# RADIO STATS

OUR RELATIVE CHARTING, AS SEEN BELOW, RESEMBLES BASEBALL'S BATTING AVERAGES. IT ESTABLISHES A RATIO BETWEEN THE IDEAL, (HEAVY AIRPLAY AT EVERY STATION WHICH REPORTED); AND THE WEIGHTED COUNT THAT A RECORDING HAS ACTUALLY EARNED. THIS MATHEMATICAL FORMULA IS APPLIED TO EACH RECORD—FIRST REGIONALLY, THEN NATIONALLY. A DUAL WEIGHTING SYSTEM IS USED TO DERIVE THE COUNT. IT ADJUSTS FOR MARKET SIZE AND FOR HEAVY OR MODERATE AIRPLAY. THESE CHARTS SHOW THE RELATIVE INTENSITY OF RADIO AIRPLAY FOR BOTH NEW AND ESTABLISHED RECORDINGS.

Performing mostly unreleased material, Elvis strummed out overpowering, brazen chords (with a tremelo bar), rather than the supportive licks used on his Lp. His words were drowned out, but his message wasn't. The album's endearing embitterment was replaced by an intense feeling of hatred, largely aimed at the audience. At one point, Elvis cruelly threatened to smash the lens of a nearby photographer with his mike stand. Tension lasted even after the band had stormed off the stage, their instruments still blaring. There was no encore. Maybe Elvis fears he'll lose his artistic integrity unless he totally disregards his audience. Or maybe he thinks he can attract a following by playing hard to get.

## CHANGES & REFLECTIONS

It is hard for us to believe that this issue marks Walrus' ninth anniversary. That this journal has come out every other week for nine years is a feat we are both proud of and awed by.

If you have found this CONCEPTS, there is no doubt that you have stumbled onto some changes we have made in our format. They are the continuing finishing touches on the major format change which we made last January. Our new back page is an answer to the one constant criticism by the music people who felt that the review section had been buried. We hope that these adjustments meet with your approval.

\* \* \* \* \*

Further reflection on last year makes us more convinced that it was a major time of adjustment.

When you think that the radicals of the sixties are well into their 30's, having settled into the mainstream of American life, and that the children of Woodstock are now married with kids, it is not surprising that the 18 year old relates less and less to them.

Further, since the focus of popular music has always been the 18 year olds, (they were the ones dancing in the aisles to big bands in the 30's and 40's) it stands to reason that music would again have to talk to its core audience, as it had in the past.

1977, it seems, was the year when the legacy of the 60's began to fade into a secondary role. It will never die, any more than big band jazz will, but it will be progressively less potent a force. 1977 was the year that a new wave began its ascent. More of the same for 1978.

## MERIT ALBUMS CONTINUED

- The Hometown Band/A & M SP 4671 (When it is right The Hometown Band's music is clean-cut and bright. Innocence pervades this Canadian band's sound while their material is consistently good. Not as hard as Heart.)
- Horslips/ALIENS/DJM DJLPA 16 (Couched in their classy, traditional music-gone-rock context, Horslips gets points at the start. Their play is expert and their songs good, though stronger lyrically than melodically.)
- The Jam/THIS IS THE MODERN WORLD/Polydor PD1-6129 (By maintaining the same tempo through 13 songs, some of The Jam charm gets lost. The insistence of their music tends to keep you involved in spite of counterpoint problems.)
- Kool & The Gang/THE FORCE/De-Lite DSR-9501 (They are not Parliament or Funkadelic but Kool & The Gang reach a step beyond the simple funk format. They are adventurous musically in some ways and they deserve credit for that. Well mounted. Distributed by Phonogram.)
- Ernie Krivda & Friends/Inner City 1031 (Getting by a terrible cover is a chore worth the effort. Ernie has a fiery spirit burning in him and it comes out through his music. Lots of rhythm powers as his saxophone cuts a curvilinear path.)
- Dave Snaker Ray/KID-MAN/Mountain Railroad MR 52780 (Dave is a blues player. His voice and guitar do it all. He is a very rhythmic player. But his presentation is on the esoteric side. It needn't be. You can hear how a small combo could help him. Dist. by Flying Fish.)
- Scruffs/WANNA MEET THE.../Power Play HLPP-5050 (Place Scruffs at about 1962 in England. Their music is pleasing and primitive but not so much in the punk sense. More in the early Beatles sense, as their LP title suggests, they are not nasty or threatening. Write: Box 4818, Memphis, Tenn. 38104.)
- Noel Paul Stookey/REAL TO REEL/New World NWS 090477 (Working in one effectively is a rare talent. Like Steve Goodman, Stookey is a seasoned folksy and humorist who can keep his audience enthralled effortlessly for a long set. Fine songs and in fine voice Paul captures the old days. Write: Sparrow Records, 8587 Canoga Ave., Canoga Park, Ca. 91304.)
- Various Artists/THE ALBUM PROJECT - 2/Brute Force Cybernetics 1002 (WEBN's second album to benefit Cincinnati's United Appeal is a success. It presents local musicians who reflect the thriving music scene in that city. Further, it helps a charity and the station too. Several standouts spark it. Write WEBN.)
- Cory Wells/TOUCH ME/A & M SP 4673 (As one of the powerful 3 Dog voices Cory Wells established himself in a collective sense. Here he solos. He does not write but, he chooses solid material. The production, like 3 Dog production, finds a hip pop groove. A standard approach.)
- Wondergap A & M SP 4674 (Wondergap is a new vehicle for Andy Goldmark. The production works at the best possible presentation for the given material. It's the material which averages things out. Whether lead by the male voice or the female voice, they have a way of making it sound hard to do. Other groups with more organic songs make music sound easy to do.)

## SATISFACTORY ALBUMS

(Albums of acceptable quality, which, of themselves, require only secondary progressive radio consideration.)

- Peter Brown/DO YOU WANNA GET FUNKY WITH ME? / Drive DR-104 (Half rock, half disco, Peter Brown wants it both ways. Actually, the context is less important than the fact that his tunes are not much to get excited about. As a whole the LP does not have a firm grasp of its own intentions, though it has moments. Side one is much stronger than side two.)

## FRINGE ALBUMS

(Good albums which are not progressive, yet hold some interest for progressive audiences.)

- Alessi/ALL FOR A REASON/A & M SP 4657 (Soft and creamy, the Alessi Brothers are 2nd degree romantics. It's a hip brand of softness, one which places them on the fringe fence. Side two is much harder and, hence, more appealing.)
- Barbara Carroll/FROM THE BEGINNING/United Artists UA LA 778-H (A classy, cool jazz combo album is up dated by sophisticated orchestrations. This recording's presence is also notable. Very well done. Stick with the unsweetened tracks.)
- Bill Evans/ALONE AGAIN/Fantasy F-9542 (Another eloquent statement from Bill Evans. His choice of material is the only question mark. It might have come from a hipper side of the music world. The idea of taking tunes from the middle of the road and giving them a jazz treatment seems archaic in a world where most everybody writes their own material.)

## FRINGE ALBUMS CONTINUED

- Jerry Fielding/SOUNDTRACK - THE GAUNTLET/Warner Bros. BSK 3144 (For a movie score there is lots of foreground music. Fielding's style is big band jazz with Jon Faddis and Art Pepper stepping out front. They both wait it at times. Solid, hot playing.)
- John Stowell/GOLDEN DELICIOUS/Inner City 1030 (Stowell takes his cues from the unobtrusive style of Jim Hall. Because he is a very quiet guitarist, it is sometimes hard to believe that John is this session's leader. Pleasant but, not very distinctive.)
- Bill Summers/CAYENNE/Prestige P 10103 (A couple Afro-Cuban instrumentals are the class of Bill's album. The rest tends to rely on worn R&B cliches. Though its all well turned out CAYENNE gets jazzy only part of the time.)
- T-Connection/ON FIRE/Dash 30008 (Though the thrust of T-Connection music is straight funk, no chaser, they are capable of writing real songs. Tunes like "Lady Of the Night," "Watching You" and "Cush" make them a group of concern.)
- Leonard R. Willis/SHE WON'T STAY/Tangerine AW-11008 (It's basic, non-production gives Willis' music an anemic quality. His singing is real country and his song selections are O.K. With the addition of some punch he might become an artist. Dist. by Album World, Nashville, Tenn.)
- Tim Winters/GOOD WOMAN BLUES/Fairlane AW-11009 (This record sounds like a demo but, it succeeds in demonstrating a good country singer's ability. He chooses good material too, most of the time. With a producer to cut out the crap and clean up the production values Tim Winters could be respectable. Dist. by Album World, Nashville, Tenn.)

- Steeleye Span/STORM FORCE TEN/Chrysalis CHR 1151 (Storm Force Ten flows in the pattern well established in other Steeleye albums. It is one of craft and inventive applications applied to traditional music. An exceptional presentation distinguishes their work here. Merit Plus.)
- Trickster/FIND THE LADY/Jet UAS 30132 (Like their label partner, E. L. O., Trickster uses big production techniques and heavy-handed electronics to create their individuality. Their songs are good, but not up to Jeff Lynne's and they lack his humor. Resultantly, they can sound overproduced where E. L. O. gets away with it. Merit.)

### SPECIAL MENTION ALBUMS

(These records which, in our opinion, deserve special mention because they come closest to perfecting their musical genre regardless of progressive radio application.)

(None.)

### STRONGLY MERITORIOUS

(We feel that these Lp's have an extra edge.)

Mtume/REBIRTH CYCLE/3rd Street TSJ100 (He takes risks. His music is at the avant edge of jazz and yet, unlike so many others in this space Mtume remains a melodic wellspring. It is the combination of African-rooted avant style and inspired melodies which raises his Lp above the crowd. It's artistic success aside, Rebirth Cycle is not the kind of thing rock stations will play heavily.)

Sea Level/CATS ON THE COAST/Capricorn GPN 198 (An upgraded Sea Level moves from a respectable band to a potent force. Two former Otis Redding drummers bottom the band giving side one a distinctive Allman Bros. feel. The second side pushes beyond. It is of a different character, more urbane and sophisticated, it gets very jazzy. Instrumentals and songs, Southern rock and jazz give Sea Level two faced clout.)

### MERIT PLUS ALBUMS

(All Merit and Merit Plus Albums are recommended for serious progressive radio consideration, recognizing that not all of these recommendations are suitable for all stations. The Merit Plus Albums distinguish themselves with an extra vitality.)

Herb Alpert - Hugh Masekela/A&M SP 728 (The story here is in the approach to rhythm. Stewart Levine, master of tight rhythms, keeps it inside and easy to digest. The African feel is limited to a little local color. Both Herb and Hugh have notable ears for good tunes so it is not surprising to hear several here. The Lp isn't as pop as Alpert has been or as advanced as Masekela has been. They make a nice combination. The Alpert economy of play contains it. Was Ralph Marteri the last one to record "Skokiaan?")

### MERIT PLUS ALBUMS CONTINUED

John Hartford/ALL IN THE NAME OF LOVE Flying Fish 044 (A man to be admired, Hartford has more raw talent as a musician and as a writer than most top artists have in either area. He makes it look easy. Coupled with a sly wit, he becomes a musical treasure. He gets the best out of these old Nashville hands.)

Horrell McGann/APRIL FOOL/Clouds CL 8802 (Driven both by an aggressive rhythm approach and an insistent vocal quality Horrell is a fresh wind in the singer/songwriter genre. Impressive writing establishes his credibility. Dist. by T.K. Records.)

Roomful of Blues/Island ILPS 9474 (Roomful of Blues recalls the pre-rock and roll 40's. Their music is decidedly urban and has the advantage of a pile of good jump tunes from which to choose. Joel Dorn is the perfect producer for this stylized, jazzy set. Fun.)

Third World/96° IN THE SHADE/Island ILPS 9443 (Though the commercial base for reggae may have evaporated, groups like Third World still maintain a high musical standard. The playing, the feel and their songs are consistently above the average level of craftsmanship.)

McCoy Tyner/INNER VOICES/Milestone M-9079 (Everything isn't "Opus," which drives insistently, but McCoy places himself at the upper level of jazz because he charts his own course. His integration of voices and orchestra with the combo is unique while his sense of melody is superior.)

### MERIT ALBUMS

Companion/ON THE LINE/Sleepy Eye COMP 1001 (Their first two super songs will blow you away. After them the melodies and arrangements settle into a nice but, less inspired pattern. Then you begin to hear the second class recording quality. Still, Companion makes itself highly desirable. Write: 200 Gregory Lane, Pleasant Hill, Ca.)

Crack the Sky/SAFETY IN NUMBERS/Life-song JZ 35041 (Precision is the consistent element uniting all of Crack the Sky's work. Like Kansas and Yes, they like to show off their ability to handle complexity. That can get in the way of solid linear melodies. Tunes like "Long Nights" and "A Night On the Town" transcend that potential problem especially well.)

Double Image/Inner City 3013 (Similar to much of the music heard on ECM, Double Image plays in an airy style. Too mallet players, vibes and marimba, pound out the warm enticing and sometimes abstract sounds. Their melodies are usually good but not memorable.)
