Winner of WXLQ is evidently Frank Susoreny, when I got my letter from SGT Wertheim he said it was either Thomas or 2 rpters from Toronto, but after he left there Fanks rpt arrived. DX this week 2/19 Up for CKPG and hrd WCPO S/off but very bad buzz was on and I hrd another sig which I didnt then identify, but which I learned was WCMA. WCPO is mighty swell to us and I hope no one forgot to thank them. 2/20 Logged WHNC with difficulty, a very noisy AM, did get rpt anyway. 2/21 Old buzz back again and I hrd WFBL come on and go off for us and another sig could be hrd, but identification was not possible. However I sent the rpt on what I hrd to CP3 in hopes it was they I hrd. 2/22 Up all AM; WMAN seems to have moved its 2 hour test to the 4th FRI 1-3 as they were on battling with WJLB. Is a Cuban on 1460 staying on till 2:30 which has program of readings and organ music 2-2:30, but a test from WOKO ruined him. WTJS hrd 2:37, probably moved its test to 2:30-2:45 4th FRI; WJAG 780 kc 3:15-3:30; WHOP 3:30-4; also checks on 1450 kc of WGOV-WHMA-WROX-WCRS. APO 174 % Postmaster, NY, NY reading it. Sure would like to be back home and knock off these new stations. If I remember correctly I had about 200 veries when I cam in the Army so by the way they are opening up these new ones I could almost double my score on new stations alone. Life is beginning to get rough as we have an endless of guard details. Other outfits are being redeployed as we are taking over their guard. Right now the remp is kicking around Zero and my feet are still cold from a 6-8; 12-2; 6-8 seige last night and this morning and they give no promise of warming up before noon when I go on again for 2 hours. My APO has been changed again, seems I can never keep one for more than a month. (OK Chuck and new QRA above)

HILDING GUSTAFSON-ROCKFORD ILL My mystery on 1210 turned out to be WSMB. How come? Image I guess. CP-3 not audible here but sent tnx cards to KGER-WFBL. HCJB were hrd on about 994 kcs on their DX. Seth was out last week with SX-25. Hope to try it against Hammarlund next month. F ll asleep on TGO, luckily I came to at 3:43 and managed to hear him thru very heavy summer like static. Was surprised and pleased to have him stay on till 5:07. Was Q-0 R 5-7, used both languages but could only catch a few words thru noise. Hope other boys caught them. No luck on KPQ this AM. Very weak station was there but loud power noise-buzz prevented me from reading him. KGMB on 590 was good hrd much better. Will send KPQ a thank you card as I have done to WCPO-WFBL-KGER.

Reports spotty too. 2/18 KNAK testing and s/off 3:20; No go on CKPG tho WCPO was off, WCMA logged 3:06-3:35 for rpt; KGFJ caused QRM 3:45-4, thought I had something definite but guess not. KOVO was on but got them last month, pretty noisy to get decent rpt on; 2/20 Struck it lucky WBBB at 5:30 S/on and WMMN left air due to difficulty, left N C stations in clear; 2/24 CMHK on 1380 for DX, fairly good but static bad. Caould get once in while a drift of TGO on 1140 but not enough to even copy, dare say no one else did either, so tuned to 6490 SW and some static and CW there; 2/25 No KPQ, thot at 3AM through WIND some station played National Anthem tho not sure it was KPQ s/on. After 3:07 AM not a thing hrd, entire band was a nightmare of static except 1340, got WFEB 3:10-3:31 for test; Got WKRZ thru WEBR nights around 6PM.

Rpt to WHNC hrd 2/20, another inch of snow. 2/24 CMHK fair here, lots of static, no TGO, showing again, nother blizzard by the looks of things. (Wall Stan we aint the only ones who get them-Pop)

PAT REILLEY-JAMESTOWN N Y 2/19 Wife sick no DX at all; 2/20 WHNC for new one 2/21 CHUM at 2:50; WAGC at 3:06 with WWDC not hrd at all; 2/22 WMAN at 3:15 WGOV on F/C at 3:18, is this a change?? 2/24 WDOD at 2:30; WINN at 3:05, no CMHK hrd 4-5; TGO picked up at 3:31 until after 4 but lousy noise and bad fade, sandwiched between WNEW-XEJP. New veries are WPAT-CJCJ and 16 rptd still out. New WKRZ is a daytime station here; To LEFTY Quote from CJCJ letter "You were among the very few who had any degree of success in picking out enough to establish the fact that it was our show you heard" by C F Mock. Ed Wyman was visiting friends in town over week end and had two nice but short visits from him, sorry he couldnt stay longer; 2/25 Nothing hrd of KPQ altho KGMB was good for 1st time this year; WCMA for new one, all the 4th TUES 1450 stations were on today at same time as listed for TUES; WOR wasnt hrd either; WING tested 3:47, unknown on 560 testing with no call 4:45-5 when they s/off with no call given, quite noisy and weak today all over the band, alnighters were even weak.

J WARREN ROUTHAN-YORK PA Since last rpt I logged WHNC-WROX-TGO-WMLT-WCMA. Only veries were WHNC-WEGO-CFAB; 2/20 WHNC like a local on their DX 2/21 KRKO unreadable on F/C; KGER off at 5 but no Cp-3 here up to 5:15; Too bad. 2/22 F/Cs WCRS 3:50; WAGC 3:54; WROX 3:55-4:10; WRLC 4:10; WGIL 4:12-4:30; 2/23 CKLWs s/off 3:30; KONP couldnt get thru WWDC; WLAG test 3:45; KPKW couldnt get thru 1340; 2/24 TGO got thru the noise but hard to copy. TGOA was emen noisy at times but they came in anyway; 2/25 No luck on WKIX; WMLT 2:35-2:45; WJBW 2:50-3; WCMA 3-4; WFEB 3:30; WKEU 3:45-4; WING 3:50-4:10; Tried for KPQ at intervals but got nothing and didnt wait.
