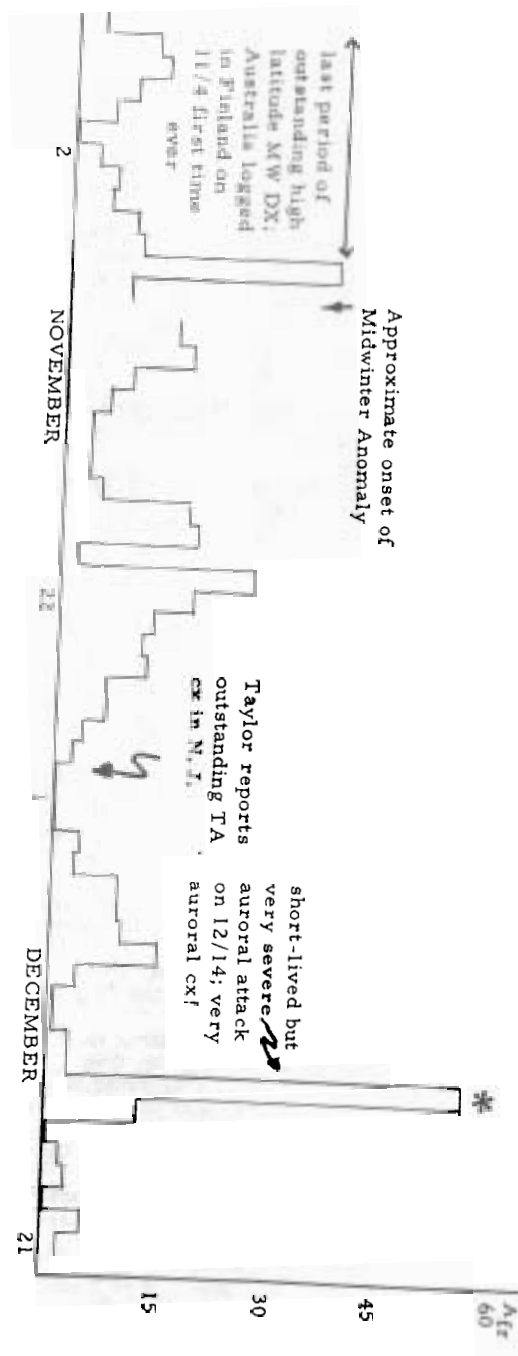

The graph shows the daily values of Afr, the Fredericksburg index of geomagnetic/auroral disturbance in the upper atmosphere as the result of certain types of solar disturbances. The medium-wave signal absorption produced by one of these events is strongest in high latitudes and persists for some days following the initial high-latitude TA and TP signal path. Very high values (above about 40) are usually accompanied by E-layer blanketing over North America and Europe; on such a night stations from the South will appear to dominate most channels. Long periods of low geomagnetic/auroral activity are necessary but not sufficient to guarantee excellent high latitude TA and TP reception - other ionospheric effects such as the "Midwinter Anomaly" may effectively mask what would otherwise be periods of excellent reception on high latitude paths during periods of continued low geomagnetic/auroral activity.

REPORTEDLY IN OPERATION....

YUGOSLAVIA. On 11/28 Skopje Radio began to transmit over a new transmitter of 1,000 kw power on 809 kHz; former power was 135 kw. Three new programs will be broadcast over this facility beginning soon; this should make Yugoslavia much easier here in North America. (Editor)

INDONESIA. "You may be interested to learn that I recently paid a visit to Djakarta, and found - as suspected - at least a dozen stations operating in the MW band... I will supply a full report shortly..." (Lars Ryden, Japan) **This is the first information to confirm the existence of the Indonesian MW transmitters reportedly authorized for operation some time ago and first reported here in IDXD about a year ago.** (Editor)

CHINA. According to Scandinavian sources there is now a new Peking outlet operating on 1515 with enough power to get to Northern Europe; West Coasters should watch for this one... (ARC)

POLAND. New high powered Polish station now being heard on 719 kHz; no further information at this time. (ARC)

THAILAND. Although the 1971 WRTVH may list a number of AFTN relays, later information reveals that all the relay stations have been closed down, or converted to rediffusion systems. In addition, all the remaining stations are to be converted to FM by mid-1971. Here's the situation as of 11/23 as supplied by C. E. Larry Loback:

1450 Korat (Net HQ also here); longwire; 25 watts nominal

1220 Utapao; longwire; 25 watts nominal

770 Nakhon Phanom ("NKP"); longwire; 25 watts nominal; do not confuse with WABC whose jingle style they use.

940 Ubon; longwire; 25 watts.

1520 Takhli; longwire; 25 watts; This base is being closed down. After 2/1 this transmitter will no longer originate programming but will relay Korat. It and the base will close about April, 1971.

Following a disastrous crash last April when the AFTN building was completely demolished in Udorn, and 9 AFTN staffers killed, AFTN Udorn has been rebuilt with an FM transmitter only... So you have but a few months to DX AFTN on the BCB. (Glenn Hauser, Thailand)

PROJECTED OPERATIONS.

CENTRAL AFRICAN REPUBLIC. A new radio center has been opened in Bangui using Soviet transmitters; the range of Bangui Radio has supposedly been greatly increased but no further information is available at this time.

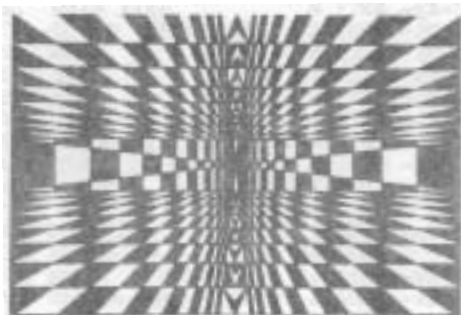
