NO CHANGES IN TRANSPORTATION RATES ARE IN CONTEMPLATION

Report That Railroad Shows Will Pay Full Fare

In Addition to Regular Contract Rates

Is Contradicted by Director of Railroads' Office

During the past week the excitement of railroad showings has been disturbed by rumors which apparently emanated from several sources to the effect that Director General of Railroads William G. Mackdon was considering measures to compel every circus, carnival or other show using its own cars for transportation, to contribute in part full transportation rates in addition to the regular railroad contract rates.

That there is absolutely no truth in the rumors, and that no change in rates is contemplated, is evidenced by the following record in the Washington, D. C., March 11—No change from rates which have heretofore been observed by railroads for the transportation of circuses, carnivals or other railroad shows are contemplated by the Director General of Railroads. Mackdon reports to this effect which are in circulation. Authority for the statement that no change in such rates are contemplated comes from Justice Dorothea Gannett of the Interstate Commerce Commission, in active charge of the Director General's office under Mr. Mackdon.

It was further stated, on the same authority, that nothing had even been before the Director General or his assistant for action touching such proposed measures. That, however, several firms and other railroad shows would be compelled to pay full fare in addition to regular railroad contract rates, it was suggested at the office of Mr. Frink, who was absolutely in charge of such matters. It was also said that the office of the Director General is being divided in such matters by agreement in effect with railroads in the past.

The general impression also was received from this office that a decision to permit the transportation of such itinerant companies and their outfits during the coming year will not be required to be followed by action looking to the restriction of the same.

PHILADELPHIA CENSORS BRING "GUILTY MAN" TO GUILLOTINE

Submits Paramount Picture to Unmerciful Blasting

Eliminates Detroit From Artistic Value of Picture

Original Version Now Being Shown in New York

New York, March 11.—Philadelphia, the city that has been the beautiful scenery in its expensive new State House, could not stand the Paramount's production of "The World's End" as long as the cinema the most advanced was not.
