# RADIO STATS

OUR RELATIVE CHARTING, AS SEEN BELOW, RESEMBLES BASEBALL'S BATTING AVERAGES. IT ESTABLISHES A RATIO BETWEEN THE IDEAL, (HEAVY AIRPLAY AT EVERY STATION WHICH REPORTED); AND THE WEIGHTED COUNT THAT A RECORDING HAS ACTUALLY EARNED. THIS MATHEMATICAL FORMULA IS APPLIED TO EACH RECORD—FIRST REGIONALLY, THEN NATIONALLY. A DUAL WEIGHTING SYSTEM IS USED TO DERIVE THE COUNT. IT ADJUSTS FOR MARKET SIZE AND FOR HEAVY OR MODERATE AIRPLAY. THESE CHARTS SHOW THE RELATIVE INTENSITY OF RADIO AIRPLAY FOR BOTH NEW AND ESTABLISHED RECORDINGS.

# CONCEPTS

## HYPES ARE LITTLE SENSATIONS GROWN UP

Common among the complaints which musicians have against record companies is the notion that the company could have done more to help the band make it. This re-occurring theme is the reason many artists insist that guarantees of trade ads and other promotional efforts be spelled out in their contracts. Only musicians or managers with clout can get those kinds of provisions. Most others would like to have them.

The underlying suspicion really grows out of a misunderstanding of how a record company, especially a major company, usually works. And about how hype usually works.

It might save lots of aggravation if record companies would explain to its signees the run-them-up-the-flagpole philosophy which is commonly employed in the business. It should be explained that every record is not a "work" record. That only those records which get saluted are gone after with the full force of company commitment. If

this was explained thoroughly so that an artist knew that the response to a record is the triggering mechanism, pain and anguish would be relieved.

About the word hype. It should be explained and understood that hype only works after the fact. Hype, before the fact, is almost always a negative. It was at the time of his first LP when Clive Davis was quoted as saying that Springsteen was the new Dylan. That statement inadvertently set Bruce's career back several years. The audience and many media people adopted a show-me attitude.

It is only hype after the fact which tends to broaden response. All of the hype disco music is now getting is only effective because disco's are happening, Saturday Night Fever is hot and Arthur Murray Dance Studios are busy again. Hypes can make big sensations out of small sensations. However, the combustion must be spontaneous.

Great musicians are often rather naive about how things work. Some discussion up front might save time later.

## FRINGE ALBUMS

(Good albums which are not progressive, yet hold some interest for progressive audiences.)

- Karen Alexander/VOYAGER/Asylum 6E-130 (Karen Alexander sings in a low resolution style. Her approach is soft. That requires some sharp edged arranging, some punch to contrast with the mellow. She does not get it from Pete Robinson's diffuse arrangements. Resultantly, the album, even in a hip MOR sense, washes out too often. The material is okay but, didn't get its best shot.)
- Bombers/West End WE 104 (Rock-disco, as opposed to the standard R&B-disco, is the music made on the Bombers' album. Clean production and solid playing help to keep it a possibility especially in a production studio.)
- Norman Connors & The Starship Orchestra/THIS IS YOUR LIFE/Arista AB 4177 (Jazzy disco and lush soul sounds are the Norman Connors turf. He gives his old jazz allies one track, "The Creator Has a Master Plan" which features the raw edged Pharoah Sanders sax.)
- Raul De Souza/DON'T ASK MY NEIGHBORS/Capitol SW-11774 (A pleasant enough rhythm cruise. Raul's album fills in the background in a hip, modern way. It is tough for the trombone to be a forefront instrument because of its imprecise tone.)
- Farrell & Farrell/Newpax NP 33050 (A squeaky clean appearance and the word of God do not impair a pretty fair rockin' feel. The Farrell's songs are bright and airy and well written. Their Jesus lyrics are not forced.)
- Wayne Henderson/LIVING ON A DREAM/Polydor PD 1-6145 (It is probably not Wayne's fault that his bio claims he left the Crusaders because they weren't exploring "New Directions." Because if this is supposed to be the advancement it is a failure. Good for what it is, Henderson's LP is the same step-above-a-rhythm-track that the Crusaders churned out. So much for bios. The lesson is that enduring music is made with enduring melodies. This album doesn't stress melodies.)
- Paul Horn/DREAM MACHINE/Mushroom MRS-5010 (The produced Paul Horn is a low key mellow personage, just as was the spiritual Paul Horn. Lalo Schifrin's arrangements place the album in the hip background music class. A nice change of pace.)
- Pleasure/GET TO THE FEELING/Fantasy F-9550 (Seventy percent style and arrangements and twenty-five percent material is an unbalanced equation. The writing has to be better for this band to have any lasting reason to be. The production makes it acceptable.)
- Demis Roussos/Mercury SRM 1-3724 (Harnessed. The monster Demis voice is disguised in a production veil which lets just enough through to establish individuality. He sounds less like a European style singer than he has before but the arranging still keeps him on the rock fringes.)
- Various Artists/HOW THE WEST WAS ONE/Myrrh MSY-6598 (Rock and roll for God. This 3 record set documents the Western tour of 3 bands in a united "ministry." Together Phil Keaggy, The 2nd Chapter of Acts and a band called David make decent music all of which is laced with the word of the Lord. Suitable for Sunday morning.)
- Various Artists-Soundtrack/GREASE/RSO RS-2-4002 (Though pop throughout there might be a reason to play some music from the LP. The best music tracks are done by Barry Gibb and Sha Na Na. There is an overwhelming urge to dip into the original versions.)
- Various Artists-Soundtrack/THANK GOD IT'S FRIDAY/Casablanca NBLP 7099-DJ (More disco than your aching feet can take. Donna Summer's "With Your Love" stands out as something more than dance music. Watch-out for those beats per minute.)

- Alex De Grassi/TURNING: TURNING BACK/Windham Hill WHS C-1004 (Thoughtful, mildly complex and engrossing is the guitar music of Alex De Grassi. Captured here the man's music sounds good because of its innate quality and because of precise sonic qualities too.)
- Willie Nelson/STARDUST/Columbia JC 35305 (Without a doubt Willie Nelson gives these old tin pan alley songs the most honest reading they have gotten in years. He and Booker T. Jones have made another in a list of Willie Nelson masterworks. From a progressive radio stand point these songs are awfully difficult to get around. They must be played sparingly.)
- Mary O'Hara/AT THE ROYAL FESTIVAL HALL/Chrysalis CHR 1159 (Sentimentality is the main emotional theme in Mary O'Hara's sense of traditional music. Her lovely soprano is well suited to it. She sings an ancient MOR style.)

- Fuhrs & Frohling/AMMERLAND/Brain 0060.105 (Guitar and synthesizer together fill a pleasant instrumental space on the edge of the forefront/background music line. Their melodies are straightforward and their playing rather standard, not spacey. Enjoyable. Special Programming.)
- Jane/AGE OF MADNESS/Brain 0060.124 (The music of Jane isn't free and liberated. Though melodically all right, it feels rigid. The restraint is in the rhythm pulse and that inhibits enjoyment somewhat. Merit.)
- Pulsar/HALLOWEEN/CBS 82477 (With this piece Pulsar proves that symphonic rock music needn't be pompous. Halloween is grand scale music bolstered by synthesizers. The music is okay, though not always captivating. Merit.)
- Release Music Orchestra/BEYOND THE LIMIT/Brain 0060.115 (Here's an electronic jazz band with traditional roots. They are not fusionists in the true sense of that term. The groove is solidly rock influenced and filled with good tunes. Merit Plus.)
- Michael Rother/STERNTALER/Sky LP 013 (Pleasing instrumentals which conjure Big Country images fill Sterntaler. Synthesizer based, the tunes are arranged with an orchestra in mind. Notable tunes and the beat keep it interesting. Merit.)
- The Saints/ETERNALLY YOURS/Harvest SHSP 4078 (By comparison to the first Saints' LP, Eternally Yours is rather musical. The punk thrust now permits the listener to hear the tune - a few have some nice turns in them. All are audacious. Merit.)
- Various Artists/IMPERIAL ROCKABILLIES/U. A. UAS 30101 (This collection includes the original version of Robert Gordon's "Red Hot" among other treasures. Reissue.)

## MERIT PLUS ALBUMS CONTINUED

- Ben Sidran/A LITTLE KISS IN THE NIGHT/Arista AB4178 (The misfortune of Ben Sidran is that he often makes records too good for radio play, which says something sad. Ben's terrain is black music from any era, ancient to current. Somehow he ties together far flung ideas into cogent Lps. All of the man's instincts are pure.)
- Andrew Lloyd Webber/VARIATIONS/MCA 3042 (Considered an emissary from the devil in his day, Paganini is a perfectly appropriate starting point for Webber's Variations. Those tracks which capture the fire which was Paganini's also capture the spirit of rock and roll. Andrew Lloyd Webber's training sometimes interferes with his ability to touch the rock but, this Lp represents an effort which transcends petty squabbles.)

## MERIT ALBUMS

- Michael Bloomfield/COUNT TALENT & THE ORIGINALS/Clouds 8805 (Bloomfield can't make a bad album because he is so well rooted in the core music blues. However, he has not yet gotten it together to reach his potential. This Lp isn't the work of a unit. It is more like a various artists Lp which is loosely tied around the blues. A cohesive sound has to evolve if Michael is going to start making better than average records. Distributed by T.K.)
- Hank Bradley/MUSIC OF THE POISON COYOTE KID/Bay 303 (Bradley's mountain music has a light-hearted quality about it. It's good humor, even more than the skill demonstrated, is the basis of its appeal. Write: 1516 Oak St., Suite 320, Alameda, Ca. 94501.)
- Lisa Burns/MCA 2361 (Craig Leon's production mixes a new wave feel and Phil Spectorisms behind a genuine rock and roll lady. Though there is something undisciplined about this production it moves in the proper direction and gets a yes vote.)
- Cheap Trick/HEAVEN TONIGHT/Epic PE 35312 (An enthusiastic, dynamic performance is the key to appreciating Heaven Tonight. The writing is good but not more. If it were a few percentage points better the Trick would have even more value.)
- Climax Blues Band/SHINE ON/Sire SRK 6056 (Shine On glows sure and steady. Though they do not boil the juices Climax Blues Band maintains its journeyman status with this wholly secure issuance.)
- Duke Jupiter/SWEET CHEEKS/Mercury SRM 1-3718 (Though packaged like a disco Lp Duke Jupiter is more revealed by Chuck Leavell's name as producer. The band has a distinct southern feel in their rhythm section. Twin guitars also signal the south. Adequate songs provide the area where improvement would do the most.)
- Pete & Sheila Escovedo/HAPPY TOGETHER/Fantasy F-9545 (Their best album by far. Billy Cobham's production has pulled together a collection of exceptional tunes. The Lp is Latin, jazzy, funky and appealing. Some of the mixing creates questions and problems.)
- Aretha Franklin/ALMIGHTY FIRE/Atlantic SD 19161 (Only a singer with the forcefulness of Aretha could make the songs of Curtis Mayfield, another forceful character, her own. That's not to say that Curtis hasn't affected Aretha, because he has. She doesn't get the chance to explode her vocals as much as she used to. A dynamic duo.)
- Generation X/Chrysalis CHR 1169 (Clear distinctions become cloudier by the day. Here some new ravers start with John Lennon's "Gimme Some Truth" just when the movement was supposed to be away from that generation. Still, Generation X pounds out the classic punk audacity.)
- Garth Hewitt/LOVE SONG FOR THE EARTH/Myrrh MSB-6597 (With Dave Matlocks, Gordon Haskell and Bryn Haworth in his corner Garth lays down some substantial folk-rock Jesus music. In fact, the message is so well incorporated in Garth's songs that you won't feel preached to. Solid. Write: Word Records, Waco, Tex.)
- Doug Kershaw/THE LOUISIANA MAN/Warner Bros. BSK 3166 (Another in a long list of good Doug Kershaw Lps and another which contains "Louisiana Man." That's O.K. because the Lp also uses a fine selection of songs by outside writers too. Doug's voice seems to be a few degrees too far back in the mix.)
- Louisiana's Le Roux/Capitol SW-11734 (A commanding performance establishes Le Roux from the start. It also shines their decent songs in the best light. The formula is grooved; aggressive rockin' and vocal harmonies.)
- Marshall Tucker Band/TOGETHER FOREVER/Capricorn CPN 0205 (Their songs are O.K. but, it is when the Marshall Tucker Band shifts into their southern shuffle that the gear ratio gets critical. Another flowful Tucker success.)
- Bernie Mappin/MOONSCAPES/Mercury SRM 1-3717 (Moonscapes is not spacey. Instead it rides on grooved rhythms and is driven by Bernie's sometimes searing saxophones. He plays in the ensemble, as a contemporary soloist and as an avantist depending on the flow of things. Decent tunes run through the effort.)

## MERIT ALBUMS CONTINUED

- Moxy/UNDER THE LIGHTS/Mercury SRM 1-3723 (The discipline imposed on Moxy music by the production of Jack Richardson helps to make the band credible. Their sometimes childish songwriting gets its best shot because of the controls.)
- Pezband/LAUGHING IN THE DARK/Passport PB 9826 (A spirited Pezband issues a solid rock and roll album. Their performance is powerful without ever being excessive while their writing shows signs of developing real quality.)
- Pure Prairie League/JUST FLY/RCA AFL 1-2590 (Mild mannered. Pure Prairie League's cruise is made of pleasant songs and warm harmonies. Their playing is on the sparse side with a funkier rhythm feel than they are remembered for having. Good show.)
- Flora Purim/THAT'S WHAT SHE SAID/Milestone M-9081 (Fusionized and energized, on That's What She Said, Flora steps out. Some strong performances add credence to it. Yet, there is something melodically off center which works against the grain of the album. For her devotees.)
- Scarlet Rivera/SCARLET FEVER/Warner Bros. BSK3174 (The mystery and the emotion which Scarlet projected in Dylan's "Hurricane" has never been regenerated. Her music does not establish an individual identity. It sounds like everything else. Rivera is both defeated and saved by the production.)
- Seals & Crofts/TAKIN' IT EASY/Warner Bros. BSK 3163 (Their music is creamy and arranged now. Still, that special vocal harmony which identifies Seals & Crofts spills through. They seem to be writing a higher percentage of good songs these days.)
- Stanky Brown/Sire SRK 6053 (A clean production brings the Stanky Brown message into sharp focus. Their mild rockin' feel fits comfortably while it doesn't rock the boat. O.K.)
- Television/ADVENTURE/Elektra 6E-133 (Fractionally less primitive than their first album. Hence, this Adventure is less of an adventure and probably more broadly based in its appeal. The Lp's beautiful mounting has an appeal of its own.)
- The Domenico Troiano Band/THE JOKE'S ON ME/Capitol SW-11772 (Lots of movement creates the impression that something's happening. To properly support the image some better songs were needed. Adequacy in that department requires Dom's guitar to save it.)
- Townes Van Zandt/FLYIN' SHOES/Tomato TOM-7017 (The melancholy folk, Townes Van Zandt demands that his audience come to him. His introverted style requires a lot but, is rewarding to those willing to pursue the flow. Nice tunes.)
- Richard Wagner/Atlantic SD19172 (Start with the stronger side two. It has personality and strong songs, two elements which side one glosses over. Front side emphasis is on production size rather than substance. Side two is Merit Plus level work.)
- Michael Wendroff/KISS THE WORLD GOODBYE/Ariola America SW 50030 (Wisely Michael augments his own adequate writing with a few outside classics. His own songs suffer from a percussive, rather than flowing, rhythm approach. The art school cover could have been improved upon too.)
- Robin Williamson & Merry Band/AMERICAN STONEHENGE/Flying Fish 062 (The articulate statement of purpose is worth reading in order to fully appreciate Robin's ideas and music. In that regard, his own music has the disadvantage of not being time-tested as is the music of his Celtic heritage. It is when he is able to get off a tune like "Pacheco" the vision gets closer to realization.)

## SATISFACTORY ALBUMS

- (Albums of acceptable quality, which, of themselves, require only secondary progressive radio consideration.)
- Mike Johnson/MORE THAN JUST AN ACT/Newpax NP 33043 (Too often the Christian message which Mike is compelled to deliver gets hung up in the delivery system. As has been said before, words cannot be forced into a melody and result in a flowful song. The opening and closing tracks on side one work best.)
- Roger Vondouris/Warner Bros. BSK 3154 (Roger's writing labors, as it has in the past. That undermines any appreciation of other aspects of his music. A middle weight rock feel neither mellows out or explodes. Outside material would help. The instrumental, "We're Out Of Time" moves best.)
- Joyce Yarrow/JUMPING MOUSE/Pacific Arts PAC 7-109 (A pretty soprano, which can bend toward either Joni or Maria, and clean production usually reaches higher than this Jumping Mouse. However, in this case Joyce's not-quite-ready songwriting puts a drag on the project.)

(These records which, in our opinion, deserve special mention because they come closest to perfecting their musical genre regardless of progressive radio application.)

### STRONGLY MERITORIOUS

(We feel that these Lp's have an extra edge.)

The Band/THE LAST WALTZ/Warner Bros 3WS-3146 (For those who were there this album must be magical, evoking memories of the moment. For the rest of us the album has the aura of a happy class reunion. Whether an 18 year old radio listener would fully understand the event embodied here is in question. But, the joyous music is undeniable.)

Todd Rundgren/HERMIT OF MINK HOLLOW/Bearsville BRK 6981 (The density of Todd's music seems to be in inverse proportion to the number of players. Since he played all of the parts himself you can imagine how crowded the Lp is. But, Hermit Of Mink Hollow has something else going for it. That is, a collection of songs finer than any Todd has released before. Quality track follows quality track. A tour de force.)

### MERIT PLUS ALBUMS

(All Merit and Merit Plus Albums are recommended for serious progressive radio consideration, recognizing that not all of these recommendations are suitable for all stations. The Merit Plus Albums distinguish themselves with an extra vitality.)

The Alpha Band/THE STATUE MAKERS.. / Arista AB 4179 (Capable of writing fine songs, even important songs in terms of what they say, the Alpha Band stirs the juices. Their presentation could be under a bit more control but, as it is, those tunes come through resoundingly. A live album feel.)

Russ Ballard/AT THE THIRD STROKE / Epic JE 35035 (Each song has a big hook and each is arranged with a degree of majesty. Though it is not rough street rock, it is not pompous either. Top-notch pop music exudes from a meticulous production.)

### MERIT PLUS ALBUMS CONTINUED

Allan Clarke/I WASN'T BORN YESTERDAY / Atlantic SD 19175 (That an old trooper like Allan Clarke should write a line like "We need some new blood, the 21st century kind.." is curious. He hardens the sound around him to come out of the Hollies cocoon powerfully. Hit level writing puts him in competitive position.)

Jack Clement/ALL I WANT TO DO IN LIFE/Elektra 6E-122 (Representing the class of Nashville, Tenn. Jack Clement shows how to do it. Seemingly uncomplicated, he sings marvelous songs, set in an appealing and original musical soup. Tender and charming.)

Kraftwerk/THE MAN MACHINE/Capitol SW-11728 (That they helped us cross the emotional barrier to electronic music enshrines them. They continue to make music which is melodically enticing and which stays true to pure electronic sound. Kraftwerk is The Man Machine.)

Kevin Lamb/SAILING DOWN THE YEARS / Arista AB 4166 (Sailing Down The Years has the advantage of Kevin's consistent writing quality. Further, Gary Lyons gets an energetic performance out of the gathered players to enhance the project too.)

The Paley Brothers/Sire SRK 6052 (Pure pop. Some will say that The Paley Bros. represent a major problem in today's music. That is, the young players have to look backwards to find the truth. Their hip bubblegum music works because of superfine tunes and an avoidance of excess.)

Prince/FOR YOU/Warner Bros. BSK 3150 (Both a virtuoso and an originator Prince charts his own musical course. He comes out of a long R&B tradition - singing falsetto and writing graceful songs - yet, he is unlike anyone else. Well, maybe he is like an updated Smokey Robinson.)

Rank Strangers/Pacific Arts PAC 7-112 (Chris Darrow has a history of involving himself in quality musical enterprises. Rank Strangers is another one. Their music is more western than country and benefits from its pollution free presentation. Pretty. Notice that the designer's name is the only one readable. Write: Box 5547, Carmel, Ca. 93921.)

Gove Scrivenor/SHADY GOVE/Flying Fish FF 048 (Folksters will gather around Gove's album in groves. He distinguishes himself as a performer with a sense of the past, as a writer and as a song chooser. A top-notch folk music Lp results.)
