Breaking Down The Chart, By Daypart

Ask any programmer today about dayparting, and most will tell you they don't. And, in relative terms, they don't. Compared with a decade ago, when aggressive PDs started rap at 3 p.m. while most others waited for 6 p.m. and weekends, today you can hear the biggest hip-hop records—and not just the smoothed-out ones—in every daypart.

But dayparting still exists at R&B radio. Some of our exclusive analysis of Nielsen BDS data on where songs are played is intuitive: new hip-hop and developing records overall starting at night, powers and recurrenents taking the bulk of the morning slots. But as hip-hop becomes the predominant flavor at R&B radio, you're more likely to see a ballad or slow-groove record being dayparted into middays than a rap record being dayparted out of them.

R&B Airplay Monitor looked at the top 40 R&B/hip-hop records for the week of Nov. 8, breaking them down by the percentage of airplay they received in each daypart. We also reviewed the songs in Monitor's Most Airplay Adds feature for the past six weeks, which breaks down where those songs are receiving their airplay by daypart.

MORNINGS REMAIN CONSERVATIVE

With the average morning show only having room for six to eight records, those few slots often go disproportionately to songs that used to be powers, have already peaked, and are now moving down the chart. Nelly's "Dilemma" got more than 18% of its total spins in morning drive, while Aaliyah's "I Care 4 U," Eve's "Gangsta Lovin'," and Fabolous' "Trade It All" each had 17% of their airplay in mornings.

In fact, all of the records with the highest percentage of morning airplay were former top 10 songs, earning between 13% and 18% of their airplay there. Established hits that were still moving up the charts earned 12%-16% of their airplay in mornings.

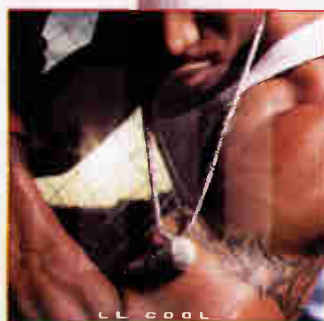

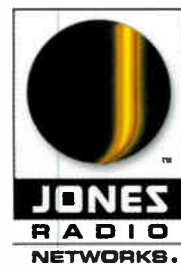

FMC Consolidation Report Angers NAB

A new report from the Future of Music Coalition (FMC) concludes that consolidation of the U.S. radio industry has led to decreased competition, less diversity of programming, and unsatisfied listeners, according to *Billboard Bulletin*. The report—which has been filed with the FCC—has riled the National Assn. of Broadcasters (NAB), which claims that the study's methodology is flawed and its assertions are "myths."

Among other findings, the report, which analyzed data compiled from *Airplay Monitor* and other publications, concludes that the U.S. radio industry is an "oligarchy," with every territory dominated by four companies with market share of 70% or more.

The report also found "considerable format homogeneity," with "playlist overlap between supposedly distinct formats" of as much as 76%. As a result of shrinking playlists, it says, record companies have limited their promotion efforts, creating a "double bottleneck" for artists.

An FMC survey of 500 radio listeners found that 80% support action to prevent further consolidation and less repetition of songs and playlists with more variety. About 68% of respondents say they support congressional involvement to curb the use of indie promoters.

The NAB says that the survey results contradict the positive responses of 3,000 listeners in a recent poll conducted by Arbitron and Edison Media Research.

CC CLEAR ACROSS THE ATLANTIC

Reports in the British press say that Clear Channel is readying a bid for several British properties, including Capital Radio. *Airplay Monitor*'s sister publication *Music & Media* reports that the British government has already loosened a pending communications bill—which will also allow greater foreign ownership—to allow only two owners in a market, rather than three.

Back at home, Clear Channel has officially named **Andrew Levin** senior VP of government relations. He will be based at the company's new Washington, D.C., office, reporting to chairman/CEO **Lowry Mays**. Levin, an attorney and CPA, was most recently minority counsel to the House Committee on Energy and Commerce.

In other legal and business news, the Senate voted Nov. 14 to approve the FCC nomination of legislative assistant **Jonathan Adelstein**, which had been held up since February. And on Nov. 15, both houses of Congress passed the Small Webcaster Settlement Act of 2002 to allow copyright

holders and Webcasters to cut their own performance royalty deals rather than adhering to the Library of Congress royalty rate that many small Webcasters found prohibitive.

BUSINESS & MANAGEMENT

The *Arkansas Democrat Gazette* reports that ABC Inc. is suing the owner of adult R&B KYFX (Foxy 99.5), claiming breach of contract to sell the station to it for \$2.6 million. Loretta Lever House is the principle of Nameloc, which owns Foxy. The complaint claims that House agreed to sell the station to ABC in March and had until April 15 to file an application with the FCC requesting approval of the sale. An attorney for Nameloc told the paper, "We don't believe there is any merit to the case." KYFX runs ABC's **Tom Joyner** morning show and the **Touch**.

Ronita Hawes-Saunders, owner of WROU (U92) and adult R&B WRNB Dayton, Ohio, filed for Chapter 11 bankruptcy protection Nov. 4, in the wake of a court ruling ordering her to sell off the company's stock. Court papers say the company was sued by four venture capital firms in March 2001 after Hawes-Saunders and **Donnie Saunders** defaulted on several loans, with a combined debt of \$6.2 million. On Sept. 16, a county judge ordered Hawes-Saunders to sell the company to Radio One for \$8.5 million. The sale did not go through, and the judge appointed a receiver Nov. 4. Hawes-Saunders told the *Dayton Daily News*, "This is a necessary strategic move suggested by my attorneys . . . The stations will remain on the air."

Milwaukee Radio Alliance GM **Dan Manella** exits. He oversaw adult R&B WMCS, jazz WJZI, and rock WLUM.

United Stations Radio Networks has bought Launch Radio Networks, the syndicated music and entertainment news arm of Yahoo. The Launch networks will continue to operate under that name and are expected to maintain their editorial, affiliate relations, and advertising staffs in New York, Los Angeles, and Nashville. The syndication operation is separate from Launch's online music portal, which continues to be part of Yahoo.

BMG Buys Out Davis, Folds J In With RCA

As *Airplay Monitor* went to press, BMG announced it was buying out **Clive Davis'** 50% stake in J Records and combining it in a new division with RCA. Davis will serve as chairman of the two labels, known as the RCA Music Group. Current chairman/CEO **Bob Jamieson** exits the former RCA Music Group, which comprised RCA, BMG Canada, RCA Label Group Nashville, RCA Victor Group, strategic marketing BMG Special Products, and BMG Heritage.

RECORD-BREAKING SPINS: The bars are raised for a second consecutive week on all three airplay charts for highest number of spins over a seven-day period. **Musiq** beats the record he set last week with "dontchange" (Def Soul/IDJMG), with 1,041 detections on this week's adult R&B chart. It is the first time a record has broken the 1,000-spin mark at that format. Prior to Musiq's record-setting two weeks, **Maxwell's** "Lifetime" (Columbia) held the record with its 965 spins in the Dec. 8, 2001, issue. **Missy "Misdemeanor" Elliott** also bests her record-setting week in the previous issue, raising her spins and the bar for R&B/hip-hop and rap with "Work It" (the Gold Mind/Elektra/EEG), hitting 5,485 and 8,516 spins, respectively.

Bowing at No. 36 on the adult R&B chart this issue, **Next's** "Imagine That" is the first entry for the trio as a J Records act. Although they were featured and spent three weeks at No. 1 on **Jaheim's** "Anything" (Divine Mill/Warner Bros.), "Imagine That" is their first appearance on the chart with their own record since "Wifey" in July 2000. That track peaked at No. 14, the group's personal best.

With the bow of "Thugz Mansion" (Amaru/Death Row/Interscope) at No. 32 on the R&B/hip-hop chart, **2Pac** makes his eighth posthumous debut. Gaining 670 spins, it earns the Greatest Gainer nod for that format. On the rap chart, it enters at No. 20, tying with **Nelly's** "Hot in Herre" (Fo' Reel/Universal) for the highest debut position this year. It is the 15th time 2Pac has appeared on that chart since his 1996 death.

Also returning to the charts, **Toni Braxton** follows her last No. 1 single, "Just Be a Man About It" (LaFace/Arista), two years later with "Hit the Freeway" featuring **Loon**. It bows at No. 36 on the R&B/hip-hop chart. It's the first single from Braxton's new set, *More Than a Woman*, which hits stores this week.

Coming off the adult R&B chart is **Luther Vandross'** "Take You Out," the longest-running single in that chart's history. The track spent 81 weeks on the chart, seven of those at No. 1.

AC sister WSNI, who had been OM for both WSNI and Q102, is now CC's latest regional VP of programming.

XHTZ (Jammin Z90) and adult R&B **XHRM** (Magic 92.5) San Diego PD **Rick Thomas** resigns. Replacing him is top 40 sister **KHTS** PD **Diana Laird** at Z90 and adult top 40 sister **KMYI** PD **Duncan Payton** at Magic.

Cumulus' **KMJJ** Shreveport, La., PD **Hozie Mack** and sister **WZBN** Albany, Ga., PD **Long John** switch stations.

Rhythmic top 40s **KXME** Honolulu and **KQCH** (Channel 97.7) Omaha, Neb., are both starting to filter in more non-R&B titles, including **Avril Lavigne** in the case of the latter.

PEOPLE: WHISPERING FOXX

WGCI-FM Chicago continues to make staff adjustments, with **Bionce Foxx** returning to

host its late-night slow-jams show, *Whispers in the Dark*. Foxx was a part-timer at WGCI before heading to **KVGS** Las Vegas earlier this year for middays. She replaces **Al Greer**, who moves over to adult R&B sister **WVAZ** (V103) for P/T. Also at V103, longtime Quiet Storm host **Mel Devonne** shifts to assistant production director, while **Myke Julius** slides into the Storm's host duties. Julius was last doing nights at adult R&B **WALR** Atlanta.

XM Satellite Radio's uncut hip-hop channel, Raw, hires three legends of hip-hop as air talent: **DJ Marley Marl**, **DJ Pete Rock**, and **DJ Premier**.

WFXE (Foxy 105) Columbus, Ga., production director/p.m. driver **Ed the World Famous** heads back to **WHBX** Tallahassee, Fla., as music coordinator/afternoon host. He started his radio career there under then-PD **Hurricane Dave Smith**.

Not surprisingly, new records were lagging far behind in morning play. On average, new records had only 4%-8% of their play in mornings, although PDs made exceptions for their biggest acts. During its first few weeks in our Most Airplay Adds column, Missy "Misdemeanor" Elliott's "Work It" consistently had 9%-10% of its airplay in the morning, while Jennifer Lopez's "Jenny From the Block" and Eminem's "Lose Yourself" each had 12% of airplay in mornings in comparable weeks.

ARE MIDDAYS STILL MELLOW?

As programmers will tell you, dayparting rap out of middays is rare today. But most brand-new rap, regardless of an artist's name, will initially get less airplay here than in other dayparts. Snoop Dogg's "From Tha Chuuch to Da Palace" got only 11% of his play in middays, Baby's "Do That" had 13%, Benzino's "Rock the Party" received 16%, and Fat Joe's "Crush Tonight" was at 17%.

But a proven rap hit can get as much of its airplay in middays as any other hit record. "Dilemma" was the record with the highest percentage of midday airplay, with 27%, and the top two records on the chart that week—"Work It" at No. 1 and LL Cool J's "Luv U Better" at No. 2—each had 23% of their overall airplay in middays. That's comparable to Musiq's "donichange" with 24%, Erykah Badu's "Love of My Life (An Ode to Hip Hop)" (25%), and "I Care 4 U" (23%).

That said, more traditional R&B and slower records almost always received anywhere from 21% to 25% of their airplay during middays, whereas rap tracks racked up as low as 11% to a high of 27% of their airplay in middays.

Some R&B records, within their first few weeks out, often found more of their play in middays. For example, Kelly Rowland's "Stole" had 25% of her airplay in middays when she picked up the Most Airplay Adds honor for the week ending Sept. 22. A week later, TLC's "Girl Talk" had 26% of its play in middays, more than any other daypart.

AFTERNOON RUSH

With afternoon drive, like mornings, having more spots and traffic reports or even a mix, the amount of music being played in an hour will be less. Most stations play between eight and 10 records in an hour. During that time, you're more likely to hear the most diverse sample of music on the radio.

With individual songs' percentages of airplay in afternoons being the most consistent across the board (between 15% and 21%), it's likely you will hear the greatest balance among rap and R&B, fast and slow, new and hit alike. For example, looking at the top five records on the chart that week, the average afternoon spins comprised 17.6% of their airplay. The average percentage of p.m. drive play for the bottom five records was 18%.

PARTY ALL NIGHT

Nights are still the No.1 daypart for hip-hop

airplay, especially new rap. For the past six weeks, the Most Airplay Adds titles that were rap records broke out of nights, according to the percentage of their airplay—from 24% to 32% of their overall play was in nights.

While more proven hit rap records like "Luv U Better," "Dilemma," and Jay-Z Featuring Beyoncé Knowles' "'03 Bonnie & Clyde" received on average only 19% of their spins at night, most other charted rap records—such as "Crush Tonight," "Do That," "Rock the Party," "From Tha Chuuch to Da Palace," and "Tell Me (What's Goin' On)" by Smilez & Southstar—on average earned 28% of their spins there.

What you do see a great deal less of at night are ballads and slow jams. Of all the charted ballads the week of Nov. 8, the average percentage of night spins for a record was 17%.

Only one current chart ballad, Dru Hill's "I Should Be . . ." sported a higher percentage of night play, at 23%. It is also the sole ballad to earn Most Airplay Adds in the past six weeks. The only daypart where it got more spins was in overnights.

OVERNIGHT SENSATIONS

Percentage-wise, it's not hard for overnights to give songs their greatest percentage of spins, since there are six hours vs. four to five hours in other dayparts. And with a lower spotload, stations can play as many as 12 songs per hour. So it's not unusual for a record to get as much as 25%-30% of its play in overnights. But go significantly beyond that, and you are likely to see a record that's being banished to "lunar rotation" or likely to midchart.

Looking at two records that have already peaked, "Stole" had 34% of its airplay in overnights for Sept. 22 and still had 36% of its play in overnights. "Crush Tonight" had 31% of its airplay in overnights. By comparison, "'03 Bonnie & Clyde," a top 10 hit within four weeks, had 24% of its play in overnights.

If a record makes it to the top 20, it usually has less than 30% of its play in overnights. Top 20 songs on the cusp of that were the No. 18 "Girl Talk," with 31%, and Erick Sermon's No. 19 "React" (30%).

That said, R&B/hip-hop radio has a better record of rotating its music across all dayparts than other formats. During the past six weeks, the only Most Airplay Adds title that had more than 40% of its airplay in overnights was Blackstreet's "Wizy Wow," with 41% for the week ending Sept. 22. That title never charted.

By comparison, three mainstream top 40 songs in the Most Airplay Adds box had more than 40% of their airplay in overnights: Sean Paul's "Gimme the Light" (40%), Good Charlotte's "Lifestyle of the Rich and Famous" (42%), and Kylie Minogue's "Come Into My World" (51%). At modern rock, two songs were over the 40% mark. And in the traditionally conservative heritage rock format, all five of the songs in the Most Airplay Adds box were receiving more than 45% of their airplay in overnights.

MONITOR PROFILE

For XM VP Steve Harris, The Sky's The Limit For Radio's Future

With his recent appointment to VP of music programming at XM Satellite Radio, R&B radio veteran Steve Harris will be overseeing 70-plus channels, in all music formats. He'll also continue to work closely with such external programming providers as Radio One, Salem, MTV, and VH1, among others, a job he has held for the past two years.

XM launched nationally earlier this year and currently has slightly more than 200,000 subscribers. The pay service has been facing financial concerns in recent months, as is its main competitor Sirius Satellite Radio. Concurrent with Harris' promotion was the departure of XM VP of programming and operations Dave Logan, as well as 80 layoffs in all XM departments. Both companies contend they are still in the building process and will take several years to become profitable.

'We don't have the same challenges as terrestrial radio'

Despite the speed bumps, Harris believes the future of broadcasting is in satellite radio. "It's about cutting-edge programming," Harris says. "I don't want to do the same things over and over again, and with XM, we're allowed to take chances to be innovative and creative. I tell people all the time that what we do at XM are all the things that I got into radio for in the first place—the passion for the music, being able to push the envelope on-air, and trying new ideas. If they don't work, well, then we try something else. We have something here called a competitive batting average. If we come up with 100 ideas and 30 turn out to work, then that's a pretty good average."

Harris continues, "The key is we don't have to worry about Arbitron. We don't program for the quarter-hour. In radio, your main goal is to make people think they listen to your station, so that they will write it down if they get a diary. Here, we want them to actually listen, so we program to their particular—sometimes very particular—likes. We don't have the same challenges as terrestrial radio, because we don't have to play the Arbitron game."

He should know about that game, since Harris spent nearly 20 years programming in such cities as Detroit, Cleveland, Cincinnati, Houston, and Chicago, where he was PD of WVAZ (V103). He then went on to be VP of urban programming for ABC Radio Networks.

"I'm always looking for what is the future," Harris says. "I'm not satisfied with the status quo. I got a feeling while I was still programming V103 that syndication was going to grow and be a force, especially in R&B radio. Just seeing Tom [Joyner] and Doug [Banks] and talking to them about their vision, I felt I needed to move on and be a part of syndication. I believe in compelling radio, and that's what ABC was creating. I also felt that in the world of radio consolidation, syndication allowed many small owners to compete on a level field with some of the bigger companies and ultimately have a more profitable business."

"It was the same feeling when I learned about XM," he continues. "I had worked with [XM chief programming officer] Lee Abrams before at ABC, and I called and asked him, 'What is the next big thing in radio?' He said, 'XM' and asked me to be a part of it."

That was two years ago. Now that XM has launched, Harris feels more than ever that it can be the alternative to terrestrial radio. "It's like what HBO and MTV did for television. I look at the original programming that HBO has created, how unique shows like *The Sopranos* and *Sex and the City* are, and how great an impact they've had with viewers. And more so how they've changed network television—it's pushing more buttons and has become more creative than ever before. We have that same opportunity. Our goal is to be the water-cooler talk, just as those shows have become."

"You have a much greater variety of choice with XM," he adds. "The biggest complaint you hear about radio is that it's all the same. XM has over 70 different music formats to choose from. My dad loves traditional jazz, which you can't get on terrestrial radio. But he can hear it 24 hours a day on XM. Same goes for neo-soul, uncut rap, blues, gospel, Broadway show tunes—you name it."

And the difference doesn't end with the music, Harris notes. "For Black History Month, we had programming that ran on almost every channel, not just the R&B-flavored ones. It was amazing. You would never hear that on terrestrial radio formats outside of R&B."

"The sameness at radio is due to consolidation," Harris continues. "The biggest problem is the cookie-cutter effect. It's ironic that even though we are a national service, in which you can hear the same programming from New York to Denver, it's still more creative and choice-filled than what you hear on regular radio. They are supposed to be local, and they've lost that."

With XM, the reach is also expanding beyond the automobile, with the recent launch of the company's Plug and Play device, which allows users to hear the service through a home stereo system. Harris says, "People in radio used to think, 'Oh, this only effects TSL in the car' . . . but that's going to change as well."

That said, Harris doesn't think radio programmers or owners should look at satellite radio as a threat. "I'll use the same comparison I made earlier with cable: Cable only increased the choices you had to watch. Same thing will happen with satellite. They will complement each other. You still watch NBC, ABC, and CBS, as well as HBO, the Discovery Channel, or MTV."

Harris adds, "Radio is the only thing I've ever wanted to do"—only now, he says, "I can do it better." And not only can he have an impact on channels serving African-American listeners, but he also oversees all formats. "It wasn't a goal of mine, but it happened. At ABC, my main concern was to create the best programming for the [R&B] format by working closely with all the affiliates. When I came here, my job was to deal with the third-party content providers, similar to affiliates in a way. I was working with CNN, the Weather Channel, MTV, Salem—which does our Christian programming, HBC—which does our Latin programming, and Radio One—which does R&B, among others. I dealt with all formats. So the people at XM didn't say, 'Here's an African-American programmer, let's have him do the [R&B] channels.' Instead, they looked at my experience in all the areas I've worked and said I'd be the best person for the job." **DANA HALL**

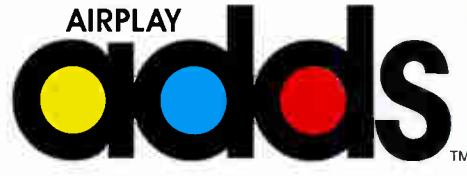
