Have just received the following letter from Mr. William C Zehring, Asst Chief Engineer of "WLBR".

Radio Station W L B R plans to broadcast a Special DX Program on the morning of March 16 1947. The entire program will be in charge of the engineering department and will begin about 1:30 AM EST and run until about 5 AM EST. We are sending along this word in the interest of the National Radio Club, which we plan to include in our dedications.

We ll boys here is a chance for you who mised them on their tests, to log-report and verify WLBR. My suggestion is to report to the above mentioned fellow account of it seems that he tends to veries etc.

With the exception of Pages 2-3 you will note a little difference in the stencils. Lefty was sent a different brand to see if we cant get a good clear mimeographed bulletin. In this issue Lefty did exactly the same as before and we now see that in dcing so, a slight portion of the heading might be omitted or not too clear. Will have to begin a little lower next issue. If this doesnt do the trick will see that Lefty gets him mill overhauled during the summer months. Cannot do it at present account of taking too long and would hold up the bulletin.

To ALL;- By the time this bulletin reaches you, there will be a new supply of NRC Report Forms and Letter Heads on hand. When it was found that the price was about the same I did not wait but ordered. Here are the Prices. Both the Report-Forms and Letter Heads are 75¢ per 100.

So the only increase effects the Letter Heads. The Report Forms are being printed on 16# paper as before whereas the Letter Heads are printed on 20# as suggested by Dick Cooper. The 75¢ per 100 sheets includes postage. We ordered 10,000 Forms and only 5000 Letter Heads, seems that more of the boys use the Report Forms. Rest assured we will keep trying to make the pages clear and easy to read.

BILL STONE-TORONTO, ONT. Att: Ted Matson - I use a 12 feet telescopic vertical antenna here with my SX-25, it starts at 35 feet above the ground; it is War Assets off a Sherman tank, my results are good, I advise use of it. My DXing since end of Nov. 46 has been spotty, I have got reports out to 7-EU in Bernie, Tasmania, Australia, with 200 watts power and to 2-DU in Dubbo, N.S.W. with 200 watts. In regards to 7-BU they were hrd here with readable signals 4 times in 10 days, as I doubted many would believe my statements, I passed my info on to a DXer whom I knew would not think me a liar, as a result Phil Nichols has an Air Mail report out to 7-BU as well, I only heard 2*DU the once. I also have reports out to a couple more low-powered TP's in Australia, but till the veries are back, muf sed. In South America, have reports out to HJCU ZYG-3 PRA-8 PRH-2 PRB-9, all hrd on same morning (Jan. 19) with elections, except HJCU. YV5RA reported. On Nov. 25th, I thought I had WXLS, but it turned out to be CX-16 in Montevideo Uruguay, on with elections, so I tuned the band, and picked up CX-6 on 650 too, both verified long ago. This should give you the answer you want, Ted. Have heard many TA's but somehow cannot get entused much over them, so have not reported any, one I hear fairly regularly is Madrid, Spain on 685 Kc/s. As Edge & Maley have ceased to give me opposition, I'm after you now Lefty, veries are at 1232 - so don't slow down any, or I'll be up to you, but fast. Letter in today from CKOK, owing to interference on 1450 Kc/s., they are changing frequency as soon as the crystal arrives, to 1550 Kc/s., so watch for tests on there - will DX for me in near future. Thanks to Joe Brauner for some nice tips, have added a few - again Joe, Thanx. FQN was definitely on, the manager of the station is here in town, we talk to each other weekly - the program was aired on one of the worst nights for atmospheric conditions - it will be repeated again, likely next fall. WFNS (1150) hrd on 14th, 4:00-5:30, off freq., was on 1128 Kc/s. KXRJ (1490) hrd same AM 3:00-3:30. WOAY (860) with 1st test 16th till 2:30 AM. WBPZ 14th (1230) all AM. (Nice going, Bill - how abt frequencies on those Australians? -Ed.)
