# THE CPC CORNER

WISR-Butler, Penn will broadcast a gala DX program on monday morning November 17 1941 from 4:00 to 6:00 Am EST. Clifford Gorsuch, Chief Engineer tells us the production dept., of WISR is preparing a program that will appeal to all DXers and trusts that we will all be listening. (R C)

WEIM-Fitchburg, Mass tells us they are seeking FCC approval to broadcast another DX program on wonday, November 24th from 4 to 6 AM EdT. They will wire us when approval is granted but we're pretty sure the same will be forthwoming so suggest that you make a date for WEIM on the 24th. Invite your friends to listen. (R. Cooper)

KSWO-Lawton, Okla ndvise Joe Becker they test for frequency each third Monday from 5 to 5:30 AM CST. This limits the possibility of hearing them in the east because of CKOC who sign on at 5 AM EST and several others who come on at 6. Perhaps we can talk 'em into coming on several hours before their freq check time.

KSKY-Dallas, Texas indicate their willingness to DX later in the winter. (Becker) WERC say only 2 operators now but maybe will be able to DX later. (Herz) WFHR notified Herz of their Sept 26th freq check 6-6:30 EST too late for publication. Would not have been heard in the east because of lateness of time. (Herz) WKNE said they would require approval to DX from the FCC and it would not be granted at present time. (R Cooper) WORC positively refused to DX as usual, seems to be mad at DXers. (Addy)

A letter from WKWK shows that 18 members of the N R C reported to their DX program which was dedicated to the MEMBERS of the NATIONAL RADIO CLUB. This is quite a contrast from the number of NRC reporters to programs of last season, being that it was the first special of the year might have had something to do with so few reports. I hope this condition will not be repeated. Our CPC staff have a wonderful start now dont you let them down. Lets get back in the stride and report as we did last season.
