DX NEWS JANUARY 16, 1935.

Well here it is time to commence this week's Bulletin and there is lots of news on hand although none of it is of great importance so far this week. We hope however, to make this Bulletin as interesting as we possibly can.

First of all we have several new members that we want to welcome into our midst. They are Mrs. William Scott, 253 South 12th St., Lebanon, Penna. and Morgan B. Kent, Box 565, 420 University Blvd., Daytona Beach, Fla. We trust that these two new members will find their membership in our club very beneficial.

Quoting from Joe Becker's card which he received from KIDW Lamar, Colorado in reference to their frequency check dedication which was to have taken place the first week of this month. "We humbly beg your pardon for the oversight, however there was a new crew at KIDW during this test and we overlooked it. If you will write me full particulars, we will personally conduct a program for your club at a time to be selected by your club." This explains why several of you wrote us saying that you did not hear KIDW mention our club. Needless for us to say that Joe Becker has already asked them for a special broadcast to the members of our club as they suggested in their letter.

We received a letter here at headquarters from Mr. M. Leonard Savage, Ass't. Chief Engineer of radio station WEEU, Reading, Penna. in which he advises us that their station will run a DX program on Sunday morning, February 17 from 3:00 to 5:00 A.M., E.S.T. He also states that the DX program which they ran in December was a big success and that they received more mail from NRC members than any other DX Club. He also mentions the fact that on their program of Feb. 17 that they will dedicate the first half hour to the members of our club, namely 3:00 to 3:30 A.M. This is by far the best news that we have received this week and we are very glad to know that our members gave WEEU such a fine response on their December program. Let's do just as well or even better with this program.

We wonder how many of you have heard that very powerful carrier on 1040 kycs after 2:00 A.M., E.S.T. during the past week or so? It has turned out that this is Rennes, France testing with 200KW. They made several announcements this past Saturday morning and played several recordings. We would suggest you watch very closely for them.

From our South Dakota member, Mrs. A. C. Johnson, we learn that the station in Aberdeen, S. D. will use the call letters KABN instead of KABR as we had been previously notified. She also states that a letter from the station advises her that they have been testing every morning during the past week after 2:00 A.M., E.S.T. We wonder if this is the station we have been hearing on 1420 kycs that does not make any announcements but keeps on playing one recording after another?

We are in receipt of a very fine letter from 'Ente Italiano Per Le Audizioni Radiofoniche which ought to be of very great interest to the short wave listeners who are members of our club. They advise us that on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays they are transmitting special programs for American listeners known as "The American Hour from Rome"
