Those follow ups really do wonders to bring in veries, incidently. KFJB back with a nice blue letter by O L Russell; KGCU by Bernard Boardman c.e.; KVOA by Andrew White; WLSL by Philip Briggs c.e.; WRRF a card by Geo Martin c.e.; WTAW sent letter and Ekko stamp for a report of 12/9/42 and WIBU sent a honey of a card showing a photo of their modern Xmitter bldg in Poynette. They will verify only if reports are addressed to Leonard Doese, c.e. and the verie is worth going after; KPOW received R4-5 on DX and KBPS was logged for 15 minutes pretty well, but faded badly. WARM hrd on test 3/20 R8; WHMA on for 10 minutes with Van Nostrand on 4/16 R9; WLSL on 4-4:30 on 4/16 R8 with WJBK off and only WWSW as interference. Am still waiting for veries from WMFR-KONO-WCBT. Spick on 1390 at 3:42 and WCOL at 4:03 on and off for an hour and covering another signal; On 4/8 KFVB at 3AM; WSOC R7 at 3:18 and WRRB s-off at Mdt. 4/9 WORK s-off 12:08; KFEL at 1:30 and WBOC test at 2:08; 4/10 WDEF at 3:45; WQBC at 4:09 and WGNC at 4:12 all testing; 4/11 WORK at 1:21 asking for DX reports at 2AM alnight anniversary; WDAE at 2:15 and another one, who? JACK WILLARD-DENVER COLO Here is a line to let you boys know how things are going out this way. I didnt receive the Mar 15th card until the 22nd so missed DXes from WBBB and CHLT. (Well you didnt Jack as neither came on-Ray) The card of Mar 23rd however received in plenty of time and I got the last half hour of KBPS DX and they put in a fine signal here. Saw Art Robb's QRA in the last bulletin and dropped him a line. He replied with a fine letter and I expect we will get together one of these days when he is on leave. East coast stations are still coming in very well. They are best about 3-5AM. The West coast is usually good all year. I received a fine letter from WTAM. I consider it the best of any of the 50 KW stations that I have hrd from. Most of those big boys send a mimeographed form signed by some secretary's secretary, but this one was from S E Leonard, Engineer in Charge. It was certainly far more than I had hoped for. Other veries in recently are from CKLW-WCAE-WMBD-WENR-KVFD-KARM-KMOX-KVOX-KRNT-WALA-KGNF-XEG. Still having antenna trouble or I would be doing much better than the above indicates. I dont remember if I told you about receiving TIPG's verie, thats the one I wrote in Spanish. I have 15 letters on my desk to mail, so I'm lucky if I get this out. I would like to thank Ivor Sutherland for his swell

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TIPS and LPO REPORTS

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JACK CRAIG-ERIE PA Well for my 1st report I have received veries from the following, letter & EKKO stamp from WSUI for test 3/31, letter from WISN and one from KLPM for test on 4/10. Card from WTJS and one from WBLK giving type of Xmitter and antenna, card from KHLD and WCED and an attractive letter from WDEF. Latest reports are to KOKO-WBTH-WKBV-KGFL-WQBC-WHBQ-WBRW-KMLB-KTUL-WJZM-WLAY-WKWK-WLIB-WORD-WJHL and CHAD whose signal I had plenty of trouble in getting because of high pitch-hum on 1340 kc only. That stopped about 5 minutes after program was over, plus plenty of summer static. Another station was on 1340 kcs probably WEXL. Did WEXL shut down? (From here it seemed so unless they were testing with just a signal-Ray) In fact the only clue I have that I was listening to CHAD is that I heard them mention CKRN at 3:40AM EWT. However I was able to recognize a few tunes that I heard, so sent them a report in care of station CKRN. Thanks to Sully Sullivan for the copy of RADEX. I can see why they called it the DXers Bible.

TED BAMBERGER-SHAKER HGTS O Not very many reports out in the last month but a lot of swell veries were received here. The best being from ZNS and CMCY. Others are WRLC-KIUP-KWYO-WRDO-KFYR-WCBI-KTNM-CHOV-KWON-WRRF. KFYR has a special DX program the 2nd Thursday from 3:15-3:45 EWT on 550 kcs. They verify with a letter and stamp. The ZNS verie was sent by the Telecommunications Dept. Recent reports are to WCBI on NRC special-KWON-WRRF-WAOV all on freq tests. The verie from CMCY took 5 months. CHOV seemed rather perplexed at the usage of the WSA-R-QKN-QSB-QRM signals, they must have had one fine time trying to decipher the reports. (Yes I guess so so I sent them the information so they could tell what they meant-Ray)

GRANT BATSON-WESTFIELD N.Y. Very little DX here for a month due mostly to sickness in family and what I did get was bad with static but here goes. 3/26 WGIL 4-4:20 Q4 R9; 3/27 KBPS special fairly well hrd on clear channel and again WNOE were off for NRC and a special txn card was sent. 4/9 KWYO on test heave QRN; KGFL hrd but not loggable due to static. Veries received are cards from KMO-KWYO-KHBC for Jan 26th report, US censored and card in letter from WCBI. Letters from KPOW-KBPS-CHOV-CFJC and from CKNB regretting that I was unable to listen due to circumstances here. 4/14 CHAD, couldnt get a report for entire hour because WEXL did not sign off, all I got was one station break at 3:08 but sent a personal txn letter to Mr. Pope. Of all the reports I've sent since last Nov 1st only 16 remain unanswered, not bad for the season, no verie from WCBT. WDBJ of Roanoke occupies 960 evenings here and KMA is seldom hrd. WBRC only hrd a couple times in as many years. TO Dick Cooper-I received WCAL on Feb 13 at s-on 7:30-7:45AM on a Z,ro morning. WJZ gave little QRM, a freak reception I call it as WCAL is double the distance and much less power. Signer was David Johnson, program director. TO Howard Judson who signed WHYN? and does WHN verify? (Grant signer for WHYN is Thomas R Humphrey, c.e. and the QRA is Hampden-Hampshire Corp., 180 High St.) Verie back in 4 days a card) My best veries for the past season are KGFJ KAST-KWRC-KBPS-KPOW-KEUB-KFUN-KHBC-CHAD-CKVD-CKRN.

JOE BRAUNER-WILLIAMSVILLE N.Y. DX has slowed down to a walk here, since last report only addition is WTOP verified with fine letter from c.e. Clyde M Hunt. Other veries are an airmail letter from WIAC, plain card from KXEL and nice letter from CHOV. Have been trying for several of the regular tests, which I need but had no luck. CHAD came in a lot better on their latest test, some announcements being almost completely understood, there was interference from someone and a hetrodyne too, but they could be verified easily in needed, sent them another report. My DX year ends 4/30 after that I'll give the usual statistics for the year, didnt do so bad at all but most of the new ones were added as a direct result of the NRC tips and programs, very few added on surprise tests. (Well Joe I am glad some one came to my rescue on CHAD, I said WEXL wasnt on-Ray)
