## T40 PDs Focus On 'Margins,' Hundt Sounds Out At NAB

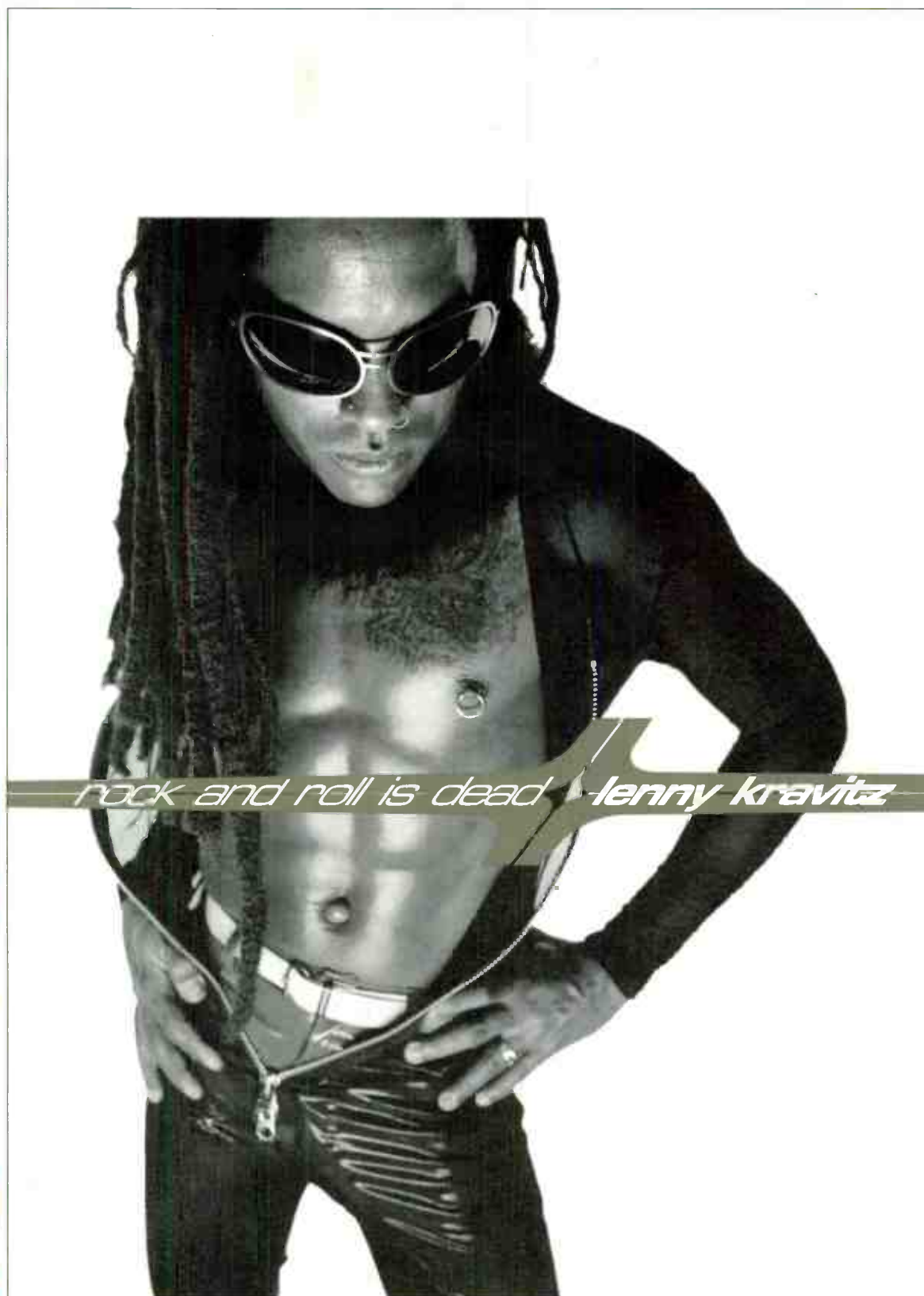
"Don't target 25-54. Make your station work by looking at its profit margins instead." Those were the messages given top 40 broadcasters at this year's National Assn. of Broadcasters radio conference, held Sept. 5-9 in New Orleans.

Like most NAB fall conventions,

this year's was more concerned with regulatory and radio business issues than programming concerns, but the state of the top 40 and top 40/adult formats were still an issue at top 40 and AC round-table discussions held Friday (8).

At that panel, KUBE Seattle OM Bob Case told his audience that while

### Lopez Official; Jackson Exits The Planet

**A**s tipped here last week, Jacor's R&B WJBT Jacksonville, Fla., inks **Paco Lopez**, last with WQHT (Hot 97) New York as PD. WJBT will move into a young-end hip-hop direction much like Hot 97. Former WJBT PD **Nate Bell** will run the show at sister station WHJX, which flips from top 40/crossover to R&B/adult along the lines of WRKS New York. **Issac Hayes** will be the station voice. **Steve Smith** will be consulting both stations. No lineup changes have been announced.

Look for **Mark Jackson**, longtime APD/MD at WHYT (The Planet) Detroit through several incarnations, most recently modern rock, to head for a new post with Hitmakers momentarily. This settles the longstanding question of whether Jackson or his fiancée, **KGGI** Riverside, Calif., MD **Sonia Jimenez**, would be the one to move. Over at KGGI, by the way, former intern **Susan Bacich** returns as promotion director from crosstown KCAL.

**Jim Beard**, Jacor's former Tampa, Fla., general sales manager, is the new GM at top 40 WDJX Louisville, Ky., replacing **Bill Wells**. Meanwhile, there are rumors that WDJX's programming will be simulcast on new Lexington, Ky., outlet **WJGG** until that station gets its own format up and running. If the rumors are true, it would give Lexington its first top 40 station in several years.

Long-rumored **WHTZ** (Z100) New York acquisition **Cane** has finally been made official for nights at the station. He'll start Oct. 2. **Freddie Vetter** stays on in an as-yet unspecified capacity.

**KHTY** (Y97) Santa Barbara, Calif., ups MD/night guy **Damion Young** to PD, replacing **John Alden**, who's still pursuing his TV weather career and working with the station on a part-time basis.

**WRQK** Canton, Ohio, PD **Ruby Cheeks** exits. She will continue to work P/T at N/T **WWWE** Cleveland while exploring her industry options. Call 216-546-9551.

Given his top 40 background, one would have expected radio veteran **Bill Hennes**, the new GM of **WQSL** Wilmington, N.C., to flip the station from hot AC to top 40. And he has. **WQSL** becomes "All Hit 92.3." Hennes and consultant **Ron White** are overseeing the transition. The station is still staffing up, but at the moment OM **Gary Alexander** is handling mornings and **Tyler Richman** joins for nights from **KYKY** St. Louis. As proof that the station is the pure top 40 that Hennes has always championed, its heavies include **Alanis Morissette**, **Michael Jackson**, and **Luniz**.

As part of its transition from AC back to top 40, **WSSX** Charleston, S.C., drops the "Mix" handle and returns to its classic "95.5X" nickname.

**KKDM** Des Moines, Iowa, which had originally announced its intention to be a modern rock outlet, will actually be a top 40 station, according to consultant **Liz Janik**, and will play **Real McCoy**, **Nicki French**, **Fun Factory**, etc. **KKDM** is still stunting and not on the air yet with its permanent format.

**KDUK** Eugene, Ore., PD **Greg Adams** has left the building and has been replaced by former **KKRZ** (Z100) Portland, Ore., APD/MD **Eric Murphy**.

Former **WCIL-FM** Carbondale, Ill., PD **Tony Waitkus** resurfaces as the new MD/p.m. driver at crosstown album rocker **WTAO**. PD **Lester St. James** amicably exited the station last week and has been replaced by production director **Paxton Guy**.

**WVKS** (Kiss FM) Toledo, Ohio, flips its AC duopoly partner **WLQR** to soft AC as **WRVF** (the River). **WVKS** OM **Mike Wheeler** will continue to oversee the new station, too. **Dwight Douglas** will consult. In other AC news,

top 40/adult **WOMX** (Mix 105) Orlando, Fla., has gone hotter, along the lines of co-owned **KHMX** (Mix 96.5) Houston. And **Frank Grimley** is upped from P/T to nights at **WMC-FM** (FM100) Memphis, replacing **Henry Nelson**, now doing mornings at rhythmic AC **WCFB** Orlando, Fla.

Top 40 **KHTO** (Hot 106.7) Springfield, Mo., enters an LMA-to-buy with **Roland Johnson**, formerly one of the owners of **WHFS** Washington, D.C. . . . This week's modern rock converts: triple-A **KQPT** Sacramento, Calif., and classic rock **WJBX** Ft. Myers, Fla.

After 15 years as morning host on **KUBE** Seattle, **Charlie Brown**—who had been simulcasting on '70s gold **KJR-FM**—will now be heard on **KJR-FM** only. The new **KUBE** host is **Rob Tepper** from all-sports **KJR-AM**.

Longtime **KQKQ** (Sweet 98) Omaha, Neb., morning man **Rocket** crosses the street to hot AC **KESY** (Y104), as **Kevin Cooper** moves to afternoons. **KESY** PD **Jerry Balletra**, who lured **Rocket** over, is a **KQKQ** alumnus too. No replacement has been named at Sweet 98.

Here's the new fall season on **KFMB-FM** (Star 100.7) San Diego: Morning personality **Shaun Ireland** exits and is replaced by p.m. driver **Dave Smiley**. Look for MD/swing jock **Greg Simms** to fill 3-8 p.m. while PD **Tracy Johnson** looks for a replacement. "The Love Doctor," previously heard on Sunday nights, will now be making house calls from Sunday through Thursday nights from 9-11 p.m. Turn your head and cough.

**KXTZ** (94 Jamz) Las Vegas evening maniac **Jojo (Mojo) Wright** has been relieved of his MD duties. APD **MC Scrappy** regains MD stripes.

**Booker Madison** moves from nights to mornings at modern rock **KISF** Kansas City, teaming with **Seana McKay** and **Soren Petro**. **Ed Parriera** moves from mornings to middays, replacing **Mark Daniels**, who goes to rock **WXLN** Davenport, Iowa. Former morning co-host **Jay Charles** goes to nights, replacing **Madison**. P/T **Jason Justice** goes to late nights.

**KBOS/KKTR** Fresno, Calif., update: Look for **KBOS/KKTR** owner/GM **Steve Miller** to be named VP of Patterson Broadcasting and oversee album rocker **KRZR** and adult top 40 **KTHH**, as well as newly acquired **KWNZ** Reno, Nev., and Patterson's Hawaii properties. Look for **KBOS** and **KRZR** to move into new facilities by the end of the year.

**Danny Wright** joins **WXXL** (XL106.7) Orlando, Fla., for that part of late nights not covered by its newly added "Lovephones" show.

**KZIO** Duluth, Minn., PD **Justin Case** slides to afternoons as former PD **James "Hojo" Baker** exits. **Mike Steele** segues from **WTBX** Hibbing, Minn., for mornings, midday jock **Christine Dean** moves to weekends, as **Holly Knight** arrives from **KJZZ** Phoenix.

Top 40/adult **WAZY-FM** Lafayette, Ind., MD/p.m. driver **Craig Quinn** exits due to budgetary cutbacks and is not being replaced. PD **John Flint** is now doing music and 3-6 p.m., production director **Fred Stewart** picks up the noon-3 p.m. shift, and **Steve Clark** is now doing nights. Call Mr. Quinn today: 317-449-0124.

**KQID** Alexandria, La.'s **Pat Cloud** handed over PD reins to **Kahuna** last week, but will remain with the station doing middays. **KQID**'s ID has changed from "Red Hot Q93" to "Q93, Today's Best Music" . . . **Carlos Diaz** goes from the morning team at **WZPL** Indianapolis to news director at modern rival **WRZX**.

AC **WHYN-FM** Springfield, Mass., adds new morning co-host **Michele Allen** from crosstown **WMRQ**, replacing **Susan Barnett**, and new morning news anchor **Kim Zachary** . . . **KSMG** (Magic 105.3) San Antonio, Texas, overnighter **Brian Christian** exits. T&Rs to PD **Pat Evans**.

### Kate Moss Made Me Quit Airchecking

**S**omething unusual happened on this National Assn. of Broadcasters convention trip—unusual for me, at least.

I went to New Orleans through Atlanta. Then I flew to Los Angeles for a wedding, connecting in Salt Lake City. Then I flew back through New York.

I went through four cities in five days.

I had a cassette recorder with me.

And yet, I airchecked only three radio stations.

For the record, the three stations I taped were the two R&B outlets in New Orleans—**WYLD-FM** and **WQUE** (Q93)—and the oldies station, **WTKL** (Kool 95). But what is significant here is that until a year ago, I'd never ventured outside whatever market I was living in without an aircheck machine. And never returned with less than four or five C-90s filled up with eight to 10 stations. It wasn't a **Clarke Ingram** level of airchecking, but it was enough to compile about 5,000 airchecks over the course of 15 years, and those are only the ones I've cataloged so far.

So what happened?

Gotta be honest. Airchecking was destroying my relationship with supermodel **Kate Moss**. She got tired of blowing off Paris and Milan to drive to Binghamton, N.Y., or Greenville, S.C., and tape radio stations. She never understood why we were listening to tapes of radio stations with the middles of songs spliced out, although I told her it made at least as much sense as "Eskimo chic" or any of this spring's other fashion atrocities. Eventually, we came up with a compromise. I stopped leaving her at parties to run back to the hotel room and flip a tape over, and she agreed to stop purging after dinner.

All right, so it *wasn't* because I got a life. But I cut back my airchecking anyway. And here's why: First, I'm about a year-and-a-half behind on editing the tapes I do have; Also, there's less that is worth taping. If, like most aircheckers, your world has evolved around taping top 40 stations, there aren't many of them anymore. For those top 40s that do exist, you'll be hard pressed to find a time to tape them on the weekend when they aren't in syndication. If they're local, they're likely to be on hard-drive automation half the time. And when you've rushed off to market after market to hear the new top 40, getting there to realize that they're really hot AC instead, or barely audible in the market they intend to serve (because nobody who's actually in

the market *wants* to do top 40), you start to feel foolish.

Even for a student of all formats, there's less to tape: Country outlets are toning down their presentations. The new clump of '70s gold and modern rock outlets spend a lot of time running automated themselves. A lot of what's interesting in a new city is now network radio—whether it's **ABC's** **Urban Gold** or **Radio Aahs**—and you've already taped it in the last city.

Airchecking starts to not seem worth it. Eventually, the idea of walking through the airport with 15 extra pounds of boombox or almost running the rental car off the road as you try to steer with one hand and adjust an antenna with the other seems kinda foolish.

It wasn't that I didn't hear anything I liked on this trip. I finally heard **Greg Street**, the new night jock on Atlanta's **WVEE** (V103), who can make a legitimate case for being the **Tom Joyner** of the hip-hop generation. I heard the new country **KUBL** Salt Lake City, which had so much energy that its decision to be the fourth country station into the market, at a time when country's audience is leveling, actually seemed to make sense. And yet for some strange reason, I got on my plane when they started boarding instead of staying in the gate area until the last possible minute, trying to tape one more break.

I started airchecking about 1980, when radio certainly wasn't in such a good place creatively. And since things aren't entirely worthless now, I have to assume that this is the early stages of middle-age crisis. **Chrissie Hynde** turned 33 and stopped duking it out with police officers. Having passed that milestone this week, I have to at least briefly *consider* learning to dance, re-learning my high school French, finally going to Alaska, volunteering on political campaigns again, losing 15 pounds, or making some other good faith effort at being well-rounded. Anybody who knows me, of course, knows that this isn't an entirely realistic goal, but it deserves a token effort, which means that airchecking is on the back burner until, say, November.

Meanwhile, I hope that there's still an 18 year old who's inspired enough to lug the box everywhere. In Gen-X, there's no shortage of folks who are young and stupid—it's just an issue of whether they're willing to focus that, er, enthusiasm on radio, and whether radio folks are still coming up with anything to keep an 18 year old devoted for the next 15 years.

## PROMOTIONS

### Bowen's Blueprint For Building Better Promos

**D**an Bowen wears many hats at the Nationwide-owned top 40 powerhouse WNCI Columbus, Ohio, including assistant PD, MD, and promotions director. Below is his checklist for a successful promotions department. He notes that some of his points may seem obvious, but a promotions director who juggles many different events may find it advantageous to keep these points in front of him or her anyway.

These are Bowen's laws:

- Know and understand both your station's goals, as well as the client's goals. Ask yourself the following questions: (1) Will this promotion make people listen to the station? (2) Does it enhance the station's image or the image of a particular daypart? (3) Does it fit the budget? (4) Does it generate revenue for the station? (5) Is it attention-getting, outrageous, edgy, compelling to listen to? Be sure to play devil's advocate.

- Ask questions: The client wants a traffic-building promotion. What type of client is it, a burger joint or an upscale clothing store? What is the client's target demo? Frequently, you realize in sales/programming/client meetings that different clients' goals are vastly different. Also, many clients' goals are unfocused. For that reason, promotions often become classic cases of "Ready, Fire, Aim!"

- Draw a blueprint: Create a checklist and a separate folder for every station event encompassing the initial proposal, rules, insurance/permits, any purchase orders, and copy points for spots/promos. WNCI makes sure that its on-air promo inventory is available and reserved, the press release is done, any special equipment is procured (van, inflatables, sound system, etc.) and that promised prizes are in-house. The folder also includes point-of-purchase displays (whether clients' or their own, with stickers or signage), event photographer info, aircheck/affidavit for proof of performance, release forms, and a post-event evaluation. (It's convenient to refer back to the folder for next year's event.)

- Divide your promotions into broad categories, such as contests, sales promotions, and topical image/buzz promotions. Make liberal use of your public service department as a resource for various community causes you can support to achieve the "nice guy" position.

- Mark your calendar! Plan promotions around major national and state holidays, as well as important local city events. Other annual national event tie-ins include the Super

Bowl, Grammys, MTV Awards, etc.

- Hold impromptu brainstorming sessions, outside the station, if possible, to generate ideas. Use the resources at hand, including every station employee, talk to advertising agencies, and utilize ideas from listeners in your target demo. These ideas will invariably lead to other ideas for future use. You can also brainstorm backward: start with a finished product in mind and work in reverse to determine how to get there.

- Each promotion should be either exciting, funny, or warm and fuzzy. The ideal promotion should also fit your station's positioning and should relate to your target audience.

- Remember to be creative and unique, even if you're recycling an old concept. Come up with a new twist that will make your promotion memorable. Increase your chances of getting press coverage by calling the media and sending out a press release.

- Overbudget to compensate for any top-of-mind event that happens to break. Some of the biggest, most successful promotions have been based on events that came up unexpectedly. Allow yourself the flexibility to swing into action immediately.

- Be prepared for anything. Expect to be hit by Murphy's Law at some point. Respond to it and move forward.

- To improve your chances of getting your promotion budget approved, campaign for pet projects throughout the year; make sure other staff members support these ideas and lobby for them as well. Don't assume you can bring an idea to the table at the last minute and expect management to fall in love with it. They may not be as initially excited about the concept as you are, because they haven't lived with it as long as you have. Most good managers are naturally more cautious and will try to take the devil's advocate position. Allow them more time to digest the idea and make a fair decision. Lobby early and often. Remember, frequency sells.

- As you set your annual budget, make sure all departments are aware internally of the station's goals; both sales and programming should be on the same page. If you make any changes in your station's positioning or image, your sales department should be aware of those changes and how to best present them on the street.

- Buy promotional items in bulk on an annual basis, not on an as-needed basis—it's much more cost-effective. WNCI does less shirt customizing than many stations, selling a single message rather than spending money on special-event shirts. Besides being too cost-prohibitive, it doesn't want to dilute the station's main message.

- Remember, we are in the promotion business, so it's all about how you best package the hype. In case of any negative promotional reaction, exercise immediate damage control to protect your station's image. When all goes well, however, maximize those positive results by taking full credit and full advantage of your station's success.

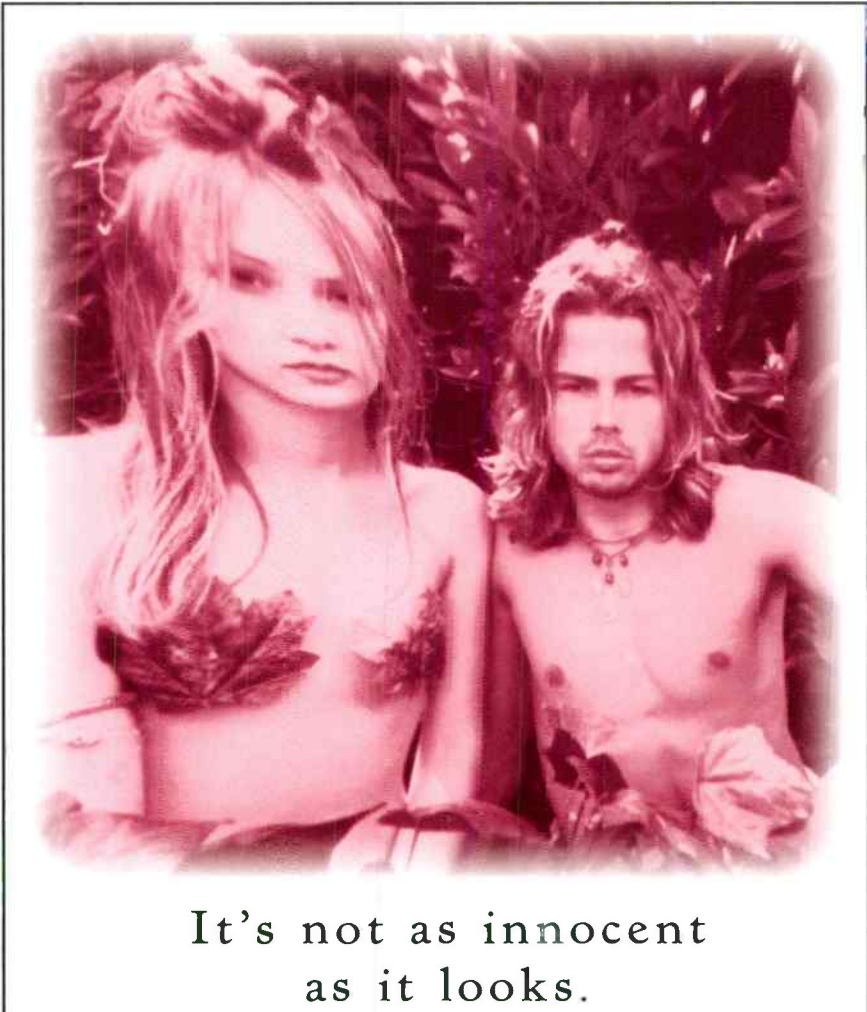

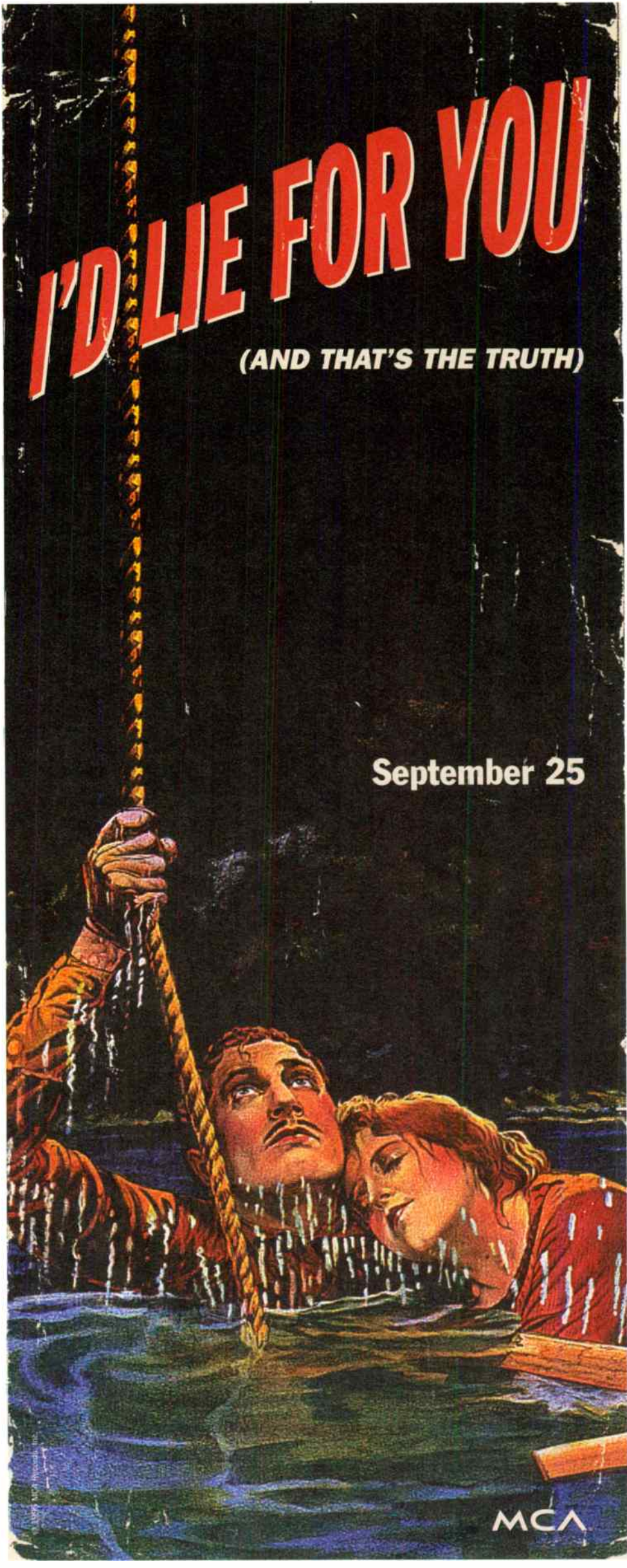

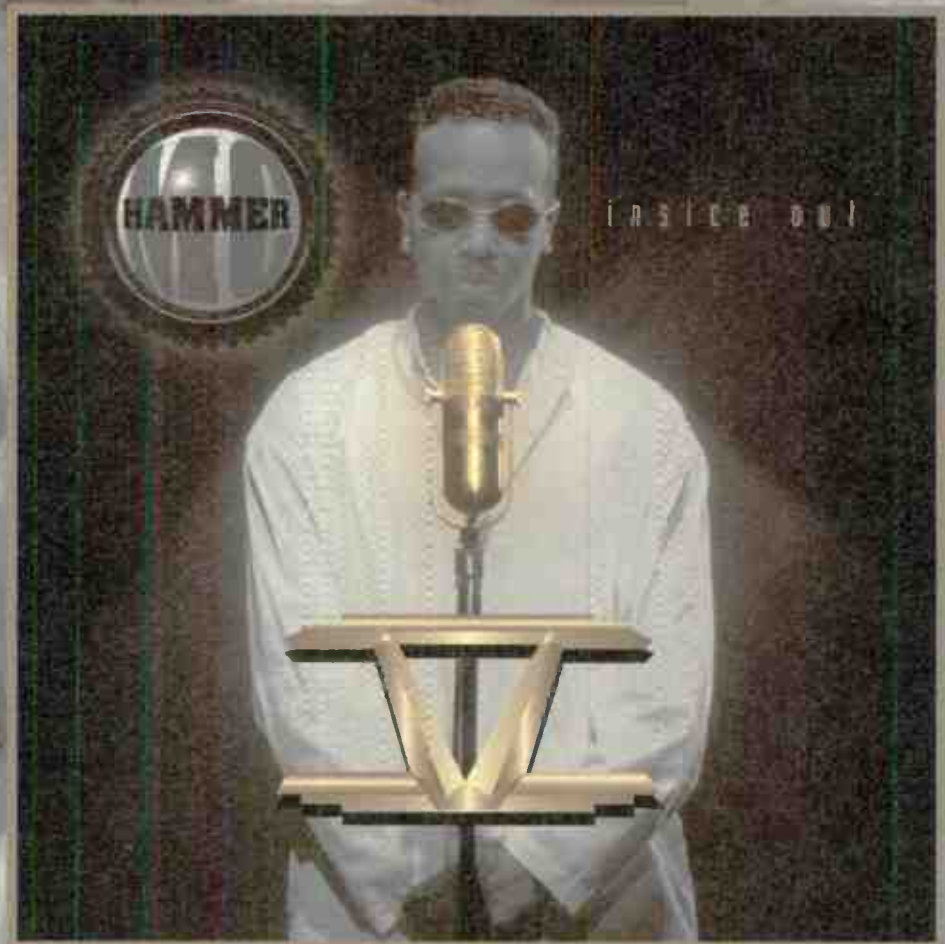
