Heard 2 new ones since last report, WINC and signed by Program Director, Pollock; WCED out 4 months and 7 days signed by David W Jeffries C.E.; A report to WWSR who has WQDM's spot on the frequency checks. Still have WFNC-WKNY-WALB-XEMC-XEGM-CMJN-CMKN-HJAN-WCAC(3 rpts) and WLOF out yet. I kissed the Spicks good-by long time ago and kicked myself for even reporting to them.

GRANT BATSON WESTFIELD N.Y. Reports out to WKNE-WERC. Veries received cards from WTAK-WSAJ-WERC and letter & card from JLG4; WERC is a Columbia station and call stands for Erie's Radio Center, signs on at 7:30 EDST. WKNE logged on June 30th signing on at 6 AM EDST. Havnt received a single verie since June 28th. Too much hard work and long hours so DXing has been sadly neglected, but will start again soon.

Some of you fellows should be able to log them now. Got myself a 5 tube Lafayette portable, did not do much in the way of DX on it but logged WCKY-WSM-CBM-WMT-WLAC-WMRO and a few more. Hope to be in Buffalo for the convention.

AL BARTHOLOMEW BRADFORD N.Y. Well I finally did receive my verie from 4YZ and 2HD. 4YZ sent a swell letter verie and stated that they were the southermost city and radio station in the world. 2HD sent a nice card verie and letter. These 2 TPs bring total to 32. By the way 4YZ brought my total to an even 100 foreigner veries, this does not include CANADA-MEXICO or CUBA but everything else. Out of 30 reports sent last season 75 have verified. Am still waiting for XEAI-HJAN-TIEP-WDAK and 4SB. Probably best verie for the past season were, KMYC-KUIN-KODL-KENO-XELH-CHGB-KTOH-HC2AJ-2HD-2YH-4YZ to bring all verie total to 1224 of which 221 are more than 2000 miles distant. Have 102 Canadians, 50 Mexicans, 36 Cubans, 100 other foreigners and the rest are in the USA. Here's hoping for good DX in 1941-1942 season. (Will see you Sunday Al. (Ray)

JACK WILLARD DENVER COLO. No time at present for DX. Am working at present out of Cheyenne and are installing a transcontinental carrier line for the AT&T Co. This carrier line operates on a radio frequencies between 8 and 500 kilocycles and we have to equip booster stations every 17 miles across Wyoming and Utah. During our lunch hour each day we have a contest shooting at jack rabbits and rattle snakes. A running rabbit counts 50 points, a snake counts 25 points and a standing rabbit counts 10 points. After this last weeks scores are figured up I think I will be in 3rd place. (This sounds like a swell contest Jack) Only DX I have heard was WGH and did not get a chance to send a report. Bought a little Echophone receiver to take with me but as yet havnt erected an antenna. Its a good little receiver and it sure pulls in the stations, almost as good as the SX-24 which is collecting dust at home.
