burning diva of the diverse, Christine Ann Leach's soul-drenched vocal floats atop a minimalist soundscape of plush symphonic synthesis, vital-quaking bass tremors, and pastoral sampledelia. Moments of ice-cool Portishead sophistication ('Ladybird') nuzzle up to masterful reinterpretations of Lee Perry's Trojantastic 'Curlylock' (spiced-up with brief nods to Junior Murvin's 'Police And Thieves' and 'Evry Time We Say Goodbye') and Marc Bolan's hymn-to-her, 'Girl'.

To achieve the prerequisite mood Baby Fox prefer to record in an eccentric selection of thrift-shop sartorials. DJ and sound architect Alex Gray is said to favour a nurse's uniform, whereas chanteuse Christine and video prankter Dwight drift haphazardly from

shabby raincoats to silver space-suits. Fortunately, this trangible, mix'n'match eccentricity permeates every glorious groove of 'A Normal Family', and consequently you never know what to expect. The sedate silken reggae vibe of 'Jonny Lipshake' is splintered by peripheral raps and an itchy and intrusive vinyl scratch, the skunked-out skank of 'Za Za (Get Ready)' is occasionally disturbed by a peripheral smokey, tokey bloke who drifts haphazardly amidst the mix, and the throbbing blisful trancing of 'Rain' is strongly reminiscent of the Scream's seminal 'Higher Than The Sun'. All in all, 'A Normal Family' is a startling and essential debut; a dazzling dub masterpiece positively drenched in iridescent and irresistible pout-pop credentials. (8)



NAMED after an old fox stole they found at a charity shop. Babyfox epitomise the louche, cocktail-lounge glamour currently being dusted off by many post-ambient Nineties producers. Taking the skunked subsonics of dub as their basis (rather than the blunted hip hop breaks favoured by Portishead and Moloko), "A Normal Family" is a modernist pipe-and-slippers album more concerned with mood and texture than structure and coherence.

In fact, the more ethereal that it gets, the better it sounds. Take the mesmeric lilt

of "Curly Locks", on which the lazy swirls conjured up by vocalist Christine Leach melt seductively into a liquid bassline. Or 'Alienway", a dreamy acoustic drift of an hallucinogenic bailad. And don't forget the recent single. "Jonny Lipshakes"

Once in a while, they up the pace and the feel then becomes much less certain. In Your Dreams* has an odd, addictive melodic step, but pseudo-Leftfield pophouse fluff like "Za Za" merely corrupts the fragile mood.

Like most normal families, then. Divided right down the middle.
