HAROLD WAGNER-H GIRARD PA The night of the 15th and AM of the 16th was the most unusual ever hid here. European stations were coming in all over the dial and the only trouble was one didnt know which one to listen to. Started out with Algiers on 1176vkc at 5:55PM hrd weakly. Then the BBC on 767 from 6:45-7:30PM. He had some interference from WJR & WJZ. Hrd at 7:10PM was the French station on 648 coming in behind WSM. Couldn't seperate them but he could be heard when ever WSM was talking. Hrd hetrodynes on all sorts but frixxxxxxxx picked up the station on 905 to be best; Fell asleep on him almost immediately. Believe he was taking in German. "oke up at 9PM worked around the house till 12:30 then decided to stay up will WSM signed at LAM and found it to be Radio TIBAS who announced at 1:15AM. Seemed to be on 650 kcs now as he cant be hrd hetrodyning WSM evenings anymore. Then tuned down and heard a station on 760 kc playing Viennese Waltzes, didnt think anything of it as it was coming in so strong and a lady announced in English, so kept going, then realized there shouldnt be anything there. Came back and at 1:30 announced as Germany calling with a program for the Allied forces. Man gave news in English at 1:30AM to 1:45, then woman came on with musical program again. Went off the air in the midst of a selection at 1:48AM. Have music box chime similiar, but not same as the SW stations, which they use on the quarter hour with sta identification. Believe she announced as Holland but not sure. Also had were Germans on 886 at 2;15 and one on 1031 at 2:30AM. A sta talking German was also hetrodyning KFI that AM, was on 638. Carriers were had on 658-785-905-1086 besides the BBC whoewere pounding in on 668-767-877 kc. Stations faded out at 2:45 and so went to bed, could hardly believe it true. Also had German on 658 the next nite 11/17, he evidentally signs on at MDT as he can be had hetrodyning WJZ then. Would like to try again and verify them when we can.

They informed me that they were "Secret confidential government stations" and that they would release no info about them. One time last Feb I did hear the one on 1950 kc announce on voice as being a tele-photo station (chatever that may be) I have here reports from as far away as Maine-Calif-Canada and Cuba reporting reception of one or more of these stations. So the FCC knows all about them and they are operating with FCC permission and are all OK. They do sound like the very devil though when you tune them in. Note perticularly the tracking signal superimposed on the reg noisy element. Suppose it has some significance. Its thought that these xmtr use relatively high power (50km) I have receive info to this effect from certain sources (not FCC). Doc mirk. 415 Main St. P.S. Its a CW station that goes like blazes and its pretty tough to hear anything through it. Think I can lick him as soon as I get a coil big enough to cover 455 kc. Also bothered with radio beams. One on 810 is especially bothersome and I think the letters are "KA" Or am I off my beam? wanaged to copy KWBU with a louder signal then WJZ but had no more luck till CKPC came along. 11/17 seemed pretty good and I got WDAY-CKRMand CKOV for new ones, also CJOC at times and CFCH on top of KLRA at times. No luck with KVNU though. CKOV made up for it though as it gives me B.C. to have heard all states and provinces. This Am was very noisy while CKPC was on but cleared up later. From 5:58-6:35 I listened to CKCW, then 6:40-7:15 I got CHGS and at 7:15 I ran into CJCH. All new ones for me except CKPC. "uess I'll have to DX a little more in the morning, but 5AM comes swful soon after LAM to me. This AM cleaned up the Maritimes for me except CBH which - havent been able to raise yet. Too much CHLT-WCOU. Oh yes a station on 640 kcs on 11/14 testing with cowboy records and off at 2:25. Believe this is the same one that Kirk hrd. Who is it?? They were all copied here even KXO poorly using directional Beverage Wave cerials. TO DICK-I had hose bowl game and description of Riggle backward run. Do you remember the show that come out ofterwards about it? not a news reel. I even say the show. Here are some old time calls for you. KGCI-San Antonio 5 watts; AT-9-BRI-PN-WPDQ Buffelo 5wetts and his slogan was Wireless Purty Domn Quick. 1st class mail service is the stuff. Bulletin now gets here Friday PM or Sat AM, used to be anytime the following week. 17th fine DX AM; 16th 7-8:30PM Paris-Germany and Londson all well had. Berlin s/off at 8:06 PM EFT. Verie in from KPAB for 1st Onio report on 1490 kc.
