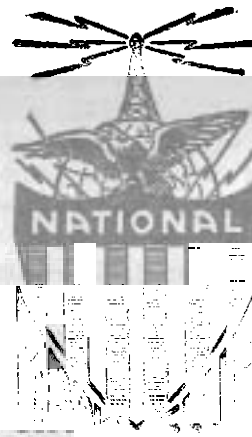

- (1) All NRC members who are regular contributors to "Supremacy Ratings" as of January 1, 1965, do not have to comply.
- (2) Indicate number of veries you have from the U.S. and Canada. (Do not include Hawaii and Alaska. For certificate purposes, they are considered "foreign" veries.)
- (3) Indicate number of veries held from countries other than Canada and the U.S. (Here is where you include Hawaii and Alaska.)
- (4) Submit a list of countries verified on the B.C.E. only. This includes U.S. and Canada. Please follow the present NRC Country List, but list separately stations you believe should receive separate country status so you may be so credited if the list is revised.
- (5) Verie Award certificates will be issued in multiples of 500. Countries Verified Award certificates will be issued in multiples of 25. These certificates are not for "heard" stations or countries. Verified only!
- (6) Do not list stations by call letters. This is not necessary. When you submit your information, your signature is your honor.
- (7) File cards (3" x5") will be kept at this den on all subscribers. Everything will be done in a business-like manner. No short cuts for anyone.
- (8) These awards are among the finest certificates you can earn in this fine hobby of B.C.E. DX. Each certificate will have a gold seal with a machine-stamped "National Radio Club" on it after the seal is adhered to the certificate.

- 1466 NORWAY. Regarding reception of Svalbard (Longyear, Spitsbergen) 1 kw., 1466 kc., Norsk Rikskringkasting said "There is a great possibility that you heard Svalbard transmitter, but we operate 3 stations on 1466, all in dual s/on and s/off and the same programs. There is not doubt but what you heard these stations, perhaps combined three, but one for sure. So please confirm your results with this list: Svalbard: 1 kw., 1466 kc., 5°W bearing; Narvik 1 kw., 1466 kc., 206°E bearing; Kautokeinol, 1 kw., 1466 kc., 112°E bearing. Since you are several hundred km. more from Svalbard than Narvik and Kautokeinol, possible that you heard the latter two, though different local transmitters are heard at most unexpected locations." - 764 SENEGAL. R. Senegal, Dakar. Logged for first TA from 0153 to 0234 on 2/15 in native language and French. News, I believe, at 0200. Native-style music on drums and stringed instrument. (Neff, N.Y.)

JAPAN. JOBE, Osaka, has English news on MM at 0445, heard in parallel with 670/750/1220 and 1370. All with excellent signals 1/25. (Dennett, B.C.)
- 834 RR. HONDURAS. R. Delize, 2047-2122 in English with "Memory Lane" show to 2100, then BBC News, and "Music from Holland" at 2113. Good signals at tune-in, but fading rapidly at tune out, with a little slopover from WCCO. (Bennett, B.C.)
 Logged 2/11 from 2020 to 2045. (Neff, N.Y.) Excellent til 2100. (Schmidt, Pa.)
- 840 BRAZIL. ZYD8, R. Excelsior de Bahia, Salvador, Bahia, heard daily since 2/1 signing on at 0230 with short mach selection. PRH9 is really clobbered out by him. "Syncopated Clock" theme of program daily at 0300. Has newscast daily at 0330. This fellow gave 12 straight commercials one morning. Have this fellow on tape and is DEFINITE ID. Even gives call letters occasionally. (Durnham, Conn.) Two Brazilians fighting SM 2/21 0239-0301, but not heard MM 2/22 at all. Dominant one had kind of rural music similar to Mexican polkas, accordion, et al. Number 2 has "carnival" music, production commercials, and had rooster crow at 0255:50. One would think the station with "rural" type programming was ZYD8, but I heard "Bandeirantes," I'm certain, so must have been PRH9 atop. (Callarman, Texas)

It was Chinese-type singing, by a female (??) at 0450, with good signals, but no station breaks and a fair bit of QRM from N.A. It's possibly Liaoning, but I wouldn't swear to it. (Bennett, D.C.)
- 1250 AS. RUSSIA. Far East Service, S8-9 at 0515 2/15. Verified several years ago. (Wilkinson, Calif.)
UNID. I did it again. Possibly Hungary around 2000 for 30 seconds. Most of U.S. to west and south lopped out, and I think I heard a weak TA in at 2002 til 2002. Does anybody else have a station around then? (Semrad, Wis.) Not me! WREN so strong here, I can't even get WEMP! (Ed.)
- 1295 SINT MAARTEN/ENGLAND. What a mess! PJD2 logged here 0020-0040 with religious programming with just about the same strength as BBC; unfortunately, the stations are 54 cps apart and the resultant mess couldn't be much worse. PJD2 logged as Country #94. (Nelson, Mass.) PJD2, Phillipsburg, logged 2/15 0430 (probably s/on as I believe anthem heard) until 0532. First positive ID at 0525 during course of advertisement; weather at 0532. (Miller, Wash.)
- 1300 PUERTO RICO/UNID L.A. WTIL heard mixing it up with 2nd Spanish-speaking station around 0300 2/8 when WERE OC off. Anybody care to venture a guess on the 2nd SS station? (Nelson, Mass.)
VENEZUELA. YVNS, R. Reloj, Maracaibo, here at sunset. ID's "R. Reloj marca la hora ..." 1709 2/9. Report out. (Silvera, Jamaica)
- 1340 DOM. REP. HIEZ, R. Centro, San Juan de la Maguana, with NRC program, excellent 2/8, sometimes with loud het. Frequent ID's. (Silvera, Jamaica)
- 1358 GERMAN F.R. Bremen, on top here at 0010 on 2/18. At least five TA's have been heard on this freq. this season at different times. (Dangerfield, Pa.)
- 1360 COLOMBIA. HJEO, R. Piloto, Barranquilla, here now from 1370 all day as usual. Noted 2/12. (Silvera, Jamaica)
- 1370 DOM. REP. HISD, R. Santo Domingo, good from sunset now that HJEO has moved. Is it parallel with 620, 860, 1270, 1310, 1350, 1360, 1380, 1390? All but 1390 logged separately. Noted 2/13. 1703. (Silvera, Jamaica)

- 1375 ST. PIERRE & MIQUELON. R. St. Pierre was S5 at 0620 on 2/15 for about five minutes. Verified several years ago. (Wilkinson, Calif.)
- 1385 HAITI. LVS, R. Port-au-Prince, assumed to be the station with Caribbean rhythms 2115-2130 and French anncts. with one chime at 2130. Tentative taped report out to see. Much sidwash from 1380/90. There are three other Latins listed here. (Callarman, Texas)
- 1392 UNID. L.A. Spanish-speaker heard here recently in the evenings, going off usually around 2200. Suspect a Dominican. (Dangerfield, Pa.)
- 1415 DOM. REP. HIAL, Ondas del Valle, La Vega, quite good here nights, logged 2/11 1969. (Silvera, Jamaica)
- 1430 UNID. W.I.B.S. with news; female announcer; got only W.I.B.S. ID, where? Noted 1736 2/3. (Silvera, Jamaica) Unknown to me. (Ed.)
- 1440 DOM. REP. HIAA, R. San Juan, San Juan de la Maguana, with L.A. program. Good sunset reception 1732 2/7. (Silvera, Jamaica.) Official government list gives this call. Mike said HIAA. (Ed.)
- 1457 ENGLAND. BBC, Clevedon, 2/1. 0200 to 0245 for my best TA this season. (Fountain, Ga.)
- 1460 UNID. Possibly Huhehot, but not as strong as the one on 1240 on 0440. Man talking this time, but no station breaks noted up to tune out at 0449. (Dennett, D.C.)
- 1480 JAPAN. JORF, Yokahama, heard at 0433 with a "Tell Your Gripes to the World" type show (it had to reach the Orient sooner or later, hi!) Moderately strong signals, but good readability, little QRM. (Dennett, D.C.)
- 1490 COLOMBIA. HJNT, Voz del Paraiso, here at nights. Appears to be NSP. Plenty of WMM QRM. Noted 2/13 0137. (Silvera, Jamaica)
- 1520 INFL. WATERS. R. Caroline South heard while WKIW fade. (Schmidt, Pa.)
- 1529 VATICAN. Vatican Radio in at 1625 2/14, but unneeded. (Dangerfield, Pa.)
- 1530 PUERTO RICO. WUPR, Utuado, signed on with unknown tune and SSE at 0430 2/15, seemed to be all Spanish. No sign of HILL on either 1530 or 1510. (Drauner, Pa.)
- UNID. Very weak 0415-0430, possibly in Chinese, but too weak to tell. Pretty sure it was Oriental, though, as skip was mainly from that direction. Nothing from East Coast noted at all. (Dennett, B.C.)
- 1540 BAHAMAS. ZNS, Nassau, spent two hours on 'em Sat. night 2/13, 2200 KXEL forgot to follow pitcher with local pitch, and Bahamian news came through WPTR for 2 min. Also ID through KXEL at 2308. Country #36. (Hansch, Wis.)
- 1560 BRAZIL. ZYK30, R. Cultura de Nordeste, Caruaru, Pernambuco, heard almost daily signing on at 0300. Carrier heard often coming on 3 to 5 minutes before s/on. Uses beautiful musical notes at s/on. Chime before each ID. Typical Brazilian music and recorded commercials. Has surprizingly good signals some mornings for 1 kw. Signals fell off fast after 0330. Long report out to him. (Burnham, Conn.)
- 1575 UNID. W.I.B.S. Kingstown listed, noted on 1709 2/3 where? (Silvera, Jamaica)
- 1580 COLOMBIA. HJAY, La Voz de la Cordialidad, Galapa, heard recently on their All-Night show. (Drauner, Pa.)
- 1590 PUERTO RICO. WXRJ, Guayama, actually covered WAKR here at 0445 2/15. (Drauner, Pa.)
- 1600 UNID. R. Cuba Libre, who? went off suddenly at 0251 2/8. (Silvera, Jamaica) Believe WKWF carries this programming AN. Probably had transmitter failure. (Ed.)
