DAVID THOMAS PROCTORVILLE OHIO Several times in the past in different DXers reports we have read accounts of some DXer hearing an unknown station, and in some cases these reports check very closely with our test files. We do not VERIFY such reports for it is a police here that all reports to be verified must be postmarked within 24 hours of reception. Whenever we operate on 1560 kcs we give a code word, call at stated intervals, these reports are verified and any other report with correct and prompt information is also acknowledged and in some cases verified. Here is a note on how you can tell if it is us. On xmitter 2-3 and 4 the carrier is often stronger than speech or music as having modulation trouble, as sometimes over, the other times under modulation. This we think is due to remote frequency control change and have been trying to remedy it.
