(Its not 500 miles from Chicago-Hay) I heard the following new ones, WRLC-WABY-WMOB-WMBH-WMIN-WGL-WSLB-WFTC-WHBY-WLBC-WORD-KVOX-KFPW-KGER-KIUP-KTOK. (Nice going Eric) FRED VAN VOOHHEES-KANSAS CITY MO Still cant get into the swing of things but I did get a bunch of follow-up letters written. Was up only on Sunday morning and logged only WJW. Bay, can anyone tell me how I can get WKBW.I still need them in my log. (Say Fred you arnt kidding are you? WKBW is on 1520 kcs and all night-Rayl 50.000 watts too-oo LEFTY COOPER-BROOKLYN N.Y. One more verie in wLOF explaining their announcer forgot what he was doing and gave the s-off message at 4:15 instead of 4:30 and played the Nathonal Anthem with the c.e. Jenkins calling the studio frantically on the phone. They do finish their test usually at 4:15, anyway the announcer didnt answer the phone until s-off message was finished so they had to sign then instead of 4:30. Not much doing here as I have had the Grippe. 1/7 9 Europeans had between 2:30 & 3:30 my log book is about 3 years old so here they are, correct me if I am worng, 904-Hamburg; 913-Toulouse; 995-Hilversum; i077-Bordeaux; 1185-Nice; 1195-Frankfort; 1385-??? (could be either Konigsburg, Ger or Halsingborg, Sweden as both are listed on 1384kcs - Kay) 1393-Lyon; 1474-Clevedon. "Iso heard KThI-w830-WLBJ test as reported in Kilocycle Komment. I dont know how much longer I'll be here. Had word from my draft board yesterday that I would be deferred until after Feb 1st but I dont know how much after. I'm 1-A as it stands now. I will notify you when I change my LRA. No slow up of bulletins, here every Monday morning. I've just completed a log book derived from several sources plus the NRC which seems to bring it up pretty well to date. I had quite a time broadcasting over CKLW on the college radio show. They have a nice layout there. Joe Gentile puts on a show every AM from 6-9:30Am, remember he used to run the alnite record show? CKLW is on from 6AM to 4:30 AM. WJR is on from 5:30am to 5:00AM-23g hours a day and they test every Friday at 5:20AM for 5 minutes. Thats all the dope for now except the only verie received since I've been here is one from W45D the fm station on 44500 kcs in Detroit, (well Fran it was swell to hear from you, hope you were nome for the holidays as thats where the bulletins went for one week. Glad to hear that they are arriving OK in Canada. Best wishes-Ray) JOE LIPPINCOTT-CELO N. CAROLINA Have now heard 199 stations on my 6

tube battery set from here. DX-Jan 5th, KLO at sign off 2:15Am; KWON R7-8 XESM at 3AM; XEMX at 3:18, station on 1360 at 3:30, who was it? 1/6 KFEL at 1:30 didnt sign off then; XEMC on 1590 at 2AM; KLO again a little better than previous day. Station on 1430 at 2:22, who was it? Then to a great surprise Radio Lyons on 1393, never expected a TA on this set and from here. It was R7g better than KEHN and KWO hrd just afterward. KWO signed at 3, expected to hear KGB but didnt, KWO was new one for me. Never even hrd it on my big set.
