A swell card picturing a beach in Montivideo, with the city in background, enclosed in an envelope (The card, not the city-Hi) 1/25 Got up to look for KBOP;1380 per Bernie Duffy's tip, but a loud carrier covered the channel. That late afternoon after trying many times, I finally was able to bring in Madrid;1022 kcs. They were not steady, but could be heard here and there, enough for a fair report. 1/28 CHGB 1350 on till 0200 with American records and French announcements, and ever the optimist, I am sending what I believe is my 7th report to them, still trying for a verification. Behind them was WEEK, which could be WEAK here. I believe I had Dakar 1433 from 0212-0235 but not positive. PRE-9 again loggabl'r at 0300 s/on on 1200 kcs. Then I fell asleep at the dial, awakening at 0430 in time to hear some of WACB's swell show. I missed (I guess) my dedication but heard many selections dedicated to others. A number of nice veries received since last report; Letters from TIHB-YVKQ-PRE-4 and Nordwest - deutscher Rundfunk, Germany 1586 kc; cards from Radio Luxembourg, C<sup>A</sup>-28 CB57 and KPOA. CX-28 received 23 reports on their special. CB-57 sent SW card with SW data crossed out and BCB confirmation inserted. Luxembourg sent big red card airmail, for country #51 verified. Europeans are still holding up here fairly well, though nothing sensational has been heard. I can hear Radio Andorra on 827 kcs late afternoons, but WNYC is so strong that logging him is almost impossible. OAX4U special well hrd here, very strong; inaudible of course while local WINS was testing. YVQJ heard 3;05-4;05, very weak at first, built up somewhat as time went by. No sign of YVQB although some carrier was heard on 1220 that AM. HIZ logged on 1355 kc one evening and reported. Have logged and reported the following Brazilians for early AM sign-ons. PRB-7 on 900 kc; PRG-2 on 1040 kc; PRE-3 on 1180 kc; PRG-9 on 1100 kc. In addition have PRE-4 on 1300 kc; PRE-9 on 1200 kc, already verified. To PAH REILLEY; 1220 kc Brazilian is positively PRE-9, 5kw "Ceara Radio Clube", Fortaleza, state of Ceara, northern Brazil. This morning 1/30, the west was excellent. KHON an S-6, KPOA S-7; KPAR S 3-4 and if KHSL signs off at 4AM, then I guess I had KFRB on 1290 kc from 4;30-4;45. No sign of ~~XXX~~ 2YC or other down unders. IMPORTANT; Watch Tuesday night-Wednesday morning February 6-7 as many South Americans will probably be on late with Pre-Lenten Carnival broadcasts.
