This is the first of the weekly Bulletins that we have put out since returning to the regular weekly schedule which we follow during the months which compose the regular DX season. We had not planned on putting this Bulletin out until September 5, but we have had so many requests to publish a complete list of the Frequency Tests, for the benefit of those members who have lost some of the supplements which we sent them and also to make it much handier for all of the members in general. Hence we figured that if we put the Bulletin out on Sept. 5 as we had planned that this list would reach you too late to be of any benefit during the Sept. tests. Therefore we have decided that this Bulletin will take the place of the one you would have received on Sept 5 and that the next issue will come out on the 12th of Sept. and after that on the regular weekly schedule. We hope that this will be satisfactory with all of you.

We also might mention that this is the first Bulletin for the second year. It might be called the first anniversary number. If the DX weather had been better we would have arranged a special Anniversary DX Party but since we find that static is still very severe, we figured we may try to arrange an Anniversary Party later on in the season.

We want to take this opportunity to welcome the following as new members in our club; Jacob N. Mitchell, 2616 Buehler Ave., St. Joseph, Mo; Louis F. We certainly hope that you will all enjoy your memberships in our club.

There are several DX programs which have already been scheduled by our CPC and we take great pleasure in informing you of them. The first are a series of broadcasts which have been arranged by our Vice-President Joseph J. Becker, Senior, from CMJP Moron, Cuba for the 5th and 25th of each month beginning with September 1934. We are in receipt of a letter from Senor Julio Rivera, Manager of this station in which he has informed us of this splendid series of programs which Joe Becker, has arranged for us. The time of these broadcasts will be from 2:00 to 3:00 A.M., E.S.T. All of you are urged to listen in to these broadcasts and send in your reports for they will be greatly appreciated. Remember these broadcasts are to be dedicated to NRC and we want you to send in a lot of reports to show your appreciation.

Our CPC Chairman, C. G. Huber advises us that WSAJ Grove City, Pa. will dedicate their Frequency tests for September and October to the members of our club. The dates for these dedications will be September 5 and October 3 from 2:20 to 2:40 A.M., E.S.T. That's fine work, Mr. Huber and we certainly appreciate your lining up these dedications. 1310 kycs.

We are also advised by James Owen, our Springfield, Mo. member that he has lined up KGBX Springfield, Mo. to dedicate their Sept. test to the members of our club. Their dedication will take place, Thursday morning, September 6 from 5:00 to 5:20 A.M. E.S.T. You are all urged to report on these frequency test dedications.

We are also advised by our Vice President Joe Becker that CMHW, 910 kycs., Cienguegos, Cuba are on the air each Thursday morning with a program for United States Listeners. Just as soon as we get the correct time of these broadcasts we will notify you. He also advises that station CMKC Santiago, Cuba was totally destroyed by fire on July 9, according to information he received from Mr. Juan Pinol, Manager, Apartado 446, Santiago

Cuba. They are considering replacing with a larger station of about 200 or 250 watts.

We have been advised by radio station WJAG Norfolk, Neb. that they intend to run a DX program on Wednesday morning, Sept. 19 from 1:00 to 3:00 A.M., E.S.T. They will appreciate reports on this broadcast and have promised us that all reports will be acknowledged.

Once again we want to thank Joe Becker for having KRGV Weslaco, Tex. and WAGF Dothan, Ala. dedicate their frequency tests to our club. KRGV operates on 1260 kycs and will dedicate their program of Sunday morning, Sept. 2 from 4:20 to 4:40 A.M., E.S.T. to the members of our club. They however, ask that the members should try to give them an accurate report on Carrier Strength in R'S; Percentage of Modulation and Quality. They say that it may be that quite a few of our members shall be unable to give them the first two mentioned factors but they say that all of you can give them a quality report on the clarity of tone and the balance between the high notes and the low notes of the program presentation. WAGF operates on 1370 kycs and will dedicate their program of Tuesday morning, Sept. 4 from 3:50 to 4:10 A.M., E.S.T. to the members of our club and they too ask for a lot of reports on this broadcast, let's not disappoint them.

At last we shall have the opportunity of hearing one of our members on the air, we are informed by our Cuban Representative, Alec Kinghorn that CMW Havana, Cuba will run a DX program for the members of our club on Saturday morning, Sept. 8 from 1:00 to 2:00 A.M., E.S.T. and that he will do the announcing during this broadcast. Do not fail to listen in to this broadcast and send in your reports to Alec, as a token of appreciation of his fine efforts. We also learn that CMHK will run a DX program on Wednesday morning, Sept. 12 from 1:00 to 2:00 A.M., E.S.T. They operate on 1225 kycs and are located at Cruces, Cuba. CMW 590 kycs.

Good ol' Joe Becker lands another fine special for us for Sunday morning, September 16 starting at 1:30 A.M., E.S.T. The station is CMHA who operate on 1125 kycs and are located in Sagua La Grande, Cuba. This is a very rare special and we know that all of you that hear this station will write in for a verification. However, if some of you do happen to hold a verif from this station write in anyhow to show your appreciation for this fine program.

We have also learned that CMBD Havana, Cuba operating on 1010 kycs will run a DX program on Tuesday morning, Sept. 18 from 1:00 to 2:00 A.M. E.S.T. Here is another fine Cuban special for you to try for. On Thursday morning, Sept. 20 CMCO Havana, Cuba will run a DX program from 1:00 to 2:00 A.M., E.S.T. They operate on 1140 kycs and we are sure that many of you still need this station in your log.

Friday morning, Sept. 21 finds CMCA Havana, Cuba on the air with a DX program to be dedicated to the members of our club. Alec Kinghorn will be at the mike which insures you of some very enjoyable chatter from the during the course of the broadcast. The time of the broadcast is from 1:00 to 2:00 A.M., E.S.T. They operate on 1230 kycs.

You can all see from the list of stations that we have just mentioned that our new CPC is really on the job already and things should really start functioning wonderfully well in a short time. We want to take this opportunity to congratulate the CPC on the excellent start they have made this season. We are looking forwards to having one of the greatest DX seasons that have ever been seen, under the fine assistance of a great bunch of workers on the new CPC.
