DXed a little the other AM and added a couple nice catches, namely VE9AI-JRAK-VLC6 the best Aussie hrd here a Q5 R 10-PIAM Radio Rangoon-Radio Shonan-XXXX JZHA, Solomon Islands, Azad Moslem Radio-GWN-PRL8-Madagascar Radio Tananarive-Ceylon-JCJC in Cairo and also WMOH in J Becker's home town in daytime. Veries in from VE9AI-CX6-VBF and a couple more. No news from Hipley here. (Just as I said in letter-Ray)

Its been quite some time since you heard from me but I have been getting around some lately. Am now located in Egypt and catching up with some writing, but have not received any mail.

When I do I'll be needing a 3 day pass to read it. With another DX season coming up I hope the club continues to go strong. Naturally I wont be doing any DXing but at least I hear a radio once in a while. Its quite a noval experience to be planted in a country like this. Many of the natives still wear robes as they did centuries ago. Far from clean and they sit and lay around streets, alleys. doorways. They figure all Americans are rich and they use their ingenuity to gup us. That wasnt hard either till we got used to their money. They pay us in the darn stuff. A few days ago we visited Cairo and saw the stage show "This is the Army" Then around town and the thives, beggers, gyps and peddlers and magicians swarmed around. Some where amusing but most of them were a nuisance. The streets are dark and crowded so we had to be careful. We get our normal needs at a PX here and the Red Cross has radio, records and piano. There is no waste of spare time and I want to see all I can while I'm here. (OK for the swell letter Warren and lots of good luck to you from all)

Have hopes of another week end with possibly not only Susoreny but also Lefty Cooper here. Veries at 1143, late ones being received from WARM-KKLA-CBJ and KFUN. Two reports out. DX while some what spotty is improving rapidly here. Notably for this time of season, the English chain of stations is coming thru here around 1:00 to 2:30 AM fairly well, best of them for strength being on 1149 kcs, also an unidentified TA on 1176 said by some to be Algiers. Am happy to see the bulletin and Club become strictly BCB. I think it is a wise move from all angles. (Hope you got that flat fixed and that the week end is swell)

DICK COOPER-KITTANNING PA I sure enjoyed having the gang over the Labor Day week end and believe me fellows, You'll always find the welcome mat out here in Kittanning. I'm looking forward to that day in Buffalo when we can renew all our friendships and have a real convention. I note that Mr. Up Paul Knight covered the details of our affair pretty well. Finally got KROY to come thru with a letter verie. Also a verie in from WKLA and they seem mighty DX minded. Perhaps we'll have a DX from them. KTHT verified and I dare say not many of you had them eh? Just lucky enough to hear their short test behind WITH one morning. Reports out to WELO, hrd as per sked in last bulletin but no go on WRDD since I fell as-Leep. The Spick mystery on 670 kc is solved men, and tnx to Dr Kirk who called it correctly. I checked with Pan American Brdg Corp in New York and they say it is CMHQ, Sanat Clara. Hope a lot of you received the card regarding CJRL in time to hear that program. I did not solicit it. And they apparently do not realize how long it takes to arrange publicity for a DX show. If you will all drop them a card as I suggested, I'll think they will repeat.

NEWT MC LEOD-WEST PERU ME The new aerial seems hot for the west coast. Recent tests netted CBK-KOH and really loud signals from KFI & KSL-KOA. No TA's here yet but VONF is pounding in with great style. Believe me they are on till 10 PM EWT now. Does anyone know if KOB broadcasts John-ny Mercers Music Shop for Chesterfield at 11 PM EWT ???(How abt it NORM) I can hear a station behind WJZ but cant get a station. Think I could get enough for a report if WJZ didnt insist on running 61 seconds per minute. Guess I'll have to put up another wire from the South and Eurpoe I cant even get the howl on 1150 though there is a similar on WMAQ. In general things point to a hot season here for DX. I'm afraid its going to be a nice cold winter though with the shortage of fuel.

RAY "POP" EDGE-BUFFALO NY Still not much DX here as yet but did manage to hear WKLA and they have already verified with nice letter signed by K.L. Ashbacker, Pres. QRA is WKLA-Ludington Broadcasting Co., Masonic Temple Bldg, Ludington, Mich. Also verie in from CKEY to make the total now 833. Received my verie also from CJRL for my duplicate report as per bulletin. Will work from MDT-8AM next week then watch me go to town.

LEFTY COOPER-BLOOKLYN R.Y. (and points west) Well here I am in Brooklyn once again, after dashing all around Pennsylvania, New Jersey and New York. First I had a wonderful visit at the home of Mr and Mrs Dick Cooper in Kittanning and I certainly was pleased to meet Paul Kary-Sully Sullivan-Chuck Bender and Art Hankins, plus renewing old aquaintances with Ray Loge and Dick. I'm still laughing over kay's description of the B & O RR bridge crossing. He would have loved my trip back to Pittsburgh when our train stopped for a good Ju minutes high up on a bridge across a "creek" (Hi-Dick) where another branch of the P PR crossed the Kittanning line. OR JOHN KIRK-PT PLEAGANT h VA Can anyone tell or give me any info about the following. Hrd on 9/17 from 10;39-11;15 PM a station on 790 kcs believed to be YV5kB. Positive it was Curacas but not sure it was YV5RB. Announced as "Cadena de Las Americas" thereas YV5RB is supposed to be Cadean Radio Inter-Americana. Also announced as "The Voice of the Nation" Did not hear coll mentioned although freq was given 3 times. Programs IL-LL;15 recordings of American dance orchestras I have every title and at 11,15 joined BBC for news in Spick from London. If anyone know who it was and if it was YV5RB please let me know as I have plenty material for a verie. Also who is the code station on aprox 1233 kc often hrd about 3 AM. He is definitely sending in some foreign language and I am sure it isnt Spanish-German-French as these just wont work unless it is code groups and it doesn't sound like that. Also who was the station testing on 1580 kc at 3:40 on 9/19 with raw AC on final. Lousy signal but very strong. Also who was the station testing on 640 kcs 3:10-3:26 AM on 9.19 with cowboy music. Sure that is was a "K". Possible that this was a stand by xatr of KFI. KAVE putting in a nice signal on their free check test this AM 9/19 between 3;32-3;44 AM. WCOL is really messing up 1230 for me. A few of the members have written in saying that their bulletin did not arrive, this being a week or so after it was mailed. It has been investigated at this end and you can be sure that your bulletins are sent on their way within an hour after they are celivered at the Main Post Office here in Buffalo. The hold up seems to be at transfer points along the way and this is caused by the large increase in all mail. If you will remember that before this war your bulletins were arriving in very good time, those up to the Mississippi getting theirs on monday and some of you west of that river also received your bulletins on mondays regularly.

Due to this hold up at the different transfer points nothing can be done about it and you will just have to wait until it arrives, however, if you do not wish that you can have your bulletin mailed from Club HQ via first class mail but you will have to pay the additional postage because paying even 3¢ per issue and there being 3¢ issues it would take \$1.02 of your annual \$2.00 dues for postage, leaving only 98¢ to cover the cost of paper-envelopes-mimeograph ink and stencils which would not be enough. Then if the bulletin ran over 4 sheets of paper it would require 6¢ postage which would again take more of your dues. So if you downsh this service you can send along \$1.00 and the club will pay the lst 1-1/2¢ postage and you pay the rest, thus it will cost you 1-1/2¢ on a 4 page bulletin or 4-1/2¢ postage if it runs over 4 sheets of paper.

Some of you have asked for another bulletin which was send at once but it must be remembered that we do not print a lot of extra copies of each issue because that would be a waste of paper as they would just be laying around and no one could judge as to how many would be used. Your editor addresses the envelopes the first part of the week and when it comes time to print the bulletin he prints them according to the amount of envelopes to be used. I hope that you will understand and if your bulletin doesn't come too soon please wait as it will arrive as they will be mailed from Club HC on schedule. It has been hearned that in cases where the bulletin was not received and another one was asked for, the first

one was received before the 2nd one arrived.

Now to a little talk on the Club becoming just a BCB Club. If you read the SW section of the Sept 9th issue you will know the answer, so I am asking you to do the folling things from now on. Please use the Frequency Frolic Column more often and use it for the important items, not with every thing you hear and PLEAGE list the items according to FREQ-LOCATION and then the remarks. By doing this it makes it so much more easier here as that column isnt made up until the last thing so that everything important that comes in can be listed and not held over from one week to another. That is why I ask that these items be listed on a seperate sheet of paper, it need not be a full sheet, any clean or piece of scrap paper will do, just as long as it can be kept seperate from your regular report. Also send in your reports as soon as possible and I am making ThUhSDAYS the deadline for everything.

One of the FIRST improvements in our BCB Belletin is that in cases of stations notifying us of a BK or some other important item pertaining to Dkes or so a care will be sent you if it can not be given to you in a bulletin that will reach you in time. IN ONIE, TO GET THIS SERVICE YOU AUST REGISTER LITH FICK COOPER-956 ORB AVE., KITTANKING, PENN AT ONCE. There will be no cost to you, but YOU MUST REGISTER. However those on the west xx coast who desire Air mail service must also send in 7¢ for each card they wish mailed that way, there will probably be only five or six such occasions. But register in order to get this postal service.

You notice that a couple different colored pages are used, this is not caused by a paper shortage here, its only that I am using some extra paper that was obtained from our member Bob -pencer, the white is and will be used as soon as this is gone. We have plenty on hand here.

Due to the tie vote for Board Chairman and the vecationing of Lefty Cooper who was finally named Chairman, the results of the other Club Offiers will be delayed for an issue or two. However Lefty says that he will contact the other board Members very soon and as soon as the results on a Vice President; Vice Chairman; Secretary- Editor-Treasurer are obtained they will be published. You see those officer have to be named or renamed each year by the Board Members.
