San Francisco, Calif. 1380 kcs Cebu City, Cebu, P.I. ADD XNEW-
 6?? in Chunking, China. The list shows WVTI on 1320 was located at Finsch-
 aven(Base F) 60 miles north of Lae. WVTI had the transcription library for
 all the AFR stations in New Guinea. I verified them with the gang at WVTE,
 here in San Fernando, as they were the original staff of WVTI and the trans-
 mitter here was the original WVTI xmtr. Also informed me that A.F.R. is no
 longer operating any stations in New Guinea. Their operation was turned
 over to the Information & Education sections of the respective bases. They
 still carry on with the same programs, but are operating on less power. If
 there was a station at Aitope it was operated by the Australian Ammenities
 Service as that became an Australian base not long after the beach-head was

Overwhelmed with 6 veries all in one week as follows;- CHUM with DEFINITE VERIE (Hi Pop) on last half hour program 4:30-5PM on 11/17 thru WNH, by return mail; WKIX swell letter and verie for last fall report from Alta E Sibbitt who is now in Islamorada, Florida evidently recuperating from a bus accident. Says she took all her old reports with her after checking them and will get out veries eventually, so dont give up hope boys. KUTA swell personal letter from c.e. G. Wendell Bell who says their reg F/C is on 1st MON 4:15-4:30 AM EST and that aerial is directional the reason for poor signal in east; CJSO with their swell letter and program dope and printed card verie from CJEM to make my total now 1247. The best verie of all was rec from WVUR direct, QRA and signer in Freq Frolics.
