DX NEWS DECEMBER 19, 1934.

Well here it is time again to get started on this week's Bulletin. According to a card which Mr. Huber sends us this week, VE9EK, 1185 kycs. Montmagny, Que. that fine 10 watt station that so many of us have had the pleasure of hearing, was on the air for us during our Canadian Nights Party on Dec. 9 from 4:00 to 5:00 A.M., E.S.T. We are sorry we didn't receive this information sooner so that you could have all listened in and heard this program, however it is evident that the card was not received in time for the broadcast. We hope that some of you heard this station and sent in your reports.

Mr. Huber also sends us information concerning the new station in Thomasville, Ga. that uses the call letters WPAX. It is owned and operated by Wimpy Radio manufacturers of radio equipment. Quoting from the letter which was received from them: "This is the first time we have been on the air since 1922 at which time the writer had a ten watt outfit operating under the same WPAX, which supersedes WQDX which was owned by other parties and which will now be deleted. Our station will be checked by the Federal Communications Commission monthly." We suppose they will take WQDX's place during the frequency checks the first Tuesday morning of each month from 2:00 to 2:20 A.M., E.S.T. Here is your opportunity to hear this new station.
