PAT REILLEY-JAMESTOWN N.Y. 11/15 WCRS at 3:45-3:55; KRIC s/off at 4:08; WORD at 4:10; WROX at 4:11 to 4:13 s/off for a new one for me. I have 10 verified calls in the WKBA to Z block. 11/16 Too noisy; 11/17 WGBR 3:10-3:20 monthly check; WSON 3-3:30 on check; KVNU not heard at all on DX; WPAD at 3:12; WELO at 3:14-3:16 on check; WMFD checked at 3:35; 11/18 In Lefty Coopers class; 11/19 Stayed up until after 4, caught WBYN, 7th report, hope they will verify this time; XELZ caught, tx to Phil Nichols note in bulletin; KLO off at 2:05; KOY off at 3; The English station on 877 kcs was good until after 4 AM when they began to fade. Read names and spelled them, and English service boys sent messages home, no call in nearly an hour. WINN hrd here; 11/20 Too noisy, snowing, XEL on 1260 at 3AM. ZNS s/off at 10 PM EWT on 640 kcs. Also gives a SWL freq, Quote "ZNS 4??? Nassau in the Bahamas" Would like to know if VONF has a YL announcer???

LEFTY COOPER-BROOKLYN N.Y. Well WCOL put the whammie on KXO all right. No chance here. Even WISE was inaudible. Was she on? I heard no signs of Betty here. KVNU likewise had no chance; 11/18 Finally did succeed in hearing a DX-CKPC came in here with good volume, but fading, through heavy QRN with a fine varied program. 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JOHN LONG cont Logged 2 new ones 11/19 KWSC & KPAS. KWSC at s/off at 2AM just before KTMS s/off. Tuned in too late for a report although they were very good. Will have to try again. KPAS very noisy, didnt report to them.

HAROLD WAGNER-N GIRARD PA The night of the 15th and AM of the 16th was the most unusual ever hrd here. European stations were coming in all over the dial and the only trouble was one didnt know which one to listen to. Started out with Algiers on 1176vkc at 5:55PM hrd weakly. Then the BBC on 767 from 6:45-7:30PM. He had some interference from WJR & WJZ. Hrd at 7:10PM was the French station on 648 coming in behind WSM. Couldnt separate them but he could be heard when ever WSM was talking. Hrd hetrodynes on all sorts but ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~ picked up the station on 905 to be best; Fell asleep on him almost immediately. Believe he was taking in German. Woke up at 9PM worked around the house till 12:30 then decided to stay up will WSM signed at 1AM and found it to be Radio TIBAS who announced at 1:15AM. Seemed to be on 650 kcs now as he cant be hrd hetrodyning WSM evenings anymore. Then tuned down and heard a station on 760 kc playing Viennese Waltzes, didnt think anything of it as it was coming in so strong and a lady announced in English, so kept going, then realized there shouldnt be anything there. Came back and at 1:30 announced as Germany calling with a program for the Allied forces. Man gave news in English at 1:30AM to 1:45, then woman came on with musical program again. Went off the air in the midst of a selection at 1:48AM. Have music box chime similar, but not same as the SW stations, which they use on the quarter hour with sta identification. Believe she announced as Holland but not sure. Also hrd were Germans on 886 at 2:15 and one on 1031 at 2:30AM. A sta talking German was also hetrodyning KFI that AM, was on 638. Carriers were hrd on 658-785-905-1086 besides the BBC who were pounding in on 668-767-877 kc. Stations faded out at 2:45 and so went to bed, could hardly believe it true. Also hrd German on 658 the next nite 11/17, he evidently signs on at MDT as he can be hrd hetrodyning WJZ then. Would like to try again and verify them when we can.

Did manage to get enough for a report. Noise level very high making reception pretty tough on the weak ones. (OK got here WED PM-Ray)

TO HAROLD WAGNER and OTHERS; I have written Harold direct, however here is essential information on the stations on 1800-2000 kcs with a very noisy type of signal and an extremely broad band. I first heard these stations last season. They seem to be on 1800-1850-1900-1950-2000 kcs. There may be others, but these are definite. Last Feb-Mar-April I was in touch with the FCC about these. They informed me that they were "Secret confidential government stations" and that they would release no info about them. One time last Feb I did hear the one on 1950 kc announce on voice as being a tele-photo station (whatever that may be) I have here reports from as far away as Maine-Calif-Canada and Cuba reporting reception of one or more of these stations. So the FCC knows all about them and they are operating with FCC permission and are all OK. They do sound like the very devil though when you tune them in. Note particularly the tracking signal superimposed on the reg noisy element. Suppose it has some significance. Its thought that these xmtr use relatively high power (50kw) I have receive info to this effect from certain sources (not FCC).
