Veries in from CKCA CKRN CKTB CMCA KIUP KGKL KRMC PRF3 CMCH. Nothing hrd of PRF3 on the 25 or 26th. Too much static so I gave up and went to bed at 2:30. Checked WBAA on Monday, so they are positively on the 27th of each month from 2:15-2:30. (We are all hearing plenty of static Nick. RHC)

ERNIE COOPER-Brooklyn N.Y. Very little DX these past two weeks. WGNC hrd on tests March 22 and 23 R8 at 1:30 with plenty of QRM from WHFC and WBNO. WRAL testing March 23, R8 at 1:30. CHSJ testing at 1:47 R8. Hrd WSNJ on DX March 27 R8 plenty of QRM. Glad to hear them start DX program with the National Anthem. WCMI on March 29 signing at 1:34 from test R8. Reception has been of mid-summer static almost every morning. For all the good season we've had, static is certainly setting in early. You folks must be telepathic--stopping the weekly bulletins just as the Summer QRM set in. Hi. (If History repeats it's self we will see a few good Mornings of TP reception, yet befor May. Editor)

DICK COOPER-Kittanning Pa. New veries from WLOK WIBU KXA WJLS WJBY WRAL KELA and duplicates from WSAL WJBO. Not a single new addition in past two weeks. DX at mid-summer peak. Had hoped for a lot of TP and West Coast reception during March and April but QRM is too heavy. HJ3ABD has been heard in the early evenings on 1105 kcs. Also am hearing CMBX spitting between WBT and WTAM on 1075 with excellent strength.

I think this is a good scheme, and if it works I may confine all DXing to the SW for the summer. The toughest part is understanding the foreign call letters. Sometimes I have to stick to a station for almost an hour trying to figure out the call letters. Have several SW lists, but they all seem to vary a little from regular stations. Am working on a new antenna to get more power out of the old lizzie. Have some great ideas but our roof-top will hardly permit anything extravagant in the way of ariels. Hi. XEFQ says they cannot believe their eyes when looking at my report. This station uses 500 watts and they hope to change to 1100 keys soon. Who is the Canadian on 1415 keys.???? Cuban reception outstanding. Evening of March 29 was full of amazing South Americans. Hrd HJLABF R7 Q5 at 10:27 at which time they proceeded to close down with what might have been the Columbia National Anthem. HJLABN was R7 on clear channel all thru this evening. Also logged new station on 830 keys., CMKW. Who was Spaniard on 870 kc March 29 using chimes identical to those of NBC and who was playing Gray Gordon's "Angles With Dirty Faces" at 10:47. Belief here is that he is the Colombia HJ3CAC in Bogota. XEB was also hrd exceptionally well on mar. 29, being R7 Q5 all evening, with CKLW inaudible. CMBQ seems to have moved from 660 kc. Havent hrd VONF since test on A.M. of mar. 21. Did log new station in way of W3AL on test DX program A.M. March 28. CMOA is the Cuban breaking thru CBF-XENT.. CMJK now on 1020 kc.,

On next morning WOI was testing with new equipment and recd VFB, guess they were not using the new antenna which they said would probably keep me from hearing their transmission. XEAU 1310 kcs. Tijuana, Mail to Box 24 San Diego is on as late as 5:00 A, EST on Sundays. A Card from Jim Walker reports he hrd them on the 26th. XEAU says no commercial over 100 words aint dat sumpin. Proctor & Gamble please Note! A note for Eldon Addy, stations on Freq. check probably will verify if you give them exact wording of all the announcements even if names of selections are not known, I have found this to be true more than once. Only Australians being hrd here now (April) are the group of ABC stations with chain programs, they sign at 8:30 AM EST, and the call of all of them is given frequency of each chain station, no chance for verie with this set up. The JO's are none too strong around 8:30 AM EST, but during past week I have reported to JOBK2 JOPK JOUK and JOMG the last three are 500 watters, havent done very well in 1939, only 12 of them reported.
