- 3 DEADLINE for the present will be on TUESDAYS of each week. Deadline for next issue will be OCT 1st.
- 4 Try to make your reports both interesting and informative, in other words if you heard WMAM, also say when, so the report will be of benefit to other members.
- 5 Anything in any members reports which the Editor deems unwise to print lest someone be offended, will of course be deleted from such report.

LEFTY COOPER-BROOKLYN N.Y. Rpts out to WDCS-WTIK-WARD-KPDR-XEFI-WKNB-WNAR-CHOK-WLAN-WINR-KGIW-WCCP-WKXL-WTOD-CJOC-WMOA-WWNR-WMUR-WBUY-XEMC-WMGR-WFTL-CMKJ-WDAR. Veries in from WIRA-WSIV-WDSC-WNCA-WTIK-WMFT-KPDR-XEFI-WLAN-KGIW-WKXL-WMUR-WWNR-KSFT-CJOC-WBUY, letters and cards WRHI-WDSR-KTRB-WNAR-XELO for a 1943 rpt and verie total now 1147. Needless to say I had a wonderful time at the Convention having just about everything I needed except sleep. Hrd a couple TAs 9/16 for the first this season but while I was fooling around trying to find if any others were coming in they faded out on me so did not get any reports out. Was glad to see announcement of contest in last bulletin, dont imagine I'll get a good total or be a threat. Does anyone know of a way to cut out side-bands?? That is on the more powerful stations. The Xtal filter doesnt do any good, neither does the wave trap. The only answer I have been able to think of is a loop antenna. The ARRL Antenna handbook shows a loop enclosed in a circular section of copper tubing designed for 160 meters but it could probably be made to work on the BCB. Say a look like this has a very sharp null. My trouble is finding 1 inch tubing. Rest of the DX equiptment here included 90 ft antenna NW-SE, a 200 ft ant NW-SE which I am in the process of putting up. Also a 2 drawer card file of all foreign BCB stations.

Then for about 15 min, WGRC climbed on top and no one else came thru. Then back came WDAR. By the way. That WKEY reception was at 10:30 PM thru the mess on 1340. WAGE was also an evening rpt. AL BARTHOLOMEW-CORNING N Y The 45-46 DX season was one of best in years for me. Plenty of quantity as well as quality. Sent an even 100 new rpts out but a higher percentage than usual failed to reply. Those of that 100 still out are CHEF-KWOR-KPKW-WCMA-WPPA-Nice on 1285-CMHK-XEG-XEL-WVUR in New Hebrides-YV5RB-HJCB-VOWN. Total now 1470 veries ATTENTION SCHWARTZ)-Hi. with log at 1555. There are a total of 273,2000 miles or more 129 are foreign veries and 43 countries are verified. 129 Canadians 56 Mex and 39 Cubans. Highlight of season was addition of more new countries verified than in any 1 season-Czechoslovakia-Sweeden-Spain-Austria-Switzerland-Alaska-Bermuda-Canal Zone-Saipan. Began 45-46 needing about 35 calls to complete USA and at end of season I needed around 40. So you can see I lost ground steadily even tho I caught a lot of new ones that came on the air.
