Immediately following I logged YV5RB, Caracas, Ven. on same frequency until their sign off at 10:06. They were QSA4, R7, and call was plainly heard at 10:05. FEB. 8: WLB was on with a DX program. TP's audible were 1YA, 2YC, and this unidentified one on 780 which I have heard several times. It must be a new high-powered one. FEB. 9: WOLF for new one logged at 2 AM sign-off. CMC was drowned out by U.S. stations. Station on 1130 kc. was logged 8:20-9 PM. I think this was Burnham's PRH8 but am not certain. FEB. 10: Fine morning. (KYUM) logged on test at 3:45 AM. 4QS in Dalby, Qsld, Aust. logged on 760 with fine signal. Barely audible TP's were 1YA 2YC 4YA and 2BL 2NR 3GI. FRENCH EQUATORIAL AFRICA FZI Radio Brazzaville 11.970 at Brazzaville Middle Congo is now operating in the evenings from 9:45-10:55PM-11PM at times. They start with news in French then Symphonic music followed by news in English at 10:45PM. Just prior to English news they broadcast

COLD COAST ZOY 4.910 Accra is now operating daily in English & French from 1:30-2:30PM but not being heard here (Mann)

PORTUGUESE EAST AFRICA CR7PE 9.720 Laurence Marques, Mezabique broadcasts English news by a lady announcer at 2:55 PM (IDA)

SOUTH AFRICA ZRO Durban is now using 9.685 in parallel with ZTE 11.800 and ZRJ 6.097 daily to South America at 4:30 PM (IDA)

ZRL Capetown 9.615 hrd 11:45PM-12:15AM with R7-8/45 sigs; Setting up exercises make up most of program. Bugle calls are used at start of program and also as identification. Chimes strike 7AM at Midnight (Lundberg)

MISCELLANEOUS NEWS Algerian & Morocco stations are still well hrd on a more or less irregular sked as well as CR7BE, OPM & OQ2AA (Mann) EAJ43 7.500 Tenerife Canary Islands has not been hrd for a long time. Has any one heard this station? (Lundberg)
