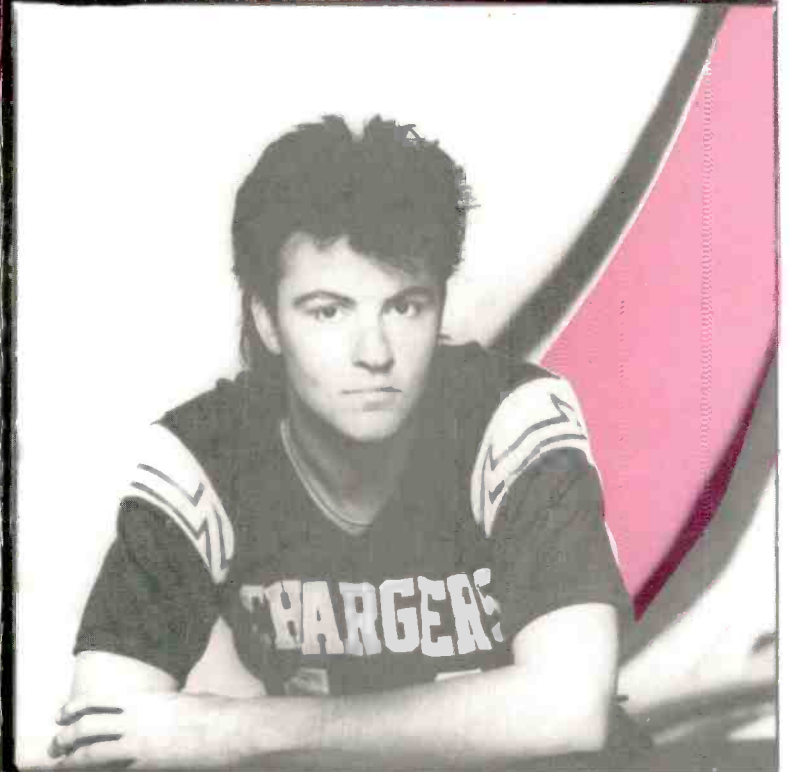
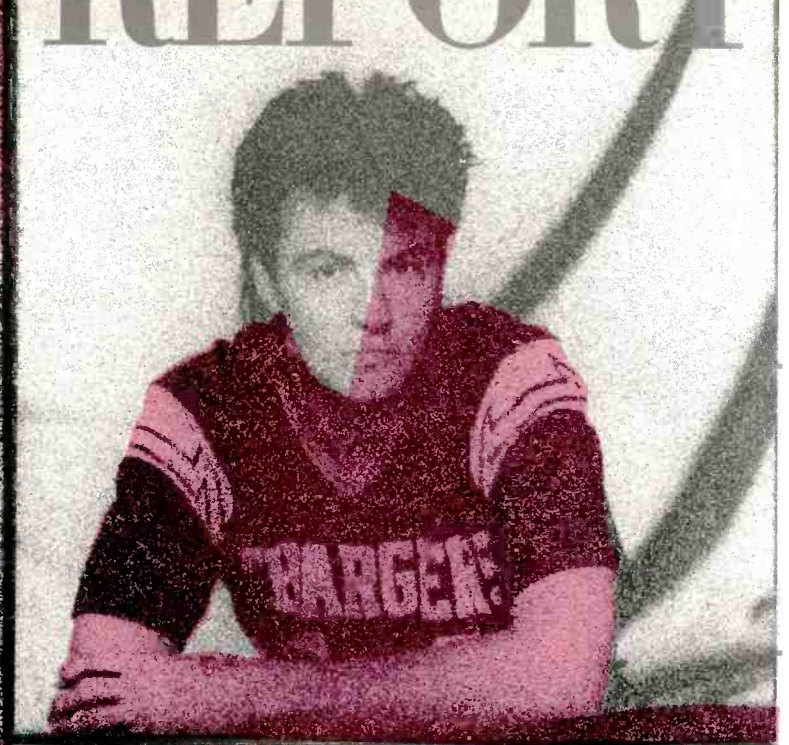

ANALYSIS

More underlines in the top ten is a signal the old is giving way to the first giant hits of summer '85. Interesting to note that only three American acts MADONNA, HAROLD FALTERMEYER and USA FOR AFRICA reside in the top 10 this week. BRYAN ADAMS pulls off one of the largest "Hit Factor" increases ever...28% to 67% in a week where the total number of reporting stations went over the 300 mark. Others that rank tops in "Hit Factor" movement are MADONNA (both "Angel" and "Groove"), KATRINA 26% - 49%, and JULIAN LENNON. Our "Record To Watch" of one month ago, 'TIL TUESDAY is barreling right on through, by-passing "Chart-bound" for a slot on the Top 40 and earning "Certified" status. Noteworthy chart action being reported by PRO/FM 18-14, KDSR 27-19, WIFC 31-24, 93FM 23-15, KKYS 20-11, KIIS/FM 35-17, KMEL 25-18, OK95 6-4, etc. Airplay growth's impressive, too, with WTIC, WDCG, WHTX, WBBQ, Z-98, 92X, WQLK, B-96, WXXQ, KCPX, KLRZ, KLUC, KITS, KKHR, KUBE just some of the 41 new believers. PAUL YOUNG is coming together awfully fast, ready to become "Chartbound" next week. We're told "My Toot Toot" has become the anthem of New Orleans with Toot Toot T-shirts, bumper stickers and a number of versions of the song being aired. But nationally, it's JEAN KNIGHT happenin' at Z100-New York 22-19, WBBQ-Augusta 28-9, Z98-Tampa

26-20, debut #13 WTHZ-Tallahassee, B97-New Orleans 17-7, WVSR-Charleston 22-17, debuts #14 93FM-Houston, KIXY-San Angelo 5-3, KWES-Odessa/Midland 16-8, etc. WHITNEY HOUSTON becomes the new number one record on our R&B chart the same week she makes her biggest crossover on Top 40. 34 adds, including B104, WTIC, WCCC, PRO/FM, 92KTU, WJZR, WAVA, WPST, WQTU, WHHY, WHYT, KAFM, KIIS/FM, KHIT, KZZK, KS103, etc. Looks like this one will indeed be a giant summer love ballad. Last week we mentioned the DEPECHE MODE record as a sleeper to look out for. This is a case of programmers reacting to public demand. Here's a record that's literally being forced on radio by massive sales and requests. KZZP PD Guy Zapoleon put it on his nightly "make it or break it" features and reports it got the biggest response of any record to date. 10 adds including WJMX, 195, KKYS, KZZP, KSAQ, KIIS/FM, KJOY, KKHR, KS103, KYNG. With interest in the Vietnam war and vets very high, beware of a record you'll be getting soon by PAUL HARDCASTLE called "19". Debuting at number 4 in England, it's number one now selling a reported 41,000 copies a day. On the radio already in New York and Philly, it's become one of the most requested records overnight. All Top 40 correspondents note that our new Deadline for reports is Wednesdays at Noon PDT.

THE SOUL OF PAUL YOUNG

PAUL YOUNG has sold over four million albums and four million singles worldwide—with only one album's worth of material. His classic debut album, *NO PARLEZ*, featured a remake of an obscure Marvin Gaye "B" side, "Wherever I Lay My Hat." Since then, the album mined three more hit singles all over Europe and from there Paul Young maintained constant popularity. With his long awaited follow-up, *THE SECRET OF ASSOCIATION*, finally released, Paul's sights are set for the United States.

Early in his career, Paul toured Britain tirelessly as lead singer in a band called *STREETBAND* then with a Soul configuration called *The Q-Tips*. He then signed a deal with CBS overseas insisting on his own "Soul flavored" formula. After two tries, he struck gold with "Hat" and has remained a European staple ever since.

Young is considered an artist's artist. At his first concert appearance in Los Angeles, Rod Stewart was in the audience to check him out. Hailed by the critics, Paul completed two American tours in '83 and '84 before being forced to return to England to nurse overworked vocal

chords. Now that the new album is out, Paul is currently embarking on a world tour and should arrive stateside this summer. We spoke to Paul by phone on a rare day off in Hamburg amidst his heavy tour schedule. We talked about his popularity and his knack for picking material.

KZ: In which European markets have you been successful?

PY: I'd say nearly every country in Europe. The first album was number one in Holland, Norway, Britain, Denmark, Belgium, Germany for three months, Italy, Iceland, top ten in France, and platinum in Sweden . . .

KZ: Do you think you filled a void in the European and British music scene? What do you think clicked for you?

PY: It happened in England first, really. There had been what you call experimental noise bands. The records were more excursions into sound than anything else. I quite liked them but I just found them very difficult to listen to because the singing was always so sub-standard. The person who did the vocals was never even classed as a singer. You get people like Paul Weller and Julian Cope from Teardrop Explodes. They class

themselves as songwriters first, where I've never done that. I've always seen myself as a singer. I thought I wanted to do that kind of music but mix it with my roots—which come from Soul. Add some good vocals. Take a bit of time. After a couple of records, people got used to it and the third single ("Wherever I Lay My Hat") went to number one (in the U.K.). People felt the same as me. They got fed up with listening to records where the vocals were bad.

KZ: You didn't originally come from a Punk/New Wave perspective. Or did you?

PY: I was in a band around the Punk time. We did draw a little bit from that in regards to stage performance. It got a bit more outrageous, but generally, Punk bands were about people getting bands together when they just started to play. This band wasn't like that. The players were all quite good.

KZ: Is the U.S. market the last frontier for you?

PY: In a way, I suppose. There are Communist countries where we haven't been to. We could break through there, but I think music is a bit risky for them at the moment (laughs).

KZ: How did you stumble on your first big hit, "Wherever I Lay My Hat"?

PY: Couldn't see Prince playing Moscow, could you? (laughs) We were talking about songs and I just remembered that one. I hadn't even gotten the record. So we went out and found it in a shop. It didn't actually fare as well in my mind's ear. It's a little like seeing it through rose-colored glasses. When you buy the record, the recording seems quite dated. That was, in the end, what made us decide it was worth working on another arrangement. It was ten years since I had heard the record, but we knew it was a good song. I could remember the melody and a lot of the words.

KZ: What should we know about the new album in the way of any changes in style, or the band?

PY: The main thing with *NO PARLEZ* was each track was a little excursion in something eclecticized that we planned for each number. *THE SECRET OF ASSOCIATION* is more of an entity. We wanted to achieve the same thing in each track—make it sound classy. We weren't mixing and matching any particular sounds. We were just starting off with a song with a basic idea and then the song would take us where it needed to go. There's a lot more continuity on the album this time around.

KZ: You've done more writing on this new album.

PY: Oh yes! Some songs were written the same time as *NO PARLEZ* but we didn't record them. Other songs are new songs. But it doesn't mean to say that the next album will be all my own songs. Unless of

course we can't find any more good songs. It was getting a bit difficult for THE SECRET OF ASSOCIATION. I had to wade through a lot of bad material to find the good.

KZ: *Is this basically part of your style, picking up obscure material that sounds good?*

PY: That's a part of my style. I'm just trying to get rid of what's been branded into people's minds over the last twenty years—that you have to do everything yourself. I don't think you get good product if you do everything yourself. If you're gonna sing, you have to get good songs. If you write twenty songs, five of them might be great. You still try and record those twenty songs and you end up with a sub-standard album. I don't think like that. Also, I've had a lot of journalists say to me, "Do you like being known as a cover artist?" My answer to that is, "No, I like to be known as a singer. As a singer that allows me the freedom to sing whatever songs I wish."

KZ: *But it was ingenious to find the new single "Everytime You Go Away" tucked away on an old Hall and Oates album.*

PY: We'd already listened to the song once, but we thought it was a bit of an obvious choice. We were going through these odd choices like the Tom Waits' number ("Soldier's Things")... then we took a look at the album and there was so much diverse stuff that we thought we needed something that was obvious pop. We went back and listened to some songs we short-listed. That was one of them. If ever there was a simple classic pop, it was there on that tape.

KZ: *Hall and Oates did an overextended version of that song. You just tightened it up a bit.*



PY: Hmm. That's the thing, you see. Most songs that we've done, we've generally done because either the songs haven't dated very well or the original versions

have left it open to other interpretations. We thought "Everytime You Go Away" was open to a different arrangement.

KZ: *What took you so long to follow up with your second album?*

PY: It started in France when we recorded three tracks and we had a load of problems. When we got back, we found out that the tape machine had been fluctuating. There were tuning discrepancies all the way through the tracks. We had to erase everything apart from the drum tracks and work around it. We had to link into a Linn Drum Machine to get it in better tempo and almost start again. Then I was ill in the summer. On the final mixes (producer) Laurie Latham was also ill with tonsillitis. It was one thing after another.

KZ: *You had problems with your voice at one point.*

PY: That was my illness in the summer. The tour we did of America last year was quite hectic. I tend to sing above my natural range. The schedule was quite heavy and I went down with three viruses. One when I came in the first place, then one in Chicago, then one in New York. I was seeing doctors three separate times. I gave it a false rest period when I got back

to England. I went straight back to work again. This starting and stopping was just a big jolt on my vocal chords. The muscles seized up.

KZ: *You were supposed to play with Elton John at Wembley Stadium in London and you had to cancel.*

PY: That was when the voice went and I had to cancel... what was to be my biggest-ever show in Wembley.

KZ: *That must have been devastating.*

PY: Oh it was at the time. It was horrible. We cancelled all these European concerts that they had been waiting over a year for.

KZ: *You've changed your band lineup a little. You have new backup singers.*

PY: We've got three black guys that do backing vocals. We've added an extra keyboard player and a different guitar player. The sound is a little bit different but the nucleus is the same. That also helps the second album to retain an identity.

KZ: *What's your current tour itinerary since the new album?*

PY: We started off in England, Belgium, France, Denmark, Norway, Sweden,

Holland, and back in Germany now, then Spain, Italy, Japan, Australia, then over to you guys (in the U.S.A.).

KZ: *A couple of years ago, there was a huge influx of British bands invading the U.S. Do you think it is difficult for you with so much American product catching on?*

PY: I think it comes and goes in waves. Now we're getting the American Invasion. Bryan Adams is picking up and Tina Turner is doing good business. It's coming back over here now. In another couple of years, we'll be floating over your way again. It just goes back and forth.

KZ: *You have this reputation for being an artist's artist. Rick Springfield told us he likes your music.*

PY: Don Henley's been doing the same thing. Apparently Bruce Springsteen said something to a Japanese magazine. Toto came to the shows in England. It's getting around in the business. It's possibly a healthy way of getting known (in the U.S.) that gives me some longevity instead of arriving in a blaze of glory.

KZ: *You were the opening voice on the Band Aid single.*

PY: The only idea of making that record was to make it sell so that the money goes to the right place. Bob Geldorf planned it as best he could. David Bowie was going to start it. Unfortunately, he couldn't make it and I got the first line. It just happened that way. It's been quite lucky for me.

KZ: *Do you get a lot of music people sending you tapes of songs they've heard?*

PY: Not well-known music people. I get people in the business that send me cassettes. A lot of them are on the wrong track, though. They send me all these classic soul songs—which is not the point. The point is to find other songs and inject them with a little bit of Soul flavor. There's been one guy in England who actually works for a publishing company and he sent two songs and we covered them both. He must be thinking before he sends them.

KZ: *Which songs were they?*

PY: The Daryl Hall song ("Everytime You Go Away") and "I'm Gonna Tear Your Playhouse Down."

KZ: *How intense was it to follow up such a large selling album?*

PY: There was a fair amount of pressure, but I tried not to feel anything. I just try to ignore those things. You try to ignore whatever fame you've got, just like you try to ignore whatever pressure you've got. I only felt it when we first walked into the studio. But we laid a few things down and I thought that this is going to be as good, if not better than NO PARLEZ. I've got nothing to worry about. Whether it sells as much is not the point in question. Is the product superior to the last? I thought it was. ❄️❄️❄️❄️

Madonna is making a predictable move toward the top and could be top ten by next issue. Every record currently in the top ten has more heavies than the sum of its other rotations. All four chart debuts have nearly identical point valves, but Bryan Adams already has a 51% Hit Factor. The new Fogerty, not shown below in Hit Factor (we need longer pages) has 83 reports, a Hit Factor of 30% and 40 adds. Though Phil Collins has changed the pace of his music with the new single SUSSUDIO, he's still having significant impact with A/C radio (68 reports with 34 adds). Look for the new Anne Murray and Paul Young to at least attain Chartbound status next week. Ron

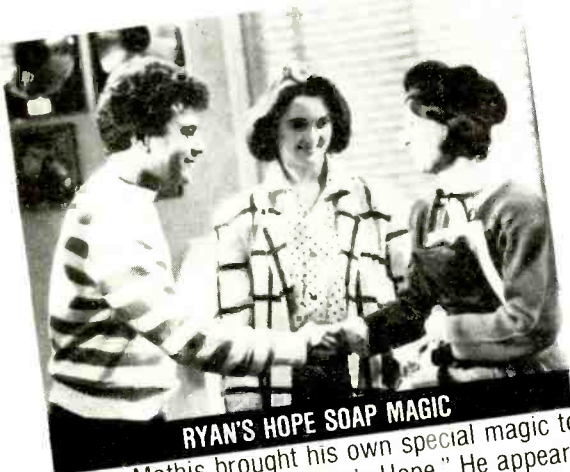

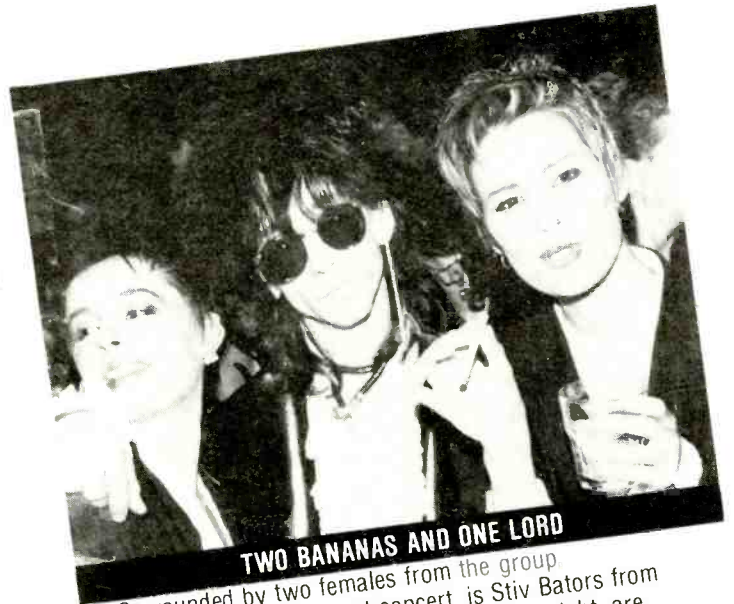

Love Vigilantes/Perfect Kiss/Sunrise/Sooner Than You Think/Subculture-NEW ORDER (Qwest) Instantly elected into the BEST OF THE BUNKER hallowed HALL OF FAME, music like this is the sole reason we crawl out of bed each morning. NEW ORDER, in a paradoxically detached manner, brilliantly meld rock n roll and synth power to new extremes. Each song builds layer by layer, verse by verse, highlighting either PETER HOOK's lead bass or BERNARD ALBRECHT's off-the-cuff distance. Admirably, out of the ashes of depression, NEW ORDER has evolved into one of the four or five true original bands of the eighties. Considering the beating that British music is now taking, this is meaty stuff. LOW LIFE is a lot like waiting for Godot, only Godot ends up showing up. In other words, our expectations were high and eventually rewarded.

So Far Away/Money For Nothing/Walk Of Life/One World-DIRE STRAITS (Warner Bros.) Even though the physical formatting of their LPs have evaded radio, DIRE STRAITS are a band of superstar proportions. It is a stature that radio has looked at pretty much from the outside in. Fortunately KNOPFLER's mood swing matches those who think in terms averaging three and a half minutes. The albums biggest surprise was getting STING to razz the concept of MTV on "Money For Nothing", a spoof on the average American's perception of rock 'n' roll "e-z livin'". BROTHERS IN ARMS stands as DS's most colorfully diverse release. As a guitarist, vocalist, songwriter, producer, and singer, MARK KNOPFLER and band remain identifiable to a large and wide demographic. Their success in the obstinant face of zero-compromise is an industry exception to the general rule of superficial imitation. This album works equally well whether it's played by radio or perceived as a literate artwork by a staunch follower. This time you get nine trax of all different styles and lengths.

Sentimental Street (LP Version)-NIGHT RANGER (Camel/MCA) Catchy common ground for Album Radio and Top Forty. The difference between the two versions is twenty seconds lifted out of the guitar solo. C'mon, what's twenty seconds. Viva la difference!

Cannonball/Still In Love/Brother Where You Bound/Every Open Door-SUPERTRAMP (A&M) After their recent Roger-ectomy, SUPERTRAMP parlay change into a Jazz/Eclectic rebirth. The opening track treads on territory close to that of STEELY DAN, yet the follow up second track honks-on using SUPERTRAMP's familiar rock approach. RICK DAVIES now handles all the lead vocals. Lyrically, ROGER HODGSON took most of the humor with him. DAVIES, instead, takes a dimly serious view of the world at large. On the title track, which could be divided into three major parts, there are guest shots from guitarists DAVID GILMOUR and (ex-THIN LIZZY) SCOTT GORHAM. BROTHER WHERE YOU BOUND is state of the art recording as well state of the art performance. I like this new direction. Beautiful packaging as well.

We Need Some Money/Meet Me At The Go Go-GO GO CRANKIN' (4th & Broadway/Island/TED) Yeah! Yeah! Yeah! No doubt the media exploitation of/for GO GO FUNK will happen faster than even break dancing and hip hop, but it's hard to deny the infectious appeal of the beat now attacking Alternative airwaves. GO GO is part of a movement away from the dryness of beatbox rap, back to real drums, organ, horns, and audience call-and-response. At this early stage (even though GO GO has been thriving in DC for a while, remember CHUCK BROWN's "Bustin' Loose"?), being the "next big thing" doesn't defray the initial excitement the music on this compilation ignites.

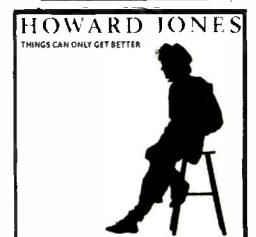

ROBERT PLANT: In the context of his new LP, the single sounds even better. Expect a new direction to keep us all guessing... A special thank you to our super "Alternative editorial assistants", Cyndi Hoelzle & Joel Moalem, who filled in admirably last week.

TEARS FOR FEARS hang onto #1 again with GRAHAM PARKER retaining his line and potential to overtake them. This marks the fourth consecutive week that TEARS have been number one on both the Album and Alternative charts.

The triple CERTIFIED is an Alternative first. The THREE O'CLOCK's support is anchored in college radio while EURHYTHMICS airplay is coming in strong from commercial programmers. LONE JUSTICE is successful on both camps and leads the pack. These three bands will hit the Top Ten with the impact of a grenade.

Further down the road we have FISHBONE, GAME THEORY, and THE BOOMTOWN RATS making respectable moves. Look for all three to rise further, especially as many of the fatigued records above them fade.

THE RATINGS, REVISITED --

PART 2

Last week I commented on the fundamental problem with the Arbitron diary-based method of surveying--the method which all too often determines whether you get a raise or get fired (and sometimes both, in consecutive rating periods, with the same programming and competition)--and I said this week I'd explain it.

I told you that Arbitron's problem is that their diary-based method does not conform to the Laws of Probability, which they must if they are to have statistical validity.

Arbitron buys a randomly selected list of telephone numbers from a national company, Metro Mail, which has all the nation's phone numbers in its computer banks (supposedly). Now, I must introduce a warning--I have seen too many cases of the same person getting a diary two years in a row to believe that there isn't at least some quirk in Metro Mail's process that stops short of true randomization. (Surely Arbitron cannot be adding the names of past participants to this sample in an effort to increase response rates.)

That sample, though, is only of households with listed telephones. For years, Arbitron denied that there was any statistical difference in radio listening patterns in listed-phone and unlisted-phone households, despite plenty of evidence to the contrary; they then developed a method of measuring unlisted households

and announced that there was a difference, and they now were measuring it. This involves subtracting all listed telephone numbers in Metro Mail's computers from all *possible* telephone numbers, and printing a list of everything that's left. Calls placed from this list reach a lot of disconnected phones, a lot of businesses (which are excluded), a lot of group quarters (military and educational--which are excluded), a lot of unlisted telephone homes, and a lot of homes that will be listed when the next phone book comes out but aren't yet.

This last group is surveyed fairly by this technique, but the unlisted phone homes are not--because when someone who is paying for the privacy of an unlisted phone gets a call from a stranger who clearly doesn't know the name of the person he's reached but does want the person's address, most unlisted homes will not cooperate. All currently active surveys have this problem when trying to reach unlisted homes by phone.

There's also plenty of evidence that homes with *no* phones have different listening patterns than do those who do, but no survey company since Pulse has attempted to address that problem.

So, okay. A good sample of listed phones and a poor sample of unlisted phones. Calls are placed. Were most of the people called willing to keep the diary, there would be statistical probability in measuring the tastes of people with listed phones. But they aren't. About half say they will; half

won't. Those who will are sent a diary for each member of the household, age 12 or over. Of the half who say they will send the completed diaries back, about half do. The resulting sample is about as little as 25% of the original random sample. The sample is no longer random, since the part who agree to keep the diary are obviously motivated differently than those who say they will and don't--and from those who refuse at the outset. Consequently, when you look at an Arbitron rating, you are looking at a survey that has statistical validity only for people who are interested in sharing their tastes and interests in radio with others, often with the hope of making a personal statement of influencing the tastes of others. (Ever notice how hot new FM's frequently shoot up out of sight in the first book, and then settle back later when they are no longer as novel?).

This is hardly a cross section of the population! Furthermore, since the number of cooperating "households" is usually about half the number of in-tab diaries, in Arbitron, the effective sample base is actually about half what it appears to be (as explained here last week). And on data like this your future depends!

Scary, isn't it?

WHITNEY HOUSTON gets a solid #1 listing this week, and is so potent right now that 61 Top 40 stations have reported playing it this week, making it our un-contested choice for "Pop Crossover". She's to

be applauded for such a successful single for her first-ever release. We "Certified" it weeks ago! Since we're into "Certified", this week's PRINCE is being played by so many stations it's senseless to list them here. BILL WITHERS, our other choice, has a good following that looks like this: WDKX, WILD, WUSL/FM, WANM, WORD, KRNB, KROF, V103, WWDM/FM, WYLD, WBLZ, WTLC, WBMX/FM, KMJM, WJLB, KHYS, KDAY, KGFJ, KSOL/FM & KUTE. Another hot item is LOOSE ENDS, a new act that we told you to keep an eye on a few weeks ago. It's now holding hard and fast to an undeniable success story: already charted at WDKX, WHUR, WRKS/FM, WUSL/FM, WQKI, WBLX, WQQK, WCIN, KMJM, WJLB, KKDA, KDAY & KGFJ, with new adds every week, making it one to keep on watching.

Ron Fell Personal Picks

John Cafferty & the Beaver Brown Band
"Tough All Over" (Scotti Bros./CBS)

To know the real story, the struggle and the dues paid by this veteran ensemble of road rats, is to appreciate their music at its fullest (you get your chance to hear the story in next week's cover story in The Gavin Report). Drawing from the same East Coast influences as J. Geils and Bruce Springsteen and Southside Johnny and the Asbury Jukes, JC & BBB exhibit the same joy of playing, the same reverence of rock roots as the afore mentioned groups. What J.C. & B.E.B. accomplish on "Tough All Over" is an album of various styles, most of which could hardly be considered derivative of The Boss, thank you. Cafferty writes with an ear to many styles. He travels down the same highways. Under the influence, he weaves from shoulder to shoulder peakin' through the rearview mirror all-the-while. Besides the hot new single, TOUGH ALL OVER, check out VOICE OF AMERICA'S SONS, C-I-T-Y, SMALL TOWN GIRL, STRANGERS IN PARADISE, and TEX MEX (CRYSTAL BLUE).

Supertramp - "Brother Where You Bound" (A&M)
Back...with a vengeance. With only Richard Davies remaining now from the first edition of this band (1970) you'd expect things to have changed. Actually the transition hasn't been that radical except 1) The late 70's saw them move from artistic self-indulgence to a pop single sensibility and 2) They hit a creative slump with "Famous Last Words"-their most recent album. But like the little tightrope walker on the cover of that infamous album, they got back up and they're in fine form once again. They don't seem to miss the departed Roger Hodgson. Davies can handle the vocals. The mix is hot. The songs are crisp, albumy and more symetrical than before. The artwork on the album cover is exceptional (fresh, clean and creative). Must be played to be heard! Superstuff. CANNONBALL and STILL IN LOVE lend them self to the short & sweet formatics of most radio, while they move heaven and earth with BROTHER WHERE YOU BOUND (aided by Pink Floyd's David Gilmour on guitar).

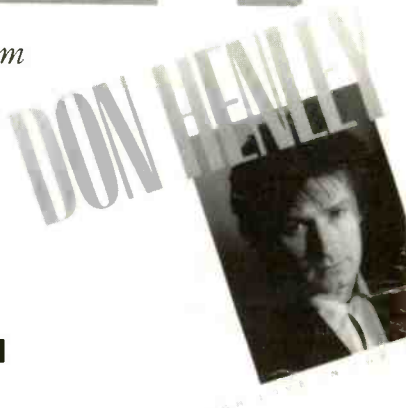
