LEFTY COOPER-BROOKLYN N.Y. On 3/14 tried for KBUR but no go, WJBK was in the clear here. 3/15 Finally managed to get a report on WRLC. Tried for XECF. I heard KALE s-off at 3:01 and KFAC take over. Thats all brother. KFAC had a jumpy gade but no signal come in from XECF. TO GEO LUTHER-The Mexican I hrd on 1250 kcs I thought was XEH. It sounded like a 3 letter call. Who could it have been?

STUART LELAND-WSRR-STAMFORD CONN KWSC is seeking to operate on 1030 kcs with 5KW days and 1KW nights with unlimited time and also take over the facilities of KOB...WLW has asked for permission to operate with 500KW days and 50KW nights...The case of WHDH vs KOA is sked to go to the Supreme Court WHDH wants to operate full time on 850 kcs....Latest station added to those broadcasting to Troops in Alaska is WVCX, which broadcast unofficially as KRAY before receiving its FCC license....the station is operated entirely by Army personnel... Kwon became a mutual outlet on March and KFFA joins this same network on April 1st....WDEL is now using 5KW nights with a directional antenna....The license of KFQD has been assigned to The Alaska Broadcasting Co....WKEU secured permission to operate with 100 watts unlimited time on 1450 kcs and is requesting a daytime power boost to 250 watts....WCHI has been authorized to shift from 1400 to 1340 kcs....The Milwaukee Broadcasting Corp., owners of WEMP has changed from a corp to a partnership which includes Senator Robert M La Follette, Evelyn Dolph, wife of the owner of WOL and Hope D Petty, wife of former FCC secretary and present owner of WHN...Transfer of WOW from Woodmen of the World to WOW Inc., has been authorized...WFAS after many years of persistent effort has just been authorized to operate full time...it will not take over the facilities of WGBB as they had hoped, but will shift to 1230 kcs from 1240 kc....The FCC has flatly stated that it has not intention to relax its regulations regarding the suspension of operation of stations for the duration...rather the Commission is endeavoring to keep every station on the air even if it is running in the red...this announcement came after WPID and KAST appealed for suspension of operation till after the war but neither station wishes to surrender its license.

STANWOOD MORSS-BRADFORD MASS Heard WPRA on FCC check 3/15 and KFPW in Ft Smith Ark also WORD. WHKY on reg sked on 1290 kc R4-5 at 5:45 (RMd by KUOA. KGO at 5:30 AM R4 and G9H calling Q14 on 1560 kc at 4:30 A, R7, talking about targets, anyone ever reported them? They were quite clear. WMAA applyinh for 250 watts days and 100 nights on 570 kc and KTHS is applying for 50kw day-night and move to Little Rock. (A couple more were send in by Stan but were also in Stuart Leland's cope so I enter it again)

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PEGGY QUINTRELL-WASHINGTON D.C. Jack came home on a week end pass from Camp Lee, where he is temporarily stationed, and is looking over some of the late loggings at the moment. Since our last report, I have received veries from WOV-KWKW-KGCX-CBM-WFBL-KFSG-KHKD-KFRC-WNBC-KYW-KFBC-KYAN-KWYO-KBIZ-KLS-KDFN-KSDM-KJBS-WAKR-KFUN-WAP-WFIL-WIRE-WCBA-CHLT. Thus in the past three weeks I have raised the veries from 386 (when Jack left) to 404. Late reports have been sent to CKNO-CHPS-KGEK follow-up WSPD-KBPS-KICA follow-up CFJC-KGER-CKNB-KOAC-WQAN-WWSW-CHOV-WLSL-WQBC-WLAY.
