First, I'd like to say that the response to the notes in the last bulletin regarding the "Supremacy Ratings" has been poor up to this date. I'll be typing up the December listing around the third week of December but if the number of DXers and their up-to-date listings aren't forwarded soon there will be very little use in publishing such a list. I believe that too many members feel that this listing is a contest. It is not! It is an accumulative listing of what each member has been able to verify in the Foreign Field as the DX seasons pass by. My reason for "pressing" is that I feel that each member interested should notify me of any changes at least three to four times a year. If I didn't do this the listing would lose its appeal. Secondly, I have a letter from the U.S. Embassy in Tegucigalpa, Honduras, and Mr. Arnaldo Berenguer, Commercial Attache, mentions that "Radio Pinares" is closed down. This station has been taken over by the government who, it is expected, will auction it off to liquidate its obligations. This is Page 6, and these are all the Musings received through Monday 12/19. The mails are surely fouled up right now, and I do hope we get a good batch tomorrow so this issue won't be a skimpy one. Not too much in the line of DX here this week. We added WQVA-1530 "Radio Quantico" on top of the channel on 12/18, 4:32-4:45 p.m. s/off, and on 12/19, one new one, my sixth K of the season - KBOM-1270, f/c-TT at 2:25 a.m. in the clear, but with slopover from WHBI's "Garden State Jamboree" which is on the air till 4 a.m. Mondays. There was someone on 1330 behind WEVD's OC at 3:05 a.m. with Christmas carols, but by the time they cut it off, the carols were gone, too.
