SULLY SULLIVAN-DORMONT PA Since joining the NRC on Dec 15th 1942 I have obtained just 51 veries to bring my total to only 127. Veries since last report are KXYZ-WOWO-WTSP-KYA-WDAE-WJZM-WFCI-WOOD-WHIO-KVOA my first Arizona station. Reports out to WSUI-WJPR-KARM-KOL and WXYZ. I have a deadly habit for a DXer. I wake up just enough to turn off the alarm and go back to sleep. I have missed plenty of specials because of this and I cant afford to miss the sleep to stay up all night to get them. Reception conditions here still pretty fair. A little more static but still quite a number of good catches available. I have a Dec 1941 Radex that anyone may have for the asking. I thought I read about someone wanting one in the bulletin sometime ago. QRA is 1406 Potomac Ave., Dormont, Pa.

FRANK S JOHNSON-PITTSFIELD N.H. Well this will be my last report till next fall. This has been my best DX season that I can remember. I verified way over 100 stations this winter making my total 429. As this is my last report I would like to remind any DXer who might have been DXing the winter of 31-32 that is when I began, I was going to high school then, living at Lebago Lake, Maine. I knew knthing of veries then, I'd just log one station then switch the dial to another. My first verie was a picture of KSL's studios in October 1934. Back to 31-32, can you remember you would turn to any station and hear "Shanty In Old Shanty Town" "Pink Elephants" or "LETS Put Out The Lights and Go To Sleep". Can anyone remember the night NBQ in Brantford, Ont was requesting reports and rewarded a picture of their studio. How many have it. I havent. Can you remember when KFLV was giving away Priscilla sewing cabnits to first one from each state who called up and can you remember that station WFW with an announcer with the southern accent, in Hopkinsville in old Kentucky, and many others. (Should be WFIW)

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J WARREN RUTZAHN-YORK PA Only stations logged since reporting are CHOV and KPOW, and veries in from KGNO and CFJC, mar 19th WSLI freq ck 3:15 to 3:30; WMRC checked at 3:50 and I didnt hear KEYS. 3/24 KPOW could be hrd and some parts of announcements came thru but WITH kept them pretty well out of the picture here. 3/39 KBPS again gave me a chase but was much better this time with WNOE off. They were still hard to get any material on so I told them so. Recent reports sent to WLDS-CHOV-WFTM-KRMD-WLAY-WABC. Not much DX of late-slept thru WCBI again-power was off for WBBB. Just got their verie, didnt hear CHLT this Am 3/22. Dont think they were on. Too sleepy to try for XECF. Have been sugaring of late. Does WKPA verify? (I doubt it Don, I'm Waiting since last October-Ray)

JACK CRAIG-BRIE PA Received your sample bulletin and so I am becoming a member. I am very much interested in DX NEWS. So far I have logged 425 stations on the BCB but I never thought of verifying any. When I read the DX NEWS I decided to also try for verifications. I now have 6 reports out to these stations, WISN-XEW-WKPA-WGWI-WTJS and KRLD. (well Jack you have got a nice log and a good start for verifying, it wont be long until that list mounts up-Ray)

HOWARD JULSON-MOLINE ILL Since my last report I have received veries from WSON-KOAM-WLAY-KWLK-KFRE-KTNM-KMYR-WHIT-WBTA-WBAB-KmmJ-KTRI-KSLM-WLDS-KGCX-WHYN-KFDA-WNBC-CKBI-CKRN-CKVD-CHAD-WJPR-WAJR-CHPS-WBRW-WGAC-WRLC-KGKO-KTTS-WMSL-WMOB-KPHO-KIT-WDEF-CFJC-KFOX. Reports are still out to XEMX-XEBK-XEG-KVGB-KJR-WMIN-KGER-WMIS-KPRO-WCBT-KWAT-WBAM-WHBY-WFTM-WCRS-KSAN-WBVA-WAPO-KLCN-WLAP-CKNB-KROY-WBBZ-CHOV-WING-WFLA-KVEC-KELA-KPOW-WMAN. DX hasnt been so good here for the past week, static has been very bad and the specials listed just failed to show up here. (Well Howard I hope you get your verie from WSAM but according to Grant Batson they wrote him saying that they are not verifying until after the war.- Also in regard to the specials, it seems that march is a bad month for them. CHLT-WBBB-KBUR-XECF didnt come on. During the rest of the entire season only KGNO and CJFX failed us and CFJX isnt on the air yet, so really up until march we only had KGNO fail us. This isnt bad when you consider we had 45 specials arranged.)

HERB CAMPBELL-ATHEWS PA Very little news here. Second month reports were sent to WGIL and WCBI, the latter verifying again against a SWL card. I finally got a verie from WBTA, which pleased me a lot. Did anyone ever report that WBAX was now operating on 1240 channel? Seem to have the Mutual time signal pep. (Yes Herb if CHOV-WCBT-CKNB would verify then every thing would be swell. KBPS will as soon as cards are printed-Ray)

Received veries from WGIL-WCBI on second special. Hrd KPOW special. I have seen this Whites Radio Log and if we could get them to drop certain things and add others I believe it could be a good station log. Funny but I have yet to hear farther that Puerto Rico on the BCB. (Well Bud just park on some of these channels and stay there, especially on a good night. I felt that way too but a little patience will do wonders.-Ray)

GEORGE LUTHER-KERRVILLE TEXAS Woe woe woe card about KBPS mailed 3/23 arrived 3/27 just a few hours too late and I happened to be dialing early then and went to bed about time KBPS was due. Such is life. Results are still negligible, mostly because of bad static but also in a slump when it is fair. Do you ell have spells when you chase up leads all over the channles and they just wont turn into anything new? LEFTY COOPER, could that have been KEAT on 1250 instead of XEH? KEAT is there, at least were in November. Eckes-a-ah-tay could sound like Eckes-a-atasy if a little slurred and the Mexes are good at that with their calls. WTSP at 3:58, and ZNS at 8:15PM and R6; 3/31 WSUI at 2:08 and WGRM at 3:09 from 3-3:30 check; KMA at 3:22 R5 and a Spick on 1470 at 3:30 and carriers on 1290-1170-1140-990-950-850-790-780-570 but no music or announcements.

TO DON REYNOLDS-I agree, no good US west coast DX since 1933 just after I goot my new radio. TO LEFTY COOPER-Thanks for tip on CHLP Xmas eve, will try for KFDA a gain and hope for a decent morning.

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NORM MAGUIRE-ALBUQUERQUE N MEX No luck on the specials from XECF, they were not on as there was no one under KFAC at all. WCBI was hrd poorly on the 17th, static was R9 with WCBI about only an R6. Boy it was really terrible for DXing. The 18-19th were also poor, I couldnt get the Los Angeles stations other than KFAC. KNX was very poor, KWLK a powerhouse down this way wasnt even able to copy. Was I mad the next day to discover my antenna had parted in the high winds of the 17th and that about 10 ft of wire was still blowing about the un-insulated lisdin wire. So I missed the KWLK program. There was practically no sign, if any of WBBB here. Was one station very weak between KHJ and KLX. Could not copy anything from it at all. While talking about N Carolina, has anyone received their verie from WCBT from the special, I havent. (No one else has either Norm-Ray) Latest veries are in order now. Have only received a few. However all are in now except for a few delinquents. The latest include KTRI-WLBJ-WCED-CHPS-WHYN-WJMC-KWRC-KELD-KGY-KORN-KMLB. Quite a list and it includes many that have been long hold-outs. KTRI brought the Iowa stations almost to a close. WLBJ was verified on 1st time hrd. WCED was received and verified on that special program of theirs, 250 watts from Penn wasnt too bad for this little Zenith. CHPS came in with a nice letter. Frank Johnson was right, my report was the furthest by several hundred miles, according to CHPS. WHYN was another surprise, a 250 watter from Mass was verified on 1st time hrd. I wonder if some of the fellows could give me the signers of KARK and KGHI. I got a verie back saying that my report agreed with the stations log but did not state the call of the station and I have reports out to both. That would help me to determine which station verified. Someone signed it on behalf of the station but that is all. Hope to get some sort of a reply out of KJR and KTRB but I doubt it greatly. When do WHOP and WSON test? Would like to hear WAYS. KBPS came thru OK until 4:30 when WFNC came on and then WHIS over rode 1450 after 5, so was glad to hear 4 peices in 1/2 hour as conditions were lousy that AM. (Looks as if the Old Irishman is slipping as you Editor heard the full 2 hour program except when WFNC was on and then he could hear KBPS thru them every now and then, best of all they have already verified the Mar 27th special-Ray-Hi. Yes Boys I wrote to Charles Weagent and he verified my Mar 27th report and also said that veries would be forth coming on both programs as soon as cards were received from the printers. That is the reason for the delay-Ray) I got my 4th report out to WFNC and I'll be ready to swear if I dont hear from them. Also got a report out to WBYN, to the new guy that was in the bulletin, that makes the 6th report to them. (Guess we will have to put some dynamite under LEFTY COOPER and see that he stops in WBYN and get those veries for us, of course Pat maybe the only place LEFTY knows is in Brooklyn is EBBETS Field, where ever that is.-Ray) That makes 22 stations verified and 12 others hrd and reported but no veries as yet, so isnt too bad this year but nearly 4 months wasted by working all night in factory.

TIPS and LPO REPORTS

April 10 1943

Dates for the summer schedule of the bulletin are April 24; May 15th; June 19th; Aug 14th; Sept 4th and 18th; These are the mailing dates and are Saturdays. Please have your reports in by Thursdays. Thanks a lot. Short Wave reports should be to the SW Editor by Tuesdays.

JOE LIPPINCOTT-CELO N CAROLINA The CPC sure did a fine job and should be congratulated. I did not hear a single station dedicate a program to any other club all during the season. DX has been terrible, summer static most of the time. On the 29th I did some DXing getting reports out as a result to KIT-KHSL-KOL-KFOX-KVOA-KVOR-WFBM. Sent about 180 reports out this season to new stations heard (includes stations heard on new freqs) Have 120 veries from these. That is somewhat of a record for one season for me. There are lots of fairly near stations that I can verify but I may not bother to DX much more now as the farming takes so much time & days are so much longer. I am now busy setting out trees for a small orchard of about 35 which include apple-peach-pear-apricot-plum-nectarine-chinese date-cherry etc. I have skeeds or part skeeds on some 320 stations all on the BCB of course.

STUART LELAND-STATION WSRR-STAMFORD CONN WTOC has applied for power increase on a D-N basis. WLSM is looking for 250 watts. WTSP now completely controlled by Times Publishing Co. KOBH wants to shift to 610 kcs. KDNT seeking ultd time. Network affiliations and changes.. WCBI became a MBC on 4/1 and will shift to 1400 kcs. WJSV, CBS Washington outlet became WTOP officially on 4/4) this call was secured from the Griffin Ohio police and is the result of a long-time effort to obtain a different, more easily remembered set of letters for the Washington station.. WJSV was formerly owned by James S Vance. hence the call letters.. WFMD becomes a special supplementary CBS outlet and WSAZ joined the Blue on 4/1.. WTAG on 4/6 takes over CBS programs, relinquishing its NBC.. This is a result of the recent acquisition of VBZ-WBZA by the NBC which serves the same area.. effective the same date WORC will handle Blue network Elsewhere KDYL was denied a change to 380 kcs as well as power increase. WPID becomes the 6th station to surrender its license because of the war. Studio and Xmitter will remain intact and station will apply for new license after the duration. WLAY has asked for CP to cover new Xmitter... WEGO and WSAP have been granted licenses to cover the CPs. WMAN temporarily suspend operations when a \$10,000 fire in an adjacent store smoked out their 2nd floor quarters and damaged the power line on 3/22. WFAS is now full time on 1230 kcs.

STANWOOD R MORSS-BRALFORD MASS The last few I have reports out to are Police Radio Stations. Here are the signers for 4 veries just received, WPGQ-C L Elliot; WQFE-Eugene E Perrigo; WPHC-Lieutenant M A Mock and from KHPF Harry W Duncan. The Police broadcasters seem to verify more promptly than the regular stations. Veries in from WHA-WJHO-WOL-KFPW-WPGQ-WQFE-WPHC. Reports out to VRJI-WRDH-WPHT-WPHK-WPGG-WANK, all Police broadcasters, where is KPXA on 1658 kc, a police radio? (Soy Stan where is your report to WMJ?-Ray) KBOR to be on 24 hours a day beginning 4/1. House of Rep voted to abolish War time in Iowa.

RAY EDGE-BUFFALO N.Y. Well since last report I received veries from the following, KMLB-KWKW-KGCK-CHPS-CKCK-KMYC-KCMC-KHSL-KPAC-CFJC-KBPS-WGPC-WKBH-KGER-WDEF all letters and cards from WMRC-CFJC-WHYN-WSTP-CHAD-WBTA. Reports went out to KPAS-KONO-WSAP-KGFL-KGMB-WGIL-KBPS-WHYN-WKBH-KYUM-WDEF. Signer for KGER is Ronald Oakley the c.e. and this might be a help to others. Ed Gibson signed for WGPC and Geo Tate c.e. for WMRC, these 3 said my reports were mislaid so were results of follow ups. I suggest those who are also looking for any of these 3 drop a lint to the above signers. As stated in another report of one of our members KBPS will verify both programs as soon as the cards arrive from the printers.
