Due to having to be at work at 4 PM some Fridays I am changing the deadline for BCB news and reports from Friday to Thursday. This means that all news or reports received in the mail received Thursday morning will be included in the bulletin that is mailed from here on Saturday morning. When working 4-12 mdt it is impossible to have time to get in all the news received here Friday morning. Please cooperate. Editor.

This will inform all members that your club (NRC) is cooperating with RADEX in order to better conditions between DXers and the different Radio Stations. This cooperation will not in any way effect our present system of operating. We will however do every thing in our power to help RADEX in the problem they have undertaken to correct. It is the belief of us here at headquarters that with most DXers behind this effort the Special DX programs and verification questions will be most gratifying. You all know that stations have hesitated to transmit special programs for DXers because only a handful of reports would be received and they would be hounded by the several clubs for programs which if granted would amount to a considerable amount of money from which they would receive no benefit. Then verifications would be slow in coming back. We are working with RADEX to try and remedy this condition. By cooperation we can present to the different stations a sort of ARRL of DXers.

Remember the above DX special programs listed in our DX Calander cannot be guaranteed. All programs are subject to cancellation upon notice from the FCC without and advance information. Try to tune in anyway.

J WARREN ROUTZAHN-YORK PA. Since last report I logged CMAX and XEJP. Veries came in from WKMO-WWSR-WSON-KFNF-HJCU-CKCO-CHLN-WGGA-TI4NRH and HJDE this last on SW 61.45 kc. The TI4NRH was from their recent DX and states they received 65 reports, mine was one of the few noting aeroplane sound effects and only one detecting the 3 different recorded speeches. I do not want to start an argument or dispute anyone's word but I have a verification from TI4NRH for DX program of Dec 1st, in letter he stated you are one among a few that heard some thing NRH on long wave, on diploma states 725 kcs Dec 1 1941, 3-4 AM EST Acknowledgement for 725 kc program etcetc. Latest veries HJCU-YV5RH-KMO YV5RX-CHLN-CKCO-CKRN-WGGA and KBIZ. WCAZ now on 620 kc. 1/142 KSCJ 4-4:30 stated this DX and DXed 1-3 AM every Monday; KCRC testing new lkw xmitter; HJAN on till 4:50 AM. "Radio Reykjavik" 5-7:10 pm long wave on 200 kc, 65 R8 (one thing about long wave is that they do come in they do really come in, like the 10 meters in that respect) WTJS-1390 easy to get just before dark 4-6 PM. 1/4th WJAR at lam. Deutschlandsender on 191 kc 6-7:06pm. In verie from YV5RH-RX they state YV5RX is now on 3487 kc and YV5RH is call now on 720 kcs. In checking new receiver which is a Hallicrafter, I found the following. It is far inferior on bcb that my other set (but can buy 4 hallicrafter for what I paid for my other one, and thke that into consideration also) But is excellent on SW, one best in that field ever tried. So going to use it on SW and stay with Sargent for BCB. (Dave we have one at WMJ and I really dont like it-Ray) (Halli)

Its just too cold for sensitivity. SW is dead here. Have 50 reports out. I overslept on KFQD and I probably wouldnt have heard it any way, also slept on PRI-3 and others. I'm sure missing plenty specials but never an NRC special. Hope DX clears up. XESK on 300 kc is good here nightly. (Keep going Jim)

ELDON ADDY-MARCUS IA. No report last week due to roads being blocked and a nice blizzard. No mail for 4 days. Had a very pleasant visit from Leo Herz over Xmas Holidays, DXed quite a bit and had a swell time. DXers are welcome here anytime. Since last report have heard the following stations, WMBD-WSYR-KHQ-KGFX-KQW-KWBD. Veries in from KFNF-WMBR-KYW-WMBD CKCO-WSYR-KQW-KHQ and a nice card from KGFX signed by Ida McNeil-owner. Reception has been very bad and its been so darn cold, around 32 degrees below most of the time. Nothing heard new on the 1st. KVCV could not be heard here due to noise and static. Wonder if they were on. Till next time best of DX to all. (Will try to get a letter to you soon-Ray)

BOB BROWN-GOSHEN IND. Recent veries are KF00-KSRO-KLUF-WEVD-CFPL-CKBI-XEQ. I found out why 13 of my rpts were unanswered, I copied them in EST and sent them out in CST. WEVD called my attention to it. The war hasnt delivered a mortal blow to DX yet. The 1st morning there were only about 6 or 8 channels open, now there must be nearly 60. One morning a Dutch station on 722 was audible after WGN s/off, on 12/19 2WL hrd at intervals from 4:37-5:22am. Same AM and also on 12/21 2TM hit R5 peaks. Nothing new Xmas but on New Years HJCS was 25 db over R9; HJAN R9 & several others were hrd. 12/20 LSI hrd under WOR. KSAN hrd several times so I think DX will easily survive. "London Calling lists the BBC skeds as thus, 668 & 767 kcs from 12:30am to 6:35pm EST; 804-1050 & 1149 kcs on from 11 PM to 7:15PM EST. I doubt if these official skeds are in effect much account of air-raids. MYSTERY STATIONS HRD 1/1 were on 1050 kc R6 s/off 3:58am EST. 880 R4-8 2:24-2:42am EST (not YV5RQ) WABC was silent several times during this period, WHY? 1090 R5-9 from 4:48-5:19 and later XECD was R7-8 and went off at 4:03-30am. Reports out to KSL on 12/30 7-7:45 PM. GSL on 6100 8-8:30 PM; 1/1 KCRC testing new lkw xmitter 5:10-5:36. WZD thru WHN 9:20-9:30 AM; WSAI on 1360 kc 9-9:15 PM; 1/2 KOL 4-4:20; 1/3 WQAM on 560 5:15-5:30 AM; HP5J on 9605 at 9:48 to 10:37 PM. 1/4 WNYC on 830 kc 7-7:38. This is only time WNYC in the clear, Sindy, also WHN 6:07-6:30 PM. 1/6 CHAB on special with many patriotic selections, Q3-4 R7 some fading. Hope YV6RE comes in. KR1D off at 3 AM daily. To Don Barnes. The station on 1340 kc after WEXL signs is WINX a 24 hour station in Washington D.C. Hope to get other dandies.

FRANK CORYELL-CLEVELAND O. Really have been going to town last week with DX. I stay up till 4 AM or go to bed at 7 and up at 4. Sent out reports to KGKO-KCRC-KFAC-KEX-KOL-KPMC-CFCO-WSYR-WJAX-WINN-KFVD. Card veries received in past 2 weeks are KGKO-CFCO-ZQI-HP5K-VLG6-COBZ and letters frm ZNS-2 WINN-WJAX-WSYR and WGGA. I tried for CMKS-CMAX and CMBZ but didnt hear a thing except a slight carrier on 950 kc but it wouldnt be CMBZ or they would have reached about an R9; KOL did come in good enough to report, also hrd a slight carrier on KFQD's channel, might have been them but dont know. Can also confirm that YNDG "Radio Gilfillan", Leon Nicaragua will verify for a dime, Opr is Dennis E Gallo. ZIK2 answered to me for an IRC. Freq was then 10600 kcs and I guess still is.
