REPORTERS ARE NOSEY JERKS...

RENO, LEAD GUITARIST OF COMPULSION HAS A MIND OF HIS OWN ABOUT THE POP SCENE

After a recent interview with Reno, lead guitarist of Compulsion about the drug scene in New Zealand, Go-Set reporters have been reluctant to try and get any more information from this angry, young man.

But, due to the many letters requesting a personal interview, we were virtually forced to try again. At great risk to life and limb, here are Reno's comments on the Melbourne pop scene and members of the pop-press.

"I find the Australian pop scene extremely groovy, especially around the city discos, like Sebastians and the Catcher. New Zealand has nothing that can even vaguely compare with these places."

"When I ventured to ask him why he disliked reporters so much, he sneered and replied: 'Because you're all the same — nose-y jerks! And personally, I don't need idiots like yourself writing about how I loved a lost or that I eat cornflakes for breakfast. If the kids want to dig me, it's because they dig my music, and not because a jerk like you writes a lot of trash about me.'"

"After I thanked him for the compliments, I asked him who were his favourite Australian group."

"Maz Merritt and the Melvins. They're instantly brilliant musicians. But I don't like them because they're from here. England or America is more their scene."

A lot of pop stars live away from home and have become quite good cooks. The ones that are lucky to still be living at home always have a favorite dish that they're mum cooks.

Each week we'll present a pop star and his favorite recipe, so that you too can eat their special fave foods.

THIS WEEK—

ROSS D. WYLLIE

Swiss Steak (serves 4)

INGREDIENTS—

One cup of white wine 3 tablespoons of white vinegar. One can of finely chopped green chilis. 1 tablespoon brown sugar. 1 teaspoon salt. 1/2 teaspoon of garlic powder. 2 lb beef round steak (cut about 2" thick). 2 tablespoons shortening.

FOR SAUCE—
1 cup of drained marinade. 1/2 cup of bouillon. 1/2 cup of chili sauce. 2 lbs. chopped onions. 2 teaspoons of plain flour and water (mixed).

METHOD—

Mix first six ingredients to make marinade. Place the meat in a pan and the marinade (first six ingredients) together in the fridge overnight.

Drain the meat sauce off the marinade. Brown the meat on both sides in shortening, then add the marinade, add the bouillon and the chili sauce and the chopped onion. Cover and simmer for 1 1/2 hours. Make sauce by mixing plain flour with water and stir into sauce. Cook until thick. Garnish this with tomatoes, olives and artichoke hearts and heat to serve.

Ivan Dayman, the man who made Normie Rowe (or vice versa) claims he has found another Normie Rowe.

He is Jonne Sands, a tall, thin rather angular looking 16-year-old. Jonne looks nearer 14 than 16, and has the voice and stage presentation of an experienced entertainer.

Jonne had been singing in Brisbane for 13 months when he auditioned for Ivan Dayman.

He made his first major concert appearance, at the Trocadero in Sydney several weeks ago when he was virtually unknown.

There he caused one of the biggest riots that the Troc. has seen for a long time.

Being pulled off the stage and mobbed didn't worry Jonne at all, he said, "I thought it was great and was deliciously happy."

I asked Jonne why he thought he should have been chosen as the next Normie. In the shy manner, typical of his nature, he answered: "It's really amazing that I should be picked. I didn't think I was qualified. It's really great and I'm very lucky."

Jonne idolises Normie. "What could you say about Normie, except he's the greatest. I've seen him on stage a few times and I don't think anyone in Australia stands up to his movements and personality."

Jonne's ambition is to follow in Normie's foot steps. "I'm very happy following Normie. He's the best in Australia, and I'd be very happy if my name was next to Normie's."

If the public reaction to Jonne's first appearance is any indication, he should realise his ambition.

GENTLE ART (THE PARTY MACHINE) (COLUMBIA)

Brilliant, tastefully presented upbeat ballad, written and sung by Ross Wilson. Flip is called "You're All Gotta Go," and is something else again. At times hysterically funny with mock-serious harmony vocals, and a hundred and one things worth a sigh. Definitely a hit. Both sides should get airplay.

HALLOWEEN (LARRY'S REBELS) (COLUMBIA)

A very gimmicky record, written by Larry himself. Has lots of electronic happenings in the backing. There's a vaguely eastern guitar sound there top. Very catchy chorus, well produced. This group deserves a hit and could well get one with this disc.

ALBUMS

THE MOVE

SFL 932886

There are two things that come to mind when you think of the MOVE. One is their wild, swinging "Flowers in the Rain" and the other is the publicity they got when they were sued for publishing some rude stories about the English Prime Minister. Both things certainly over them their share of publicity.

Their first album swings. It's got plenty of punch, suitable for a party or disco. The Move have tremendous harmony, very similar to the Hollies. The man, thing wrong with their album is that it lacks originality. They've tried nothing new. However, they have a very commercial sound. It's said by many people that a lot of bands sound a lot more exciting on stage than on record. This is true with groups like Cream, Hendrix and the Hollies and many other top groups around, and I think it is probably true with the MOVE.

The tracks on this album include "Flowers in the Rain" and "Fire Brigade". The rest of the tracks except one were written by the group. The track which they didn't write is a real oddie called "Zig Zag Went the Strings of my Heart" in which they sound like the Diamonds. As I said, quite a good party or disco record, but overall not impressive.

CALENDER HIT SERIES (FESTIVAL)
Three oldies but goodies have been released by Festival.

TONY WORSLEY AND THE BLUE JAYS

This includes gas old tracks like "Just A Little Bit" and "King Bee". There are some good instrumentals all in all 16 good tracks.

HIT GROUPS AUSSIE STYLE

This features Tony Worsley, Roy Brown and The Whispers, Billy Thorpe and the Aztecs and the Playboys. Numbers include "Foolish Ivy" and "Exodus". This is a must for fans and will bring back some pleasant memories.

THE SOUND AWARD ALBUM STARRING THE PLAYBOYS

The Playboys run through some tremendous odds like "Adventures In Paradise". Theme From Dr No, and "Exodus".

All three albums should sell very well to fans who still remember their old favorites.

BOY (LULU) COLUMBIA

Another big hit for Lulu. Has the same slow vocals that made "To Sir With Love", so dreamy. On faster numbers like this one, Lulu sounds a little like a copy of Sandy Shaw. Should do quite well.

YOU'VE BEEN SO WONDERFUL TO ME (DIANA ROSS AND THE SUPREMES) TAMLA MOTOWN

Plenty of zip in the strings and brass and a sugar-coated vocal should keep them around for a while with this one. This is the style they've established as their current sound, upbeat shuffles that take them into a more commercial vein, than Tamla artists, and it should make this one a hit.

New Jazz Club

An effort is being made to form a society in England to serve as a focal point for jazz. A committee has been elected and the name chosen is 'The London Jazz Society'. The society is not yet defined but will probably be a non-profit foundation. It will have facilities to provide rehearsal, tuition, and an archive service.

Alex Welsh Band for Newport Jazz Festival

The Newport Jazz Festival (once the subject for a movie "Jazz On A Summer's Day") is now in its 10th year and is the foremost jazz festival in America. It is always considered an honour to be invited to appear and the high regard in which the Alex Welsh Band is held is shown by their booking for the Festival which will be held from July 4th to 7th.



"Woody" Herman, who with Count Basie and Duke Ellington has been responsible for keeping big band jazz alive since the 40's, will appear with them at the Newport Jazz Festival.

This is the first English band to appear at Newport and they will have a very big on the English Jazz Club scene and commands them as guests.

All these musicians have played with Alex Welsh before while touring England and have probably spread the word about the band's excellence. The Welsh band is comparatively little known in Australia.

INTIMATE WAGGA CONCERT

The number of Jazz conventions in Australia seems to be increasing each year and the one run at the organiser Many will remember him as leader of the first successful event. It was well attended by over 1000 people. The concert will be held at the Wagga Wagga Town Hall on Friday July 26th at 8.00 pm. The concert will feature the talents of the following musicians: Don Redman, Horace Silver, Dizzy Gillespie, Roland Kirk, Archie Shepp, Charlie Bennett, Ray Charles, Ramsey Lewis and Barney Kessel.

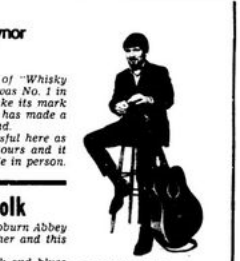
