We have had a very successful season and lets keep all the successive ones this way. If you can not listen in send a thank you card.

In the last couple weeks several of you have written in saying that your bulletin was several days late. Inquiring at the post office here I find that throughout the conutry they have had many hundreds of men taken into our Armed Services. These men cannot be replaced and so the result is that every class of mail has been slowed up some what, especially that other than 1st class and mail and packages for our service men. Your daily mailman has probably had his route extended and the result is that he has to handle more mail. Many days there is no afternoon delivery. It is there for suggested that those members who are having this problem, that they send additional postage in order that their bulletin can be sent 1st class. You can understand why the club cannot foot a 1st class mail bill as it would take \$1.02 of your annual \$2. membership fees to pay the postage on the 34 bulletins issued each complete year. You members can figure out how many remaining issues you have to receive before your membership expires as they are mailed on Saturday and there are 34 issues for each year. For example if you have 10 issues coming then send either 5 3¢ stamps or 10-1½ stamps. Then upon renewing you can send \$2.50 instead of \$2. and this will pay for the additional postage to send your bulletin 1st class. Your club pays the 1st 1¢ postage. The additional must be paid by you. In case your bulletin runs over 1 oz then your club will pay that extra stamp.

EUGENE FRANCIS-DETROIT MICH. I heard more new stations in February than the number of verifications received and that's the first time that has happened in quite some time. Best verifies in were letters from CJVI and CKMO (they also enclosed their MIDNIGHT PROWLERS card) and W3BC, a card. 36 verifications and one acknowledgement. Wouldn't you know that the acknowledgement would be from a station that ordinarily could not be heard here-WSAP. I sent a request to the station, explaining that acknowledgements weren't exactly verifies, but so far no reply has been forthcoming from WSAP. Cards came from KARM-KFXJ-KGDE-KIRO-KWYO-WCBI and WSKB. However since I collect radio station stationery (I now have 150 sheets from about 140 stations) the cards are usually enclosed with the blank sheet. I assure you I don't cheat, as I could very well turn the extra sheet WSAP enclosed, into a verify. What a temptation, though. Letters arrived from KELA-KFRC-KFRE-KGGM-KICA-KIT-KMYR-KTNM-KTTS-KWAL-KYA-KYUM-WBOW-WBTM-WCRS-WHMA-WINC-WKMO-WMFG-WRRF-WRRR-CHAB-CHPS-CFCN-CKWX. Have had to send follow-ups to KROY-KSAN-KWON and WREC. There are about half a dozen mystery stations that I would like to get some help on. On March 5th a Latin-American signed off on 1170 at 2AM and another Spanish-speaking station Mar 8th at 3:30AM on 1270. Somebody speaking in Spanish at 2:30AM same morning under KROY. Back to Mar 5th a station on 1205 kcs playing classical music at 2:30. (TAs and TPs were good that morning) The last one was heard on 1190 kcs, from 5:35 to 6 AM playing Gracie Field's records. Signal was getting better and better, then BINGO: I'll be darned if WOWO didn't s-on at 5:59½. Could it have been 2CH? That seems so hard to believe. That's all for this month, except that CKNB was poor here on its DX, and CHOV was R-9 plus. The program excellent.

WLDS was R9 plus but I didnt hear their s-off but it must have been 2:45-2:50. Then that German? station was hrd R2-3. None of the other usual Europeans such as France on 648-695-1395 or England on 667-804-1149 were heard that same morning. Exception was 648 an R2. JOE BRAUNER-WILLIAMSVILLE N.Y. Thanks to the recent Canadian club specials. I added a few new ones this past week. All of these stations hrd here and two of them were new. CKRN-CKVD and CKNB came in very good Q-5 CHAD was very hard to pick out of noise, seemed to be on the low frequency edge of 1340 causing a whistle and WEXL almost snowed them under but patient waiting brought a few announcements through. CHOV was very easy Q5 R8 almost missed this one, shutting the alarm off and not waking up, but came alive in time to hear the last 20 minutes of a swell program, adding another new one. Then continued on to add KWRC through WJW and WSAP at 5:59, this one out in front on 1490 several times until after 6:30. KBPS program was audible much of the time here but only a few station calls were hrd so was hard to tell which was their program. Came above WNOE several times, a few announcements were heard well. New veries are a letter from KMYC and a card from KWLK which says they have a DX on the 3rd Friday starting at 5 AM EWT. Of the 35 new stations added this season 23 have verified, 5 are recent loggings, one is a Mexican not reported to and the remainder are overdue, these are CBJ-KXEX-WPDQ-KSWO-WINC and WBYN. Also WHLN fails to answer, did same last season.
