### The CPC Corner by Dick Cooper

No doubt you fellows are feeling bad that the channel could not be cleared for FQX. Here's the dope as we received from C.E. P.K. Baldwin on WEEI--"We will be unable to accede to the request of the National Radio Club that we sign off on Tuesday morning, Jan 27 1942 due to the fact that we are operating on a twenty-four hour per day basis at the request of the United States Army. We are not at liberty to disclose the details of these operations, but I can imagine that you readily appreciate the seriousness of their purpose. We are sorry that we are unable to cooperate with you in this matter". To WEEI and Mr Baldwin we say "A million thanks--we understand--KEEP 'EM FLYING".

A similar letter was received from station WMBR, Jacksonville, Fla. in request to our letter asking for a stand by for CFOS program. I'm sure DXers will gladly accept the situation with an appreciation of what is involved. Later Frank Lee received a telegram from FQX stating that at the last minute they would use 670 kcs. This was received too late to advise you members, maybe another one can be had.

In arranging future programs, we do so with the understanding that the stations will put them on and take the chances of being heard. We do urge that you send a thank you card to all stations that cannot be heard. It will help considerably in arranging future programs. Likewise we will not attempt to schedule programs on frequencies that we know are blocked.

XEFC Merida, Yucatan, Mexico Another DX program from XEFC has been arranged by Frank Lee. Frank says they will DX on 1340 kcs on the morning of February 14th from 3 to 4 AM EST or 4-5 AM EDST. This channel will probably be occupied by WINX and WEXL, but there is always a good chance that enough information can be copied to merit a verification. Lets all try and send some form of report to XEFC even though it be a thank you card or a cards of thanks showing that we do appreciate this. Three dimes (30¢) enclosed in an envelope and mailed to RADEX, 148 Copley Ave., Teaneck, New Jersey will bring you a copy of the latest RADEX. This issue contains information on Transpacific radio stations.

DON BARNES-ST ONGE S. DAK. Not much doing this week with only report to KINY, they may be heard on 1460 kcs after sign off of KEVE which is generally at 2:30 am EST. Signal here about R4 but well heard in low noise level. I believe they sign off at 4:30am EST. (Say Don if I could send a report to KINY for a program hrd I would call it a very good season with just that one-Ray) For D London, the station on 930 kcs is possibly KGBU as they are on until about 5am EST, the station here on 850 kcs is 2-CY in Canberra, hrd here quite frequently with R 4 signal. Only verie this week is WDLP. Will send Don a list of s/o times for stations I hear regularly as soon as can check them. Nothing else this week.

CEG can be hrd after 7PM with good sigs daily. WMAZ & CBM new logged on 1/23 at 7:30pm also 1/23 at 8pm hrd WWRL s/off as new station in log. 1/24 CBY hrd at 4:45pm good signal, KFBI new logged at 5:30pm and at 7pm new ones logged KGGF and CBF. 1/25 Special from KOH could not be heard as KVOB on until 3am although hrd KOH s/off. KQW hrd with regular broadcast. KTNM has freq check either 25th of month or 4th Sunday from 3:30-4am EST. CKTB informs me of their special DX program on Feb 20th 11pm to 6:45am next morning EST. W H Allen chief technician signs veries from CKTB. The only veries here the past week are WFBM-KFH-CKY with card in envelope, also sent book "Manitoba Calling". I have logged 651 stations and of these 614 are US stations and have 382 verified. These are my totals after a short year of DXing. A number of members lack verie from WSON, my verie received in 5 days signed by Hecht S Lackey, manager. (OK on bulletins)

HERB CAMPBELL-ATHENS PENN. A couple weeks ago on Sunday at 9am I heard WHLD for the first time. Dunno where it has been all this time. Guess WFBM slops all over that channel. Beneath some all nighter about 4:45am I could hear some station about R2, during pauses this am. It sounded like folk songs and it mayBE that it was FQN. I have their verie on 609 kcs and they didnt use that type of program that time. (FQN was on 670 kcs according to telegram received by Frank Lee but too late to do any good-Ray) WGGG was fairly well rec for about 14 minutes. WEXL blocked out all chance for KMYR on course. (The costume would be ideal-Ray)

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TIPS and LPO REPORTS

January 31 1942

DAVE THOMAS-PROCTORVILLE O. I thing the decision of CPC to drop all special and DX programs for time being or long as channels are so blocked or for the duration of the war a wise decision. I am with you 100%. (The CPC dave is not going to drop all DXes but are planning carefully) WAYX verie card is tan with green call letters, answered my 1st report. Air-mail registered letter from HS7PJ confirms a report which confirms, JFAK in Formosa and reported from KGU (figure it out if you can-I cant) Also state all broadcasting in Thailand has ceased, except 3 stations on 825.7 kcs-6.040 and 11.715 kcs and a few phone stations still exist (letter received this week) Noticed all members complained about 790 kc being blocked on KFQD-GNSWLC special DX. It was blocked here too when I found it that way got in my car went to listening post and used Beverage Waves beamed on Alaska and in return (via airmail) received a nice letter from manager and verification from KFQD for this DX. So this my second Alaskan in less than a year, other KINY. KOAC hrd on 1/16 and verified by return mail. Here is one for blieve it or not. KOAC was hrd and verified just exactly 10 yeard to the day and hour-veries mailed same day and received the same day (just 10 years apart) 1/16/32 from 4-5am and the other 1/16/42 from 4-5am. KOAC also rechecked this coincidence. (Dave how do you like Carrols poem about Beverage Waves?-Ray)

GRANT BATSON-WESTFIELD N.Y. The veries received were skimped on, cards from WRRN-KWJJ and letter from WSAI. Reports to 1/20 WIOD on 610-5:45 to 6:15. This is the station thats on 24 hours daily and is in the clear on Tuesday ams when WIP is silent. 1/22 KMOX 6-6:15am hrd days Q3 R6, also WMT on 600 from 7:11-7:30 pm Q4 R9; 1/23 WCCO at 6-6:15am; 1/24 KWRC on 1240 from 5:40-5:50 and peak of R9 at 5:50; KFH 6:01-6:15 and WLOL 9:15-9:30; WFIN 12:30-12:45pm Q4 R9; 1/25 WBLJ Q4 R9 over WITH. The Dec 8th NRC special not yet verified as yet, other slow ones are WTAW-KVSO-HJAR-WALA-KSAM-WSAV-WHN-how about this one Lefty? and WHYN from Mar 21 1941. That spick I spoke of last week was on 1310 kcs at 5:30 am Sunday Q4 R6-7. Hope to get a chance on those specials, I dont see how WFIN and WJAS conflict as they are on different channels. WLOL gums up WFIN here. Past 3 days free od static and west coasters coming in swell, daytime reception too is also very good here.

FRANK SUSORENY-COLLEGEVILLE IND. Here are a few lines for a report. Since my last report I have received these veries, WAGA-WWPG-WJZ-WJHL-WROL-KWTO-WFIL-WKBN-KFNF-KRNT-KDTH-WNAC-KGKB-WRLC-WALA-KGNC-WTAD-WLDS-WIS-WFBC-WJAX-WMBR-WSPD-WSYR-WASH-WOOD-WWJ-WJBK-KSCJ-WMBG-WINX-WAPI-KLS WNAX-WGAR-WRC-WCPO-KANS-WAAT-WBTH-WAZL-KATE-WXYZ-WAIR-WGH-WWSR-KLO-KPAC and WGPC. This cluster raises my total to 455 veries and it seems that i'll pass my goal of 500 this season easily. SID STEELE-COLUMBUS O. No DX to report only a few verifications. WLDS signed by Edgar Parsons; WAGE by C.W. Brannen; WFIN by Edgar Smith. The letter states that WFIN operates from local sun-up to sun-down which I believe at present to be 8am to 5pm. Of course this schedule changes every few weeks as the days get longer. A card verie from KTRI signed by Carl McGee and also a pictorial card from XEQ. On Jan 1st had the pleasure of seeing my old Ala Mater, University of Toledo defeat Dartmouth 59-46 in a swell basketball game-(Hi Steve) Still waiting for replies from WKPA-WBYN and WOLF. (Glad to see your report Sid but I cant recall the other matter, be darned if I can-Ray)

JOE BECKER-HAMILTON O. Heard KBWD this morning 1/26, first one this month. It looks like Hamilton will get a radio station, if they do get it the call will be WBCO but do not know what frequency. KSKY came in nicely Sunday am. Not a word from that fellow DXer Reilley, wonder if he likes his sleep these days. (No Joe I finally got word from him and it looks as if he cant get used to working days-Ray)

LEO HERZ-CHICAGO ILL. Only report was sent to WEMP on a day time program. WSMB heard 7:30am. Veries in from CKGB-KFJB-KFKA. The last one out almost a year. CKPR was my first BCB report that got a rejection instead of a verie, not sufficient details. CKTB 1550 will DX for all DXers on Feb 21 midnight EDST to 7:45 next am.

RAY EDGE BUFFALO N.Y. Nothing to say about reporting except that I did report to KPRO and CHAB. Nothing heard from them as yet, I dont expect a verie from CHAB as I reported them on chain but I did get in their local announcements. Will be working 12mdt to 8am next week so will get some DXing done I hope. Only late veries are from WROL-CKCO-CKRN-WWSR-WCOC and CHLN. At least that cleans up those Canadian specials that I reported to. Total veries now 635 and cant seem to raise it although I have about 15 reports out unanswered. Well I am not the only one looking.

JIM WEDEWER-DRYERSVILLE IA. DX past week nothing to holler about although I have had some luck at SW DXing. Latest veries are letters from KOIN-CJCA in 5 days, thats service and a nice card from HIH in Dominican Republic in 3 weeks. New logged are WLBC-KIDO-KGCX-WNAD-KANS-WJAG at 9am One am the 21st logged such DX as CHAB-CBK-CKY & KSL as late as 9:15am thats CST too. I sent reports to WLAC-WTJS-XEP-XEJ-XENT-XEMO let me know if you get this one Jim, I am still waiting-Ray)-the 2nd to Radio Guadeloupe Radio Vichy-KIDO. The Mexican on 1340 announced as XEMH at 5 am and some where in Coahuila. I have over 75 reports out on all bands and many to Canada Oceania and Asia, so many wont come at all. DX good but static bad on 1/26 logged PRA-9 7:55-8:02 pm EST and PR-86 on 100 kcs and LRL 7:04-pm R6 & YV5RA R5 on 960 at 6:50 pm. No FQN but KHQ R9 and KMYR-WCED-WAJR OK on DX programs the 27th. ( FQN was on 670 kcs but too late to notify)

DON REYNOLDS-NEWBURGH N.Y. On 1/26 at 6pm British stations were audible on 668-767-804kcs. VONF also hrd. 1/27 KMYR was not hrd but FQN was coming in on 588. WEEI gave them considerable QRM but I did hear them well enough for a report. (Don I think you reported KHQ instead of FQN who were on 670kcs) Reports out to FQN-WGGA. Veries WWNY-WAYX-WICA-WSAR-WFCI. Total now 540. (How did you get a verie from WAYX? How Id like that one)

Have not mailed a report out for some time, thank you cards mailed to those on for the club (a fine spirit Frank) 1/16 for KOAC but WGR covered them. 1/21 KOOS covered by WITH & no luck on any other DX, got up the wrong mornings I guess. HJCB & HJAT hrd most any night with R5 signals; VOXM on 1005 hrd from 5-5:30pm. No veries from WJMA-VONF-VOXM-XEAW-HJAR-YV4RA-WAIT-WMOG-CMAC and others. No luck on FQN as they were not on 588 kc. tuned from 540 to 640 trying to find them. This morning 1/27 at 10am I received a telegram telling us they would be on 670 kcs but that was too late. (Well those things happen Frank, me too I went from 580 to 640 trying to find them but why didnt we go a little farther) Wonder if any of the boys hrd them on 670? As to specials, tuned for FQN this am but was not very successful. Not too sure that I heard him as KHQ & KGMB were on and another station with them (WEEI in Boston Norm) KHQ was R9 as usual while KGMB and the other station were only understandable when KHQ made announcements. Too much overlap. Just about shot myself last week, got up very nicely for KOAC special tuned around hrd nothing but WGR and was a little worried since KOAC usually puts in a very excellent signal, finally awoke to the fact that I was a day late, "Aint that terrible"? Some of the fellows may want some Mexicans from down this way. Hers are some that are off freq and ought to be fairly easy picking, 1405-XEXN in Guadalajara, 1423-XEF in Juarez; 1444-XEFI in Chihuahua. These stations south of the border come in here best in the afternoon. After that the stations from the mid-west and coast regions come roaring in.
