



## CMA Awards Set To Boost Country Music

LONDON - A generic retail campaign in the UK based around the 30th Country Music Association (CMA) Awards has reaped the benefits of record viewing figures for the televised event. Industry figures are already looking at ways of expanding the concept to other European territories; a further four countries are set to screen the show this month.

In the UK an edited version of the awards, held in Nashville October 2, were screened October 5 on BBC 2, and the initial audience figures stood at 2.1 million, 50% more than last year's ratings. In addition, the show was also

broadcast live in the early hours of the morning by national BBC Radio 2.

To coincide with the event, the UK arm of the CMA this year also ran its first ever generic campaign, mounted with the co-operation of the British Association of Record Dealers (BARD) and the British Phonographic Industry's marketing committee two weeks before the event itself.

According to both retailers and record labels, the greater visibility of the television event certainly made its mark in terms of sales. "We have had a big customer response from our in-store campaign," says Stephanie Heasley, Tower Piccadilly's country buyer. "All the sales of the

artists are up, particularly from people like Vince Gill and LeAnn Rimes."

For the UK record companies, the results were equally heartening. Rimes' performance made an instant impact, according to Will McCarthy, product manager at her label Curb UK, "We have seen a dramatic increase in continues on page 24

#### Gypsy Sisters Take Spain By Storm

### Danish Pubcaster To Cut Jobs In Austerity Plan

COPENHAGEN - The Danish broadcasting company Danmarks Radio (DR) has announced an austerity plan aimed at cutting annual costs by Dkr194 million (app. US\$34 million) from the year 2001.


DR will trim more than Dkr 250 million from total expenditures during the next four years. The TVradio pubcaster will inform between 360 and 420 employees in November that their jobs are to become redundant. DR expects a number of positions will disappear through natural attrition, but there will be layoffs among the 3.200 employees.

The company says that the strategy will not affect the creativity of the organisation. Most of the job cuts will be made among office personnel, data-processing employees and technicians, along with 10 to 15 managerial posts.



#### ■ UNITED KINGDOM

New BBC Record Label BBC Worldwide is finalising ambitious plans to capitalise on the archives of Radio 1 by releasing a series of up to 20 CDs a month. Head of music John Willen admits that a new BBC record label is being created for this purpose but insists on keeping the roster secret. It is common knowledge, however, that the collection contains previously unreleased recordings by Genesis, David Bowie, the Police, Led Zeppelin, the Rolling Stones and many others from throughout the station's 25year history.

Virgin Revamps Line-up Virgin Radio has revamped its line-up to coincide with the departure of mid-morning presenter Richard Skinner. Skinner, one of the broadcaster's orginal programmers and presenters when the national rock outlet went on-air more than three years ago, left the station after his contract was not renewed. Effective October 21, daytime presenter Graham Dene moves into a new morning show 10:00-13:00. as the result of this year's Sony Radio Award winning Russ 'n' Jono Breakfast show being

extended one hour to 10:00. Virgin newcomer Jeremy Clark steps into the 13:00-16:00 slot after joining the broadcaster less than two months ago as an overnight presenter. Nicky Horne's afternoon drive time programme and the evening shows are unaffected by the changes. Meanwhile, Virgin's chairman Robert Devereux has taken a year off to spend time on his new estate in Scotland. Virgin owner Richard Branson will be at the helm until Devereux's return.

#### ■ SPAIN

Jun Márquez Dismissed EMI Music Publishing Spain director general Jun Márquez was dismissed on October 3. and the group's director of continental European operations Terry Foster-Key said the split was made "by mutual agreement." Alicia Morant, financial director at EMI's head office in Madrid said there had been a "difference of criteria" between Marquez and the group, which had not been satisfied with his performance. Marquez had been in charge of the Spanish operation for some six years. The sacking came as a surprise to the sec-

## **National Revenue To Fuel Future UK Radio Growth**

LONDON - Under the slogan "Commercial Radio. Its Time Has Come," the UK Radio Advertising Bureau's recently published discussion docu-ment, "The Future Of Com-mercial Radio," confidently predicts the medium will gross £487 million (app. US\$754 million) annual advertising revenue in the year 2000. This represents over five percent of the total display advertising spend in the UK (source: Zenith Media Growth Fore-

Radio Advertising The Bureau (RAB) is the trade organisation funded by the UK commercial radio operators. Its current predictions are launched from a firm platform: commercial radio has been the fastest growing advertising medium of the 1990s in the UK, with the amount of money spent advertising on the medium almost doubling between 1992 and 1996.

The driving force behind revenue growth, according to the RAB, has been the

increase in the national advertising market, up 129% in 1995/96 compared 1992/93. But the document also points out that the local advertising marketplace, up 91% in the same period, "would have qualified on its own as the fastest growing advertising medium across much of the early 1990s.

Based on the Radio Authority's commercial radio licensing plans, the RAB anticipates there will be 250 commercial stations in the UK by the year 2000. Taking the highly com-

petitive London commercial radio market (where over 25 stations are receivable) as a model, the Bureau sees this increased competition as a stimulus to commercial radio listening. "The London mar-ketplace has seen commercial radio's share stablise at just over 60%," says the document. "If this were to be replicated across the whole of the UK then we can anticipate future growth in commercial radio audiences of around 20%. Digital Audio Broadcasting (DAB), currently beginning to take future shape in the UK following the Radio Authority's announcement that the

first national digital multiplex licence will be advertised in the fourth quarter of 1997, is seen as another stimulus to advertising revenue growth. The ability of DAB to carry visual information may, predicts the Bureau, add a further dimension to radio adver-"DAB allows for information to be transferred to a screen built into DAB receivers. This could carry detailed traffic information or perhaps even advertiser



#### **■** BELGIUM

**Positive Trends For Eva** As the Belgian industry reports a modest growth of two percent during the first eight months of 1996 compared to last year, TV-merchandising company EVA Belgium has announced an impressive 35% boost in turnover for the same period. Initially EVA Belgium concentrated primarily on exploiting back-catalogue tracks (their radio and TV based "De PréHistorie" series has sold 1.8 million units at presstime) accounting for 75% of the company's turnover, EVA GM Linda Coopman managed to anticipate the slacking replacement market by issuing more successful current hit compilations. "Virtually every major hit has been reissued on a compilation or mid-price CD, and the replacement market is close to death" says Coopman, "and we therefore took on the challenge to counter this trend with new projects. In 1994, we took a gentle start to make the radical shift towards hit-compilations the year after. In 1996, back-catalogue sales represent only 25 % of turnover. Koch Restrucures In Benelux Koch International has reorganised its Benelux operations, following the take-over of MM Productions which gives Koch access to numerous recording studios in Holland. Artistic signings will be limited to either Flemish language or instrumental, with the Belgian company dealing with marketing, sales and special projects. On the other hand, artists will profit from Koch International's integrated approach including CD-recording and

manufacturing.

**Beech Branches Out** Invicta Radio's programme controller, Sandy Beech, has left the Capital Radio-owned broadcaster in Whitstable to launch a radio and television production business. The company, S.H. Productions, is being set up in Chesterfield, Kent. According to Beech, his firm's client base include, London's 95.8 FM, BRMB in Birmingham, Key 103 FM in Manchester and the Virgin Megastores. S.H. Productions has just completed a jingle and sweeper package for the New Pepsi Chart Show produced by Unique Broadcasting, he notes. Beech has been programme controller at Invicta for the past 17 months.

**Rolling Stones Documentary** A massive marketing campaign is underway to promote the release of both the album and video of The Rolling Stones-Rock And Roll Circus. Mick Jagger's dissatisfaction with the recordings has kept them under wraps since the BBC staged the event in 1968. The highly anticipated documentary also features The Who, Eric Clapton, John Lennon, George Harrison and many other celebrities. Midnight screenings attended by some of the stars are ensuring media coverage.

#### ■ SPAIN

#### Valiente Resigns

Francisco Valiente, secretary general of pubcaster Radio Television Española (RTVE) has presented his irrevocable resignation to RTVE director general Monica Ridruejo, just four months after taking office. An RTVE statement says Valiente's departure is due to "personal reasons", although it is well known that he has had discrepancies with other RTVE executives. In addition, Valiente had been responsible for drawing up RTVE's 1997 budget which was rejected by the conservative government.

#### FRANCE

95.2 Reformats For Paris Paris-based station 95.2, is on the brink of becoming a truly urban station with a new schedule centred around traffic information, entertainment. news and sports. The station is aiming to reach a metropolitan audience of 3% in the next two years. This attempt to reverse a dramatic audience decline follows a restructuring of shareholders, with Générale d'Images taking over 25% of the station and the city of Paris dropping to a 40% share. Other shareholders include pay-channel Canal+, Paris transit authority RATP and Metro Traffic Control. The station will be run by Eric Baptiste, former general manager of

## Radio Authority Announces DAB Timetable For The UK

LONDON - Following the enactment of provisions in the new UK Broadcasting Act 1996, commercial scale digital radio has for the first time been given a timetable for introduction into the UK.

As part of a number of revisions and additions to its plans for independent local radio (ILR) licensing in the UK, the Radio Authority announced on October 9 that it expects to advertise a national digital radio multiplex service licence

during the fourth quarter of 1997. Apart from experimental DAB transmissions undertaken by commercial stations and the BBC in London and elsewhere, this will be the first appearance of digital radio on the UK airwayes.

Britain's three existing national commercial broad-casters, Classic FM, Virgin Radio and Talk Radio, will be asked to decide whether they wish to take up their places, guaranteed by the Broadcasting Act, on the new national multiplex. Those that do will

have their current national analogue licences automatically renewed for a further eight years by the authority, and will not have to go through the process of competitive bidding when their current eight year licences expire. All three are likely to take up the DAB option. Virgin Radio head of press Ellie Smith says, "We definitely want to take it up. It's the future."

The authority confirms that the national commercial broadcasters will initially simulcast their programming on DAB and analogue, pending significant penetration of affordable DAB receivers in the UK market. This may take until well into the next century. The Radio Authority also announced that advertisement of the first local radio multiplex service licences will begin early in 1998.

On the analogue front, ILR. three new regional licences for north west England, north east England and central Scotland are on the authority's agenda. The regulator is also pressing ahead with its programme of smallalternative location licences ("sallies") designed to increase the opportunities for smaller scale broadcasters to apply for commercial licences.

### **Nostalgie Confronts Swiss Authorities**

PARIS - The Swiss radio market is facing confrontation from French radio operator Radio Nostalgie over the fate of Lausanne-based Radio Acidule.

The issue is being raised by Radio Nostalgie as it contends a series of decisions made by OFCOM, following the acquisition by Nostalgie of a 20% stake in the financial-

of a 20% stake in the financily ailing Radio Acidule.

Launched in 1995, Radio Acidule has been facing bankruptcy with an audience never exceeding 1%. In May, Nostalgie took 20% of the station's operating company and reshaped the programming. Other shareholders are press group Edipresse, the bank Banque Cantonale Vaudoise 150 smaller and over investors.

The new project was presented to OFCOM in May but failed to receive approval.

Marc Furrer, director of OFCOM, wrote to Nostalgie

stating that a positive answer from OFCOM to the proposal for Radio Acidule "could create a situation damaging to the competitors of the station." According to Furrer, studies

show that there is not enough potential for two commercial stations to share the market.

Nevertheless, Acidule was re-named Radio Nostalgie Lausanne and started broadcasting a new programming on August 26, inspired by Nostalgie's French programming but adapted to local needs, with local hosts and content. Meanwhile, Nostalgie's French programme continues to be broadcast from the French city of Annemasse to Switzerland and is the leading private station of the region.

On September 24, OFCOM released a statement claiming

that Radio Acidule has violated its original licence by changing name and broadcasting a format other than the one it was granted a licence for OFCOM urged Radio Acid-

ule to revert its name and take all necessary measures to adapt the current format to that originally intended.


Frederic Coste, general manager of Nostalgie International, which

handles the international operations of the French ACE net reacted strongly to this announcement, stating that Nostalgie has acted "according to Swiss law."

Coste adds, "The Swiss audiovisual law authorises a change in shareholding up to 20% without considering it a shift in ownership. In addition, our programme is produced locally and thus not part of a network, which is illegal in Switzerland. Besides, a station can change its name without putting its licence in jeopardy."

## Clyde Dominates Glasgow Airwaves

#### ■ CITY PROFILE



Year after year, the regular RAJAR audience figures tell a staggering story in Glasgow—or rather, west central Scotland, which more accurately describes the defined transmission area, which extends down the River Clyde estuary, taking in the large towns of Greenock, Dumbarton and Helesburgh.

Every quarter, without fail, Radio Clyde's two stations, Clyde 1 FM (EHR) and Clyde 2 (MOR/gold) on AM, between them have a greater share of listening here than all BBC national and local stations, and all other local commercial stations together. Behind that extraordinary force, however, there is a strange combination of factors—social, demographic, regulatory—unique in the UK, which perhaps begins to explain this extraordinary state of affairs.

#### A Winning Combination

You can't ignore the main reason, which is the sheer strength and confidence of Clyde's programming, from the day it started broadcasting as one of the UK's first private stations on Hogmanay (New Year's Eve) 1973. Its

combination of pop, sport, politics, news and local talk, wrapped up in bold local advertising, was something entirely new in Scottish media, and made it a popular and critical success from day one. It was also the only one of the first batch UK commercial stations that was consistently (and immediately) profitable, thanks largely to the skills of its original managing director James Gordon, and chairman Ian Chapman, both of whom retired from their posts earlier this year.

Chapman and Gordon made Glasgow and Scottish commercial radio their own. How have they hung on to their lion's share of listening, despite splitting into Clyde 1 and Clyde 2 in 1990; and in the face of the deregulation and expansion of the last few years under the Radio Authority?

#### Clyde's Competition

Today, Clyde's local competition consists of commercial stations Scot FM (ACE/talk), the central Scotland regional station, and 96.3 QFM (ACE/gold) in Paisley, UK national stations BBC Radio 1 and 2, and BBC Radio Scotland. The national commercial stations Atlantic 252 and Virgin Radio (both on AM) also figure in the listening figures (see table).


Not one of Clyde's rivals, not even the local stations, matches its 1.8 million transmission area exactly. Clyde is wholly within Scot FM's crosscountry 2.8 million-strong region, and QFM's 756.000 potential listeners are half-in, half-out of Clyde's patch. Could Clyde's continued preeminence be partly due to an absence of head-to-head competition on the hard streets of Glasgow, the Victorian second city of the British empire?

"There are 13 or 14 stations serving Glasgow," argues Alex Dickson, managing director and director of programmes at Clyde, "and they do not repeat themselves. And remember, Glasgow is a small city by US or European standards—the population in the city itself is only 630.000, and falling.

"I think the west of Scotland is well-served, and anyone tuning in can get what he or she is looking for," he continues. "Within that, our role is to be the local station; and it's what's between the records that makes you a success."

The only other similarsized UK cities to have avoided head-to-head commercial competition are Liverpool and Newcastle, where Radio City and Metro Radio respectively






dominate. And unlike those stations, Clyde does not face a city BBC station, but BBC Radio Scotland. Although based in Glasgow, it serves the whole country north of the English border, from Dumfries to Aberdeen, Skye and Shetland.

When you add to this the infamous east-west social divide in central Scotland—industrial Glasgow doesn't like effete Edinburgh, and vice-versa—you begin to see why it's been so hard for Scot FM to make much of an impact in

the west, where the biggest part of its potential audience lives. And you see why, given the continued solidarity of Clyde's programming, and the enormous loyalty built up over 23 years, it still runs so far ahead of the pack.



After a difficult first year, Scot FM is now the most successful of the new UK

commercial regional licences, with an overall 8.1% share of listening across its region-it is particularly strong on the east coast. Now it stands to benefit still further, ironically following its sale this summer by the Scottish TV company Grampian to the Independent Radio Group (IRG) of England.

IRG had also bought Paisley station Q96 a few months earlier, relaunching it in the spring as 96.3 QFM and

achieving an immediate 46% rise in reach in its area. Following its acquisition of Scot FM, IRG had to dispose of 80% of QFM to comply with UK ownership rules. From November IRG may be able to buy it back under the revised rules of the 1996 Broadcasting Act, although IRG will need to pass the Radio Authority's "public interest" test in order to do so. Then, Clyde's two obvious potential local competitors

would be owned by the

same group.

IRG group programme director Jeff Graham has re-located from Paisley to Scot FM's studios in Leith, Edinburgh's docks district. With the station's new managing director Norman Quirk, formerly of Clyde and Stirling station Central FM, Graham is reviewing programming. "We see Scot FM's 50% speech requirement as an advantage," he says. "We'll be hoping to invest in our news and sport.

This could be the trick which finally enables Scot FM to break out of its 8.4% marketshare in the west. Last year, the station pulled off a major coup by winning exclusive rights to live commercial radio commentary of the Scottish football league, which had previously provided Clyde with its hugely popular Saturday afternoon "Superscoreboard" show Glasgow, with Rangers and Celtic, is a football-mad city.

But in its first season Scot FM did not capitalise on this, with its lack-lustre commentary show "Bell's Dug-Out Live" trailing in the ratings. Clyde's "Super-

## Poland's Annual Radio Meeting: On The Road To Automisation

Warsaw will again host the Polish Radio Conference, this year on October 22-23. Jointly sponsored by Music & Media, it brings together over 500 delegates from all over the country as well as equipment manufacturers and record companies active in the country's bustling radio market. Susanna Contini Hennink presents conference highlights.

Organiser Alina Dragan says this year's conference was planned on the basis of feedback from last year's par-

ticipants. "On the technical side it was clear that radio in Poland is particularly interested in going digital, and it is looking for outside broadcast solutions, as OB services in Poland are still weak. Radio operators want to know about the pos-

sibilities satellite connections offer, as well as ISDN—whatever can facilitate transmissions outside the studio."

As in all technological advances such as DAB and the Internet, Polish radio is also very interested in automisation. Managers are looking for computer solutions to make station operation easier (live assist for commercials, jingles and scheduling). For this reason a particular effort was made to invite companies offering software solutions, rather than hardware and transmitter suppliers.

Polskie Radio Programme 3 is planning live transmissions from the conference via ISDN lines (to the station in the city centre). "We intend to use Telos codecs to test the transmissions," says Dragan, "but if the ISDN lines are not up and running in time, we will have to rely on cable connections from TP [the Polish state telecommunications company]."

Record companies are more actively involved this year—some are bringing Polish artists such as Zdrowa Woda, and Sony Music is bringing Hoover from Belgium and Ten Sharp from Holland. They will have acoustic sessions during the Sony Music party at the Tango Club on Tuesday evening. Programme 3 will broadcast part of this event live

#### **Highlights Day One**

13:00 While there still aren't commercial DAB receivers on the market, there is a lot of talk about DAB and interest in the subject, especially on the part of technicians. The Polish DAB Platform is presenting a discussion on the state of DAB in Poland.

13:00 "Programming," says Dragan, "is just as important as the technical side

The Sound Of The Station Award is sponsored by Sony Broadcast & Professional of radio, so we will devote several discussions these topics. Dan O'Day has been invited back this year, because a lot of people want to hear more about how to operate on air. On Tuesday, however, his talk will be directed at station management-how to motivate your team, and invest in them. I think that a lot of managers in Polish radio don't see the importance of investing in

their staff—that they have to be trained, and also be allowed to attend conferences like this one—to meet other people, talk and be part of the industry."

16:00 Targeting management and technicians is a session presented by NAB senior vice president Richard Ducey on how radio can use the Internet—a guide for the broadcaster. He will give examples of stations active on the Net, and how can you make money with it. Many Polish stations are setting up their own home pages, and are very interested in its potential.

16:00 At the same time as the NAB talk is a discussion aimed at programmers called The Triangle. It's about relations between record companies, music presenters and programme directors. "The three elements are interdependent, but each have their own interests at heart," says Dragan. The problematic relations between them will be brought to light.

#### **Highlights Day Two**

09:30 Holland's Sky Radio public affairs and International development director Martin Banga will come to talk about the success of a DJ-less station—and what it's based on. In Poland there is no station that plays non-stop music, and programmers are interest-




ed to know more about it. Banga is also president of the private radio association (VCR) in Holland.

11:00 O'Day's second programming seminar titled "Real Life + Radio = 100%" will discuss how to create original features that reflect the station's personality and its listeners' interests. Methods will be presented to illustrate how the station's experiences can be used to discover new ways to involve its listeners.

11:00 As part of a management & sales presentation, IP Polska will sketch the development of radio networking in Europe; chairman of the Czech Private Radio Association Michal Zelenka will discuss the present situation of radio in the Czech Republic, and Martin Banga will comment on the Dutch viewpoint.

Rounding up the two-day conference is the awards presentation. Sony Broadcast & Professional is again sponsoring an award for the best Sound Of The Station. Conference attendants will elect a winner on the basis of 90-second promotional tapes submitted by radio stations. A new award will honour the best equipment or solution presented at the exhibition. As an added incentive for those who voted for the winner, one person will be chosen by lot to receive a free trip to the NAB radio seminar in Rome.

scoreboard" is still top in Glasgow and picking up awards, despite having no commentary. Its presenters describe events over taped crowd noise by reading tickertape, or watching TV monitors with their "magic specs.

BBC Radio Scotland's "Sportsound," meanwhile, is the top Saturday afternoon football show across Scotland as a

whole. "Competition is very intense west central Scotland, with more stations than elsewhere in the coun-Radio says Scotland acting managing director Neil Fraser. With an impressive 21% reach across the country, the full-


service BBC network (which combines news, talk and features with music, sport and the arts) is second only to BBC Radio 1 (at 27.7%) north of the border. Yet Clyde 1, which is only audible in west central Scotland, is third most popular station in national terms (17%), a fact which underlines the concentration of the Scottish population, not only in the central belt (Scot FM's region), but more precisely in its western half.

The only other stations to get a lookin in Glasgow are BBC Radio 1 and Radio 2. Each is distinctly different from Clyde 1 and 2. Radio 1 is much more cutting-edge musically than Clyde 1, which this summer lost its respected morning DJ and head of music Bobby Hain to Virgin Radio, and

Radio 2 has more talk and more contemporary melodic music than Clyde 2. It's fair to say that Clyde's identity and dominance are so strong that the BBC UK music channels benefit by contrast, picking up most of the substantial minority of listeners who don't like the sound of Clyde's music.

The tantalising prospect of a second central Scotland regional station to go

head-to-head with Scot FM. announced in the Radio Authority's new working list October on might answer those critics, who, like myself, believe there isn't enough musical variety on the Scottish commercial airwaves-

Recent years have seen many temporary restricted licence services (RSLs) in Glasgow. There have been some wild jazz and dance-orientated student stations, and an excellent country station. From London far to the south and beyond, Clyde appears, understandably, a dynamic local heroindependent, successful and popular. But here its strength can sometimes seem stifling, as it goes unchallenged. There are other Glasgows, too; but they're not often heard on the radio.

## Teenage Fanclub: A Band's Eye View

All four members of Teenage Fanclub come from west central Scotland, and the band still lives in Glasgow. Its 1991 album Bandwagonesque was named album of the year by Spin magazine, and 1995's Grand Prix made many UK critics' lists of best albums of last year. A new single on Creation Records (UK)/Sony (Europe) before Christmas will be followed by the release of the band's fifth album early in 1997.

Raymond McGinley (guitar/vocals) grew up listening to Radio Clyde. "My Mum still listens to Clyde 2, but the only time I hear it today is in taxis or shops." Norman Burke (guitar/vocals) has the BBC's all-speech station Radio 4 on all day in his house. Gerry Love (bass/vocals) likes BBC Radio 1's

"Evening Session."

But the radio show the band, including drummer Paul Quinn, like the most is Mark Radcliffe's late night show on Radio 1—not just because they've been on it several times, but for the show's attitudes to the music it plays. "We also like those music programmes on BBC Radio Scotland that you can tell have been well put together," says McGinley, "like Patrol' 'Beat [Sunday,


17:00], 'Hump The Queue' [Monday, 19:00], 'Original Masters' [Saturday, 12:00]. One of the things I like to do is tune along the dial until I hear something interesting about music, a documentary or feature that'll make me stop-it doesn't matter what it is, folk, musicals, jazz—and these programmes come mainly from BBC Radio Scotland, and BBC Radio 2 or 3.

Clyde 1 FM playlisted two of the band's singles during 1995 (Mellow Doubt and Sparky's Dream), but McGinley says that being in a band makes you so aware of the workings of the industry that it's difficult to distance yourself from that-so daytime radio is hard to enjoy simply as a listener. He adds, "Perhaps that's why Norman has Radio 4 on all the time!



## Belgian Indies Up Front

Propelled by the international success of bands like dEUS, K's Choice and Evil Superstars, a new generation of indie labels is making a mark on the Belgian music scene. Major labels also are moving to take advantage of the indies' savvy. Marc Maes untangles the tale.

NDEPENDENT labels' role as well-spring of talent has been highlighted by recent collaborations and take-overs. EMI Belgium reinforced its dance depart-

ment by teaming up with long-time successful dance indie Antler, which lead to the chart success of 2 Fabiola. In 1993, BMG Ariola joined forces with N.E.W.S., the Ghent-based home of house and

techno. To start with, BMG Ariola took on sales and distribution of successful dance projects like the Serious Beats compila-tions. In December 1994, the collaboration developed into a partnership with BMG taking a minority stake. More recent-Virgin Benelux acquired Play That Beat!, thus gaining access to such highly

successful local acts as Get Ready!, Luc Steeno and former Polydor artist Willy Sommers.

Arcade Music Company's dance department has been booking successes with such acts Paradisio. Originally released in Belgium in January this year, the group's single, Bailando, produced by Patrick Samoy and Luc Rigaux (a.k.a. the Unity Mixers), was pre-

sented at MIDEM and several "But we CNR-Arcade meetings. rereleased Bailando in May," says A&R/product manager Nii Van den Eynde, "when it was picked up by Radio Contact in the south of Belgium. The Flemish Radio Contact affiliates, BRTN Radio Donna and Radio 2 soon followed suit, and we have now crossed the 25.000 unit sales mark."

At presstime it was announced that Arcade has just concluded an agreement with Creastars International-more details are revealed on page 5.


#### **Dance With Big Time**

With the dance remix of the Temptations's Papa Was A Rolling Stone by Third World, dance indie Big Time International (BTI) broke the Belgian Top 20 chart. The company acquired the rights for Europe and Japan and licensed the track to CNR in Scandinavia and Ginger in Spain. Its follow-up, a re-make of Now That We've Found Love is set to mark BTI's jump from underground to cross-over dance projects.

"We have been working as dance music providers for the last six

years," says MD Laurent van Meerhaeghe, "both in producing and remixing dance tracks and in supplying DJs, specialised shops and what I would call 'trainspotters'—the dance collectors.

Van Meerhaeghe says the dance scene enjoys an extremely high "label loyalty." Sticking to quality releases is therefore one of his company's principles. "We take care not to disappoint our clients on all levels-what we produce ourselves, the tracks we revamp and our BTI styling," explains Van Meerhaeghe, adding that the company looks back on some 50 releases over the first half of 1996. On labels such as Reload Records (Reload Ambient, Reload Limited) and 21st Century, BTI caters to an international dance audience. The compilation series Ballroom Tunes-Music From The Club La Rocca opened the gates to France, where BTI recently signed a label deal with BMG. In Belgium, Ballroom Tunes Volume 6 sold 20.000 units, its follow-up also to be released in France.

Koch International is standing behind creative German language dance artist Work-nom L.A. d'artiste for Alexander Louvet. Before Koch. signing to where he released his new single I Like Sex, L.A. Work released a number of singles for the dance circuit, producers with Dominic Sas and Serge Ramaekers (of Confettis). "L.A. Work is what you

could call a self-made artist," says MD Bob van der Valk, "and we believe in what he does. He's also taking care of his own promotion and his single is much in demand for compilations.

preparing the launch of the quartet's rapper Axana, re-baptised Snake. "We are currently recording a number of tracks in the UK with Culture Club producer Dennis Dwyer," says Guilini, "and we plan to release the first single in 1997 with BMG Ariola UK as our distributor.

Guilini admits that the label is fighting its way back into the charts after Def Dames Dope suffered from line-up changes and

The success of All I Need Is You

opened the gates to the GSA territo-ries, Scandinavia, France and Holland. In addition, Lee was invited to open for Boyzone on its forthcoming tour. In support of the new release, East West France has booked a campaign with Skyrock network and the artist is featured in European

teen magazines with a wide array of merchandise for competitions and promotion.

Crammed Discs, well known for

its world music and innovative dance repertoire, released Hugo's debut album La Formule mid-September in Belgium, France (licensed to Columbia) and Switzerland (distributed by Recrec). Paris-based Hugo is a radio-friendly artist. aiming at a broad audience. "It's our policy to have at least one French language artist on the roster," says MD Marc Hollander, "and after Dominque Dalcan left for a major company

(having sold over a million records in France), we're happy to say that Hugo is doing very well in France and Belgium. After he played the Botanique festival in Brussels, he now gets airplay with Radio Con-

#### **T4A Goes It Alone**

Team 4 Action (T4A), home of Pierre Rapsat, Citizen Jane and Perry Rose, broke up its deal with Sony Music Belgium at the end of September. MD Claude Martin signed a distribution agreement with AMC and currently has three new releases in the pipeline. "I admit that a major can offer a strong distribution apparatus, but nevertheless you are facing competition with the label's own artists,

says Martin, "and as an independent producer we go for the best deal available."

Citizen Jane's new album, First Lady & The Second Man, is set for release at the end of October, and features a more "poppy" band than at the group's 1993 debut with Laureen.

This autumn Perry Rose will be releasing Green Bus, a collection of his 10 singles plus seven unreleased songs and material from his mini-CD Because Of You.

A priority for Play It Again Sam (PIAS) is Soulwax, a new band offering a US '70s sound, combined with '90s influences. Thanks to radio support from alternative stations such as Studio Brussel and




Radio 21, the act's debut album sold over 7.500 units in Belgium.

"In October [Soulwax'] Leave The Story Untold will see international release," says label manager Christophe Cocquyt, "and we are fully committed to break the act internationally." Cocquyt adds that in France the release is supported by the FUN radio network, where the album is directed towards specialised programmes. In Germany the album has been selected as "Album Of The Month" by the WOM chain.

In November, PIAS will also release the new Channel Zero album. The act's debut album sold 50.000 units Europe-wide, "which is not bad at all for a metal band destined for a rather limited audience," says Cocquyt.

It makes you really want to hear the rest of the album.

#### **INDO AMINATA**

Love Will Be On Your Side - Mercury ehr/d/ace PRODUCERS: various

With remixes by the Fugees and Massive Attack, this Ethiopian vocalist is bound to gain interest from hip programmers, but the clean radio of this gentle, soulful ballad will also charm ACE stations. The Fugees remix relies heavily on African elements, especially string instruments, while Massive Attack strips the song bare and adds a stark techno sound.

#### **DAVE ANGEL**

Timeless - Fourth & Broadway/Island PRODUCER: Dave Angel High quality dance with a radio-friendly sound. An uptempo beat, floaty synthesizers, funky keyboards and an enigmatic lion's roar make this an interesting listening experience, although it's also a funky invitation to dance.

#### **BABYFACE**

This Is For The Lover In You - Epic PRODUCER: Babyface, LL Cool J What a great move to add the street power of LL Cool J to Babyface's smooth grooves! The resulting single from the upcoming The Day album has a firm hip hop beat, a sassy tone and Babyface's trademark dark velvet sound.

#### EAST SEVENTEEN & GABRIELLE

ehr/d/ace If You Ever - London PRODUCERS: Rose & Foster For sexy grooves the Smoove Mix of this soul classic offers excellent fare, but if you want to go real dirty, you might want to play the Ruff Mix. EHR should give the energetic live version of Steam a spin.

#### **FALCO FEAT. TMB**

Naked -Spin/EMI PRODUCER: T. Börger ehr/d

Austrian rapper Falco is still rapping in German in the '90s! His new strippeddown staccato tune adds a rocking guitar to a house beat in the original mix. The Sweetbox Short mix offers a vocoder-voice instead.

#### **FOOL'S GARDEN**

Pieces - Intercord ace/ehr/r PRODUCERS: Fool's Garden Moving away from the easy going melodies, the highly successful German group forays into ACE land with a beautiful mid-tempo ballad. It's melodies are intelligent singer/songwriter material, but the production is lush and comfy enough for different radio formats.

#### **GALLIANO**

Roofing Tiles -Talkin' Loud/Mercury ehr/ace/d PRODUCERS: Demus, Ski Oakenfull Galliano produces a jazzy ballad this time. A the classic string-driven slow one, as only the British seem able to produce. Recommended for those who like the Style Council and are looking for something different.

#### KENICKIE

Punka - EMI a/r/ehr PRODUCER: John Comfield Naming themselves after a character out of "Grease", this UK quartet produces fun punk in the tradition of Green Day and Ugly Kid Joe. The female vocals sound charming and fresh, while the guitars on extra track Drag Race make it border on glamrock.

#### ONE AND ONE

Phenomenon - Next Plateau/Roadrunner PRODUCERS: Swing Of Things, One And One One and one makes two. This rap crew comes up with a midtempo track which has raps in the verses and vocals in the choruses. Not phenomenally good, but entertaining just the same, with the hook hitting your brain.

#### ADAM P.

Shake It! - Mocca/Roadrunner ehr/d PRODUCER: Art 4 Art What do we have to shake? Ah, an old Spandau Ballet-loop. In this track, a screaming voice is layered on top of an upbuilding rhythm. The whole thing lifts you up to a climax. The edit can cross this clubhit to the radio.

#### **ROBSON & JEROME**

What Becomes Of The Broken Hearted -RCA/BMG ace/ehr PRODUCERS: Mike Stock, Matt Aitken This old-fashioned orchestral remake of the Motown-classic is definitely a good choice. The single is released with their interretations of two other classic Saturday Night At The Movies and You'll Never Walk Alone.

#### **SCOOTER**

I'm Raving -Club Tools/Edel ehr/d PRODUCER: The LOOP! Rembember Marc Cohn's beautiful piano ballad Walking In Memphis? Change the lyrics in I'm Raving, I'm Raving, add some bagpipe-synths and the semi-live-gimmick patented by Scooter. This makes chart-storming seem effortless.

To call this an 'unplugged cover album' would be very unfair. This excellent collection of classics suits Joe Cocker incredibly well. Of course, Was adds his subtle Midas touch to the arrangements. Cocker attracted ace artists like Billy Preston, Tony Joe White, Randy Newman and Jim Keltner to complete the golden sound. White's High Lonesome Blue has 'Joe Cocker' written all over it, although the gritty voiced singer thinks nothing of tackling Randy Newman's Sail Away. He starts roughing it on Dylan's Dignity, an intellligent blues song which he does proud.

#### **TEN SHARP**



Roots Live -Columbia ehr/ace PRODUCER: Niels Hermes Ten sharp covers and their own hit You as an en core. Recorded for a live audience, Holland's most melodic pop duo takes you on a trip though radio-friendly covermania. Looking through the trademark John Lennon glasses of Niels Hermes, you will find discoveries including World Party's Ship of Fools, and the Doobie Brothers-tune's What A Fool Believes. Electric Light Orchestra is even featured twice with Livin' Thing and Mr. Blue Sky.

#### **COUNTING CROWS**

Recovering The Satellites -Geffen/BMG r/ehr/ace PRODÚCER: Gil Norton Counting Crows have found another big house where they can record their second album. The producer for the follow-up to the million-selling August And Everything After is different: Gil Norton instead of T-Bone Burnett, leading the American heart-rockers to a more direct sound. Among the highlights are the midtempo Children in Bloom, the piano ballad



Generation Love - Happy One/ELAP ehr/d/ace PRODUCERS: F. Adams III, T. East, A. Holtti As a young girl, Charlotte Roel already posed for an Aretha Franklin gig poster. For this Danish 'queen of soul', finally her dreams come true now that she has recorded an album of her own. The modern production makes her sound like Janet Jackson in both the title track and Let Your Love Conquer Anything. Most remarkable is the jazzy side of Charlotte Roel, to be enjoyed in the beautiful ballad Yellow.

#### **WEEZER**

Pinkerton - Geffen/BMG PRODUCERS: Weezer Life can be hard on a nerd, especially when you lack serious attention in the female department. Still without girlfriends after the success of their debut album, these college radio heroes of Weezer pick up their favourite topic again. The explanation is that their most addicted female fans are living across the ocean, as discussed in Across The Sea. Too bad! The only thing that remains, is to sing along with the enthusiastic No Other One or listen to the Moog-synthdriven Tired Of Sex. There are plenty of funny lyrics and easy to sing-along songs in this new package for lonely boys.

#### **SUSANNA HOFFS**



Susanna Hoffs - London ace/r PRODUCERS: various Naturally Hoffs has given up on her cute girl act. Just like fellow female Angeleno Belinda Carlisle, she has returned with a mature new sound, which she developed by herself with the help of Jack Joseph Puig, David Baerwald, Matthew Sweet, Jim Keltner and Sparklehorse's Mark Linkous. The result is a place where Sheryl Crow and her Tuesday Night Club were enjoying themselves before Crow moved on to more personal, darker pastures. Among the hightlights are the Linkous/Hoffs penned Enormous Wings, which offers Hoffs poppy side and her collaborator's knack for eschewing the obvious. Falling ("Piece by piece I come undone") is just as ambivalent. The tempo picks up on the bluesy rocker King Of Tragedy which is equally suitable for radio. Stuck In The Middle is a great hidden track, to be found as number 12.

## Simply Red Gear Up For Christmas And Beyond

LONDON - Exactly a year after the release of their fifth album *Life* and 12 into their career, Simply Red have returned with a *Greatest Hits* package, tipped to take a hefty share of this year's Christmas market. "Simply Red are an amazingly consistent huge seller," says East West UK MD Max Hole. "We shipped at double platinum.

An album of this nature will be so much bigger in the Christmas period than if we were releasing it at any other time of the year. It was deliberate on our part to try and get it in with a good 10 week run up to Christmas."

Simply Red's line-up has recently changed. Heitor Pereira and Fritz McIntyre are no longer contributing to the band. Manager Elliot Rashman explains that "there is no live version of Simply Red and there will not be one for a long time." According to Rashman, the release of the Greatest Hits album "was partly to clear the decks for Mick's henefit to move forward without carrying a lot of baggage. This is a nice

neat overview of what is hopefully a halfway point in his career. He has been working on a new album [to be released in 1997], of which he has already recorded sixty percent." Max Hole backs up what he calls a "review process". "We regard it as a mid-term report rather than an end-of-term report."

#### **Aretha's Cover**

The album features fifteen tracks, fourteen of which are from the group's five studio albums, which between

them have sold over 30 million copies worldwide. There is also one new song, a cover of Aretha Franklin's 1973 hit *Angel*, which is released on October 28.

This collaboration with Wyclef Jean, Pras Michel and Lauryn Hill of the Fugees was recorded for the Set It Off OST. Coincidently, Quincy Jones, who produced Aretha's version, asked Hucknall to perform some songs with his big band at the Montreux Jazz Festival earlier this year. Their live version of Angel will be featured on one of the singles as is the soundtrack version and several remixes, all which

should ensure there is a market for the single.

CGD/East international marketing manager Bruno Pasini spoke in last year's Music & Media issue 42 about his plans for marketing Life which since then attained double platinum. Twelve months on, what he calls the "special relationship between Mick and Italy" has developed even further. "Simply and especially Red's Mick's popularity in Italy has grown tremendously since last year," says Pasini. "It's because he lives here and because Life has been worked for one solid year." Pasini cites the positive impact of the band's involvement with Euro '96, in which

the video for We're In This Together was shown at the beginning of every soccer related TV show. "For us to have a Greatest Hits album is a way to exploit this popularity which Mick has achieved in Italy. Radio is already picking up *Angel*. Of course, the fact that the Fugees are on the track is a little cherry on the cake. Some stations have even started playing some classics when they found out about the compilation album."

#### **Heavyweight Marketing**

Although there is an emphasis on the Christmas market, Hole says he expects the album to sell all through next year and there will be another single. "The plan is to go with at least one other, probably in January or February, which will probably be So Beautiful. He describes the marketing campaign across Europe as "heavyweight in all the major markets" while in the UK, is totally candid about spending £1 million on marketing this album just up until Christmas.

After the high profile campaign for the last album and tour, Hucknall is keen to keep promotion to a minimum this time. In the UK, Hucknall will be available for selected major interviews. As his manager comments "We've kept this campaign relatively low-key. We will back it to a point, but it can't interfere with creating the next record, because that's where his heart is."

## Algerian Raï Star Khaled Crosses Over With Goldman Track

PARIS - If Aicha had all the ingredients for a hit, the magnitude of its success was quite unexpected. The song, performed by Algerian-born singer Khaled and composed by Jean-Jacques Goldman, is one of the season's biggest crossover hits in France. At presstime, the song peaked at number two in the French sales charts.

Khaled's label Barclay knew "something big" could happen with the song, due to the combination of Khaled's and Goldman's talents and by the catchy chorus of the tune, but not a landslide to that extend. The French success of Aicha exceeds that of Khaled's biggest hit to date - 1990's Didi produced by Don Was, which established Khaled as the indisputable "king" of raï, this musical style born in Algeria in the '80s.

#### **International Market**

Khaled's eponymous first album for Barclay, which included *Didi* and its successor *Nssi Nssi* sold over 200.000 units each in France and respectively 170.000 and 70.000 on the international market.

Aïcha is the first single from Khaled's forthcoming album Sahra, named after Khaled's daughter, to be


released in France on November 12. The album will include a series of songs produced by Philippe Eidel, three tracks produced in Jamaica by Clive Hunt, three tracks cut in L.A. with Don Was and a duet with French rap act IAM. Two of the songs including Aicha will be in French.

Barclay GM Olivier Caillart explains that, "It was Khaled's will to sing in French. He asked Goldman for a song, which for us, is a fantastic opportunity to expand Khaled's public. Our strategy was to release the single a long time before the album so we could capitalise on the success of the single. But it exceeded our expectations." According to Gaillart, massive radio airplay made a difference. "Apart from Skyrock, Khaled wasn't played, but now the song is heard on virtually every station in the country. Airplay started earlier this summer on ACE, EHR and full service stations."

ACE RTL2 music programmer Christian Lefebvre explains why he playlisted the song. "The tests weren't too good initially but they improved over time, so now we're playing it twice to four times a day. I have to admit this song is good for the quotas." ACE Europe 2 had no problems with the song. Head of

music Nicolas Du Roy says Aicha is on top rotation with "good tests" on its core market.

It also qualifies for EHR stations. Director of music programming Caroline Davigny says she plays the song three times a day. "The tests are good on the 15-24 and 25-35



demographics." She admits playing it to meet with quotas. "And it's a good song. You can spot the Goldman touch, but it has not hindered Khaled's personality in any way."

#### **Human Stupidity**

Davigny admits she wouldn't have played it if it was sung in Arabic, simply because it would not help her meet the quota requirements. "It would have played an Arabic version, "because it is not in our format." He adds however that he received insults from listeners who complained about hearing an Arab artist. "Human stupidity has no limits. France is quite a racist country and it scares me. But this won't prevent me from playing the song." Former head of music for RTL Monique Le Marcis says these negative comments usually originate from "the acting minority. I can't help thinking that for two angry people calling the station, there are millions of listeners who like the song."







#### **Breakin' & Entering**

A weekly Eurochart analysis by Ramon Dahmen

The Spice Girls with its smashing debut Wannabe (Virgin) remains at its position on top of the Eurochart Hot 100 Singles. This week highlighted by the stars of the Sales Breaker award, Wannabe charts outside the top in Ireland (number 16) and the UK (39). The girls also claim this week's highest new entry with the follow-up to their million-selling number 1 Say You'll Be There. So far the single only charts in home country the UK, where it has booked the largest shipment to record stores since George Michael's Jesus To A Child. Say You'll Be There debuts at number 5 in the UK and is highest new entry in this week's EHR Top 40 (see page 25).

The top spot of the European Top 100 Albums is still in the hands of R.E.M. with New Adventures In Hi-Fi (Warner Brothers). The band charts in all countries contributing to the Top 100 Albums with a number 1 position in Austria and is listed outside the Top 10 in France (number 22), Holland (11), Portugal (14), Spain (16) and the UK (16).

Climbing up 53 notches to a position in the top 10 (number 7) is Simply Red with his Greatest Hits (East West). For this

remarkable leap, for which the amount of chart points is multiplied by 10, the UK artist is rewarded with the Sales Breaker stars. In the UK Greatest Hits climbs up 13 notches to the top spot. The album also is listed outside the top 10 in Austria (20), Belgium (25), Denmark (25), Finland (38), Italy (20), Holland (44), Norway (27) and Sweden (20). Greatest Hits is Simply Red's sixth album to hit the chart after Life in 1995.

That was the artist's third album to celebrate a number 1 position after A New Flame in 1989 and five times platinum-selling album Stars in 1991. Stars appeared in the charts from 1991 until 1994. In this week's EHR Top 40 Simply Red has earned the Radio Active award with Angel (page 25).







Christian Nissen, director general of DR addressed criticism claiming that the structure of the company was overadministrated and bureaucratic, but insists it will now be streamlined.

Around Dkr 110 million of the annual saving made after 2000 will come from the TV sector. The radio division will lose some Dkr 20-30 million in funding, while the remainder will be cut in joint administration operations. Through the plan, DR's board hopes to boost productivity by 35% in TV activities and by 25% on the radio side.

The austerity plan stems from new legislation designed to prepare Danish media for the next century. Employees of the company have known for several months that cuts were inevitable, and they were definitely not pleased when DR announced the plan. Complaints were heard earlier this year when DR called in a management consultancy to perform a study on how the organisation could be rationalised.

Initially, Jazz FM Records will release compilation albums, including a blues record in November and two albums of other styles of jazz/blues next February. Eventually, the label hopes to sign a number of original artists and emerging acts, according to Golden Rose chairman and chief executive Richard Wheatly.

On the launch of the new label, Wheatly comments, "The records will reflect the breadth of Jazz FM's programming. We are seeking to deliver high quality jazz products to our listeners." He claims that there are more than a million listeners between the two Jazz FM stations. The launch of the new record label is the first initiative by Jazz FM Enterprises, the company's business develop-ment arm. Other ventures to be announced over the next few months include; international programme sales, jazz restaurants, stations' merchandising and publishing, according to Wheatly.

## **Arbore Resigns As RAI** Radio Chief

MILAN - Renzo Arbore resigned as head of RAI Radio October 14, just over two months after he was appointed to restructure Italy's three national public service radio networks (Music & Media, August 24)

Following a week of discussions with top level RAI executives who attempted to convince him to stay on, Arbore confirmed his decision, describing it as "irrevocable" and criticised strong interest groups within RAI whom he says made it impossible for him to implement real change.

Arbore told the Italian press that the last two months saw his dream of modernising RAI Radio turn into a nightmare of bureaucratic blockage.

"I have spent the past two months often without sleep to develop a new direction and new programmes, however at a certain point I realised that I risked being used as a front to represent a new direction, when in reality I had no real power to change anything," explains Arbore.

sales last week. The event has definitely struck a chord; the CMA viewing figures have quadrupled over the last two years and I am sure it is another indication that this is an expanding market," he says.

Glenn Crouch, the UK product manager at BMG, responsible for country music on Arista, RCA and Giant Nashville adds, "TV is crucial and is certainly very beneficial in terms of sales. It was excellent that the CMA in this country pulled the record companies, broadcast and retail elements together."

Although BBC 2 has screened the show for a number of years, head of music programming Avril MacRory says the awards this year benefited from a much higher profile and the final rating figures may reach three million. "One of the things that made a big difference this year was the commitment from the BBC to trailering. We ended up getting very high profile trails and we were thrilled at those. That is why the audiences were as big as they were." She adds that BBC 2 regards country as a growth area. As well as the BBC in the UK and RTE in Ireland, screenings have been lined up for Denmark (TV2), France (Canal Jimmy), Sweden (SVT), Switzerland (DRS) and Germany (Premiere); the show was also screened in Australia on Prime TV and in Canada on Global TV.

Kate Farmer, director of international marketing at MCA Music Entertainment International, sees no reason

why similar retail initiatives to the UK campaign can't be arranged for other European territories. "We have been booking ads in television listing magazines in the territories planning to show the awards," Farmer says. "I would hope that the generic campaign could be expanded to other territories because the CMA also has offices in Germany and the Benelux."

#### Broadcasters Sign With MTV

LONDON - MTV Europe has inked a licencing deal with commercial radio stations in 12 countries for the broadcasting rights to this year's MTV Music Awards, to be staged on November 14 at London's Alexandra Palace. Each broadcaster's deal with MTV has been tailored to meet the needs of the individual stations, according to MTV's president/business director, Peter Einstein. He comments, "Radio syndication is a thriving and growing part of MTV Europe's business and an important means of extending the distribution and reach of MTV's unique music programming."

Participating broadcasters include Capital Radio/England, Fun Radio/France, RTL 104.6/Berlin and Brandenburg, Radio DeeJay/ Italy and Los 40 Principales/ Spain. More deals between radio stations and MTV concerning the awards are pending and will be announced shortly.

### **Airplay Action**

EHR Top 40 commentary by Pieter Kops

Phil Collins' Dance Into The Light has to leave the EHR top slot after two consecutive weeks of chart reign, in favour of I Love You Always Forever by Welshborn, US-signed Donna Lewis. The Atlantic artist acquires the pole position during her seventh charting week, while attracting a 94-station roster on EHR, spread out over 21 European countries—a remarkable achievement for a newcomer on the format.

Holland currently stands out as the most supportive territory for Lewis, generating an 83% penetration ratio. Denmark follows closely with 79%, while Germany, Sweden, Switzerland and the UK form the second league with figures between 65-75%. On a major market level, Lewis' mellow single is also number 1 in three of the markets listed by Music & Media-GSA, Scandinavia and Poland (see Major Market Airplay charts, page 27).

The hottest record on European Hit Radio this week is Simply Red's version of Angel, which entered the chart just last week. The single now shoots up 17 places in one go, thus landing at number 13 and earning the Radio Active award in the process. Incidentally, Simply Red's Greatest Hits grabs this week's Sales Breaker award on the European Top 100 Albums.

On EHR, Mick Hucknall's band is supported by 39 programmers spread out over 14 countries. As yet, the UK, Ireland, Austria, Denmark and Portugal provide the best figures (with 50-53% national penetration). The band's current growth is mainly due to substantial new additions in Germany, Denmark, Poland, Austria, Belgium, Italy, Portugal and Turkey.



Spice Girls

While the debut single Wannabe is still positioned at number 7 during its 13th charting week, Spice Girls seizes the highest new entry in the EHR Top 40 with its follow-up release, Say You'll Be There, the second single from the act's forthcoming debut album Spice-due out in November. The new single kicks off at number 22, backed by a 33-station roster that includes 17 new adds—the highest number of the week. The EHR roster of Say You'll Be There encompasses 11 countries, of which the UK stands out as most supportive (71%), followed by Holland and Greece (67% each).

#### On The Road

Border Breakers commentary by Pieter Kops

After six weeks of chart reign on Border Breakers, Eros Ramazzotti's Stella Gemella has had to make way for French-signed Triangle act B.B.E., whose Seven Days And One Week hits number 1 during its eighth charting week. The track has accumulated a 35-station crossover roster, spread out over 13 countries. It marks the first time since the inception of the chart in October 1993 that a French signing occupies the top slot.

B.B.E.'s roster encompasses all formats, but notably EHR and Dance, and is particularly strong in Belgium, where no less than 50% of Music & Media's reporters have the single in rotation. The UK, Holland and Greece are next in line with national penetration ratios between 32-33%. Seven Days And One Week is also charting well on EHR, debuting in the EHR Top 40 as second highest new entry at number 28 this week (see page 25).

The fastest mover on Border Breakers this week is One And One by Robert Miles, which leaps up 15 notches during its second charting week, landing at number 6 with a heavy-weight, 13-station crossover roster on its side. Apart from home country Italy, Miles' new single appears on playlists in seven European countries. This roster is led by the UK, where seven stations have reported the track in rotation, including Platinum-ranked outlets like BBC Radio 1/London and 96.4FM-BRMB/ Birmingham. Other countries that provide Platinum support include Spain (Cadena 40 Principales/Madrid), Portugal (Antena 3/lisbon), Poland (Polskie Radio 3/ Warsaw) and Turkey (Radio Number One FM/ Istanbul).



French singer Ophélie Winter (above) seizes the highest new entry in this week's chart, as Living In Me, a contageously funky disco single, debuts at number 20. As yet, seven stations outside France have added the track to their rotation lists, five of these being Platinum-ranked—a pretty high proportion of 71%. Especially in Italy, Winter can boast a good radio following. Five stations in that country reported her single in rotation, four of them Platinum-ranked. In Holland, Platinum-ranked ACE outlet Radio 2/Hilversum has also added the track.

The charts on this page track the border-crossing movement of product. The Border Breakers chart ranks the 25 most successful . Continental European records making airplay impact outside their country of signing (airplay achieved in the original country is excluded from the calculations).

The second chart, Channel Crossovers, registers the airplay penetration of UK-signed artists in mainland Europe, while the third Top 25, the Atlantic Crossover chart, ranks the most successful Non-European artists according to airplay impact in Europe.

All three charts are non-format specific. "Country Of Signing" is not necessarily an indication of where the artist comes from but, more significantly, where he/she is signed. An increasing number of national artists are signed to "foreign" labels and M&M aims to acknowledge the crossover impact of such deals.






