Modern-Leaning Top 40 Grapples With Boundaries, New Rivals

As modern rock alters the landscape of top 40/mainstream radio, many of the programmers that use it most heavily are looking for their boundaries. Some still see modern rock as a condiment to flavor their mass-appeal sound and continue to play rhythmic product. Others, after experimenting with a mix of modern rock and nonmodern rock artists, have decided that the two do not belong on the same frequency.

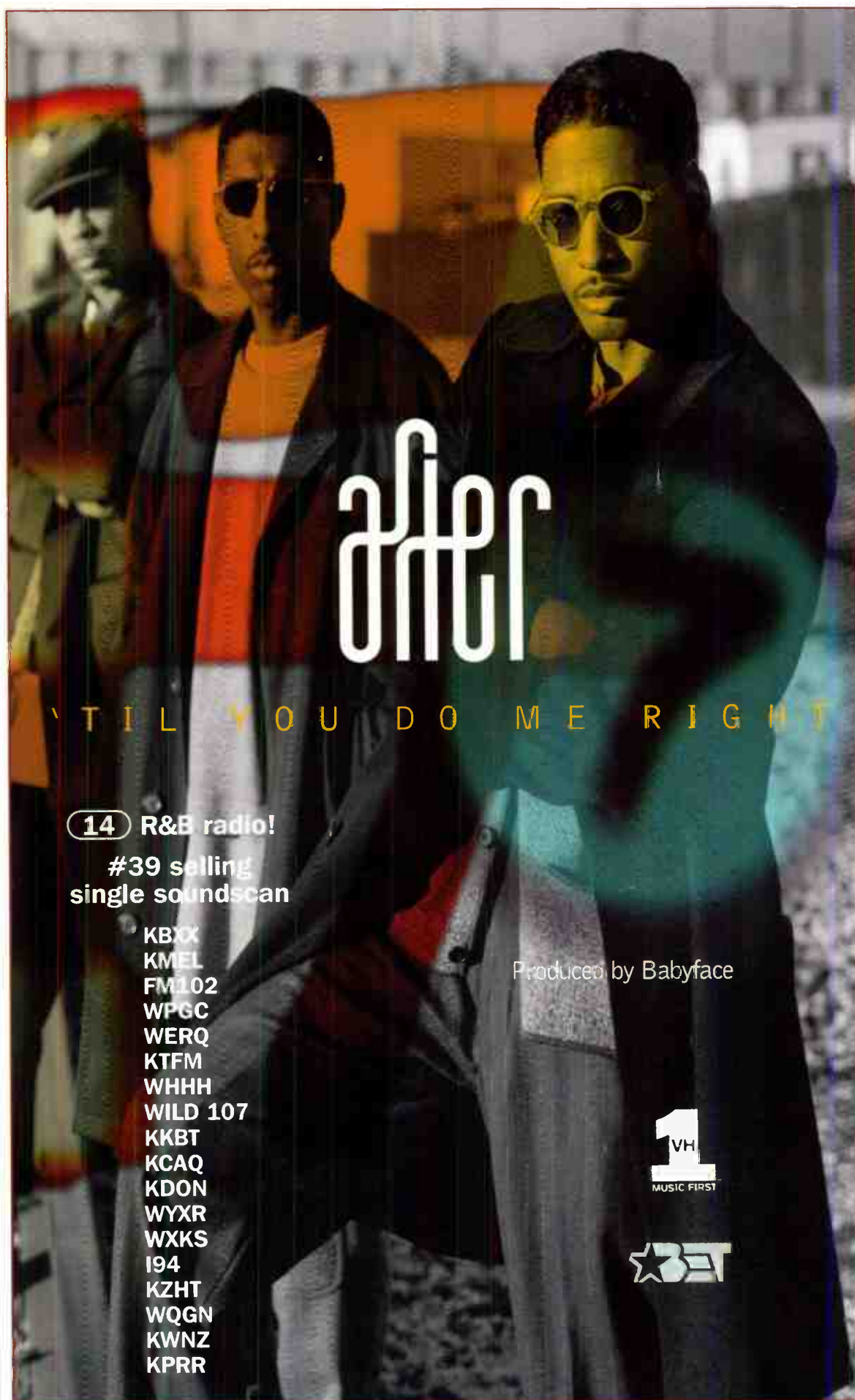
Most modern rock-based top 40s continue to evolve, especially with pure modern rock outlets coming into most major and medium markets. WHTZ (Z100) New York, one of the key stations in the modern rock boom, had toned down most of its nonmodern rock titles in recent weeks even before the debut of crosstown WNEW-FM's adult-leaning modern rock format.

Titles by Corona and Real McCoy re-

main on Z100 but in considerably lower rotation. The highest-ranked non-modern rock title on WHTZ last week was Bon Jovi's "This Ain't A Love Song," with 34 plays. Z100 MD Andy Shane says, "It seems that in smaller markets you can [play] both, but in a major market we find we have to appease one group or the other... As you know, this is a market in constant flux. We keep a close eye on what's happening, and we try to stay on top of what our listeners expect from Z100."

Other stations that now play only a handful of titles that would be considered out of place on a modern rock station include WEZB (B97) New Orleans, WEDJ (the Edge) Charlotte, N.C., and KHTY (Y97) Santa Barbara, Calif., all of which seem to be leaning further in the modern rock direction than they were three months ago. WPLY (Y100) Philadelphia has

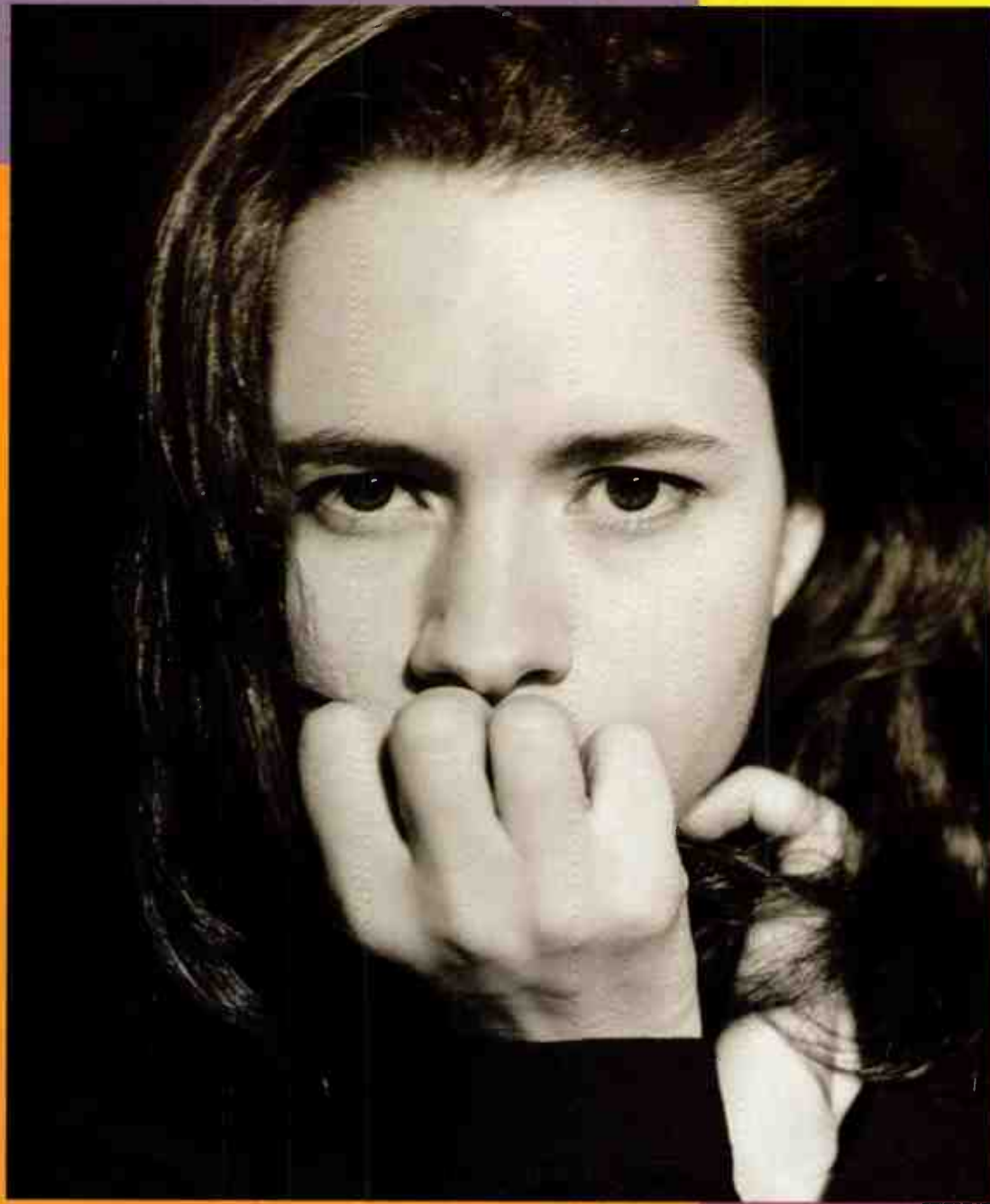

World Radio History

Conclave '95 Highlights Unusual Hires

The Emmis Broadcasting stations aren't the only ones trying to find air staff in unusual places these days, judging from the attendees at the Conclave '95 seminar, held July 13-16 in Minneapolis.

While WQHT (Hot 97) New York's Dr. Dre & Ed Lover, KPWR (Power 106) Los Angeles' Baka Boyz, and WKQX (Q101) Chicago's Lupins—all nontraditional hires at Emmis outlets—have gotten the attention, a discussion of nontraditional hires at the top 40 panel brought forth several other broadcasters who'd made similar moves, among them:

- WNDU-FM (U93) South Bend, Ind., PD Bill Mitchell, who put Notre Dame University's 20-year-old Leprechaun mascot on the air, because he had the "work ethic and drive" missing in other aspiring broadcasters.

- WZOK Rockford, Ill.'s Tom Garrett, who put a local theater major—who had worked at one other radio station—on the air, because top 40 is "all about performing."

- Independent promoter Tom Evans, who, as PD of KIYS Boise, Idaho, hired a student on a Boise State University track scholarship who visited the station. "I don't know what possessed me, but I hired the guy on the spot." That DJ, whom Evans re-

named "Wombat," is now the host of a dance-party show in Australia.

- KQCR Cedar Rapids, Iowa, morning man Scott Schulte, who ended up doing mornings at the station after having taught language arts at an alternative high school.

Even Atlantic's Danny Buch pointed out that he had hired a former EMS worker to oversee the label's low-powered radio program, "because I knew he could handle stress."

The glut of stories about nonradio radio people prompted WKBQ (Q104) St. Louis PD Michael St. John to warn PDs not to assume that listeners don't care about traditional DJs. With the format still at a crossroads, St. John said, "listeners don't know what they want."

This year's Conclave—the 20th such meeting—drew a little more than the 700 people who attended last year. Its best-attended sessions included keynoters Stan Freberg and Minnesota Vikings coach Dennis Green, as well as a modern rock panel that drew an overflow crowd and where KDFW Dallas PD Joel Folger predicted that "mornings [are] the next place the format is going to [expand]. Once someone figures that out, we're going to really see this format grow."

Evergreen Inks 12-Station Pyramid Deal

Guess where I was this weekend? Some leading questions: 1. When did you get in? 2. Where are you staying? 3. Did you go to any panels? 4. Where's the bar? 5. I'm sorry, was that your head I stepped on? 6. May we have another bucket of Lowenbrau and a wheel of cheddar, please?

Answer: the 20th annual Midwest Conclave in beautiful, hot, humid, sweaty, rainy Minneapolis, where Tom Kay and company pulled off another successful soiree.

Who's the lucky winner in the bid for Pyramid Communications? Evergreen Media, which this week inks a \$306.5 million deal for Pyramid's 12 stations, including top 40s WXKS/WJMN Boston, WEDJ Charlotte, N.C., and WYXR (Star 104.5) Philadelphia. The deal turns Evergreen into radio's second-largest group, following Infinity. The Pyramid deal also means that Evergreen will either have to sell or get waivers to own excess FMs in Chicago (where it will have five) and Charlotte, N.C. (will have four). It will also have to either sell or get waivers for owning 23 FMs, three above the FCC limit.

Tom Gjerdrum has been named PD at WZPL Indianapolis, as Jim Cerone exits. Middayer Mark van Ness moves to Cerone's morning slot, teaming with Julie Patterson, Carlos Diaz, and Stuntboy, as weekender/promo voice Kramer fills middays for now. Gjerdrum was most recently PD of KFMB-FM San Diego. He officially starts Aug. 1.

Another top 40 heads for extinction with the word that KHQT (Hot 97.7) San Jose, Calif., has been purchased by Susquehanna for \$8.2 million. Look for the format as well as PD Bob Perry and staff to vacate around Aug. 7, when an LMA with Susquehanna begins. Expect sister triple-A outlet KFOG San Francisco to simulcast on the frequency.

Lots of strange goings-on this week at R&B KDLE Wichita, Kan., the station programmed by former KKRK Wichita PD Greg Williams. Seems that local pastor David Brace, who has been LMA'ing the station from owners Gary and Viola Violet was arrested on federal money-laundering charges. Since then, the Violets have been trying to take the station back, according to local press reports, claiming that Brace has missed payments and that they object to "sexually explicit rap" on the station. (The "objectionable" record cited in the local paper is the nonrap "Froggy Style" by Nuttin' Nyce.) At press time Williams was still at the station, despite an attempted takeover by the Violets, but eight part-time employees had walked out on the air and have since been replaced.

WNVZ Norfolk, Va., inks the services of "Wild" Jay West (WIOQ Philadelphia,

KNRJ Houston) for p.m. drive. West most recently worked at AC WBEB (B101) Philadelphia as Eric West. . . . Look for KEGE Minneapolis night guy Cane to be heading for WHTZ (Z100) New York by the time you read this.

After 3 1/2 years out of radio, Scott Davidson is the new MD/night jock at top 40/rhythm NOVW (Star 95.5) West Palm Beach, Fla. He replaces Scott Chase, now PD of WAOA Melbourne, Fla.

KFRX Lincoln, Neb., PD Sonny Valentine was still trying to come up with a team name for her new morning show at press time, but individually, they're Andy Vaughn and Kristi London, from AM sister station KFOR. The new team, whatever they end up being called, will replace Derek Parker and Patti Reed; the latter heads for KXLK Wichita, Kan.

Will Bradley from WDJB Fort Wayne, Ind., migrates one state south for P/T at WDJX Louisville, Ky. . . . Greg Fry moves from nights to afternoons at WTCF Saginaw, Mich. . . . KFFM Yakima, Wash., assistant PD Lisa Adams goes to middays at KDON Monterey, Calif. . . . WRVQ (Q94) Richmond, Va., morning hosts Corey Dietz and Jay Hamilton exit.

WKFR Kalamazoo, Mich., MD Glenn Dillon has left the building. Night guy Kidd O'Shea moves to mornings. PD Dave Michaels is looking for a new night jock. T&Rs to 4154 Jennings Drive, Kalamazoo, Mich. 49001. Also, WEDJ Charlotte, which had been running the syndicated Matt Siegel show, is looking for a new morning show. Package to Brian Bridgman, 137 S. Why You Secretly Work For A Soft AC

G OING SOFT: Summer vacation is here. And with it, two exciting new games to play as the family heads off in the station van:

Game 1: When Did *That* Become An AC Record? Make the kids listen to AC stations all the way to the beach, the campground, or the militia meeting. (Chances are you'll have to, because the only music choices on the drive will be satellite AC or country, and you're still worried about the kids discovering country.) If they complain, point out how much of today's AC music is stuff your own parents hated, since at least half the music on AC would never have been played by that format as a current.

Think back to a time when "Keep On Loving You" or "I Can't Go For That" would have sounded funny on a soft AC. (They seem to be format mainstays now.) Hear again those industrial feedback noises at the beginning of "In The Air Tonight," which kept a lot of top 40s from playing it as a current, much less AC stations. Dwell on the fact that soft AC core artist **Elton John** once had songs called "The Bitch Is Back" and "Jamaica Jerk-Off." (Or that fellow soft AC core artist **Billy Joel** once alluded to the latter activity on "Captain Jack.") Remember when "Caribbean Queen" was actually a street R&B record. Try to imagine hearing "Hit Me With Your Best Shot," "I Will Survive," or "Y.M.C.A." on an AC station before WPLJ New York came along.

Chances are that if you worked in top 40 radio in the '70s or '80s, your efforts helped make the world safe for safe radio—breaking songs that may have been of short-term value to top 40, but which will live forever as continuous lite soft rock favorites. Such songs as "Glory Of Love" by **Peter Cetera** or "Cherish" by **Kool & the Gang** or "Back In The High Life Again" by **Steve Winwood** not only helped mark the end of the top 40 revival in the mid-'80s, but also ensured that former top 40 stations would have a body of familiar music to rely on after they switched formats.

Game 2: When Will This Become An AC Record? As you'll have established from listening to AC for awhile, most major top 40 hits eventually become so familiar that they don't sound nearly as edgy. So imagine how long it will take for most of today's hit music to become usable for AC. For instance:

- **Adina Howard's** "Freak Like Me." It's no edgier than **Jody Watley's** "Looking For A New Love" or **Janet Jackson's** "What Have You Done For Me Lately" when they were hits. Those particular records are already part of the new "rhythmic" adult top 40s that have popped up in Philadelphia and Orlando, Fla.; they appear on top 40 and hot AC's "Retro Flashback Weekends"; and they'll probably comprise a significant part of the all-'80s format that seems imminent. So, if it's taken eight years for Jackson and Watley to border on AC usability, count on today's uptempo R&B to show up on AC by 2005.

- **Montell Jordan's** "This Is How We Do It": I know one PD of a top 40/adult station who, anxious for some tempo, brought this into his music meeting. (He hasn't succumbed yet.) Count on this being on AC in 2007 and hope that you'll have to explain to your kids what the line "all the gang-bangers forgot about the drive-by" meant.

- **Green Day's** "When I Come Around":

I thought this would become "Two Princes" eventually. So far, it hasn't, probably to the immense relief of the band's label and management. As long as **Billie Joe** remains the poster child for modern rock, Green Day could represent a line in the sand that some stations won't cross. (Even New York's new adult modern **WNEW-FM** used Green Day as the initial example of something it wouldn't play.) Once grunge is eclipsed by some yet-louder subgenre of alternative, this might again be up for discussion.

- **Live's** "Lightning Crashes": Probably no harder in 1995 than "Keep On Lovin' You" was in 1980, the only difference being that the latter was a love song. Count on this one to pick up steam at top 40/adult this fall, when everybody who didn't play it puts it in their auditorium tests (the same way they did with "Little Miss Can't Be Wrong"). Then expect it to trickle down to mainstream AC stations about 1997 and soft AC about 1999.

By now, your kids will have pointed out that I'm cheating here, since "Lightning Crashes" and even "When I Come Around" already have some top 40/adult airplay. So does **2 Unlimited's** "Get Ready For This," which managed to break the airplay barrier for techno at top 40 and a few hot ACs. In fact, it's hard to find many top 40 mainstream chart records that haven't crossed at least to hot AC. **The Rembrandts? Nicki French? Hootie & the Blowfish? TLC? Blues Traveler? Seal? All-4-One? The Dave Matthews Band? Real McCoy?** All accepted by at least a few ACs of some stripe. Even **Better Than Ezra** gets some top 40/adult airplay, your kids will note.

(All of this proves, by the way, that today's teens really are brighter and more cynical. When you play your own station in the car, they always say things like, "Daddy, that DJ just swallowed the calls. Why don't you hotline him? You always hotline us when we swallow the call letters.")

That top 40 and AC could share so much music in an era of alleged modern rock dominance indicates both that AC is confused and that top 40 hasn't quite shaken off its "25-plus disease." It also means that a lot of the alleged modern rock crossovers are actually triple-A crossovers—Dave Matthews Band, Blues Traveler, etc.—that are considered alternative more because of where they broke than what they are.

AC PDs expect top 40 radio to warm up songs for them—something that is the bane of any AC rep's existence. And, save for the occasional "House Of Stone And Light," they rarely return the favor. If top 40 PDs want to stop building everybody's gold library but theirs, it means finding records that can't cross to AC quite as quickly. And if this sounds like yet another pitch for mainstream top 40s to loosen up on R&B and hip-hop, remember, those won't be AC records until the next century.

CHANGE MACHINE: **KWMX** (Mix 107.5) Denver and **WBEB** (B101) Philadelphia become top 40/adult reporters, bringing the total stations to 59. In addition, **KKFR** (Power 92) Phoenix moves from the top 40/mainstream to the top 40/rhythm panel, making the number of stations on the rhythmic panel 33 and the number on the mainstream panel 78.

SERVING THE MUSK

Modern-Leaning Top 40 Grapples With Boundaries

phased out artists like Bon Jovi and Aerosmith that it would have once played and now positions itself on-air as "new rock." Here's a sampling of how programmers in diverse markets are handling the modern rock issue.

GEIGER: WALK TO THE LIGHT

KISF Kansas City PD Chuck Geiger recently completed a transition from top 40 to modern rock. "We used to be described as a top 40 that leaned alternative . . . now we're an alternative that leans top 40," says Geiger, who observes that his station is no longer that different from KROQ Los Angeles, WNNX (99X) Atlanta, or WKQX (Q101) Chicago. "We saw the light, walked down the long tunnel, and came over." The change means that where Geiger had waited for songs to cross to top 40, "stuff like Natalie Merchant and the Foo Fighters are now getting into our system a little faster."

"We flipped this thing on Jan. 9 from a rhythmic top 40 to an alternative top 40, and it seemed that right from the start, the sales staff, the clients, the listeners, and the industry all called us alternative, so why fight it?" says Geiger. Initially, KISF kept oldies by Tom Cochrane, Bryan Adams, and Robert Palmer. After about 90 days, "It got to the point where if we tried to play anything in a pop or rock vein like Van Halen, Aerosmith, or Bon Jovi, we would get complaint calls from our active core listeners," says Geiger. "We were already 90% there when we first flipped the station and dropped all the dance product. We found out pretty quickly we can't play Crystal Waters and Pearl Jam on the same radio station."

Geiger also notes that Kansas City's only modern rocker before KISF's switch was suburban KLZR Lawrence, Kan., which, he says, covers about 40% of the market, predominantly on the city's west side. With the owners of KTOZ Springfield, Mo., having announced their plans to close on a 100,000-watt signal in nearby Ottawa, Kan., Geiger wanted to make a preemptive strike. "We want to be able to own Smashing Pumpkins, Pearl Jam, Gin Blossoms, Red Hot Chili Peppers, Nirvana, STP, etc."

BRIDGMAN: COMPETITION SUCKS

By contrast, WEDJ didn't move its transition along until after the debut of modern rock rival WEND. Brian Bridgman, who has programmed the station for about six months, was a strong proponent of modern rock. "Unfortunately, by the time we figured out this was the way to go, a modern rock station signed on, which sucked," he says. "They're still the new guys, and people are still checking them out," adds Bridgman.

As for why WEDJ didn't go full-tilt modern itself, Bridgman says he wants to keep his options open. "You have to make a decision. If you want to lean female, you still have to play Bryan Adams, which is the No. 3-selling record in the market. Songs like that, dayparted carefully, make your station more mass appeal rather than being typecast as an alternative station. We have to walk that fine line every day between what's consid-

ered modern rock and mainstream . . . Pearl Jam are like gods here, but we can't overlook something like a Seal record."

At the other end of the spectrum is Neal Sharpe, OM/PD of WJET (Jet 102) Erie, Pa., which leans modern rock but continues to play the biggest R&B crossovers from Boyz II Men, TLC, etc. Jet 102's top 10 requests contain those songs along with modern rock crossovers from Nine Inch Nails, Alanis Morissette, Barenaked Ladies, Deep Blue Something, Jill Sobule, and Sponge.

"Erie has always been known as a rock market," says Sharpe. "In 1995, alternative is where we find most of today's best new music." Erie also has no other alternative music outlet, which gives Jet more freedom to play more of the modern rock product that sells, gets requests, and sells out shows.

"We've managed to keep most of our regular listeners through the musical shift," says Sharpe, allowing that the station lost some upper demos but gained new listeners. A recent in-house perceptual has shown growth among males in the 18-24 demo. The current audience composition is 55% female and 45% male. "We're not programming to the hardcore alternative listener," says Sharpe. "We're getting them by default, especially from the local college stations. Jet-FM is more highly produced, has a better music mix, and has more high-octane promotions [than most modern rock stations]."

KELLY: THE BEST OF THE BEST

Likewise, Kid Kelly, PD of WBHT (Hot 97) Wilkes-Barre, Pa., still feels that some R&B product fits, even though modern crossovers are now his station's trademark. "We play about 60% modern rock product, maybe as high as 70%, depending on the daypart. Our audience doesn't seem to label the music as modern rock or alternative . . . it's just today's top 40 for our 12-24s and 18-34s. We've taken a lot of the disposable dance music off the air. We still play some dance music, but it has to be the best of the best."

"Our female audience has no problem hearing 'Buddy Holly' by Weezer into Boyz II Men's 'I'll Make Love To You' into 2 Unlimited's 'Get Ready For This' into 'More Human Than Human' by White Zombie. For this market, this is their interpretation of top 40." There is no other modern rock outlet in the market, but Kelly feels that hardcore alternative listeners probably aren't sampling WBHT.

Other stations, like WEZB (B97) New Orleans and KUTQ (Q99) Salt Lake City remain on the format's cusp. Says B97 assistant PD/MD Joey Giovingo, "We will play modern rock stuff, but only the cream of the crop. We've also backed off on many dance records and now wait until they're established. We don't have much direct competition, so we don't feel the need to jump out early on stuff." Q99 PD Brian deGeus does play current tracks by Van Halen, but won't play them as recurrent. Says deGeus, "Once we're done with them, they're gone."

vate new music. Surely, new music has its place in the format, but only to the extent that it complements the proven concept, not subverts it.

Top 40, in its purest form, is a reflection of the attitudes and tastes of the masses. Gordon McLendon never intended it to be a testing ground for music industry research and development. When top 40 programmers are manipulated by a different agenda, the format will fail to live up to its potential. Programmers must recognize and resist being exploited into believing they are modern-day cultural clairvoyants, exercising their divine right each Tuesday to set the tastes for the masses.

Before you sit down in this week's music meeting, remember that the success of top 40 has been and will continue to [stem from] playing the most popular songs. If you're not programming the most popular songs, you're undermining the format, your station, and ultimately your own personal success.

PROGRAMMER PROFILE

How Don London Helped Norfolk's Z104 Find Its Rhythm

Researcher Jon Coleman asserted recently that top 40 stations that rely heavily on modern rock product and shy away from dance and R&B product were off-base—more concerned with their PDs' own sense of hipness than the audience's needs. When he first made that statement earlier this year, Coleman could cite the success of KUBE Seattle, which had segued back to rhythmic top 40 after a disastrous dance/rock experiment. Now he can point to the success of another client, WNVZ (Z104) Norfolk, Va.

Like many other top 40s, Z104 has been through several variants of top 40 in recent years. It all but went urban in 1991, followed by a 180-degree turn toward rock with few R&B crossovers by 1993. Over the last year, Z104 has returned to rhythmic top 40 under PD Don London, who joined the station

nearly two years ago when it was duopolized by crosstown AC WWDE (2WD). In the second spring Arbitrend, Z104—which spent most of last year in the 4-5 share range—was up 6.2-6.9 12-plus, making it fourth in the market with a weekly cume that's grown from 156,000 to 234,000 in two years.

London's initial plan for Z104 was just to play a variety of "active" top 40 records, ranging from Aerosmith to Pearl Jam to TLC, without the AC image artists that were WWDE's turf—Amy Grant, Elton John, Richard Marx, etc. "But all along," London says, "our listeners expected us to be a dance/pop radio station . . . The longer we [played nonrhythmic cuts], the more we were banging our head against the wall in frustration over our pitiful time spent listening."

Now, Z104 plays only one nonrhythmic record per quarter-hour, ranging from rock titles like "Lightning Crashes" and "When I Come Around" to such nonrock titles as "I Know" or "All That She Wants" that London still codes as nonrhythmic, because "you wouldn't hear them on a churban or urban radio station."

The few rock songs that Z104 still plays have been long gone from KUBE, and London admits that "we have talked about losing anything nonrhythmic. We've got a couple of projects coming up that will help us solidify our position in the market. If that will get us to an 8-9 share, so be it. So far, we're taking it step by step . . . We've tried to be slow and steady so that the bottom never drops out all of a sudden." (The station did make one major change last week, moving MD/p.m. driver Sean Sellers to mornings, replacing John Trout.)

Here's a monitor of Z104 in early evenings: Tony Thompson, "I Wanna Love Like That"; Seal, "Kiss From A Rose"; Salt-

N-Pepa, "Shoop"; Montell Jordan, "This Is How We Do It"; Ace Of Base, "All That She Wants"; Boyz II Men, "Water Runs Dry"; Marky Mark & the Funky Bunch, "Good Vibrations"; Brownstone, "If You Love Me"; Pearl Jam, "Daughter"; Soul For Real, "Every Little Thing I Do"; Brandy, "Best Friend"; Blessid Union Of Souls, "I Believe"; and Snap, "Rhythm Is A Dancer."

To distance itself from its previous rhythmic incarnation, Z104 has readded a lot of pop/dance oldies: Stevie B.'s "Spring Love," Young M.C.'s "Bust A Move," and Shannon's "Let The Music Play" among them. "I don't think that kind of music ever went away, but this station, and others, decided that people didn't want it, or maybe they asked and didn't want to see the results," says London. "We found that the more successful rhythmic top 40s play a lot of those titles and always have."

London has also taken the unusual step for a rhythmic top 40 of positioning Z104 as a station that doesn't play hardcore rap. He uses rap in the station's "This is Z104 music . . . this is garbage" promos as an example of what the station won't play. "We wanted to make sure that when we started dancing again, people didn't think we were going off the deep end again," London says. (Z104 also has a "modern rock" version of the "this is garbage" promo where the song in question features a female vocalist singing about a brain tumor.)

Despite the "garbage" promo, crosstown WOWI—the market leader and one of R&B radio's most rap-driven stations—is Z104's biggest cume sharer. "We get most of our quarter-hours from WOWI listeners who either made us their first choice or made us their second choice when they wouldn't even have considered us before, which is how we got another 80,000 listeners a week."

Z104 also got some unintentional help from WOWI when that station took its own duopoly partner WMXN from top 40/adult to jazz, thus eliminating a competitor both for Z104 and 2WD and potentially fragmenting WOWI's own upper demos. WOWI's other duopoly FM, R&B/adult WSVY, also competes with WOWI itself and, as a result, London says, "by this fall, they may not be an 8-9 share radio station. The time will soon come when WOWI and Z104 are tied or within a share, as opposed to WOWI leading us 3 to 1."

Z104's gains in the spring happened without TV or cash giveaways. Instead, Z104 concentrated on station concerts featuring Sophie B. Hawkins, Real McCoy, Stevie B., and the Human League, as well as ticket and music giveaways and "a lot of street appearances."

Being in a resort market, Z104 ends up doing sponsor remotes not only on the customary Saturday morning but also throughout the week. Such broadcasts make most PDs cringe, but London puts a positive spin on even those as giving the station a chance to touch its audience.

"We're just trying to maintain our street presence. Keep it visible. Keep it active. Keep introducing the station to people who don't know what we're doing or reintroducing it to those with a bad taste in their mouth. We may do another flight of TV shortly, but for now we really want to be as visible as possible and really plug those active people," London says.

Burns: Program For Listeners, Not Labels

Since its inception, top 40 radio's success has been based on one simple premise: play the most popular songs! Would the format's founders have achieved the same success by playing the dozens of songs that the jukebox patrons they observed were *not* playing over and over? Absolutely not!

Top 40 radio programmers must constantly be aware that the format's success can be easily compromised by the lobbying efforts of the music industry. Many of today's inexperienced programmers are being conditioned into believing that it's top 40's sole obligation to culti-

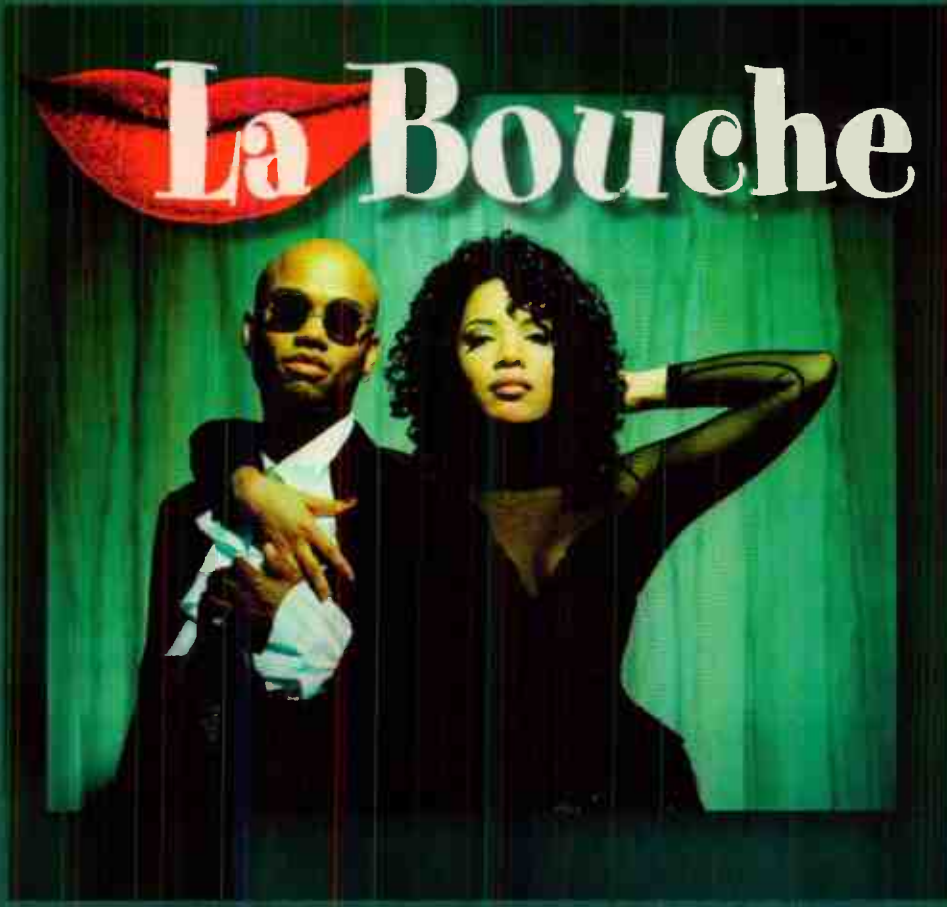
