BIRELEY ROSS-Austin Texas. This is my first report but it is very poor, as I have been ill and have not done much dial twisting. My BCB total of verification is now 1073 and I hope to bring that up to 1100 before the season is over. The main catches lately thanks to NRC is FQN and HOK LS11 also have received verification from HJLABN Latest catch was WFTL Fort Lauderdale Fla. Just received a belated verie from VP2SA on the SW. My VIC on the SW is 140, with the cards coming thru the British Censor, they are very slow. My total VIC heard is 162 but I doubt if I will receive all of them, but I am pleased with the ones I have. I could raise my verification total on the BCB if I would write to the Mexicans and Cubans but I have been so unlucky with these that I have about give up writing to them. Last week I pulled in Algiers and if I get that verification I will have verified all continents on the BCB. The CPC has been doing an excellent job and I hope they keep it up.

AL BARTHOLOMEW-Bradford N.Y. A little new DX here of late WTMA WFIG on 1st and XEAG this morn 3/10/40. XEAG on for URDXC came in swell here. Only TPs heard here yet are Zedders. A few veries in lately including CKNB CJAT CBY To bring me over 100 mark in Canada verie's, also back are WBAB and XEZ the Mex with swell veri card. CJAT gave me a lot of satisfaction, certainly took me long enough to catch. Hope we have clear channel on HOC and a good morning.
