Santer addresses music's concerns

BRUSSELS — European Commission president Jacques Santer knows just what the continent's music industry wants to hear.

The commission attaches "great importance to music," and seeks "to promote the healthy state of the European music sector." It also wants "to nourish the unifying role which music can play." Santer's comments come in a speech due to be delivered at the second IFPI Platinum Europe awards dinner in Brussels on July 9 (taking place after M&M closed for press).

The event's organisers are the International Federation of the Phonographic Industry (IFPI); the first awards were presented in 1996, also in Brussels. Over 350 artists, music industry profes-

sionals, European policy makers and media were expected at the awards in the city's Albert Hall to celebrate what Santer calls "the success of the European music industry today" and

CLT-UFA finalises sell-offs

LONDON — CLT-UFA is close to selling off national U.K. station Talk Radio and London's RTL Country 1035, and is flipping the format of the up-for-sale Atlantic 252 from CHR to dance.

The Luxembourg-based group is in "exclusive negotiations" over the sale of Talk Radio with a consortium headed by Kelvin MacKenzie, former editor of U.K. tabloid newspaper The Sun.

MacKenzie's group, which includes Sun owner Rupert Murdoch's News' International, is understood to have bettered a bid by the station's current management headed by managing director Paul Robinson. The price tag is said to be over £20 million (\$32.6m).

Meanwhile, sources say RTL Country 1035 is on the verge of being sold to a group which currently broadcasts country music in Europe via satellite.

Ohayon to depart EMI France

PARIS - EMI Music France is losing its president, Gilbert Ohayon, after seven years in the job.

Ohayon will step down at the end of the company's current financial year, in March 1999. "He's done a superb job," says Rupert Perry, president Europe, EMI Music. "It [EMI France] is a very strong and wellmanaged company."

Ohavon, who has also headed EMI's Benelux affiliate since 1993, joined EMI in January 1990 as marketing director for international repertoire in continental Europe. Previously, he was VP of southern European operations for CBS/Fox Home Video, where former EMI Music

chief executive Jim Fifield was president before joining EMI. The two executives were close, and following Fifield's departure earlier this year, there were persistent rumours that Ohayon would follow him out of EMI.

When EMI acquired Virgin, both companies remained separate entities in France, with Ohayon reporting to Perry and Virgin president Emmanuel de Buretel reporting to Virgin CEO Ken Berry.

Swedish 'listener bribes' row resolved

STOCKHOLM - RUAB, the organisation which carries out audience research in Sweden, is to review part of its contract with the country's radio stations after criticising a promotional campaign by Mix Megapol.

The agreement with the stations forbids any improper attempt to influence listener responses to audience surveys. RUAB had complained about the promotional campaign by the AC network in which listeners were told that they could win Skr1,000 (\$125) if the station called them, simply by saying when they answered the telephone that they listened to Mix Megapol.

RUAB, fearing that the money on

offer could affect the fairness of its audience surveys (which are conducted by phone) sent a letter to all Sweden's commercial stations which described Megapol's campaign as being "tantamount to a breach of contract". The organisation even threatened to cancel the release of its pending set of audience figures.

Now, however, Mix Megapol's managing director Marcus Forsell says the two sides have had a "positive dialogue," and that the situation has been cleared up. "It's important to choose your words carefully," he stresses. "The idea was that our listeners should be ready to say they listen to us when we call. It was never meant to encourage that response to every caller or to interfere with RUAB's research."

RUAB managing director Riccard Montén suggests it is "tricky" to draw a line between legitimate promotional activities and campaigns which bend the rules too far. He says the paragraph in the ratings contract which refers to attempts to influence listeners may have to be clarified later this year. "The changes may be small, but we must be as precise as possible," he says.

Montén's preferred solution is to set up a dialogue with the stations via Sweden's Commercial Radio Broadcasters' Association. "Perhaps together we could establish a set of guidelines on ethical issues," he says. "It's in everybody's interests that our figures are seen to be completely reliable."

Music Factory starts Belgi IN

HILVERSUM - The Music Factory is starting up production in Flanders.

The Dutch music TV station is to launch a separate Belgian service on cable in Flemish-speaking northern

Belgium on October 3, following the territory's recent media decree which has liberalised the cable TV and radio market.

Since its launch on cable in May

Factory, owned by Dutch broadcasting and music group Wegener Arcade, has eclipsed MTV in the Netherlands with its Dutch-language programming. Official Intomart viewing figures for May show that TMF has a 7.2 percent market share amongst its core target group (13-19 year-olds), compared to 1.3 percent for MTV. The shares amongst the 20-34 age group are 2.0 percent and 0.5 percent respective.

"Emphasising TMF's national characteristics has been the key to success in Holland," says TMF managing director Lex Harding. "We're planning to do exactly the same in Flanders.'

The broadcaster has already recruited one presenter for its Belgian service, namely Inge Moerenhout, from

VT4 in Flanders. The complete TMF team for its Flemish operation will be announced in September. The new channel will broadcast to Belgium from TMF's existing Dutch base in Bussum.

Open mike

Peter Hoogland Music director/presenter, Top Radio

In charge of music at the Belgian CHR network, Hoogland combines his radio job with remixing work for several leading record companies. He's also the presenter of the station's new

daily phone-in show Het Land van Hoogland, which features listeners' personal problems alongside humour, music and lifestyle features.

Q: What's the format of Het Land van Hoogland?

A: Interaction with the audience is what counts, and I spend 85 percent of my airtime talking to callers-we only play two or three records per hour. This show is completely different to the rest of Top Radio's daytime programming, which is predominantly uptempo hit repertoire.

Q: What sort of problems do the audience ring up with?

A: Young people call us to talk about school, parents or issues like rape and suicide. We try to help out by inviting school teachers or specialist people into the studio. But, on the other hand, we also invite artists over for interviews, because part of the show's success also has to do with the very wide spectrum it covers.

Q: Would you say this type of radio programming has a future? A: When we started the show, everybody laughed and gave it two months. But we have been able to add substantial numbers to Top Radio's 15-35 core target group.

I think the reason for the show's success lies in the fact that we lend an ear to people's problems, and it also provides a keen mix of humour and serious subjects. We've noticed that more older people are tuning in. too-they want to know what and how today's youngsters think.

Q: How do you feel about present-

ing this kind of show every day? A: Let's say that I've had my share of problems myself-people either love me or hate me, because I've got a very direct way of talking. What they hear comes from the inside. You cannot compare "Het Land" with other [Belgian] call-in shows, because they mainly offer humour.

We also have our share of spoof commercials and sketches, but when we get to the serious points, the audience is still there. With this pro-gramme I'm proud to say that I've achieved something as a human being. Interview by Marc Maes

Rockland set for summer launch

BERLIN - Radio Rockland will be rocking the state of Rhineland-Palatinate from August 1, after it finally convinced the local radio regulator to award it a licence at the second time of asking.

However, it remains uncertain whether the new rock format station-which will broadcast to nearly a million potential listeners-will lean towards German rock, or rely on tra-ditional U.S. and U.K. fare. "We will be playing German artists such Peter Maffay, but we are still conducting some research to find out exactly what the best programming should be," is all a station spokesperson would say.

Rockland's original application to

broadcast its rock format on the six FM frequencies previously occupied by NRJ's CHR station Energy Radio (M&M, February 14) was rejected by the state radio regulator LPR last December because of concern about the regional domination of commercial broadcaster RPR, which already controls the existing two commercial networks in Rhineland-Palatinate, and which also has a stake in the new broadcaster.

Another objection cited by LPR assembly members at the time was Radio Rockland's adult-orientated format-there was concern over a lack of "youth" programming in the state.

However, a second vote by the authority's members in May granted the licence to Rockland, after the station promised to limit RPR's decision-mak ing power within the company and increase the number of partners



involved in the venture-the LPR was specifically looking for a broadcaster to fill the frequencies which represented a plurality of ownership. The other partners in the

Radio Rockland project are now public broadcaster Saarlaendischer Rundfunk, France's Europe 1 Communication, Radio Salü/Saarbrucken and German rock artist Klaus Lage.

Spain: heat turns music up

MADRID - Spain's "big four" music networks scored notable successes in the country's second national radio audience sweep of the year, between them garnering an average of 150,000 new daily listeners.

The research, conducted during April and May, showed the country's top four news/talk networks lost 713,000 daily listeners compared to the first EGM survey of the year, covering January to March. That trend is consistent with EGM ratings in previous years, with listeners tuning into "lighter" matter as the temperatures rise. In 1995, for example, the



Steenhuisen is new PolyGram **MD** in Portugal

LISBON Dutchman Rudi Steenhuisen has been promoted to managing director of PolyGram Portugal, replacing Rodrigo Martin, who becomes non-executive chairman of the company.

Steenhuisen, a former musician, had been marketing director of PolyGram Portugal since June 1997 and is credited for having signed and developed several successful domestic acts including Exceso, Setimo Ceu and Silence 4.

"Working alongside Rodrigo, Rudi has repeatedly demonstrated his talent for breaking records, and I look forward to him building on his impressive record," comments PolyGram president central Europe Rick Dobbis, whom Steenhuisen (and Martin) will report to.

"There is still a lot of work to be done, but I hope that with the great team that we have built here, we can continue our rapid growth," says Steenhuisen, who takes over the dayto-day duties of a company which enjoyed an album chart share of 26.6 percent in the first five months of 1998 (up from 15.8 percent for the same period in 1997), according to Music & Media figures.

PolyGram is currently the second most successful record company in the Portuguese music market, behind Sony Music. Steenhuisen notes that the country's music industry "is still in its growth phase, and PolyGram seems destined to capture the leadership in both international and national repertoire."

Steenhuisen previously worked in Brazil, where he established a jointventure music club involving PolyGram and publisher Abril Group. He also established Dutch music club Music Plus in 1993, which was sold three years later to Bertelsmann.



New TWIST IN 'BORSATO CASE'

HILVERSUM — The Netherlands' Media Commissariat has reconsidered its verdict in what has been dubbed the "Borsato case." In May last year, the Commissariat fined all eight Dutch public broadcasting organisations which



contribute programming to CHR station Radio 3FM Dfl26,000 (\$13,000), when it found 3FM's "Borsato Week" (promoting Borsato's Polydor album De Waarheid) had broken strict rules applying to product promotion in the public broadcasting sector. The fine consisted of two components-Dfl10,000 for illegally boosting another company's profits and

Dfl16,000 for illegal advertising. But in an appeal against the ruling on June 26, the Commissariat dropped the first fine. Instead, it fined public broadcasting umbrella organisation NOS Dfl80,000, holding NOS responsible for the breach of the law. The second fine of Dfl16,000 was upheld against six of the eight broadcasters-the Commissariat accepted that public broadcasters EO and VPRO were not involved with the promotion.

WEA TAKES TOP SPOT IN U.S. ALBUMS MARKET

NEW YORK - WEA has regained the No.1 position in the U.S. album market from Sony Music Distribution, according to figures from Soundscan. Although Sony was the leading current album distributor in the six month period from December 29 1997-June 28 1998, WEA took top spot in the total album market, with 18.3 percent. BMG was the leading singles distributor during the period with 23.5 percent market share.

NEW TERRITORIES GET LOCAL MTV

BUDAPEST - MTV Networks Europe has signed an agreement with the Hungarian Broadcasting Corporation (HBC) which will result in dedicated MTV programming for Hungary, the Czech Republic and Slovakia. HBC is developing a daily, hour-long magazine show, "MTV Magazine," which will air on HBC's cable channels in the countries concerned, starting this autumn. The programmes will draw on material from MTV Europe, adding local presenters and music for each territory. MTV currently has 24 hour cable penetration in the region through its MTV Central and MTV Northern streams, but lacks country-specific programming.

CASTILE COMPETITORS LINE UP

MADRID - Some 80 companies have submitted a total of 618 applications for the 52 new commercial FM licences which are to be awarded in the northern Spanish region of Castilla y Leon (Old Castile) by its regional government. The licences are part of the Spanish government's allocation of 650 new FM services throughout the country. But Castilla y Leon's chief minister Juan Jose Lucas warns that the licence decisions are unlikely to be made until the end of the year "because of the complexity of the situation."

MOVING CHAIRS

LONDON - Heart 106.2/London presenter Gary King is moving across town to present shows for 95.8 Capital FM. AC-formatted Heart recently recruited Capital's David Jensen for King's drivetime slot.

U.K. royalty collection body the Performing Right Society

(PRS) has re-elected Andrew Potter as chairman of the PRS board for a second three year term, beginning in January 1999.

BERLIN - PolyGram has named Christian Gummig, founder of Hamburg-based new media company MME/CC, as the new managing director of music publishing group PolyGram Songs Musikverlag. He starts his new job in October.

Bertram Schwarz is the new managing director of AC station Radio Hamburg. He was previously in charge of Bertelsmann Infoline and, prior to that, MD of gold station Berliner Rundfunk.

Dutch ratings prove FM power

HILVERSUM — Stations which were able to move onto the Netherlands' FM band on January 1 are reaping the rewards, according to bimonthly radio ratings for April/May1998.

Last year, the Dutch government made an "interim" decision to grant commercial stations more FM frequencies in advance of its controversial frequency auction in 2000. In addition, a number of stations already on FM were able to significantly expand their coverage areas.

Veronica

FM (formerly HitRadio Veronica), one of the stations able to move to FM in January, has made ob**ert Jen**se**n** the biggest audience

gains. Its market share for April/May 1998 is up by 1.6 percent compared to November/ December 1997, the last set of Intomart ratings before the frequency changes.

"Our start on the AM band in September 1996 allowed our [FM] competitors Sky and 538 to get a head start," explains Veronica FM programme director Robert Jensen. "Programming by our radio arm is now more focused on catering to the 18-34 demographic, which has made us a key player in TV."

Also making significant gains compared to last year's figures are oldies station Radio 10 Gold (up 1.1 percent), which made its FM debut in January, and CHR/dance broadcaster Radio 538 (up 1.3 percent), which has significantly improved its nation-

Instead of being imported from the U.S., European orders made through CDnow will be directly shipped from a European warehouse based in the Netherlands and sourced directly from European labels. According to the company's president Jason Olim, this will enable CDnow to lower shipping costs and will reduce delivery delays in Europe.

Olim says he does not expect CDnow's prices to consumers in Europe to be affected by the move, as the reduction in shipping costs from the U.S. will be offset by higher prices for

music product in Europe. However, "as the Euro [currency] comes into existence, there will be an increasing reduction in price differentials," he predicts.

Olim unveiled his new plans in a keynote speech delivered at the second Musicom Europe on-line conference at London's Mount Royal Hotel in London on June 24.

"It will dramatically increase our profile in Europe," he predicted. "There are a lot of European products that were not available in the U.S. that we will now be able to service to our customers.

Currently, European orders being fulfilled by CDnow from the U.S. have to pay customs duties and VAT. However, in practice, few parcels are opened by customs officers in Europe, resulting in tax losses for EU member states and lost sales for European labels.

Olim candidly admits that he is not too concerned by the tax aspect of the current situation. "It is at the receiving end that it should be dealt with," he says. However, the CDnow president says he is conscious of the reticence from major labels, especially on the issue of trans-shipments. "I hope that someday we'll all sit at the same table and resolve these issues," he says. We have to sit and address those complicated problems and maximise the value [of on-line retailing] for artists and labels."

CDnow's international revenues currently account for 20 percent of its total revenues, which topped the \$10 million mark in the first quarter of 1998.

BBC Radio 1 at U.K. music's 'leading edge'

U.K. public CHR station BBC Radio 1 is one of Europe's most influential new music outlets. Head of music policy Jeff Smith says the station has "changed the charts," and claims responsiblity for establishing new cutting-edge acts from the U.K. and around the world. Here, he talks to M&M's Terry Heath about R1's music policy and its aspirations for the future, while below, two of the U.K.'s most prominent pluggers reveal how. they see the station in 1998.

Q: How would you describe Radio 1's programming philosophy?

A: Specifically, our policy has always been about new music and at the same time being an entertaining radio station. Radio 1 has to be championing new music and British music.

We are lucky that, unlike many places in Europe, there are no [national product radio airplay] quotas. But the majority—around 60 percent—of Radio 1's output is from U.K.-based artists [who may not necessarily be U.K.-signed]. That is not a conscious decision by Radio 1, but there seems to be among the listening public a wider tolerance to new British music.

We were championing what was called "Britpop", which was really Britrock. <u>Now</u>, we're championing Britpop—because new music has a poppier nature at the moment—but also new music from the U.S. and Europe, for example Brandy & Monica and Eagle-Eye Cherry.

It's really an organic process of development. We're at the leading edge, and because the A-list is so important [to artists & labels], we therefore have a responsibility.

Q: Do you have what you consider to be a good relationship with record companies/pluggers?

A: We have an excellent relationship with labels and the music industry, from MDs to promotion divisions to pluggers. That goes for the majors and lots of indies. We're very open to the music industry since I came back to Radio 1. We make our own decisions, but we're also very realistic. We want to be playing the future hits, but listeners also like the charts, they like the idea of hit records, so nobody should be snooty about it.

Pluggers' meetings are very important, and take up hours of time. We want to come up with a thoughtful list of records that expresses the current state of music.

Q: Is the nature of what you play in terms of its newness—more important than achieving the overall station "sound" which most commercial stations see as central? A: No. I'm very concerned with the station sound. We're the alternative-lean-

ing future and contemporary hits radio station. We've got the hits on board, but we also want to play the future hits. The difficulty, as far as station sound goes, is to get the right flow, because of the diversity [of material we want to play]. We are, as well, a public service station. We cover the innovations, and some material that won't make it [commercially] for years, if at all. That doesn't mean it can't sound good in the mix.

Q: Have the music industry and the listening public finally understood Radio 1's programming objectives? A: It's not been an easy message [to get across]. But now, although we are losing audience, we still have around we're doing good business with a constantly developing music policy. We have a list of artists to be proud of-The Verve, Catatonia, Sashand listeners understand they heard them first on Radio 1. Just look, for example, at [national commercial CHR station] Atlantic 252's playlist. It's now very much like ours.

But we could be

clearer on-air about what we're doing, and we are using our own airwaves to say what "new music" is. We've learned a lot; people do want to be told about their radio station, and they now understand our "new music first" policy. We're saying we played Prodigy, Radiohead, Oasis first; now they're mainstream, and we're not scared of the mainstream. We changed the charts.

Q: Are your presenters talking more than they used to?

A: Yes. Otherwise it's a missed opportunity to tell listeners about the station. We don't do 12-song sweeps. This is 1998, and they're ancient his-

The pluggers' view

Dylan White

Head of radio department, Anglo Plugging

"There's more free play on Radio 1 than any other [significant] station, more sessions, more outside events with endless opportunities to give airplay to new acts that commercial radio wouldn't touch. Look at the airplay charts with Radio 1 included and Fatboy Slim is at the top. Look at it with Radio 1 excluded and there's no Fatboy Slim at the top.

"Radio 1 is so important in playing new types of music. If it wasn't there, you'd have to read about new music in the press; we don't need the press now because you can hear it on Radio 1.

"There are now two sets of records in the [UK] charts: Garbage, theaudience, acts you'll only hear on Radio 1; and Des'ree, Celine Dion, LeAnn Rimes, which get airplay on [U.K.] commercial radio but not on Radio 1. There's some crossover—for example the Corrs—but the division is there to be seen. That's O.K., and there's no criticism of commercial radio. They've both got their agendas, and they're different.

The BBC is a public service to provide interesting television and radio for the nation. If it was just about ratings, we'd have nothing but crap soaps on the television, and safe pop on the

radio. Radio 1 does play popular hit records, but that's not all it does. It has room for the new, the unusual, the next thing that's sometimes too risky for anything but a public service to play. "And Jeff Smith is a music man. I'll

And Jeff Smith is a music man. I'll go to see him and he's surrounded by towers of CDs. I'll bring him an album and ask him what he thinks, and he says 'Well, actually, I think track three is a good one.' All credit to him, if in his position he has the time and the interest to really listen, to get three tracks into a new CD, he's doing the job."

"My take on Radio 1 is that the pendulum has swung away from alternative bands towards dance and pop. The station is rotating more accessible pop more frequently, and that's understandable. It's not haemorrhaging listeners, but there is a steady attrition which the station wants to stop. It is changing its musical landscape.

"The music industry remembers R1's great promise to represent all new music as much as possible. Like the [U.K.] Labour government, R1 is living in the real world, and some of its election promises have to be modified. But

tory. We're going back to personality radio. We have DJs who can talk, and we sometimes get them to talk about Radio 1.

FEATURE

The audience wants innovation. I've been in commercial radio, and there is a 2-way street between commercial radio and the BBC. We need to find the next [R1 presenter] Simon Mayo. Either we find [that talent] or we develop it. We also need to use the tactics of commercial radio to get the public service message across in a young style.

Q: What's the most difficult part of your job?

A: Trying to make a massive range of music work—trying to make the programming flow. We have a weekly dialogue with the music industry, which means we meet most labels at least every two weeks. We are at the leading edge, but we have to remember that they're music people and we're radio people—public service radio people. We're paid for by the licence payers.

Q: Where is Radio 1 now?

A: In 1967 we started young and rebellious, and we're back to that in 1998 still young. In the '70s we made the mistake of growing old with our audience. A lot of stations have figured that out. We have now taken the decision to stay young, and that means a constant turnover in audience. But it's still amazing to me how many over-35s—even over-45s—are still Radio 1 listeners.

in Radio 1's defence, a lot of bands haven't delivered the goods after long and steady support from the station.

"It's harder to break and develop album artists than pop, and the balance of the R1 mix has switched to, by and large, supporting the second and third albums of artists the station helped to build. They're adhering more to a 'proper' radio programming policy, where before they used to playlist on faith. If anyone doubts the change, just look at the playlist over the past six months.

"There was a time when record companies got pissed off with the station for not playing their new post-Britpop alternative bands, even though many of the releases didn't deserve to be daytime airplay singles. R1 has re-established control over its own domain. People don't have a right to get played."

The new Dutch beat: pop or purist?

Cruising through Holland's major cities, car stereos drown out the traffic noises—and amidst the monotonous techno and gabber beats, the more suave pulse of R&B reigns supreme in Amsterdam and Rotterdam.

The current wave of streetwise Dutch R&B has not appeared out of the blue. With large black populations originating from Surinam, the Dutch Antilles and Morocco—those two cities have grown to become natural providers of home-grown R&B talent. A strong swingbeat scene in the 1980's provided the firm foundation for today's artists.

"Finally, there's a musical genre for the youth that they can fully identify with," observes Virgin Benelux A&R manager Flip van den Enden. "Compared to techno, it's more traditional and social. You don't have to pop pills until five in the morning to dig it. Lovers can take each other to the dance floor again."

Van den Enden adds: "From their parents' record collections, they've picked up soul music by Sam Cook and Otis Redding from the 1960's, Stevie Wonder and Marvin Gaye from the 1970s and artists like Luther Vandross from the 1980s. Right now, R&B is the dominant genre in the charts again, and these kids want to have a go at it as well."

On the radio side, specialist R&B stations, such as City FM in Amsterdam and Sun FM in Rotterdam—as well as youth-oriented CHR station Radio 538—offer R&B nationwide support. "When regional commercial radio first appeared possible, I immediately checked the demand for an R&B station in Greater Rotterdam," says Ronald van der Meijden, managing director at Sun FM, which launched in 1997.

"Our first anniversary gala on May 28," he adds, "featured live performances by most popular local R&B artists. We're only on cable, but within one year, we've achieved a one percent market share in our region."

TV personality Sylvana Simons, presenter of R&B show Sylvana's Soul on Dutch music TV station The Music Factory (TMF), is often described as Dutch R&B's female patron. Simons comments: "R&B is here to stay. Talented kids have always been out there, but you need money [to break into music TV]. In the three years of TMF's existence, the quality of locally produced videos has improved significantly."

Sweat and Dignity

The local R&B roster for Virgin Benelux includes all-girl trio Dignity whose former member Edsilia Rombley represented the Netherlands at this year's Eurovision Song Contest—and male vocal group Sat'r'day.

Van den Enden became involved with Dignity when Virgin distributed the *No Sweat* R&B sampler, released by the Dutch National Pop Institute (NPI) last year. The album was part of NPI's *Unsigned* series, a project set up to help new talent to secure a record deal.

All the tracks on the album were recorded in Amsterdam-based Cruise Control studios, where Dutch R&B started some 10 years ago under the guidance of owner/producer Rutti, alias Rutger Croese. for a manager, the right repertoire and a skilful producer," adds Zijlstra. Now the band is managed by Delft-based company Mojo; producer/songwriter Bas van den Heuvel (of Total Touchfame) provides creative support.

Virgin's Van den Enden agrees with Zijlstra's view that R&B has to be developed with a long-term perspec-

"Unlike its Afro-American namesake, European R&B needs to be more poppy to guarantee a crossover to a wider public than the niche market it is now. Even more so, if you want to sell it back to the U.S. [in the face of so many established players]."

This is pop?

The main choices facing Dutch A&R men seems to be between taking a pop or purist approach to R&B.

"There's no doubt that it has to be pop," insists Polydor Holland A&R manager Paul Zijlstra. Zijlstra, who signed male quartet Voices In Motion, featured on *No Sweat*. He explains: "For pure R&B, the market is too small to get a return on investment."

So, if pop songs are the key to establishing home-grown R&B acts with chart success, then the most urgent issue at hand must be making sure the scene's songwriters grow at the same rate as the performing artists. Right now, "the lack of great song material is a weak point," warns Zijlstra. "We [the labels] shouldn't try to sell local R&B by banging out albums after only one hit single. Instead, we should take time to develop careers."

Voices In Motion's debut single Never Think Twice was released on March 8—a year after they first teamed up with Zijlstra—and their first album is scheduled for a release this autumn. "I wanted to get everything sorted first, including the search

tive in mind. "We are confident that Dignity and Sat'r'day will prove themselves as real artists, rather than one hit wonders," says Van den Enden.

However, taking a long-term approach to development and investment remains an experiment for all parties invloved in the Dutch R&B scene. "We don't have a long tradition at Dignity's end of the market [in Holland]," points out Van den Emden. "Eighties female soul/pop trio Mai Tai was the first and last of its kind."

In love with Roméo

So far Rotterdam foursome Roméo (Dureco) are the only band to convert a loyal fanbase and singles success into album sales. Their May 20-released debut album *Roméo* received a silver award for sales in excess of 21,000 copies and peaked at number 8 in the official Mega Top 100 Albums chart.

Roméo's breakthrough (second) single, *Coming Home*, was released on February 27. The sugar-coated ballad peaked at number 2 in both the Mega Top 100 and rival Rabo Top 40 charts. *Coming Home* earned the band a gold award (50,000 units) and was only held off the top slot by Celine Dion's *Titanic*-fuelled *My Heart Will Go On*.

Coming Home and Roméo's debut album will soon be released through BMG in 32 countries across the world, and a U.S. deal is currently under negotiation. The band's new single, Secret Love, is out now in Holland while airplay for Coming Home is rapidly building across Scandinavia.

Clifton Giersthove, one of the four members of Roméo, attributes the success of his band to firmly sticking to the 'pop' side of R&B. "We don't want to be at the deep end of R&B," he explains. "We like to be seen as a pop act, doing material [similar to] Boyz II Men's *End Of The Road*." He adds: "Let's be honest, Europe is our main market. We are ambitious, but it's pointless to compete [here] with deep R&B repertoire from the U.S."

Soul deep

Unlike Roméo, KéShaw—another Rotterdam-based band—have no qualms about going for deep R&B in the vein of their U.S. idols Jodeci and Blackstreet.

Six years ago, thanks largely to the belief of Rutger Croese, KéShaw were directly—albeit briefly—signed to Motown Records in the U.S., as band member Clyde Weiboldt (a.k.a. Stec) recalls: "The label organised a release party at Midem in 1992, but our album never saw the light of day."

Last year, EMI Holland offered them a new chance. The success of *The Heat*, KéShaw's second single under the EMI deal, underlines the fact that their belated debut long-player—a completely new set to the aborted Motown album—which is scheduled for autumn release, is the most eagerly anticipated album amongst Holland's R&B fraternity this year. Weiboldt notes that the Dutch media and music industries have both opened up for R&B since the early 1990s.

At Free Record Shop, the Netherlands' largest music retail chain, buyer Jean Broeks testifies to R&B's enormous potential. "With local R&B artists singing either in English or in Dutch, [the market] can only get bigger," he notices. Of groups singing in their mother tongue, Re-Play (Rhythm Records) and Arnhemsgewijs (Mercury) are the most popular, according to retailers. Newcomers in the genre are Claudia Nelson (VAN Records), Chapter One (Virgin) and Vogelvrij (EMI).

TMF's Simons concludes: "Local repertoire in general is faring better than ever in the Netherlands [with a 30 percent market share]. R&B can benefit from the upbeat mood the entire [Dutch] industry is currently in; its current surge in popularity is based on the industry's greater understanding of the genre and the bigger investments being made in it finally, labels are aware you can make a profit on it."

Heroes write on new pages

If all goes to plan for Mercury's London-based Talkin' Loud imprint, Two Pages, the new album from drum'n'bass duo 4 Hero-original pioneers of the genre-could ring in a renaissance of the dance album as a hot ticket in itself, not just a collection of hit singles.

Having established a successful blueprint for marketing drum'n'bass to a wider pop audience with Roni Size & Reprazent's album New Forms last year, Talkin' Loud will release Two Pages as a double album on two CDs or four vinyl 12 inch



records on July 13. A single album on CD will follow on August 3.

In an unusual Talkin' move. Loud is not leading off the album with a single release. The first single, Star Chasers, is in fact due out on August 3

together with the "compact" version of the album. "A series of singles is an expensive way of promoting a band," says Talkin' Loud A&R manager Paul Martin. "You need support to a certain level to break into the mainstream." Martin insists that the right album can do far more for a niche act to break out of its specialist market.

"4 Hero come from basically a specialist dance arena," explains Martin. "Two Pages will hopefully serve to widen their audience. It appeals to active clubbers as well as people who want a body of work, an album in the classical sense.

"As with Roni Size and Reprazent, we did not want them to provide us with 10 separate 12 inch singles, we wanted a vision which brings the album as a whole to life. And to help people to judge 4 Hero by the whole depth of

Two Pages, we're making the single available after the initial album release."

The double CD album is split into two parts-Page One and Page Two-which explore different sides of 4 Hero's musical universe. "Page One is an organic, orchestral 'new soul" record," says Martin, "while Page Two comes from a technological approach to music." The single CD version of Two Pages with which the label is targeting the pop market will feature a mix of 80 percent material from Page One and 20 percent of the darker "underground" sounds from Page Two.

By releasing a more commercial version of the album to ride on the buzz built by the initial "trendsetter"-edition, Talkin' Loud is following the marketing blueprint for Reprazent's New Forms to a tee. In the case of New Formswhich reached sales of 500,000 albums internationally, half of them in the U.K.-the single-CD version of the album has accounted for 70 percent of its sales, according to Martin.

An additional PR coup is 4 Hero's performance with a 20-piece band at this year's Montreux Jazz Festival during a special Talkin' Loud label showcase night on July 16, which will attract the attention of media outside the dance scene. "With the double album, we're targeting trendsetters in the club culture market." says Martin. The Montreux gig and the single will try to build on this buzz and attract early adopters in the pop market, "who will then have access to the more competitively priced single album CD," adds Martin.

4 Hero's Dego MacFarlane says he sees the duo's artistic integrity left untouched by the label's plans to crack the mainstream market with Two Pages. "We haven't felt pressurised or compromised artistically," he says.

"Being signed to Talkin' Loud doesn't feel like being with a major at all. In fact the only real pressure came from ourselves. We had access to a bigger budget which allowed us to work with excellent musicians and we knew we had to deliver a great record.'



THE GOSPEL MOB

More powerful crossover material from Eric Morillo's New York label Double Platinum has hit European shores. Fun by Da Mob featuring Jocelyn Brown picks a fluid'n'funky garage groove and, with astonishing vocal interplay between Brown and the backing singers, ends up sounding like a fullon gospel workout. Uplifting, inspirational and with a tune you can actually whistle, this is credible dancepop at its finest. The mad drops and time-stretched voices of the Mongo Fun Dub make for a pre-destined dancefloor hit.

ALL IN ORDER

Very much on the borderline between pop and club is Soulman's Put Your House (Celebrative/Netherlands), which features a fairly full and highly seductive vocal contribution. As it stands, Put Your House is a pure club track, but the combination of witty, bright instrumentation and sensual vocals could easily be slimmed down to a playlistfriendly length with an additional radio edit.

NEW LUIC FROM SWEDEN

After Swedish indie label Dot introduced its own take on drum'n'bass, a new twist on the genre comes from Luic with Another Day (Left Right Recordings/Sweden). Featuring the jazz timbre of singer Jeanette Fredenburg alongside breakbeats which sweep from industrial strength to subtle, sinuous rhythms, the track also boasts an excellent pop hook. Carcrash on the "B-side" is equally strange and praiseworthy.

SEVEN AND SEVEN IS

SevenDub's laidback Rock It Tonight (Pro-Zack Trax) could be the breakthrough track for this Parisian independent label. With a radio version that rolls along on a sweet reggae groove, allowing the chorus room to breathe, plus a thumping house remix by labelmates Aleem, the track has all bases covered. With dreamy, innocent vocals, a perfect soundtrack to a summer's afternoon.

POSITIVA TOUCH

Since its January 1997 launch, the Dancesite from EMI's Positiva imprint has proven to be amongst the best of the "dance-culture" websites. The combination of an editorial style which manages to be funny without denting too many showbiz egos, 20-30 new soundbites each week, stories about everything



amirez' Dreams less dista

Caribbean roots and an Italian production team steeped in European club tastes have

combined to make R&B diva Karen Ramirez one of the hottest newcomers of the year.

Brought up in a musical family in London and Trinidad on a mixed diet of jazz, classical, soul and Latin, Ramirez spent her teenage years torn between maths and music. She claims she opted for music when she realised singing in jazz clubs paid more than her lab technician's job.

She found soulmates in Italian producer team Souled Out, with whom she originally recorded a jazz-funk album which never saw the light of day. Second time around, their collaboration has resulted in her debut solo album, Distant Dreams, recorded at Souled Out's Naples studio and due to be released across Europe by Mercury's dance imprint Manifesto on July 20.

"I had a concept for the album, which was 'fantasy versus reality,' " explains Ramirez. "I wrote a lot of the songs about my childhood and they're very emotions-based." One of those songs about childhood, Troubled Girl, came to

the attention of Manifesto and got Karen her deal. Released as her debut single this spring, it appears in both English and Spanish versions on the album.

Mercury is now working follow-up single Looking For Love-a cover of a song by U.K. duo Everything But The Girl. The track is a Top 10 hit in the U.K. this week, and the company is confident it can extend that success across continental Europe. Leading the field is Denmark, where the single entered the airplay chart at

number 5 and is on power play rotation on CHR network P3.

"[Everything But The Girl's] Tracey Thorn and Ben Watt are fantastic lyricists," says Ramirez. "I just wanted to bring something of myself to it. Simple lyrics and simple melody always hook people and the Dave Sears remix-which seems to be very popular at, radio-is very happy-sounding."

The single is being promoted simultaneously to clubs and radio and Ramirez is happy to take time out of rehearsals to promote it to radio. "I especially like going round to stations to play the guitar and do acoustic sets in the studio," she adds. "I've always had a drive to write songs and get involved in music but I don't like being put into a box. Maybe that's part of my drive in writing music.'

Take a trip back to the end of the '70s with Six Was Nine; laid-back rock that smells of six-figure studio costs and cries for a big, shiny hi-fi. Think of a mix of Foreigner, 10cc and a dash of the



Eagles and you have an idea what Six Was Nine sound like. German studio wizards Achim Degen and Markus Tiedemann create lovingly crafted five-minute time capsules recalling the golden age of album rock on Zen & Now, their fourth album in six years. They only lose their form once,

on a somewhat uninspired cover of Bob Dylan's Like A Rolling Stone. From a European point of view, Six Was Nine's adult oriented rock fits in nicely with the recent comebacks of artists such as Page & Plant or Deep Purple. A wider European release for Zen & Now is pencilled in for the autumn. The first single, Turning Wheel, is still in the German Top 100 more than two months after its April 27 release. As well as the German mixes,

BMG Ariola has a U.K. mix by veteran producer Mick Glossop in store which brings the chorus in earlier, creating a prime slice of AC pop-rock.

More old-skool hip-hop beats from one of the U.K.'s premier DJ teams. The Beastie Boys may have creamed off much of the recent media attention with their new album Hello Nasty (Grand Royal/Capitol), but to overlook We Rock Hard in the process would be a mistake.

All the hip retro elements are here-vocoders, electro beats and prominent scratching-but a touch of reggae fleshes out the sound, and the Freestylers give Ace Of Base a run for their money on tracks such as Here We Go. A "proper" pop record at times, We Rock Hard captures the sound of a night out in "swinging London" with its eclectic mix of styles. The Freestylers' scratching technique is awesome, and used to build suspense and melodic hooks rather than cheesy effects. Overall, the album could profit from a bit of tightening up for the Continental market but it'll have you whistling along just fine as it stands now.

Unlike its predecessor, this track is a bright, uptempo rocker, which should do well on a variety of formats. Last week, When was added as the powerplay track at Belgian public CHR network VRT Radio Donna (headquartered in Brussels), which means it's picking up more than 20 plays a week on the youth-oriented station. Werner De Backer, one of Radio Donna's music programmers, explains: "Every week, 10 people who are involved in programming list their five favourites (and those judged most suitable for the station) of that week; this time around, one was the clear winner-although I must admit that it was a less than exciting week releasewise!" De Backer continues: "What definitely influenced our choice is the fact that its predecessor did very well over here and we think Shania Twain is well under way to become a big star in Europe. Looking good and being all over magazine covers and TV programmes doesn't hurt either..."

Being programme director at Romebased CHR network Radio Dimensione Suono (RDS), is, according to Marco Minelli, his dream job.

However, it's part of a workload which would seem like a nightmare to other music programmers-Minelli also holds down several other roles outside the station, most notably artist management of DJs/producers Ike Terry and Dr. Felix and singer Natasha. "Radio,"

he enthuses, "is my hobby. I'm not in this career from the business angle, but because I like it."

Minelli believes his other activities and his varied previous jobs keep him in touch with his listeners and knowing what they want to hear. "I started living radio at the age of 12 in 1974, when the first commercial stations started popping up in Italy," he says. "I've also worked in the theatre, dubbed movies, created advertising campaigns and produced sponsored syndicated radio shows.

"I also started my own local radio station and when it was bought out by Radio Dimensione Suono [in 1990], I joined them and became part of the team that built up [the station] into what it is today.

For 18 months, RDS has been Italy's most listened to national commercial network; in the Audiradio ratings for the 2nd quarter of 1998, it's approaching a record-breaking 5 million average daily audience.

"We have a very clearly defined target audience, says Minelli, describing RDS's average listenerequally split between males and females-as a well-educated 25-34 year-old with

above-average spending power. "They want to know a little about everything that's happening, from national and international news, to the economy, sports, popular culture and events. We programme that information in concise spots, mainly in our top-of-the-hour five minute bulletin; of course, our listeners also tune in for the music!"

Apart from the hourly new release titled Promo Hit, broadcast as the second song after the news (the first being a "gold" classic), RDS's playlist comprises established hits, with a 50/50 domestic/international split. "We're evolving our content into a general format similar to a public network, but with the rhythm of a commercial network-especially during daytime," Minelli notes.

"In the evenings, we specialise a lot more because we're in competition with TV." Each night between 21.00 and 00.00, RDS broadcasts a different themed show including love (Mondays), comedy (Tuesdays) and movies on (Wednesdays). Minelli co-hosts several of those shows.

Concludes Minelli: "We do a lot of qualitative research to find out who our listeners are and what their ideal radio is. Our listeners want to hear positive and happy programmes, and I believe we have created their-and my-Mark Dezzani ideal radio station."



This German female rapper's first claim to fame was the infectious Walk On By, which peaked at 5 in the German singles 100 and at 22 in The European Hot 100 singles earlier this year. This track has proved no slouch either, hitting the German singles chart at 10 and the Eurochart Hot 100 Singles at 52. Stimulated by its domestic success, Warner is releasing Wannabe Your Lover elsewhere; one of the first outside Germany to add the track was Jocke Bring, programme director at Swedish dance station Hit FM 94.2, which covers the Stockholm area from its Bromma base. He explains: "We decided to add it to our playlist mainly because we got a lot of requests from our listeners-we also played its predecessor, which went down reasonably well without becoming a real chartbuster. Currently we're playing Wannabe Your Lover at least eight times a week; that will increase if the requests continue." Bring adds: "In general our listeners are guite active—they call and e-



mail us a lot. Sometimes they're even better informed than US. because they surf the Internet and listen to satellite radio a lot. We add and drop titles much quicker than more mainstream stations do; our listeners expect that from us."



On Europe's airwaves, the saga of girlpower continues... Not only is the new Spice Girls single Viva Forever (Virgin) the highest new entry on the European Radio Top 50 at number 29-and also the most added record-this week, but female voices have the top six positions in the chart.

Most striking performance this week is by R&B divas Brandy & Monica, who climb to number three with their duet The Boy Is Mine (Atlantic). As the Major Market Airplay section shows, they've made the regional top 5 in the U.K., the G/S/A countries and Scandinavia.

Stretching the girlpower theme even further, 16 of the overall top 20 on the pan-European chart are sung by female voices! "It's definitely the Spice Girls who started that fire," declares head of music Jan L. Hansen at Danish hot AC outlet Radio Mojn/Aabenraa. Despite the recent speculation about the future of the fab five-become-four, Hansen says he had no hesitation in adding the new Spice Girls single to his playlist. "The leaving of Ginger Spice won't spoil the popularity of the Spice Girls," he reckons. "The music will stay the same."

Radio Mojn, although one of the 10 biggest local commercial FM radio stations in Denmark, is situated near the German border, so one of its major competitors is actually over the border, in the shape of Radio RSH/Kiel.

However, Hansen says Radio Mojn has a secret weapon against this challenge: the flourishing Danish R&B and hip-hop scene (he particularly recom-mends Den Gale Pose and MC Clemens). He explains: "We're never afraid of playing new things, whatever it may be. Danish language hip-hop is not only popular among the younger elements of our audience. Most of the lyrics are funny, so most 30-40 year olds can appreciate it too."

Back on the European Radio Top 50, one thing which all three new entries this week have in common is that they're backed by strong videos. Viva Forever is an animated tour de force, the sexy side of Garbage chanteuse Shirley Manson is to the fore in the clip for I Think I'm Paranoid (Mushroom), a new entry at 36, and the Beastie Boys-in at 48-are as entertaining as ever with the visual version of Intergalactic (Grand Royal/Capitol).

Those clips assure strong support from music TV across Europe for all those tracks, but at radio, a hefty chunk of the support for the Spice Girls and Garbage is coming from the U.K.-22 out of the 54 total stations playlisting Viva Forever are situated in the U.K. The



song is also developing nicely in Denmark, Germany and Switzerland. For the dance/rock crossover I Think I'm Paranoid, it's mainly the U.K. and rock-loving Poland at the moment, while the experimental hip-hop of Intergalactic is supported by the more leftfield stations across Europe.



Bubbling under the Top 50 this week, we find: The One by The Artist (NPG/RCA), Just The 2 Of Us by Will Smith (Columbia), Thinking Of You by Hanson (Mercury), and-unsuprisingly-two female artists, Shania Twain (Mercury) and with When teen-popper Billie with Be-Want cause We To (Innocent/Virgin). BPI's 'unity and strength'

LONDON — Leading representatives of the U.K. record industry called for unity across the whole music business in the digital age at this week's annual general meeting of the British Phonographic Industry (BPI).

Around 250 attendees at the AGM in London on July 8 heard BPI chairman (and chairman of Warner Music U.K.) Rob Dickins call for labels and publishers to be united and strong in their approach to copyright, piracy and technology. He announced: "We're all in this together—publishers, songwriters, artists, record companies."

The BPI chairman railed against the picture of a disunited, ailing industry recently presented in the U.K. press. "The image to the digital broadcasters, the internet providers, the telecoms companies, of a cowering industry in defeat—which is the way we've been presented in the press—is appalling.

"It not only doesn't serve us well with them if we look like weak opposition that they can just beat up—and we know they want to—but also with government, because the government doesn't want to be seen to back a loser."

The real problem facing the industry, Dickins insisted, is that: "for the first time, the delivery agents are actually probably smarter than we are; they have more money than we do and more to gain." This raised the spectre of creative businesses being submerged by the delivery systems, making the need for copyright protection imperative.

Dickins cited, however, the success of Catatonia, Robbie Williams and All Saints as proof that the demise of the industry has been greatly exaggerated. "More people, he said, "are buying records in 1998 than have ever bought records before." The rise of new U.K. pop acts with young fans also augurs well for the long term health of the industry, he opined. "Remember, the 12 year-olds who bought Herman's Hermits and Freddie & The Dreamers when they were 12 or 13 bought *See Emily Play* and *Strawberry Fields Forever* when they were 17."

Dickins also emphasised the importance of the U.K.'s independent labels to the music industry—and to the BPI—in his speech. Earlier, following an address by John Hutchison, chief executive of rights body Music Alliance, Dickins asked independent members to pass their concerns about their relationship with publishers' body the Mechanical Copyright Protection Society—one half of Music Alliance—to BPI representatives on a new labels/publishers liaison committee, to meet on July 31.

Guest speaker at the AGM was Secretary of State for Culture, Media and Sport Chris Smith. He delivered a broad-ranging speech touching on education, on-line issues, copyright and piracy. He also called for the music industry as a whole to be "coordinated in its efforts to establish watermarking and identification systems for digitally transmitted music, to give the best protection possible."

Earlier, BPI director general John Deacon told the AGM the BPI and the International Federation of the Phonographic Industry were making progress in opening up communication with governments on piracy, thanks to "a wellstructured lobbying programme." Those lobbying skills would be needed, he added, if the EU Copyright Directive is to be "moulded to preserve and encourage our trading opportunities."

He also underlined that the music industry has to ensure European legislators do not unfairly favour telecommunications companies and on-line service providers at the expense of the creative industries. "People," he said, "do not buy the wires, they buy programmes. They do not buy discs for the plastic, they buy them for the recorded music."

Croatia on July 4 to watch the DDD/BMG Ricordi artist perform the first of two open air concerts in Munich. Another 18,000 fans gathered for the second gig the following day, which was attended by BMG Entertainment International president and CEO Rudi Gassner and BMG Entertainment G/S/A president Thomas Stein.

On both nights, Ramazzotti was joined on stage for duets with Joe Cocker and Tina Turner. Belgian tenor Helmut Lotti also accompanied Ramazzotti in his live rendition of the epic ode to the power of music, *Musica è*, from his current album, *Eros*.

Gassner says he feels "close personal bonds" with Ramazzotti, "whose career has developed together with the growth of BMG International." He adds: "Ramazzotti has the charisma, the drive and the ability to be true to himself, which make him an international superstar. There are only a few people in this world who have what it takes, but if you do, language is no barrier."

After the July 5 show, Gassner and

Stein presented Ramazzotti with an award marking sales of over one million units of *Eros* in Germany—the artist's biggest market (see picture, page 1).

"The public here has a high affinity with Italy, which has been a favourite German holiday destination since the '50s," explains Stein. He suggests that a certain amount of Ramazzotti's success north of the Alps is also based on "the continuity in the relationship between the artist, his management and BMG."

A retrospective of Ramazzotti's biggest hits, *Eros*—released in October 1997—traces the artist's 15 year career, during which his highly individual vocal style and romantic pop songs have entered the hearts of millions of fans across Europe. Among the new recordings were the duets *Cosa della Vita* with Tina Turner and *Musica è* with Italian crossover star Andrea Bocelli. Bearing testimony to the artist's Europe-wide popularity, *Eros* was certified four times Platinum Europe by IFPI last month, for European sales in excess of four million units.

Santer at IFPI

million units in Europe. Artists to pick up their accolades in person at the event included Joe Cocker, Ricky Martin, Zucchero, Nek, Robbie Williams, Eric Levy and No Mercy. Aqua, Pascal Obispo and the Corrs were to perform live. Also due to appear was French artist Jean-Michel Jarre, IFPI's European industry artist spokesman (M&M, July 11), collecting a special award for "exceptional contribution to the European music industry."

Also in Santer's speech:

• A dynamic picture of the European music landscape. "Your industry," says Santer, "is a major source of income and investment throughout Europe; it is a multibillion-Euro business; it exports European music repertoire with great success throughout the world; it employs hundreds of thousands of people across the continent; and it is a pioneer of new technology."

• Santer notes that the EU has already "taken concrete, practical steps," investing in music-related projects. "We hope,

taken earlier this year in major cities in northern England, which represent Atlantic's biggest audience centres. "You just can't sit still," says programme director Al Dunne.

Under its new format, Atlantic's target demographics will be more focused, on 15 to 24 year-olds rather than the previous 15-35 age group. There will also be a slight skew towards 20-plus females. "We found these women to be assertive, confident and sassy," says Atlantic's marketing controller Alison Victory. "These are the kind of females—as well as males—we are seeing as we go on the road to clubs."

Victory acknowledges the change will see Atlantic going head-to-head with public CHR broadcaster BBC Radio 1 and Chrysalis's Galaxy dance stations in Manchester and Leeds.

Atlantic is already playing more new music earlier, according to Dunne. "Before, we would wait until

from the year 2000, to strengthen support for truly European music projects with a new structure, the First European Community Framework Programme in Support of Culture."

• On intellectual property rights and the Commission's proposed copyright directive, Santer says: "If the music business is to continue to thrive, then it is vital that our intellectual property rights are properly protected."

Santer calls digital technology "a new challenge" for law makers. "Where previously there was piracy on the high seas, there is now piracy on the high streets. Fighting piracy is becoming more complex with the further development of the information society." However, the Commission "is already responding to this swiftly changing environment. Its proposed copyright directive intends to harmonise important aspects of copyright and related rights in the information society." Next week, M&M will publish a special supplement

celebrating the IFPI Platinum Europe awards.

songs tested well with the audience. That's no longer the case. The challenge for me is to make sure it is the right new music. Some of the tracks might not do well in the charts, but they fit in well with what our audience now wants."

New tracks now have the chance of being placed straight into Atlantic's hottest rotation category (up to 65 spins per week). "Before, new music was placed in a different category with a lower rotation," explains Dunne.

Promotions executive Jo Hart, director of independent promotions company Jo Hart PR, says of the changes: "We as pluggers take on records from new and established acts that we feel we can do something with. But it is frustrating when some [radio stations] won't take the risk. Now Atlantic is taking the risks and will help break new music and artists. This is exciting stuff."

Naïve seals Auvidis deal

PARIS — As anticipated, Naïve, the multi-media company created in 1997 by former Virgin France chairman Patrick Zelnik, has acquired French production and distribution company Auvidis, which specialises in sound-tracks, classical, world and children's music, for an undisclosed sum.

After 20 years of independence, Auvidis chief executive and founder Louis Bricard opted to sell to another indie, rather than a major. "We received other proposals, particularly from majors, which were more interesting financially, but I wanted to ensure the future of Auvidis as a company," says Bricard, who becomes a partner in Naïve, with slightly less than 10 percent of the shares.

Zelnik says the Auvidis acquisition was driven by "its catalogue and philosophy." It will give Naïve access to a prestigious catalogue and control of a distribution company. Auvidis is not a very profitable company, but it is not vulnerable because its catalogue is very rich and diversified. 80 percent of Auvidis' turnover comes from back catalogue."

With an annual turnover of Ffr75-100 million (\$12.5m-16.5m)and a 1,500 title back catalogue, Auvidis biggest successes have been original soundtracks. "Louis [Bricard] will probably be in charge of our classical catalogue while remaining chief executive of Auvidis," notes Zelnik. Bricard does not anticipate "changes in the short term at Auvidis, which will continue to operate separately from Naïve."

"We will develop joint projects in the area of soundtracks and children's material with sister company [book publisher] Actes Sud, and Auvidis will distribute our products," says Zelnik, who is looking to acquire other catalogues for Naïve's new distribution arm.

OTR hears that French music industry body SNEP is "upset" with broadcast radio group NRJ's decision to drop-almost completelyrecords by new artists on the AC Nostalgie network. Nostalgie, acquired by NRJ in June, has been transformed into a gold network and SNEP apparently considers it is in breach of quota regulations which require stations to programme a minimum of 40 percent French music, half of which must be from up-and-coming acts.

U.K. regulator the Radio Authority has given its official approval to Capital Radio's takeover of alternative music station Xfm/London. Expect some swift changes in personnel.

MTV Networks Europe's new "freeform" channel M2-the first TV station to debut on the Internet-will launch next month. M2 will initially be available 24 hours a day at the address http://www.m2europe.com from August 3 onwards. The station will continue the webcasts after it goes on-air as a full digital TV service via the Canal Digital platform in Scandinavia on October 1. "Guest programmers" for the launch include Air, Pulp, Money Mark and Nick Cave. Readers wanting a preview of the "no ads, no presenters" format should check out the site-inprogress at M2's internet address this week.

Staying with MTV Europe, the company has teamed with U.K. radio production company Unique Broadcasting in a joint, London-basd venture-MTV Radio Productions (MTVRP)to provide music and entertainment programming, including live artist performances, for European radio. Unique will provide management and production services; the MD of the new company will be announced shortly.

Former Sony Music France chief executive Henri de Bodinat has confirmed his acquisition (through his company Musisoft) of "a substantial" share in indie distributor Media 7. He also recently acquired the catalogue of world music indie label Sonodisc.

In the next six months, the BBC plans to launch a new digital radio service, broadcasting music from its session and concert archives of the past 30 years, the U.K. public broadcaster's director of radio, Matthew Bannister, has announced. The news came on July 9 during the official launch of digital radio receivers by five manufacturers.

French AC network Europe 2's Canadian programme director Guy Banville is quitting after five years "for personal reasons." Banville has been the driving force in reshaping the format of the station, which has enjoyed record audience figures during the past three years. According to a source, other changes are about to be made at the network...

At this week's British Phonographic Industry (BPI) AGM, government minister Chris Smith was given a light-hearted grilling on his musical tastes by BPI director general John Deacon. What emerged was that the U.K. Secretary of State for Culture, Media and Sport's favourite record of all time is the Schubert



Quintet in C by the Amadeus Quartet, with Scott McKenzie's San Francisco also held in high regard. The last gig he went to was by Welsh chanteuse Shirley Bassey, and the first record he bought was, in 1963, She Loves You (cue BPI chairman Rob Dickins, playfully asking: week 29/98
