Stations 'disadvantaged' by quotas in Catalonia

BARCELONA — Radio stations in Catalonia say that Europe's latest set of quota laws is putting them at an unfair disadvantage in ratings battles with Spain's national networks.

A revision of the Catalan Language Policy Law, approved by the Catalan parliament on December 30 last year, means that all radio and TV stations licensed in the region have to ensure a minimum 50 percent of speech programming is in the Catalan language, and at least 25 percent of music broadcast is "sung in the Catalan language."

Catalonia is the first European region to introduce music quotas for radio since France in 1996—French broadcasters are required by law to programme 40 percent French language music.



The music TV broadcaster is preparing to launch a service in Russia and will also launch its fifth regionalised ser



its fifth regionalised service in Europe, MTV Nordic, in the summer.

In Russia, MTV Networks has entered into a licensing agreement with Moscow-based TV entertainment programming company Biz Enterprises to develop a customised MTV channel, due to launch in the fourth quarter of 1998.

MTV Russia will mark the first time a western TV network has formed a network specifically targeting the Russian population, according to Bill Roedy, president of MTV Networks International. "We have been building a relationship in Russia for the past nine years," he says.


Nostalgia wins in German ratings

Six out of the ten broadcasters who showed the biggest year-on-year gains in audience play oldies or schlager, or a mixture of both. In Berlin, for example, BB Radio switched from AC to

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

BRUSSELS — The European Commission is set to launch a pan-European study which will look at the prices of CDs and a number of other consumer goods in the different EU countries.

The move is part of an overall EU plan which aims for "price transparency" and harmonisation of consumer goods pricing in Europe. The issue of harmonising CD prices was raised when U.K. chancellor Gordon Brown called for an investigation into the price differentials of several goods, including CDs, at the March 21 meeting of European Finance Ministers in York.

However, three weeks after that speech, sources at the Commission tell M&M "no decision has yet been made as to who is 'competent' to deal with the matter." The question of consumer CD prices could be tackled by a range of EC departments, including DG III (industry), DG IV (competition), DG X (culture), DG XV (internal market) or DG XXIV (consumer policy). It is most likely to fall to DG XV, say EU sources.

Adrian Strain, Brussels-based senior media advisor/Europe at the International Federation of the Phonographic Industry, (IFPI) says: "At this stage, the IFPI has not been approached [by the European Commission], but we are interested in [by the European what will come out of this study, and will help in any way we can.'

Once it is under way, the studywhich is not expected to be made public until July 1999-will look at the reasons for CD price differentials in Europe, including market conditions, investment costs, promotion, distribution and copyright costs, as well as VAT.

The VAT on music issue was raised last year, following a call from EU culture ministers for unified VAT cuts on sound carriers, in an attempt to boost the Union's music market. This proposal was rejected by the Commission.

In light of this resistance to just one aspect of CD price differentials, sources in Brussels think it unlikely the Commission will follow the matter all the way through, despite Gordon Brown's support for the issue.

In theory, after the study has been completed, the Commission could rule on the issue by drafting a European Directive on the subject, but sources suggest this is likely to be a long-term prospect.

However, if the Commission chooses not to address CD price differentials, it could be directly contravening a number of key "consumer principles" laid down in the Maastricht Treaty, including consumer protection and the free and equal circulation of European goods within the EU.

Universal, BMG win at Spellmannprisen

Oslo - Universal and BMG sharted the spoils at the Spellemannprisen music awards in Oslo on April 3, taking home four and three prizes respectively from Norway's leading domestic music awards.

At the event, held in the city's Chateau Neuf venue, Universal Music Norway's Espen Lind picked up three honours. He was voted Artist of the Year and Solo Artist of the Year; his single When Susannah Cries also won the Song of the Year award. A special was presented to Aqua's award

Norwegian vocalist, Lene Crawford Nystrøm, for her international efforts.

BMG's Velvet Belly were voted Best Pop Group, while label-mates Locomotives received the Best Newcomer accolade. Bjørn Eidsvåg, also signed to BMG, was named "Spellemann Of The Year."

For the first time in Spellemannprisen's 25 year history, this year's show was split into two categories: one for the more commercial music genres like pop and rock, and one for specialist

"cutting edge" music policy. Now he helms all BBC radio operations.

Q: With the advance of digital radio, what plans do you have-in terms of new services—for the BBC's vast archives of sessions, concerts and interviews?

A: Any new [digital radio] service that we might launch will be subject to the approval of the BBC board of governors [and the government]. But the options we are considering include using the unique archives that we have built up over the past 30 years-largely from Radio 1. It includes 26,000 session tracks, 1,200 hours of concerts, 16,000 artists' interviews, and about 1,500 hours of documentaries on pop music. It would be good for the public and

listeners who have invested in (the archives) through their licence fees to hear it again. And we are constantly building the archive by recording concerts on Radio 1 and Radio 2.

Q: Have you consulted the music industry regarding copyright issues about the idea of an "archive channel' on radio?

A: We are beginning talks, yes, with those who would be involved. It is going to be a big project. We want to work out a sensible way with those who own the rights to get the material released to digital radio. They will have to understand that—at the beginning—audiences will be low. So we have to be careful to keep our investment in digital radio prudent. That's the backdrop to our conversations with the rights bodies.

Q: Recently you said [MOR/AC] Radio 2's music policy is being "updated" to embrace the "post Beatles generation." Can you expand on that?

A: There's a gap between the perception and reality of Radio 2. People used to caricature R2 as a station for those wearing cardigans and slippers. But it's definitely not that anymore. It's a station which reflects the hertitage of popular music and culture in the U.K.

Record companies also see R2 as an outlet for new music, provided it's suitable for the network. For example, Paul McCartney launched his last album on the station. Other artsist such as Phil Collins and the Corrs have done work with R2. Also the record companies are interested in the rotations of the songs. We need to look at that, balanced against the needs of the listeners.

Q: Despite an audience decline, are you happy with Radio 1's course?

A: Yes, it's about playing new music first across all ranges of contemporary music. It is the leader in the U.K., and as a public service station, that's where it should be. Radio 1 was always going to lose audience.

Since 1993, 82 new commercial stations have been launched in the U.K. Then, there was no Virgin Radio in London and no dance stations in Yorkshire and Manchester. We were getting Radio 1 ready for this onslaught on commercial stations by being cutting edge. I'm really proud of it. Commercial radio waits until we make hits. By the way, Cornershop had a session on John Peel's show on Radio 1 in 1993..

Westside turns new shade of blue

LONDON — A surge of blues power is to hit the U.K., with three of the genre's leading advocates launching a label dedicated to releasing "the very best newly recorded blues and soul music around today."

Blueside is headed by Bob Fisher, managing director of the Westside subsidiary of Music Collection International (MCI). He is joined by the doyen of the U.K. blues scene. Mike Vernon, whose track record includes producing acts such as Peter Green's Fleetwood Mac, Chicken Shack, John Mayall and Eric Clapton in the '60s, many for his Blue Horizon label. The third member

"The difference with Blueside," says Fisher, "is that everyone involved is a genuine blues fan. We can do things thoroughly. We know the market, and we'll have the advantage of being able to coordinate better on developing promotion strategies, because the producer, the agent and the record company are already in bed together."

The debut Blueside release, Midnight Doctor, is a compilation by soul/blues artist Willie Clayton. Signed directly to Blueside, with forthcoming albums scheduled for release, are Otis Grand, Eugene "Hideaway" Bridges and veteran Big Lucky Carter. "Otis Grand is in Boston now recording a new album for us," says Fisher. He adds that his ambition for the label is "to create a catalogue which will put Blueside along with labels such as Alligator and Bullseye Blues."

It is, he says, a commercial project, but with "a different level of commerciality [from mainstream labels]. We are fairly low-budget, but with the benefits of a big group behind us.'

V scores \$200,000 for charity

LONDON — This year's annual Football Extravaganza organised by U.K.-based music retailer HMV raised £125,000 (\$203,750) for the Nordoff-Robbins Music Therapy charity.

The total came from tickets for the event, a raffle and an auction of soccer memorabilia. HMV Europe MD Brian McLaughlin told the audience of 1100 that the Extravaganza-which last year raised £102,000 for Music Therais now established as the charity's second biggest annual fund-raising event, behind only its own Silver Clef Awards. He describes the total as "an absolutely fantastic response from everyone who came along.'

The £125-per-head dinner evening, now in its third year, was held on April 2 in London's Grosvenor House Hotel. It was attended by representatives of the U.K. record industry, music retailers and media, and featured the presentation of a lifetime achievement award to 83-year old football legend Sir Stanley Matthews and a speech from former

PolyGram in upbeat mood despite warning on profits

AMSTERDAM — Despite a recent profits warning followed by a drop in its share price, PolyGram shareholders

ny," declared Philips president/CEO Cor Boonstra, who chaired the meeting. With the words "Let's work on better results," he paraphrased Philips' company tag line "Let's make things better!" On February 11, the global entertainment group had announced a 17 percent rise in net sales and 11 percent growth in operating profit for the full year 1997. At the AGM, Poly-Gram president/ CEO Alain Levy spoke about the music arm's success; it reported a 17 percent rise in both sales and operating profit.

Levy warned, however, of the unpredictability of new album sales at the AGM, telling shareholders the

company could no longer rely on long term public loyalty to artists. "Established acts don't sell as much as they used to," he said, adding: "Diversity of repertoire is vital...step by step, local artists can be developed to regional or even international stardom, such as Andrea Bocelli."

With new albums by Sheryl Crow, Hanson, Elvis Costello & Burt Bacharach, Page & Plant, Bryan Adams and All Saints, and a Paul Weller greatest hits package scheduled, Levy insisted he was still confident about the full year performance for 1998.

At the meeting, PolyGram president/CEO David Fine retired from PolyGram's supervisory board, to a standing ovation. In his final speech, he said: "In my years with PolyGram I've watched an enormous growth of the music industry in general, and the development of PolyGram as the top music company in the world in particular."

'Political interests' cited as ORF chief quits

VIENNA — Director Gerhard Zeiler is citing "political" interference as a reason behind his quitting Austrian public broadcaster ORF to become chief executive of RTL Television in Germany.

Zeiler will take the reins at RTL on November 1, replacing Helmut Thoma, who will become head of RTL Germany's advisory board. Zeiler was head of Munich-based TV station RTL2 before taking the ORF post in 1994.

After Zeiler's arrival, several of the state-owned broadcaster's radio and TV stations moved away from their traditional cultural and local programming to more commercial output. National CHR station, Ö3, for example,

was criticised by musicians and record industry executives for playing too little Austrian music.

In 1994, Zeiler was elected director by ORF's 35-member board of trustees. In a letter to staff announcing his

decision not to seek re-election for another four year term, Zeiler claims his changes gained ORF "a higher acceptance from viewers and listeners."

Despite those audience gains, Zeiler says in his letter that "resistance to the course I was promoting of competitive and financial and entrepreneurial independence [for ORF] never died down." He also insists that promised reforms at the public broadcaster

were not implemented, and that what he claims was a lack of support for

ORF management was partly down to board members' "political interests."

Although there was no direct

response from ORF, 11 members of the broadcaster's board of trustees allied with Austria's Conservative party signed a letter refuting Zeiler's allegations. "The task of a responsible member of the board," they wrote," is to look at management's plans from as many points of view as possible and to scrutinize them."

An election for Zeiler's successor at ORF is scheduled for June 15.

BORSATO TOPS TMF POLL

HILVERSUM — Marco Borsato was the top local winner at The Music Factory awards in Rotterdam on April 3. The awards are voted for by the viewers of the market-leading Dutch cable music TV station. In the domestic music categories, Borsato was Best Male Singer and also scooped the Best Album award for De Waarheid, Newcomer Anouk,



whose Nobody's Wife received the best single accolade, was voted Most Promising Act. Total Touch (whose lead singer Trijntje Oosterhuis was voted Best Female Singer) were Best Pop Group; T-Spoon were Best Dance Act. The Backsteet Boys, No Doubt, Aqua, Janet Jackson and the Spice Girls were amongst the international acts honoured.

CZECH RADIO 1 SUSPENDS PLAYLIST

PRAGUE — Former pirate station Radio 1 has temporarily suspended its playlist, just two weeks after it was introduced (M&M, March 28). A spokeswoman for the station, which had created a niche on the Prague airwaves by allowing DJs to chose their own music, says a torrent of complaints via phone and e-mail prompted a management re-think, and the playlist ceased operation on March 27. However, she adds: "We are planning to introduce a proper [playlist], and it will start as soon as possible.


BEL RTL GOES LOCAL IN LIEGE

BRUSSELS — The BEL RTL network has introduced a local breakfast show on three of its affiliate stations in Liège, Huy and Verviers. The regional show will be presented from Liége by Pierre Bail, a TV personality on RTL-TVi. "We noted that in Liège we had the potential to gain more audience," says BEL RTL station manager Eric Gilson. "In most French-speaking cities we beat the [public broadcaster] RTBF in the morning daypart, but not in this particular area. We think the regional programmes will boost our audience substantially." The CHR network has also expanded its Liège newsroom from two to six journalists.

MUSIC COMES TO SKY BOX OFFICE

Sky Box Office, a pay-per-view (PPV) service operated by

U.K. satellite broadcaster BSkyB, is to transmit live a sold-out Robbie Williams concert from London on June 3, in what could be the first of several PPV concerts from the channel. Previously Sky's PPV services have been mainly used for sporting events and films, although it broadcast the Music for Montserrat charity concert last September. The Williams concert will cost Sky TV subscribers £9.95 to view. Says Bruce Steinberg, director of Sky Movies and



Box Office: "We want to open up a new entertainment choice for our customers and hope this will be the first of many such events on Sky Box Office."

CLIFF'S 'CONGRATULATIONS' FOR RADIO 10 GOLD

HILVERSUM — Dutch oldies station Radio 10 Gold kicked off its 10 year anniversary festivities on April 4 with a live radio appearance by Sir Cliff Richard. Sir Cliff, cur-



rently celebrating his own 40th anniversary in the entertainment industry, chatted with Dutch radio veteran Tom Mulder. In a fans' phonein, Richard told callers that he is in the middle of the recording a new

album which will be due for release in October on EMI. His '60s smash "Livin' Doll" was re-released in the Netherlands as a single to promote his Greatest Hits In Holland compilation album.

VPRO instigates 3FM debate

HILVERSUM - Public broadcasting organisation VPRO is to organise a symposium on the future of national Dutch CHR station Radio 3FM.

When Radio 3FM's programming is restructured on September 1, VPRO—the most "alternative" of the nine public broadcasters which supply programming for the station-will see its programming contributions axed or moved to off-peak night-time slots. The changes are being implemented by Radio 3 programmers who believe ratings for VPRO's shows cannot compete with the average for the station (M&M, January 31).

Although some pressure groups have appealed to VPRO to raise the issue on air at Radio 3, VPRO Radio editor-in-chief Gerard J. Walhof is refusing to allow his presenters to raise the issue-he says that would be

"an unnatural use of public radio." Instead, VPRO is organising a symposium on "the purpose of public pop radio" on May 15 at Amsterdam's Paradiso club. In addition to a keynote speech by U.K. alterna-

tive radio legend John Peel, there will be debates between commercial and public broadcasters, and panels featuring

Dutch politicians.

Walhof says he hopes the symposium will create political support for the previously-mooted idea of splitting of Radio 3FM into a CHR station-which would then be privatised-and an alternative public broadcaster. "Radio 3," argues Walhof, "is now the only station where the listener pays twice, through commercials and the licence fee." He continues: "We want to make it clear to the government that Radio 3 FM should either



be a commercial or a public station, not a mixture of the two."

Industry observers suggest that a split Radio 3 FM would probably not be possible before 2000, as the allocation of frequencies in

the Netherlands is a major political issue. There is a possibility that Radio 3's "alternative sister" could go ahead earlier on cable, but that option would also need to be studied.

More likely is transmission of VPRO programmes on the Internet. The VPRO website is already one of the most stateof-the-art sites in Dutch radio, and part the purpose of the symposium is to publicise VPRO's specialist shows on the net. Says Wallhof: "The Internet is a genuine option which we can carefully consider as an escape route from the Dutch broadcasting system."

PARIS - EMI France is reorganising its sources of repertoire following what its president/CEO Gilbert Ohayon describes as "an economic and strategic assessment of our structures.

Effective since April 1, the changes centre around the restructuring of the Odeon Label Group (OLG), previously an umbrella department within EMI France encompassing special marketing, catalogue exploitation and niche repertoire.

marketing The special department (back catalogue exploitation, compilations and special products) is splitting from OLG to become a standalone unit within EMI France under Claude Amrane, managing director, sales operations and distribution.

As a result of this move, "the current [special marketing] team will be able to work closer to the market and greatly improve our performance in this field," comments Ohayon.

Ohayon is merging dance label DLA (Dance Labels Associés), the French home of boy band World's Apart, with Odeon Records, which previously signed contemporary acts to the OLG division. "This new structure, which will keep the name Odeon Label Group, will exclusively focus on current repertoire," he says.

The "new" OLG will have a strong dance feel, handling marketing and promotion of

labels such as Positiva, Antler Subway and Dance factory, as well as acts previously signed to Odeon Records. U.K. R&B band Eternal, previously handled by DLA, will now switch imprints, to EMI.

OLG will be headed by DLA general manager Frédéric Juarez. Current MD Bart Swanson, who joined EMI France two years ago to launch OLG, is returning to his native U.S.

Says Ohayon: "The 'reformatting' of Odeon Records will give birth to a label which will have its own promotion team and allow our company to offer three alternatives [in terms of repertoire] which are really different and complementary-Chrysalis, EMI and Odeon.

BERLIN - Bavarians leaving Germany for their holidays in the Italian lake regions this Easter will be able to take the sounds of home with them.

Bavern Antenne Says

New believers at indies' revival show

In sharp contrast to the situation during the early part of this decade. French independent labels have made a strong comeback, and are rejuvenating the domestic music scene with fresh ideas and new artists. Rémi Bouton reviews the indie revival. spearheaded by the launch of new labels—many of them under the guidance of former majors' executives.

key aspect of the recent revival among French independent labels revival is the fact that many of the emergent imprints have been launched by executives with major label track records. They bring mainstream commercial experience to bear upon the fast-moving, creative world of indies.

Right now, the most talked about new label is Naïve, founded in late 1997 by former Virgin France chairman Patrick Zelnik. His partner in the venture is Frederic Rebet, formerly of Sony where he signed Deep Forest and Wes.

Zelnik believes the rise of indies is part of a market cycle: "When concentration reaches such levels, which is the case now, the market needs new independent labels."

Other recent arrivals include Freedonia Entertainment, set up in 1997 by former Ariola MD Fabrice Nataf; the French affiliate of Richard Branson's V2, headed by Thierry

Chassagne, previously marketing manager for Sony Music imprint S.M.A.L.L.; and Musisoft, a specialist dance and world music company set up by former Sony Music president Henri de Bodinat and his partner Jean Karakos.



"We're living in a very exciting period for indies," says Marc Thonon, who launched his Atmospheriques label two years ago in partnership with another indie, Trema

Thonon's first signing was folk rock Louise Attaque (M&M, band November 1, 1997), whose eponymous debut album has reached platinum (over 300,000 units) status in France. Atmospheriques is distributed by Sony Music.

"It's not totally by chance that we've seen, during the same year, the creation of companies such as Naive and V2, and the success of bands such as Louise Attaque," suggests Thonon, who believes many record company execs have become frustrated with major labels' structures, and are ready to embrace the indie world, with its alluring combination of artistic freedom and streamlined decision-making. Thonon himself previously worked in A&R for Virgin Music Publishing and Barclay.

Thierry Chassagne, whose V2 label has scored a major French success recently with rapper Passi, concurs. "Today's indies have nothing in common with the labels which launched in the '80s. Now, they all have [senior managers with] a professional background in major companies."

Added awareness

Passi

These days, indies and majors alike have to be sharp, experienced and equipped with solid management skills, says Gilles Bressand, president of XIIIbis Records, founded in 1991.

Bressand suggests that the indie

labels which have survived this far into the '90s are tougher than they were. "The labels created in the 1990s, during the crisis affecting the music industry, have learned to be efficient and cost conscious, to have a real vision and not only to act as craftsmen."

Marc Thonon also suggests that the development of specialist labelssuch as Lithium [indie rock], F Communications and **Vellow** Productions [both techno/dance]—has been very important for the French industry. "If you add all these elements together, what you get is the shape of a whole new scene slowly building up," states Thonon.

The basis of the new indie label scene in France is emerg-

ing talent, and creative development of that talent to fill gaps in the market. Hervé Deplasse, managing director of Belgian indie affiliate Double T Music France (distributed by Sony Music), points out that the two main up-andcoming acts to break under the Sony Music umbrella in 1997—Passi and Louise Attaque-both came from the indie sector.

"Majors have problems keeping up with things that are happening, even if they make the effort," Deplasse. "The simple fact is they are not adapted to the market, because it takes them time to react.'

Thirst for creativity

Deplasse's assessment is shared by Patrick Mathé, founder of Last Call.

The label, distributed by indie Arcade, doubled its turnover in 1997. "The music business has realised that if nothing new happens, we'd all slowly die," argues Mathé. "There is a thirst for creativity and new personal initiatives; those usually come from independents."

Yet, says Chassagne, majors remain a dominant force in the French market, chiefly because they have the most powerful distribution tools. "As much as the indie movement is important on the creative side, distribution remains mostly a business for the majors," he says.

However, the success of Belgian indie label and distributor PIAS in France since the mid-'90s has also shown there is room for specialised distributors. The turnover of Play It Again Sam (PIAS) France has jumped from Ffr40 million (\$6.45m) in 1996 to Ffr65 million in 1997. "PIAS is one of the few specialised distributors which has access to the major hypermarket chains, and is able to chart albums and singles," explains the company's managing director, Isidore Brobst.

PIAS' biggest successes in 1997 were the soundtrack to the movie Ma



6T Va Crak-er, which is certified gold (100,000 units), and Miossec, whose Baiser album is also certified gold. PIAS distributes French indie labels such as F Communications and Boucherie Productions.

"Our strength," says Brobst, "is the professionalism of our team. We have the capacity to react quickly as a small unit where information flows rapidly, while benefiting from the solid warehousing structure of our parent company in Brussels."

Distribution saturation?

The challenge of achieving effective product exposure at retail level can still be a tough one for indies.

Independent distributor Arcade France drastically reduced the number of labels it was handling in 1997, allowing the company to work more efficiently on a limited number of priorities. "I don't think there is room for the creation of a new indie distributor," suggests Edel France marketing director Stéphane Girard.

Philippe Gaillard, in charge of export at Arcade, points out that "the entry ticket for independents is higher today than it was in the past, bearing in mind European economic integra-



tion, because you have to look at things with a more global perspective."

Patrick Zelnik, who founded Virgin France in the early '80s and was three times president of industry body Snep, now helms Naïve, which he describes as "a multicultural independent group."

Zelnik says he deeply enjoys his new status as an independent operator, and relishes the freedom he has gained. "There's no more corporate attitude," he enthuses.

"People talk to me normally since I stopped being president [of a major company]. I have the feeling that I'm now backstage, after all those years in the limelight."

Epic puts 'hip-house' on the map

"Hip-house" is building in Europe.

Run DMC's streetwise hip-hop imagery coupled with Jason Nevins four-to-the-floor house beats on It's Like That (Profile) has given Europe one of its biggest singles of the year so far. Now, Sony Music Germany's Epic label is poised to take Nevins' "hiphouse" into the album charts.

Epic MD Jörg Hacker confirms that the label is "close to finalising negotiations with Jason [Nevins] regarding an exclusive worldwide album deal," and a debut album could be out as early as June, if all goes according to plan.

New York-based club DJ Nevins shot to fame in Europe at the beginning of the year with his remix of It's

Like That, originally a U.S. Top 20 hit for New York hip-hop trio Run DMC in 1983. Accredited to Run DMC vs. Jason Nevins, the track surfaced first in the Italian charts and soon after went to No.1 in Germany, where it has sold close to one million singles to date.

At time of going to press, It's Like That was

atop the U.K.'s CIN-com-piled "official" single charts for the fourth consecutive week and also sat in the Top 10 in Sweden, Belgium, Ireland, Norway, Denmark and Finland.

end of March with pre-orders of more than 70,000 singles. German indie Edel, Profile's G/S/A licensing partner re-released the 1991 Run DMC "best of" compilation Together Forever: 1983-91 in January, and it has sold over 100.000 albums so far.

Hacker brokered the current G/S/A licensing deal between Profile-Run DMC's original label—and Edel during his time as head of A&R at the Hamburg-based independent. He took up the G/S/A rights for It's Like That for Epic after Edel passed on its option to pick up the title. He believes there is potential for a whole "theme" album by Nevins, based around the DJ's "hiphouse" sound of classic hip-hop rhymes over contemporary house beats.

"Jason has started a whole new trend," explains Hacker of the track's

popularity. "Hip-hop is widely perceived as a very 'cool' genre, but nobody in a mainstream 'cool' genre, but club can dance to it." With standard dance tracks in Europe being faster than their U.S. counterparts, Hacker believes "you need more than 120 bpm [beats per minute] to appeal to the club audience over here." He adds: "There is still a wealth of classic

hip-hop which could reach new audiences through Nevins' treatment.'

average week, "two thirds of the 60 titles in our weekly playlist are rap or hip-hop tracks. That is almost a bit too much, sometimes. The Nevins songs are more dance oriented, halfway between hip-hop and dance.'

Eins Live currently alternates plays for the two singles, but Rausch does not want to read too much into the "hip-house" phenomenon.

Citing audience research results for similar tracks which appeared in the wake of It's Like That-most prominently NYCC's cover of the Beastie Boys' 1986 hit (You Gotta) Fight For Your Right (To Party) (Def Jam) on Edel-Rausch comments, tracks burn out faster than, say, a record like [Natalie Imbruglia's] Torn."

Meanwhile, Run DMC-the first hip-hop act to score a platinum album in the U.S. (for sales of more than one million units of their 1986 Profile release Raising Hell)—are keeping a watchful eye on the revival of their back catalogue. Already playlisted by MTV's Central Service and German broadcaster Viva TV, the video for It's Tricky-commissioned by Epic and shot by German director Markus Sternberg-was temporarily withdrawn when the band and Profile refused to approve the clip.

John Sharp, London-based international director for Profile, explains, "The video features Kung Fu fighting scenes between street gangs. The

band and Profile do not feel that this agrees with the ethos they would to represent."

"Profile told us they and the band do not approve of the video because it would glorify violence in their eves," concedes Hacker. "But we do not feel that

[Sternberg's clip] fulfills this criterion." He adds, "We checked out the legal situation and believe that we are operating on safe ground as licensees if we go ahead and use the video."

According to Hacker, Sony Music had sent out letters to MTV and Viva at time of going to press, stating the label's view of the situation. He says he expects the video to be back on air in the G/S/A region "in a couple of days."

New Flamenco in the New World

Some 18 years after they were first hailed as pioneers of "New Flamenco," it seems as though Ketama's big moment has finally arrived.

On April 23, the Spanish trio embark on their first comprehensive European tour, followed by a sevennation trek through Latin America and the U.S.—their first serious foray into the region-starting on

Before the band gets on the road, they will play a one-off concert in Cuba—another first for Ketama—on April 19 at Havana's Karl Marx Theatre. The concert has been arranged by Eurotropical, the Cuban imprint of Spanish indie label Manzana Discos, and is backed by the Spanish authors' and publishers' society SGAE as part of Cuba 98, a year-long series of events which commemorate the centenary of the end of Spanish colonial rule.

"After the Pope, it's time for the gypsies," joked singer Antonio

Carmona (in reference to January's Papal visit to Cuba), when he presented the plans for the concert during a press conference at SGAE's Madrid headquarters last week. The event will be filmed and televised later this year by Spanish public broadcaster RTVE.

According to PolyGram Spain, the band's latest album, Konfusionreleased last September—is moving faster than any of its predecessors, and has shipped 220,000 units to date. "We think the time is right to make a big push abroad," says PolyGram Spain international product director Beatriz Pérez. According to Pérez, the imminent six-nation tour is their most important promotional effort in Europe to date.

PolyGram expects to open a completely new market for Ketama outside Europe with the American leg of the tour, adds Pérez. The visit, with concerts scheduled in such key Latin music markets as Puerto Rico, Miami and New York among others, "is their first Latin American/U.S.

tour as such.

Over the past 15 years, Ketama have made several flamenco-based albums with an increasingly broader sound, averaging sales of 40,000 units each, mainly in their home market. The breakthrough for Ketama came with the 1995 live album De Aki A Ketama (Mercury), which has sold in excess of 500,000 units worldwide to date.

"Ketama come from an extended

family of excellent musicians," notes "Their command of other music forms means they can play with [other artists] without losing the 'flamenco touch." Konfusion bears witness to Ketama's knack for widening the genre's appeal, featuring guest performances by Frenchbased raï singer Khaled, Uruguayan singer/songwriter Jorge Drexler, and Cuban artists Gema y Pavel.



BBE go back to their roots

With two million singles sold, French trio BBE have established themselves as one of the most successful techno crossover acts of the past 12 months.

Now, with the March 27 release of their debut album *Games*, BBE are set to convert their singles track record into long-term success. Their first three singles—*Days & One Week, Flash* and *Desire*—draw on the trance scene of the early 1990's and take the genre's hypnotic hooks one step further into the pop mainstream.

"There's always an element of luck in commercial music," says Emmanuel Top, the "E" in BBE. His philosophy is refreshingly simple: "All you can do is make the music as good you can, and then wait and see. If it's right for the time, it sells."

Despite his relaxed attitude towards success, Top would be the first to admit that he will do all he can to keep control of the musical side of BBE. For example, the trio carefully choose which company releases their material. *Games* is licensed to EMI for 38 countries world-wide and EMI's U.K. label Positiva actually premiered the album on February 16.

In France, Games was released on Virgin's Labels imprint, in the Benelux countries it goes through Jive and in Germany it is due out on PolyGram's Motor Music on May 11. "I think it's healthy to create a sense of competition between labels," explains Top, "especially with commercial projects." He adds, "My job is to do the music, the job of the label is to sell it."

Ironically, whatever happens with *Games*, Top's plans for the next few months are a long way from the lush, hook-laden soundscapes



that typify BBE's current approach. For some years now, he has been releasing much harder tracks such as *Acid Phaze* and, more recently, *Lobotomie* under his own name on experimental outlets like U.K. indies NovaMute and Warp. Now the "dark side" is to be his main thrust for the foreseeable future.

Top is currently preparing to launch a new label called Electret alongside the two imprints he has already established—one for BBE (Triangle) and the other for his more underground oriented projects (Attack Records). "Unlike Triangle and Attack, which serve as licensing vehicles for specific projects, Electret will be a self-contained label," reveals Top.

"At present," he concludes, "it looks like it's

"At present," he concludes, "it looks like it's mainly going to be an outlet for my own solo recordings, but part of the concept will be to cooperate with other artists as well."

'Transisterised' Clark renewed

For a band who are being touted in rock circles as U.K. newcomers likely U.K. to cross over into continental Europe and the U.S., Transister are no spring chickens.

Guitarist Gary Clark fronted Scottish group Danny Wilson in the late 1980's and worked with bass player Eric Pressly in the short-lived act King L—both signed to Virgin Records U.K. Singer Keely Hawkes and Pressly had written and recorded together for Hawkes' solo album six years ago.

After Virgin dropped King L in 1996, Clark and Pressly joined forces with Hawkes in London and formed Transister. He recalls: "When we'd finished half the album—six songs, that is—Eric took them back to the U.S." What happened next was "a real stroke of luck," says Clark.



"A friend played a tape to a DJ at [public station] KCRW in Los Angeles and he started playing a couple of tracks per day on his show. Before we knew it, we had a bunch of record labels putting offers in." Virgin Records America co-president Ashley Newton—who had previously signed King L to his Circa label—secured a worldwide deal with Transister, except for North America, where the band is signed to Interscope. "I've been with Virgin for 10 years now," laughs Clark. "I always had a good relationship with them."

Transister marks a significant turning point for Clark, who in previous incarnations was regarded first and foremost as a song-smith. "The direction [of Transister's debut album] was set once Gary purchased a sampler," says Pressly. "We started to see anything as a potential noise to make a record with," admits Clark. "The sampler pulls the

diverse elements of the songs together. Once we got the rhythm tracks, we got Keely in."

At present, Pressly is back in his native California sorting out his U.K. work permit while Hawkes and Clark have stayed at home in the U.K. to fulfill the group's promotional duties for Transisters debut single Look Who's Perfect Now—released on March 16.

The band's self-titled album will be released this summer after a string of festival performances in the Netherlands, Switzerland and the U.K.

Dance arooves

STRUCK IN THE GARAGE

Leaving room for the silky voice of Tempo O'Neal to carry the tune, London Connection's Love Struck Energy (Fifty First Recordings/U.K.) is classic speed garage. Underpinned by woofer-bending sub-bass and a deeply funky clavinet, O'Neal lays down a sinuous, energising melody. Thanks to its raw soul, a track with much crossover potential.

THE HARD STUFF

On an industrial tip, Cio's *Operation* EP (Boozo/Madrid) showcases some of the better "hard stuff" currently coming out of Madrid. Opening track *Jump*, with its minimalist groove is not unlike a groovy Stockhausen track. The second version of the track is more atonal and odd but charming and genuinely different.

DRAMA FROM THE INSIDE

Michelle Weeks AKA "the voice," has another clubland floorfiller on her hands. *The Inside* (Cleveland City/U.K.), Weeks' follow up to *Give It Up* mixes a pumping disco/house groove with a dose of drama. Few voices are more immediate than Weeks' primal scream and here, thanks to music from Andy & The Lamboy, it's in an ideal environment. Remix-wise, the Sol Bros.' *Mash Up Dub* and the *Xpress Mix* are excellent.

LOUNGING INTO THE FUTURE

With their second album, Danish trio Future 3 delve deep into "loungecore." On Stay With... (April/Denmark) easy swingbeats are wound around a musical style that takes in everything from '60s film music to drum'n'bass. Generally bracketed as underground/experimental, Future 3 make beautiful, wistful music. Their biggest asset is the controlled exuberance permeating their arrangements.

BACK IN THE JUNGLE

Sweden has become synonymous with a wide range of musical styles over the last quarter century. But quality drum 'n'bass would be the last thing most people expect from a country associated with R&B and slick pop productions.

Gothenburg-based Dot Music—whose first release, *Hab* by Hab, came out only 13 months



ago—has rapidly shown that its roster of Friend, Hab, Quant and Tupilaq has a forceful and original take on breakbeat science. "Dot's mission is to give people music they didn't know they wanted," says marketing manager Stefan Bede.

Articulate, fresh, music, a strong label identity and valuable support from founder Anders Bersten's ex-employer, distribution company Border Music, means Dot already has distribution in most major territories, with media support from European and U.S. college radio plus Sweden's public-owned CHR network P3, as well as London stations Kiss FM (urban/dance) and Jazz FM.

The next release on Dot will be the compilation *Endlessnessism* on April 27, based on the children's game of Chinese whispers. The initial "whisper"—a track by Sarilou—was remixed by Quant then passed to a third remixer who had not heard the original, and so on. The high standard set by previous releases continues with contributions from Funki Porcini, Endemic Void and Spacer.

GARBAGE VERSION 2.0

Mushroom

International release date: May 11 Garbage's self-titled 1995 debut sold four million albums worldwide. Not a bad omen then, for the follow-up, Version 2.0, which the band embarked upon exactly a year ago. The U.S./Scottish

rock quartet built around top producer Butch Vig has an extensive fanbase in Europe, particularly in France, Denmark, Ireland and the U.K. Garbage is actually one of the few albums in recent times to have hung around in the U.K. charts for a full year after its first entry, so potential demand for this new album could be considerable, but needs to be re-kindled. Accordingly, Mushroom is trailing it with first single Push It on April 27. Like much of the album, Push It updates the Garbage formula of loops, noise and guitars, with the sultry tones of Shirley Manson's intoning lyrics from the Beach Boys' Brian Wilson-penned 1964 hit Don't Worry Baby (as a hint to the influences woven into the album, the additional tracks on that single feature a cover version of Big Star's Thirteen and a dance remix by Tokyo-based Boom Boom Satellites). An upcoming European tour in June and July will see the band targeting major

mainstream audiences at key open air festivals in Germany, Sweden, Finland and Austria.

SILVERBULLIT SILVERBULLIT

Clearsnot

European release date: April 27

After three years of relentless gigging, Sweden's Silverbullit finally get round to releasing their debut album. Like many Swedish acts, the garage

rock five-piece are a truly international bunch, with bass player Jukka Rintamäki coming from Finland and drummer Zenaid Jugo hailing from Bosnia. Together since 1995, Silverbullit play their brand of rock'n'roll, with a hint of The Stooges and The Fuzztones



thrown in. There's one cover version-the 13th Floor Elevators' I Had To Tell You-on their debut, but their own material is original and not stuck on idolising the usual original '60s punks. Frontman Simon Ohlsson definitely has gospel power—think Chris Robinson of the Black Crowes here. Shame then, that the first single King Of The Line-released on April 6-is not one of their poppier songs. It's possibly a bit too close to the Hammond riff of the Fuzztones' Cinderella to appeal to a straightforward rock audience.

One of those is Richard Maddock, head of music at Liverpool-based CHR station City FM. This week, the song is No.1 on the Billboard Hot 100 chart for the second week, and Maddock declares: "We are not surprised that it is performing so well in the U.S. We all agreed that it was a great song." At the moment, he notes, "On average, we're playing it at least once a week. We added it a couple of weeks ago when it was serviced to us and currently it is confined to specialised shows which feature 'slow jams,' where it seems to work quite well." However, Maddock also adds that, now that the single is commercially available in the U.K., the number of weekly spins could increase considerably if it performs well sales-wise, meriting inclusion on daytime shows.





Once again the combination of opera and pop looks like being a winning formula. Possibly with the success of last year's Rapsody multi-artist project in mind, opera-trained singer Shapplin has teamed up with French prog-rock veteran Capdevielle to produce something which has links with both opera and new age material (a la Enigma). M&M's weekly airplay analysis column

The boy bands vs girl bands battle on this week's European Radio Top 50 is swinging towards the

girls. Let's make a trip down the list along all those pretty faces (of both sexes, naturally). Lining up under the girl bands banner are the Spice Girls at number 2



(Stop/Virgin), All Saints at 5 (Never Ever/London), Cleopatra at 28 (Cleopatra's Theme/WEA) and finally Destiny's Child at 43 with No, No, No (Columbia)

The boy bands on this week's Top 50 are the Backstreet Boys (All I Have To Give on Jive at 7), Five (When The Lights Go Out on RCA at 32) and—an early new entry this week—Boyzone at 46 with All That I Need (Polydor). The Boyzone track is already doing well in the U.K. and Denmark. An early supporter in Switzerland is Philippe Unterschütz, head of music at Luzernbased CHR-outlet Radio Pilatus 104.9.

His comments should reassure those at the band's label who are looking for the teen act to attract an older audience: "It's nothing special, but it's a fine pop song, which could even easily be liked by my mother." Unterschütz says he is programming other tracks by boy bands at the moment, including 2 Be 3 (Don't Say Goodbye/EMI), 911 (All I Want Is You/Virgin), Another Level (Be Alone No More/Northwestside), but that he doesn't see them as a trend anymore, rather as a major part of the music scene. "Their songs and vocal achievements have improved quite a lot," he notes.

There's no fresh news at the top of the airplay chart, where Madonna's Frozen to the No.1 slot, but the follow up to that record, the title track of her album Ray Of Light (Maverick), has already gone to radio in the U.K. and Denmark and is now being aired by nine stations, including BBC Radio 1.

At the top of the Border Breakers section, the reign of Cose Della Vita by Eros Rammazzotti & Tina Turner (DDD) has finally come to an end after 10 weeks. Sweden's Eagle-Eye Cherry has taken over at No.1 with Save Tonight (Superstudio/Polydor). The record's initial success in Scandinavia, soon spread south-west to the Benelux countries, and now it's reached Italy, Switzerland and Portugal. As a result of that, the track also rises to number 14 on the Top 50 this week.

Highest new entry is Kiss The Rain by Billie Myers (Universal). The U.S.-signed English female singer had reached the top 20 of the Billboard Hot 100 before the song was available in Europe, and Scandinavian and U.K. stations are now reacting strongly to the track, as the Major Market Airplay listings show.

Further new entries include the long awaited new Garbage single Push It (Mushroom), which comes in at 39, due to early approval in the U.K. and Poland. The song is expected to develop strongly in the next couple of weeks. Another favourite on U.K. and Danish radio, Ultra Nate sees Found A Cure (A&M), the follow-up to her successfull Free, new at 45.



And back where we came in, for those of you who want to take the boy band/girl band competition further, bubbling under the Top 50 are girl band Solid Harmonie (I Want You To Want Me/Jive) and boy band Another Level's Be Alone No More.

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

alonia's population being non-Catalan speakers, the quota requirements are seen as potentially disastrous by local commercial broadcasters trying to compete with national networks, which are unaffected by the new law because they do not broadcast from Catalonia.

"As we're directly up against [national CHR network] Los 40 Principales," says Carles Cuni, head of programmes at Flash FM/Barcelona, we'd suffer greatly by having to play 25 percent Catalan music on a station whose content is 90 percent dance music."

Cuni expects some flexibility from the authorities in the law's implementation, especially with regard to



such Flash FM which, he

stations

says, would obviously lose some of the audience it has fought so hard to lure away from the likes of Los 40.

"There is no real market for a format that includes 25 percent local product, but it creates a starting point for meaningful discussion, continues Cuni. "We do take very seriously the idea of fostering our culture." To this end, Flash FM is currently in discussion with Max Music about possible Catalan language dance productions.

Juan Puerto, head of music pro-

gramming at full-service public broadcast-Cat-

alunya Radio-which already broadcasts all of its speech programming in Catalan-is more positive about the quota requirement. "We were already playing about 20 percent Catalan language music," he says, "although that extra 5 percent has proved difficult, mainly because there simply isn't a lot of quality repertoire in Catalan."

Puerto's solution has been to include more live concert broadcasts and artist interviews. "The 25 percent [music quota] can be reached without undermining programming," he claims. "You just have to use your imagination."

A further controversy surrounds Catalonia's soon-to-be-awarded 22 FM licences (the region's share of the Spanish government's 350 new FM radio licences). It has been clearly stated by the Catalan authorities that preference in the licence awards will be given to stations which propose Catalan language content "above the minimum laid down by law.'

"Currently it's impossible to say how much the law will affect the licence applications," says Alfonso Miro, the Barcelona-based regional director of broadcasting for the Spanish ministry of communications. LONDON - Demon Records, the label co-founded by Elvis Costello in 1978, has been acquired by Crimson Productions, a subsidiary of U.K. wholesale distributor Entertainment UK (EUK).

The deal, which has been anticipated for some time, sees Crimson purchase Demon's owner, the holding company F-Beat Records, for around £2 million (\$3,260,000). The eclectic back catalogue-largely Demon licensed material-includes albums by a wide range of artists from the likes of Costello and Graham Parker through to the Shamen and left-field U.S. acts such as Giant Sand and T-Bone Burnett.

The label-until now, distributed by Pinnacle-also won respect for its

pro-active approach to re-issuing classic albums on its Edsel imprint from such acts as Taj Mahal, The Byrds and The Flying Burrito Brothers. It also through prospered licensing deals with


U.S. labels such as Hi and Black Top.

The back catalogue of Elvis Costello and Nick Lowe, both of whom have material licensed to the label, is included in the Demon/EUK deal, says Richard Green, commercial director of EUK. Lowe's latest album, Dig My Mood, recently appeared on Demon; along with Costello and their joint manager Jake Riviera, Lowe is a company director. All current directors, however, will leave Demon, with the exception of 14-year company veteran Pete Macklin, who will continue to be resposible for the sales and marketing of the label's catalogue.

Adrian Fitt, general manager of Crimson, will now head both operations. Les Willis, business manager of EUK's Internet direct

sales operation Entertainment Express, will take over the running of Demon's mail order operation Blackmail, which will be merged with the on-line service.

Richard Green says in a statement that Demon's position as "a wellestablished and respected back-catalogue specialist... ideally complements our existing business." EUK is part of the Kingfisher group, owner of retail chain Woolworth.

20. While reluctant to be quoted on ship-out figures, label insiders believe a top 20 entry, at least, is imminent. Such an arrival would be impressive indeed for a band with no singles chart history, coming fully six years since they debuted on MCA with the album From Hell To Paradise.

Trampoline has already made great strides in the U.K., with sales well past 40,000. It has also charted in the Netherlands, Ireland, Belgium and Sweden, and Kate Farmer, international marketing director for Universal Music International, sees the success as the reward for three years' hard work by a devoted team.

The band's dedication towards international, making it a part of their year-long plan, has been instru-mental," says Farmer. "So has the work of their manager Frank Callari, who has a very close relationship with us. We've sat down from the beginning, put in the groundwork, and the band have toured, promoted, revisited the U.K. and Europe, Australia and everywhere else we've done, saying 'One day' this will pay off.' I hate to say this out loud, but it looks like this is the day."

The Mavericks tour this month in Denmark, Sweden, The

Netherlands and the U.K.; on April 15, the day before beginning the British dates, they'll play their highest-profile TV booking when they perform Dance The Night Away on public network BBC 1's National Lottery Draw show. At BBC Radio 2, where the track has been playlisted, a onehour recording of a recent London showcase performance was due to air on April 11.

Farmer cites the support of VH-1, which broadcast another London special last month, and MTV, as well as airplay in The Netherlands and the Scandinavian countries in which the band are playing. U.K. publicist Richard Wootton points out that a recent appearance on BBC2's Top Of The Pops 2 and exposure on The Box also helped build the current momentum.

Says Farmer: "The Mavericks seem to sit inside and outside the Nashville genre, and this album really had the potential to cross over. They've delivered an album that's got nothing to do with country, but doesn't alienate any country fan.

Jan Hansen, head of music at Hot AC outlet Radio Mojn in Aabenraa, Denmark, has playlisted Dance The Night Away, which he agrees is not really a country song. "It's more like rock-pop," he says, "with a lot of instruments in it, which makes the song much happier. I hadn't really heard anything from them before, and I wasn't even told about this one. I just put it on because of the title alone.

"It's very, very catchy. Today we had a caller who wanted to hear a track from the album, and she already knew the name.'

Two more dates on the British leg of the tour were added just before press time, completing a ten-day itinerary from April 16-29. Asgard's Paul Fenn, who is promoting the shows, estimates that the band will play to 18,000 people in the U.K. alone. "We've always sold tickets with the Mavericks," he says, "but this time we moved up a level. They've just got this reputation for great live shows.' The group is touring this time with a four-piece brass section.

Universal plans a second single from Trampoline (probably Tell Me Why) in the summer, followed by a return European visit by the band in September, including the G/S/A/ territories and Spain, and their introduction to the French and Italian markets. "We've all had a long-term belief in the band," says Farmer, "and it's paid off.

Nostalgia wins in German ratings

gold/schlager two years ago. In the 1997 MA ratings, the station saw a huge 126 percent increase in its audience; the new survey shows a further 12.8 percent rise, to an average of 100,000 hourly listeners. Says BB Radio programme director Juergen Karney: "Oldies are nostalgia. Our listeners are between 30 and 50 years old—it's the music they grew up with. These are the people who are listening to the radio."

Despite having three of the ten stations showing the greatest audience gains, Germany's public broadcasters lost 4.1 percent of their audience share, while their commercial rivals enjoyed a 2.6 percent growth.

This is the first year in which two sets of MA ratings are being released—this set will be followed by another in August. Two surveys have always been conducted (in the spring and autumn) by MA, but previously only one set of figures had been published (in June), combining the results of the two survey periods.

Under MA's new twice-yearly presentation of ratings, the figures issued this month are based on data gathered in autumn 1997. The August figures will be a combination of these figures and the results of a spring ratings survey which is currently being conducted by MA.

"With ratings released twice a year it will be easier for stations to see trends," says Susanna Baldauf, a spokesperson for advertising sales house IP Deutschland. In Berlin-Brandenburg, Germany's most competitive and lucrative radio market, CHR/dance station Kiss FM registered the second biggest audience gain in the country with a 35.3 percent increase, upping its average number of hourly listeners to 23,000. NRJ's CHR station Energy Berlin achieved a 22.4 percent increase, while gold/schlager station SpreeRadio was up 17.7 percent.

Berlin-Brandenburg's leading station, the AC-formatted Antenne Brandenburg, remained relatively stable, with 170,000 hourly listeners, while CLT-UFA's RTL 104.6 lost some 20,000 listeners and now has to share second place with AC/gold station R.S.2.

Meanwhile, Radio Fritz, the youthoriented CHR station of public broadcasters SFB and ORB, made up half of last year's audience losses with a 7 percent increase. With an average age of 25, Radio Fritz claims it now boasts Germany's youngest audience profile.

In Hamburg, Energy's CHR station averaged 20,000 hourly listeners in its first MA ratings appearance, while AC broadcaster Radio Hamburg dipped to 150,000 hourly listeners. In the neighbouring state of Schleswig-Holstein, gold/schlager commercial broadcaster NORA registered a 25.6 percent gain, while Delta Radio (which switched from AC to rock/CHR last year) lost 8.5 percent of its 1997 audience.

In the southern and central states of Thuringia and Saxony-Anhalt, full-service public broadcaster MDR 1 enjoyed the third and fourth biggest gains in continued from page 1

the country with increases of 34.4 percent (Thuringia) and 26.4 percent (Saxony-Anhalt).

With an audience increase of some 37.8 percent, commercial gold/schlager network Antenne Sachsen in Saxony enjoyed the country's biggest percentage gains. The station registered 40,000 more listeners per hour, bringing its average to 170,000. "It's clear that our programming concept has succeeded marvellously," says Antenne Sachsen general manager and programme director Norbert Seuss.

Ratings for Energy in Saxony showed an hourly audience of 51,000. With an average age of 26, it has the youngest listeners of all the Energy CHR stations in Germany.

Bavarian AC station Antenne Bayern strengthened its position with a 13 percent audience gain, reaching 700,000 listeners per hour; its main rival, public rock station Bayern 3, lost 4.6 percent of its audience.

In the state of Hessen, public broadcasters fared better than their commercial rivals—Hessischer Rundfunk's AC/talk station HR1 moved up 12.3 percent, while the AC HR3 remained steady on 260,000 hourly listeners. Frankfurt-based CHR commercial station Hit Radio FFH saw its average hourly audience fall by 40,000 to 410,000.

In North-Rhine Westphalia, public broadcaster WDR's critically-acclaimed CHR network Eins Live gained slightly, attracting an average of 620,000 listeners per hour.

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Madonna's Ray is double platinum

LONDON — Madonna and James Horner are amongst the latest recipients of IFPI Platinum Europe awards, marking sales of over one million album units across the continent.

Madonna's current album Ray Of Light (Maverick), which racked up sales of 2 million units in Europe last month, has attained double platinum status. Meanwhile, James Horner's Grammy-winning score for the boxoffice hit Titanic (on Sony Classical) goes from two to four times Platinum. And Celine Dion has moved from five to six times platinum with Let's Talk About Love (Columbia/Epic), which features the love theme from Titanic, My Heart Will Go On.

Among the albums passing the one million mark for the first time this month are Andrea Bocelli's Viaggio Italiana (PolyGram), Janet Jackson's The Velvet Rope (Virgin), Pascal Obispo's Superflu (Sony Music) and the John Lennon compilation Lennon Legend (EMI). Viaggio Italiana is Bocelli's third album to enter the Platinum Europe hall of fame. It follows in the footsteps of Bocelli—certified three times platinum in June 1997—and Romanza, which reached the five million mark earlier this year.

MTV Awards head for Milan

LONDON — Following MTV's move into terrestrial distribution in Italy last September, the music TV broadcaster has confirmed that this year's MTV Europe Music Awards (EMAs) will be held in Milan on November 12.

MTV Networks Europe president and CEO Brent Hansen announced on April 6 that the show will take place at Milan arena Filaforum, broadcast live to an estimated world-wide audience of over one billion viewers. The two-hour ceremony will feature presentations in 14 different award categories and 10 live performances.

The awards line-up will be unveiled over the next few months, says Hansen. "There has been an upsurge of fresh, new talent over the past year, so the awards give us the opportunity to showcase some great new acts."

Warner Music Italy president and CGD East West managing director Gerolamo Caccia Dominioni comments: "We are very happy that MTV have chosen Milan." Caccia Dominioni, who is also president of Italian IFPI affiliate FIMI, adds: "The choice is in line with the station's success in Italy after the recent terrestrial deal [with commercial TV channel RETE A]."

MTV Europe's flagship awards show was first televised from Berlin in 1994. Paris followed in 1995, and London in 1996. Last year's EMAs took place in Rotterdam.

benchmark in our on-going localisation of MTV around the world," Roedy adds. Blocks of MTV programming from its western outlets have been available in various packages to Russian viewers since 1990. The project is being financed by Russian Partners, a consortium of Russian and U.S. investors.

Biz chairman Boris Zosimov (a former chairman of PolyGram Russia) has been named chairman and general producer of MTV's operations in Moscow, where the programming will be produced. "This is the perfect time for MTV to launch in Russia," says Zosimov, who will continue to be a non-executive director of PolyGram Russia. "With the rich musical and cultural variations of the region, MTV will highlight the music and issues of interest to the first free Russian youth."

MTV Russia—which will be broadcast terrestrially—will initially have a potential audience of about 10 million households, mainly in Moscow and St. Petersburg. The 24-hour channel will broadcast in Russian, with the majority of videos being from domestic artists such as Mumji Trol', Splin and DJ Groove. Videos from international acts will be woven into the programming mix.

MTV Russia will be supported by advertising, initially from international brands, such as jeans and soft drinks companies, but Roedy is confident there is potential for "very quick growth from local advertising."

Although MTV will have a "long term commitment" to its Russian operations, Roedy admits that the current economic climate in Russia, together with widespread corruption, warrants concern. "People have tended to focus on the problems Russia has, and they do exist. We do have challenges when you go into a market like this with your eyes wide open," he says, "But we are encouraged by the change in Russian youth culture in just a few years."

MTV Nordic, meanwhile, will cover Denmark, Finland, Norway and Sweden. The move leaves Belgium, France, Holland and Spain under the auspices of the broadcaster's Northern Service (now re-named Pan-Northern) which was originally launched in March 1996.

MTV Nordic will feature a higher level of rotation and earlier support for video releases than the existing feed. The broadcaster also says it will increase total music hours on the new service. At launch, the feed is scheduled to feature 80 percent localised programming, which will be produced in London in collaboration with (asyet-unnamed) Scandinavian production companies.

"The Nordic territories are a vibrant, 'happening' market," comments Michiel Bakker, managing director, U.K. and Northern Europe, at MTV and VH-1. "We will have the flex-

ibility to air videos in line with the needs of the record buying public in Finland, Sweden, Denmark and Norway." He adds: "I am really looking forward to breaking new, indigenous artists on the Nordic service and across [our] other services, too."

"MTV's decision to launch [a Nordic] service is very welcome," says IFPI Sweden information officer Claes Olson. He believes that labels and artists alike will benefit from a dedicated feed for the region. "Over the past few years we have noticed signs of more and more local acts being successful all over the [Nordic] region. That makes the market a stronger springboard for launching international careers."

However, Martin Theander, label manager at Swedish indie Vibrafon, offers a different view on the split of the existing Northern service. "I am not sure if the creation of ever smaller music TV channels actually helps local acts," says Theander. "MTV had a much bigger impact when it launched as one big station [in the '80s]."

The creation of further local services as part of MTV's regionalisation in Europe will remain on the broadcaster's agenda after the launch of MTV Nordic. Says MTV Networks Europe president and CEO Brent Hansen: "We will continue to build MTV's relevance in local markets where it is practically and financially viable."

The launch of MTV Nordic (see front page)—servicing Denmark, Finland, Norway and Sweden from the summer onwards—has apparently prompted some fears among the local music industry community over the creation of an artistic ghetto. Keenly aware of the quality of local productions from the region, they point to the fact that, compared to European territories which embraced the concept of local music TV over the past four to five years, the Nordic countries have enjoyed a much higher success rate when it came to establishing local acts on MTV's network programmes.

Music Control's London-based international director Julian Wall has left the company, following a restructuring of the company's European operations. Wall was responsible for the launching of the airplay monitoring company's pan-European media services and the running of its U.K. Office.

Former Crash FM/Liverpool MD and programmer Mike Gray is expected to be named programme director of Assembly Radio, a recently launched Scottish radio group bidding for new licences. The group is backed by investors 3i Group.

It looks as though **Eric Baptiste**, MD of Paris city station 95.2 (partly owned by conglomerate **Générale des Eaux**) will be leaving. Baptiste will, apparently, keep his post as president of radio organisation **Vive La Radio**.

Parlophone's Beverley Knight, Billie Piper (Innocent Records/Virgin) and Johnson (Higher Ground/ Columbia) will perform at London's Cafe de Paris during a party for delegates to the U.K. Radio Academy's annual radio music conference (April 23), where the Radio Academy/Music & Media award for Outstanding Contribution To Music Radio will be presented.


Virgin France president Emmanuel de Buretel has been voted Manager of The Year 1997 by French yearly trade book L'Anné du Disque. "He is as much a talent spotter and a pioneer of new musical genres as an inspired manager and a sharp businessman," writes editor Dominique Vialard.

Rock station Virgin Radio has been hit by a £2,000 (\$3,220) fine by U.K. regulator the Radio Authority for failing to comply with its promise of performance in respect of broadcasting "community campaigns." It is required to carry ten week-long campaigns a year, but only broadcast seven last year.

M&M was saddened to note the death of French TV and radio personality **Yves Mourousi** on April 7, of a heart attack at his home. Aged 55, Mourousi's career began as a journalist on public station **France-Inter**, before moving to TV, where he anchored the midday news show from 1975 to 1988. He was appointed programmes director of full-service station **Radio Monte Carlo** (RMC) in 1991, a position he held until 1993.

And finally this week, the understandably

heavy press coverage of the demise of country legend Tammy Wynette at age 55 tended to overshadow the loss of another talent from a very different genre. British hard rock drummer par excellence Colin "Cozy" Powell died in a car crash on April 5, aged 50. With a CV which reads like a virtual A-Z of the



genre (Jeff Beck, Black Sabbath, Emerson Lake & Powell, Yngwie Malmsteen, Brian May, Rainbow, Michael Schenker...), Powell was a much respected figure in rock circles, but his recent work with Peter Green emphasised that there was a more sensitive side to his abilities. week 16/98




