## NEW YORK AND LOS ANGELES

### NEW YORK

**ROCK DISCOS NEW APPLE TREND:** The term "rock 'n roll disco" may seem a bit incongruous to some, but this past year has seen the flowering of rock 'n roll clubs in New York City which feature a deejay spinning danceable new wave (and other) rock 'n roll records between acts: basically, applying the disco format to rock. The first such club was Hurrah, a converted disco which opened its doors to rock last fall — initially using personalities from local radio stations as deejays — and quickly became one of the city's most important new wave rock clubs. The success of the rock 'n roll disco format there led to the opening of the smaller, more exclusive, but equally successful Mudd Club last winter. This summer has seen at least two more clubs with similar policies open their doors, Tomato and Heat, which held its grand opening last week and flaunted a Studio 54-type "pecking order" entrance policy. At least one more rock 'n roll disco is scheduled to start operating in the near future.

Whether this trend will mean anything in areas outside of New York City remains to be seen. Nevertheless, the fact that rock 'n roll discos have caught on so quickly and are currently thriving and expanding here, bears noting and watching.

**FIXIT:** Jerry Wexler, wrongly listed here as the executive producer on the new Dylan LP is really a very active co-producer of same with Barry Beckett. Apologies to J.W. and raspberries to the misinformer.

**MOVIES, MOVIES?:** Elvis Costello makes his film debut next month in *AMERICATHON*, a film about a time in the future when the U.S. is forced to hold a telethon to raise enough money to save America from falling into the hands of a jogging clothes and running shoes manufacturer who holds a mortgage on the country. The film, which also stars Meat Loaf, John Ritter and Harvey Korman, will feature a new Costello composition, "Crawling from the U.S.A." — written, incidentally, before his last American tour! The soundtrack LP, featuring Costello, Meat Loaf and others, will be available later this summer on Columbia.

**NEW LOOKS:** Little River Band has announced the name of their new bassist, replacing George McArdle, who left earlier this year to pursue religion. He's Barry Sullivan, a top studio musician in the band's native Australia. Sullivan joins the band in time for their fourth U.S. tour this August. LRB's fourth album, *FIRST UNDER THE WIRE*, co-produced by John Boylan and the band, is due in

late July. Meanwhile, the Kinks are sporting a new keyboard player, Ian Gibbons, on their current U.S. tour.

**TIDBITS:** Tycoon had to cancel their summer tour when lead guitarist Mark Kreider broke his arm while roller skating on the closed down section of the West Side Highway here . . . The Rumour's Martin Belmont joined Rockpile on stage at their Dr Pepper Festival appearance opening for Blondie . . . Bay City Rollers, in town for Nassau Coliseum gig, say their new LP, *ELEVATOR*, is the first they've had complete creative control over, and will be different from past Rollers outings . . .

**IN THE STUDIO:** Ex-New York Dolls/Criminals Sylvain Sylvain, recently inked to RCA, is at the Power Station, with Tony Bongiovi producing his first solo LP . . . Arista's Willie Nile getting set to record his vinyl debut . . . Geils producing themselves at Longview Studios in Massachusetts . . . In London, Fabulous Poodles working on a second Epic LP with Muff Winwood, and Clash finishing up soundtrack to a film called *Rude Boy* . . . Recent Epic signing Frankie El Dorado producing his debut disk at the Hit Factory.

**COMING SOON:** From Arista in early August come the A's debut, produced by Rick Chertoff; Theives' *YUCATAN*, produced by Mike Chapman, and Jeff Lorber Fusion's *WATER SIGN*. Later in the month come debuts from Angela Boffill, Jay Hoggard and The Pop! . . . EMI's got Breathless's debut coming July 30; Zwol's *EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY* due August 13; with Kate Bush's *LIONHEART* and the new Geils in September . . . UA releases the Dirt Band's *AMERICAN DREAM* and Fischer Z's *WORD SALAD* on August 13, with Ronnie Hawkins' *HAWK* and a new Whitesnake due in September . . . The Sinceros, formerly Lene Lovich's back-up band, debut in late August on Columbia with *SOUND OF SUN BATHING*, produced by Joe Wissert . . . Chip Mergott debuts on London August 1. London also releasing two more "Collectors' Series" LP's on August 15; a Zombies and a Thin Lizzy . . . Alan Parsons Project's *EVE* due mid-summer on Arista . . . Ian Lloyd's *GOOSE BUMPS* in August on Scotti Brothers.

### LOS ANGELES

**BUGS BUNNY TO BUY BMWs?:** Bob Marley & The Wailers August-expected *SURVIVAL* LP will be the reggae/rock star's final album under his current contract with Island Records. While Capitol was said to be in the running, it

looks now as though Marley's management is in the process of closing a deal with Island's distributor, Warner Bros, which will see future BMW works released on the Warners label proper.

**BUGS GETS CODE BLUE:** Last ish, CBS and Warners were neck and neck to ink local rockers Code Blue. Well, Warners has 'em, and not surprisingly since frontman Dean Chamberlain, once a Motel (now signed to Capitol), used to be employed by the Warner Bros. A&R department. Word has it that staff producer Ted Templeman (Van Halen, The Doobie Brothers, Nicolette Larson) will be involved with the project, perhaps as Executive Producer.

**MORE FRESH INK:** British band Eddie & The Hot Rods have signed with EMI/United Artists . . . Capitol has acquired Pyramid, a ten-piece aggregation of soul/jazz/rockers from L.A. . . . Former Stone Pony Shep Cooke has pacted with Sierra/Briar Records. His *CONCERT TOUR OF MARS* is due in September. . .

**LOUDON WAINWRIGHT TO RADAR:** Recently dropped by Arista, Loudon Wainwright has been inked to British-based Radar Records (home of E. Costello, N. Lowe and B. Tchaikovsky). Does this mean that Polydor, who has first option on all Radar product coming from o'erseas, will be releasing the new Wainwright disc when it's ready?

**NEW TRACKS DOWN THE TRACKS:** Upcoming releases include Randy Newman's *BORN AGAIN*, Utopia's *ADVENTURES IN UTOPIA* and Britishers Vapour Trails' debut all from Warners in August . . . Lorimar Records (distributed through CBS) has their soundtrack to *AMERICATHON* due in August, featuring songs from Eddie Money, Elvis Costello, The Beach Boys, Nick Lowe and Meat Loaf . . . Polydor/Radar will issue the Yachts debut in August, with two tracks not available on the U.K. edition. Polydor has the new Rainbow album ready, *DOWN TO EARTH*, Roger Glover reuniting with Ritchie Blackmore. And, in August, Golden Earring's U.S. Polydor debut . . . Antilles Records (the Island subsidiary usually distributed by Gem) is releasing a Kim Fowley studio LP titled *SNAKE DOCUMENT MASQUERADE 1980-1989* . . . From Elektra/Asylum: John Fogerty's *HOO DOO*, Richie Furay's *SATISFIED* and Jerry Jeff Walker, all in September. The Eagles' *THE LONG RUN* is also slated for an early Autumn release . . . Columbia's September slew includes Kris Kristofferson, Jules & The Polar Bears, Mary Kay Place, Weather Report and Karla Bonoff . . .

Arista has Iggy Pop's *NEW VALUES* due in August.

**IN THE STUDIO:** Producer John Boylan is working with Epic act Trillion in L.A. . . . Shoes are recording their debut *PRESENT TENSE* with Queen engineer Mike Stone in England . . . Quiet Fire, a new RCA band, recording with Clarence McDonald at Golden Sound . . . 20/20 are putting the finishing touches on their Earl Mankey-produced Epic debut at Sound City . . . REO Speedwagon at Kendun recorders . . . The Dwight Twilley Band are at Salty Dog Studios with Bob Schaper shaping things up. Also recently at Salty Dog: Phil Spector working with The Ramones . . . Wowii, an East Coast act recently contracted to Elektra/Asylum, recording their debut in N.Y. . . . Paul Butterfield is at Spectrum Studios with ex-Band member Garth Hudson producing.

**RADICAL FRINGE NEWS:** Some short snips of U.K. punkdom — Polydor is releasing Sham 69's *THAT'S LIFE* over here in August, while lead singer/guitarist Jimmy Pursey is said to be leaving Sham to form a new group with the Sex Pistols' Paul Cook and Steve Jones. Meanwhile, The Damned, who recently toured the U.S., played to packed throngs at L.A.'s Whiskey Au Go Go. The quiet, retiring British foursome hurled fans from the stage head first (one, a girl who had taken off her clothes in front of Captain Sensible), and smashed whiskey bottles over the enraptured audience's respective heads. The paramedics were called three times during one night's set.

**ODDS & ENDS:** Producer Mike Chapman, very hot with The Knack, Blondie, Exile, Nick Gilder, etc., is set to produce the upcoming Tanya Tucker disc . . . Bram Tchaikovsky will tour the States in September with new member, guitarist Dennis Forbes . . . Belgian crooner Plastic Bertrand has recorded The Four Seasons' "Walk Like A Man" — in English . . . Jackson Browne, Linda Ronstadt, Bonnie Raitt, Nicolette Larson, Emmylou Harris and the Little Feat Band are set to do a special tribute to Lowell George at L.A.'s Forum on August 4th. Money from box office receipts will go to George's widow and three children.

**THE KNACK, AND HOW TO KNOCK THEM:** During their recent gig in San Francisco, The Knack were greeted by a faction of the lively crowd joined together under a "Nuke The Knack" banner. The anti-Knack folks wore large plastic noses in the image of singer Doug Fieger and hurled objects at the L.A. band throughout their show . . . People either love or hate these guys — choose your side.

# HOWARD SHORE



Shore has proven himself to be one of the most straight forwardly intelligent judges of what is relevant . . .

**W**hen Howard Shore is amused he does not laugh but rather lets out repressed snickers like some snot-nosed kid whose big kick in life comes from burning insects under a magnifying glass on hot summer days. This is Shore's benignly subversive sensibility, the same outlook on life that drives him to place a copy of Lawrence Welk's autobiography "AH ONE AH TWO" under a poster of Elvis Costello in his office. As musical director of Saturday Night Live, Shore is obliged to indulge in delightful absurdism, but in his choice of musical acts for the show, over the course of four seasons, Shore has proven himself to be one of the most straight forwardly intelligent judges of what is relevant to the show's target college dorm audience.

In his attitude and demeanor,

Shore himself is very Joe College. As he bops around the NBC executive offices, playing with his yachting cap and searching for loose joints he seems eternally preppie; well in keeping with the National Lampoon humor level of the show, aimed (intentionally or not) at those pseudo-smart-ass "Yalies" Ann Landers is always bitching about. For Shore's part, the music too is often hipply obscure (even better if ethnic), Los Angeles laid back (even going to the extreme of Leah Kunkel in one case), or trendily "intellectual." That means Sun Ra chosen over Eno in the first category and Talking Heads taken over The Ramones in the last. But on the positive side, like the freest radio programmer imaginable, Shore has brought spontaneity and unpredictability to T.V. rock. In a medium filled

with human Sominex tablets like Don Kirshner, Shore stands alone in bringing respectable rock to everyone's favorite piece of talking furniture.

Another of the best aspects of SNL's musical bookings is that new acts, about to break, either in the press or on the charts, are often given time. Big breaks have been given to Devo, Talking Heads, Leon Redbone, Rickie Lee Jones and others. "We act like a newspaper here," says Shore on the show's timeliness. "A lot of acts aren't booked until the week they're on. That way we keep current. With something like Devo, we got them before anyone even knew who they were. Rickie Lee Jones was perfect timing. We got her just as she was gonna break to the top. I think it might have been bad for her to be on though. She's not fully

developed as a performer yet and too many people see this show for that not to matter. It's super-high exposure and people could call it hype to see her on so soon and then have the album fly up the charts. I don't know if she's ready for that yet as an artist. She may have turned some people off because she's so stylized now."

Shore likes to have new artists on, but the basic philosophy behind his choosing process is fairly random. "We get an act by my whims and what I think is different and interesting. I would like to have The Plasmatics on." (a New York band with a lead singer who, at various times, scratches her snatch, eats the drum kit, and Texas chainsaws a Gibson into splinters). "But I don't think we could get them past

## ANALYSIS

### BY GEORGE MEIER

Soaring to the top of radio play is The Knack. Quite a story is built into their success when you think that two months ago they were unknown. More amazing is the quick public acceptance of the group. While they are the number 1 radio group, they are the number 3 retail group. For a new name to get that level of penetration is wonderful.

The proof of how difficult it is to translate radio play into sales action can be seen below:

The turntable hit syndrome is more understandable with the newer names than with the more established ones. That only emphasizes the uniqueness of the response surrounding The Knack. Even Dire Straits and Rickie Lee didn't show up that fast.

Some positively weird sales patterns also show up. They are weird in that they require another issue for confirmation. Dire Straits dies in the Northeast and the Midwest while maintaining well in the South and West. Wings softens in the Midwest while Neil Young and Charlie Daniels Band weaken in the Northeast. Finally, Bad Co. collapses in the West. These things seem unnatural.

The Radio Action Chart shows Billy Thorpe coming back from the dead while The Kinks and The Knack show real life too. Their vitality is confirmed by the New and Established Songs listings.

Finally, while the Retail Futures chart doesn't look too healthy, the Radio Futures chart is crowded with the next generation of chart makers. They just keep coming.

Not only did she make a second rare appearance here in one month, but at a guitar shop no less! And unlike her whisky sets, powerful though they were, this was a solo performance! - and for that reason it was just that much more intense. At one point she reduced the crowd to real tears in a performance of her "Valley of the Kings" (dedicated to Charles Manson?!). Nico always seems to stress audience participation beyond its accepted boundaries. More than stress it, she virtually wills it. As always she is in complete control.  
 As for David Blue, he should stick to playing pinball in 4 hour Dylan movies (Renaldo & Clara is Blue's high point), but even his boring tough-cynical-folkie image and tired Leonard Cohen jokes could not dampen the power of the poetic high priestess of our subconscious universe as she unveiled new material (from her next album, promised for September - DRAMA OF EXILE) and past classics. Nico is an original, as exceptional as any artist in our midst who reveals to us the myth, the authenticity of the passion of our own lives.

the censors."

Shore claims one of his chief criteria in choosing acts is to keep up a high level of diversity. "I don't want all top forty acts," he says. "That would give us better ratings but I'm not interested in that right now. This way I can bring anything to people's attention regardless of how uncommercial it is. We had Sun Ra on once. When he was blowing away, people were literally frightened. Thousands of people shut off their T.V.'s and started calling us up and cursing us out. It was scary. I'm glad we did it, though. As least we got a reaction. We also had Ornette Colman on once and alot of people found that hard to deal with. He did long numbers and we had to cut them. He was nice to put up with that."

Shore's love of particularly perverse diversity, though, does not extend to disco or the heavy metal bands like Aerosmith or Kiss. It simply wouldn't fit the show's Princeton Lacoste shirt sensibility, yet Shore prefers to offer the excuse: "We don't have a large enough stage for the more theatrical groups like that. We did have the Stones on, though. That was the first show of this last season and it was probably the most exciting thing we've ever done on the show. Patti Smith was awfully loud and heavy metal. She's the loudest person we've ever had on. The sound was terrible



actually. We had some problems with Patti. She wanted to read a poem, Easter, and it was censored. She was nice about it and agreed to do 'My Generation' instead. Anyway, at the end of the number the band did a thing where they kick over all the instruments and start breaking them. The problem was that the band had come in late since they were on the road and they didn't have time to rehearse so the camera men didn't know what to expect. Now these camera men are old professionals who've been working in these studios since about 1950. Anyway, when the drummer started kicking over the drum set the camera

guys thought it was the band getting back at NBC for censoring Patti's poem. There's no time delay on our program so the camera men got pretty nervous as it is. They kept on trying to frame the shots away from whoever was smashing an instrument until the only thing left was Patti's mouth and that's the image they ended with. It was hysterical."

On a live show like this, these sort of things happen all the time, especially when you've got predictably un-predictable types like Elvis Costello on. "Elvis was great," Shore beams. "He had rehearsed two songs and when he started his second he was five

seconds into it and he suddenly stopped and said, 'I don't have to play this song. Nobody tells me what to play.' Nobody had told him what to play, that's the annoying part. Then he went into 'Radio, Radio'. It didn't do him any good at all since the camera guy who was directing it was thrown off and couldn't do any good visual effects."

Much more disturbing was the incident with Brian Wilson, who did a solo gig on one of the first SNL shows. "Brian Wilson was under the care of Dr. Landee then," Shore explains. "He brought Brian to New York. Brian decided to perform 'Good Vibrations' on the show, singing only his part of the song. No one could figure out what he was doing. It was a terrible idea to let him do it but Brian related this to Gershwin doing 'Rhapsody In Blue'. Brian's favorite composer is Gershwin and 'Good Vibrations' was Brian's 'Rhapsody In Blue' — his greatest song. Gershwin apparently would play 'rhapsody' alone on the piano. So once Brian was into the idea, there was no turning him around. He went out and did it and it was terrible. About half way through Landee came up to me, when we were on the air, and said 'this has to be the most embarrassing moment of our lives. This is going out to ten million people.' I tried to calm Landee down. I said, 'don't worry, it's actually going out to 14 million.'"

"During the rehearsals for the show I could see this was

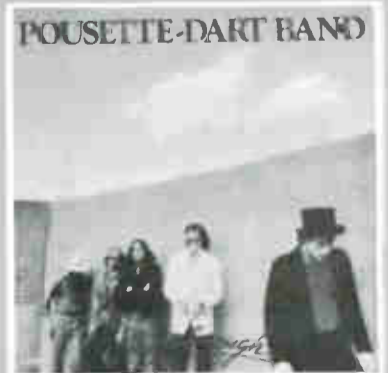

coming. Brian had me over to his hotel room one day and I came in to see him lying on the bed trying to read the lyrics to 'Good Vibrations' off cue cards held up by a little kid. He could barely do it."

As Shore relates the story, I find myself wondering why I don't hear phrases like, "I felt so bad for him," or "I was so embarrassed." Confronted with this, Shore simply states: "It was one of my first shows. I wasn't prepared to deal with problems like Brian Wilson's."

It's attitudes like this that have caused many critics to view SNL as a kind of modern day Theater Of Cruelty. The major difference between truly brilliant nihilist comedy and the pseudo-sort of SNL is that while the former involves a sense of self-indictment and truly transcendent self-deprecation, Michael O'Donahue's crew are never made vulnerable; never indicated in the snickering humor they present. Another musical scene some people took offense at was Belushi's epileptic imitation of Joe Cocker, when Cocker himself was on the show. Shore was puzzled by all the shouting. "Cocker knew that was going to happen. I don't think he was embarrassed. Belushi may have been sorry but I don't think he apologized to Cocker and anyway, imitation is the sincerest form of flattery."

It should come as no surprise, then, that Shore, fitting so snugly into the SNL consciousness, contributes to the skit writing, especially in the musical parodies, such as the recent send-up of The Village People. "I was surprised we got away with that," Shore giggles. "I was sure we were going to be sued. We did a whole song I wrote called 'Bend Over Beethoven.' I played the cowboy in the group. I was so glad to get on T.V. I'm really a frustrated comedian. We were going to dig into The Village People much further than we did. I originally had all these references to K-Y Jelly and stuff like that but we figured it would never get by the censors. . . . We had some suit problems once with a Mickey Mouse parody called Rickie Rat. The Disney people are notorious for suing. We had three NBC lawyers in here listening to the skit. They just sat quietly, didn't laugh, nodded their heads and said, 'okay'. That was it. Also, when we did the 'I Love Sodom' song to the theme of 'I Love New York', the composer of the 'I Love New York' jingle wanted to sue. We sang it accapella and wound up getting out of it that way."

Another idea of Shore's was The Blues Brothers, which he is proud of despite accusations, by



some critics, of subtle artistic racism, due to the dangerously un-bluesy and un-emotive singing of Belushi and Ackroyd. "Belushi wanted to sing in a bad way," Shore says. "It was a great dream of his. I arranged all the material and got the band together. At first it was just a small project. We had no idea it would become a major musical act."

Shore often plays the role of arranger and general yenta of the show, even bringing together such diverse performers as Linda Ronstadt, Phoebe Snow and Robert Fripp on one recent outing. "The two of them (Phoebe and Linda) came to me and said they wanted to be on together but they had no idea what to perform or how to go about it. That was an insane week of work. That's my job at its hardest. Some acts come in all prepared with their own arrangements and others leave it all up to me. . . . We immediately went into rehearsals (with Linda and Phoebe). They wound up doing The Roches' 'Married Men' and even flew in Robert Fripp from Stockholm to do his Frippertronics."

Actually The Roches themselves were supposed to be on the last show of this past season but another musical guest, Bette Midler wouldn't hear of it. "She demanded they be taken off," Shore reveals. "She simply didn't want another musical act on."

Other problems Shore has had with performers came with The

Stylistics who insisted on breaking SNL's un-written no-lip-synch policy, Earth, Wind And Fire who refused to be on the show because, according to Shore, they wouldn't be allowed to use any special added tapes, and Labelle, who were the only act ever to cancel out on the show. "They claimed it was due to illness," Shore sneers. "I don't know but I always thought the show must go on, no matter what."

Another, less annoying problem was when Hugh Hefner was host. "Hef" (as the chi-chi call him) wanted to do a musical lounge singer type number, accompanying himself with piano, plus the backup band. "When he got on the show 'Hef' was so self-conscious and so aware of the audience that he totally ran away from the band. He was playing miles ahead of them and finally the band just phased itself out and let him finish on his own. The funny thing was the whole time 'Hef' didn't even notice there was a problem. In fact, when he did his 25th anniversary Playboy special on T.V. this year he did the same song and requested the same arrangement including the playing out of synch with the band. I saw a tape of the show and thought it was hysterical. It was totally off and he didn't even know and he liked it that way."

Shore has had a long background to help him cope with such problems calmly, starting out in the snoozeable province of hometown Toronto. "I worked with some comedy

shows up there — Second City Television," Howard explains. "I also worked with the band Lighthouse (who had a hit with 'One Fine Morning'). That was insane, being with them. We were on the road constantly and I was stoned constantly. I was really losing my mind. It took me a full year to get over it after I left the band. From there I came to New York and I knew Lorne Michaels from before. We kept on bumping into each other and gradually the show came together and he offered me the job."

One of Shore's first duties as musical director was to put the Saturday Night Live band together. "Since I was new in New York I was fearless. An insider knows all the cliques and won't try to get through them. I didn't know any better so I did try. When I wanted to put together the band I just looked at names off album covers. I just picked who I wanted from New York session men."

For several reasons alot of people seem to think the session/independent group Stuff is the SNL band, but Shore claims, "That's not true. They played on the show with Leo Sayer and Joe Cocker but it's really Stuff themselves that have tried to make people think they're our band. They played on the first SNL album and on one of their albums they used a picture from the SNL set, which is a very distinctive set. I think they're trying to associate themselves with a good thing."

The good thing that Shore and the rest have kept going for four seasons may soon change significantly, though. Freddie Silverman has suggested to the SNL people that they go prime time and Shore seems ready to cash in. "A lot of people are for it," Shore explains. "Lorne Michaels is against it. I, personally, feel we're ready for it. We've done four years here, I'd like to go prime time. It would probably mean more top forty music and certainly we couldn't have Sun Ra on. The show would have to remain live, though."

In the final analysis, Shore claims the live, no-turning-back quality is essentially the lifeblood of the series. "The best part of the show is that at Saturday Night at 1:00 it's all over," intones Howard, taking a deep breath. "Whatever was on, was on and you can't go back or punch in or edit — it's done. And Sunday it's over and you feel terrible, you've got a bad hangover and you regret everything you said the night before, you don't even remember saying half of it, and you want to die." Suddenly Howard begins to snicker. "And then you get up Monday and do it all over again." ●

# RADIO CITY

**A Dogfight** — That's what radio is. And if you're a PD you'd better keep the dramamine close by, just in case. When your station is flying high in the ratings everybody else is The Red Baron trying to knock you out of the sky. And of course, the situation seems reversed to the scrappy fighters down below. Confusing? Well, maybe that befuddlement accounts for the variety of tactics/philosophies expressed by some of today's pilots.

**Frank Cody** is in a climb with KBPI in Denver and he thinks it's important to be aware of competition. "But, I avoid being preoccupied with that," he says. "I'd rather put my energies into the station. Today in radio, you have to aggressively demonstrate a profile. And that profile, if it reflects the current taste of your target audience and if you're able to show them that what you're offering is what they want, they'll not only sample you but they'll embrace you. You'll become their station."

"The main thing, in terms of outdoing other stations is not so much any one of a handful of little things — you can try to handle concerts or merchandise t-shirts, posters or do a book cover drop in the newspapers. Everything's on a day to day basis; maintaining a consistent air sound and responding to the moment — if something's happening you must be able to react at that moment. That helps you to beat your competition because if you respond first to something in the market, without a doubt that's the best thing you can do in terms of radio warfare. And of course, the station's budget enters the picture. But a moderate advertising budget properly spent and carefully researched is worth twice as much as a large one spent haphazardly or just intuitively. You can get everyone to tune in your station but you've got to be able to back up your advertising. You can't buy ratings. You might be able to buy sudden success, a quick jump in the ratings. I think that all of us who commonly share an interest in what we call AOR are looking for long term success, a station which actually satisfies the needs of the community rather than hyping everybody during a rating period."

One of the side effects of this warfare can be the feeling of animosity on a very personal level between the staff members at rival stations in a given market. Of course, it doesn't have to be that way. **Jeff Appleton** of WBUF in Buffalo remembers his days in Lansing, Michigan, "We used to bring about seven stations into a mall, all broadcasting a benefit for handicapped children. We were all doing live remotes, doing interviews with each other, challenging each other — the one time of the year when all of us got together and just had a ball. It was fun radio. The people there were into radio, not 'my station is better than your station.' Radio was our business and it was fun. We didn't have time for the petty little hassles."

It's not always smooth sailing when stations work together on a project. **WLIR's Dennis MacNamara** recalls a recent incident, "When Billy Joel announced his charity concert, WLIR anchored a network of Long Island stations. It was the first time it's ever been done and let me tell you it was a fucking pain in the ass because of some of those stations. But it was worth it because we pulled it off and because Billy and his people were thrilled. We had to stay up all night the night before the show. It took

that much work because of the politics involved. So that's probably why stations don't want to get involved because you waste so much time with petty ante bullshit when you've got more important things to worry about."

Then again, the situation can get even worse. The fur flies in Philly as **Alex Demers** of WIOQ explains, "We recently ran a Cheap Trick concert live from Chicago. Another station in the market dug up a live tape of the band, called it the Cheap Trick special, said it was an exclusive and rolled with it the same night and time as the real show. That's the primary tactic going on in our market, where station 'B' will copy station 'A'. If 'B' has more fire power than 'A', which they do, then basically you can fool your audience, which is pretty jive but it works."

"There's also the situation where stations play an album before the date specified to get the jump on other stations. Personally, I detest these types of warfare. National Promotion Directors trust us enough to give us records early, knowing we'll hold it. We sat with The Stones and McCartney. It's just a matter of ethics. The way business is done in the real world is unfortunately a way of life. It's just a shame that it's finally come to Philly."

**Tim Spencer** at KTXQ has seen at least one unsettling incident. He says, "We went through a situation with the Texas Jam where we made a proposal for the whole thing and we were awarded it and became the official Texas Jam Information station. We went on the air with it and a few days later another station went on the air saying the same thing. And we went through that for two months during the book."

What about the positive side of warfare?

**Jesse Bullet** describes the WLUP philosophy, "We buy a lot of television, and a lot of cum building things which give you a certain amount of flexibility. We also have our Loop Stores located in seven record stores in the area where we sell tour jackets, t-shirts, vanity mirrors, jogging shorts, baseball caps, etc. We recycle the profits back into the radio. But we have the cash flow to do that kind of thing. Money in the bank is a great asset."

"Another point of interest is a kind of chain of events we have in the works. First, we're putting on a show at Kaminski Park (yes, they will let us return). You take that ticket stub to a certain chain of clothing stores and they will give you a free Loop shirt. Now, we've also set it up so that if you wear a Loop shirt to an event we call Chicago Fest, you get in free. By a conservative guess, there are 50,000 Loop shirts on the street right now. It all comes down to management, money and momentum."

**Dennis MacNamara** has a few more guidelines to set down. He informs us to, "1. Know your competition. 2. Know their strengths and weaknesses by your own research. 3. Know your own audience. 4. Create only a positive image for your station not only for your own audience but for those who can be attracted to become part of your audience. You can do this through special programming and good promotion both internally and externally."

**Tommy Hedges** at WCOZ in Boston feels that the future of AOR and its ultimate potential will suffer because of animosity or any lack of understanding between rival stations in a market. Tommy says, "Increasingly, record companies say to me that they're in a very difficult position. They don't want to give something to BCN, for example, because they know COZ will get pissed. And they don't want to give it to COZ because BCN will get pissed. A lot of record people tell me they just don't want to do anything anymore because they end up creating more ill will than anything else. This to me is a real disappointment because the listeners pay the price. And it is a situation that is repeated in city after city. It causes a good bit of alienation. So, how do you win?"

"You need the support of two or three AOR stations in each market to break acts nowadays. A lot of these little baby acts that are just getting started need that kind of support. And if you alienate a programmer enough he won't want to play your act if his competition is doing a live broadcast of that act. I wish there was a way for it to be more equitable, but there simply isn't. I honestly think that record companies don't know how to deal with it. If we get into this heavy competitive trip it's really gonna be a bummer. All it will ultimately mean is that we aren't taking advantage of the potential of the medium. The fact that it gets down to all this needless bickering between individual stations is not healthy for the future. I'd be happy to get half of the live broadcasts and I think anybody else would too. But there's an attitude at most stations where they want it all. We are really achieving a level now with satellite and microwave hookup so that the concept of a nationwide broadcast is that much more accessible. The bottom line is that we all just have to learn how to take our turn."

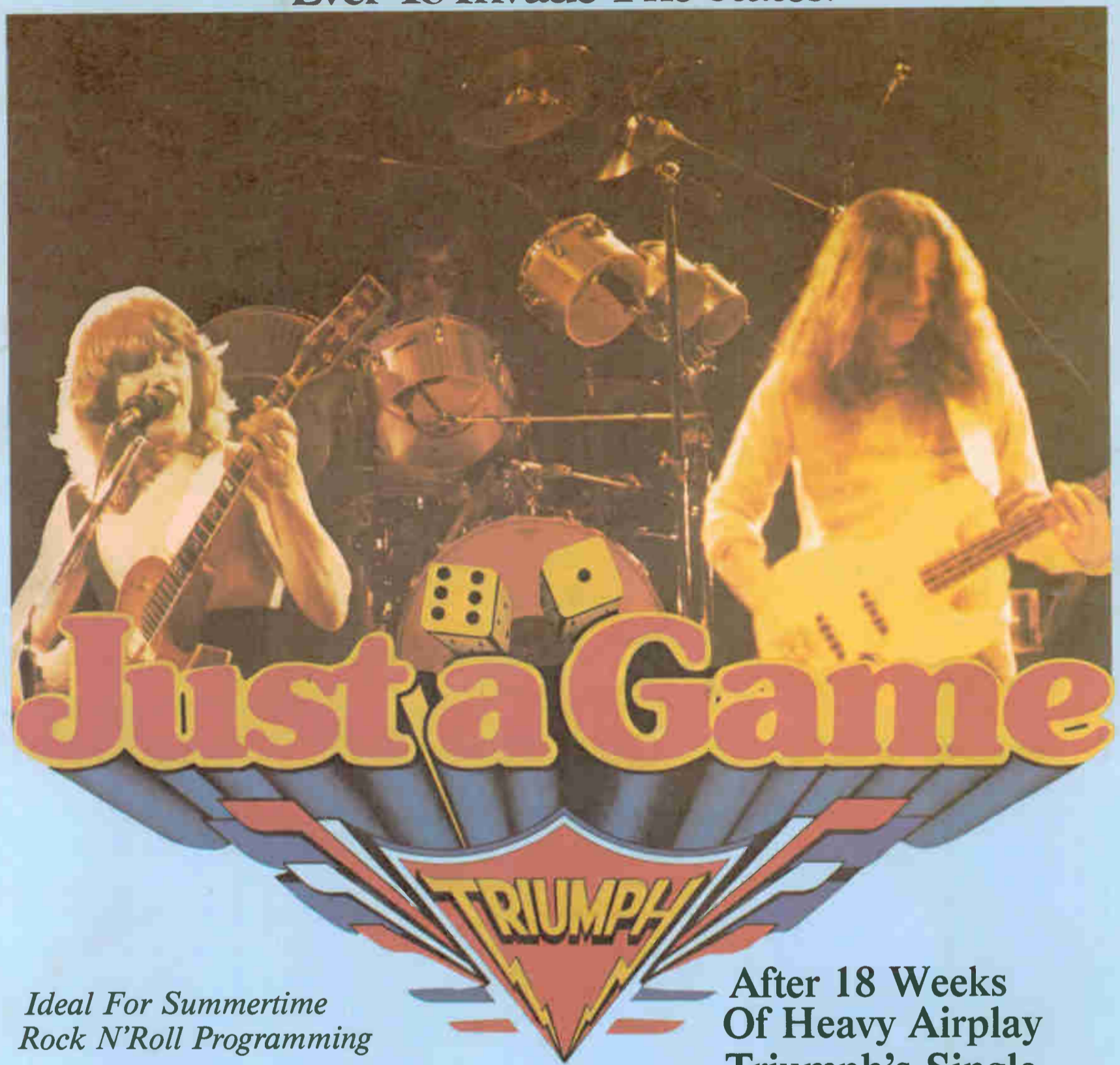
