Looks like there was a pretty good TA opening on 12-2, I was up for awhile that morning but not until after 0730Z so missed the TA activity. Very little from the West Coast this week so don't know how things have been out there. Possible log of KFAR in Ohio the most interesting thing this time, I'm having problems with this typewriter, so don't know what this thing will look like when I get through.

- 540 -NICARAGUA 12/2 1020 adstring, 1024 EST TC "...en Radio Corporacion", Nicaraguan folk mx; good reception. (Hauser)
- 595 -SOUTH KOREA HLSA R. Korea, Seoul noted in Japan in August on this frequency from nominal 600, Foreign Service in EE at 1530 and KK at 1600. (NZRDXL)
- 655 -EL SALVADOR YSS R. Nacional, San Salvador noted 11/28 w/continuous cl mx from 0440-0457. S/off and anthem at 0500. Excellent signal. (Long)
- 660 -UNID/KFAR?? Noted 0345 w/Meet The Press type show..back 0400 and got "KF???" ID, then what may have been AM (as in AM-FM) or Anchorage (partial copy). Right at 0400 CBS news..(New Net?) outta this 0406 local wx, high of 34, rain or snow showers, etc. Then very poor copy, lots of CBS mentions- Net Programs? Lost 0425 to WNBC MN. As this DF above KORL, weaker, and deeper fades could be KFAR; KORL was S6 till 0400 and gone. Letter to KFAR and card to Foxy to check Net. (Boyd) 109! Great catch if it turns out to be KFAR Wes. Date on this was 12/2. (ED)
- 670 -CUBA CMKP San Pedro de Cacocum, 11/14 0802 "R. Enciclopedia (Nacional?) desde la Habana, Cuba" (mutter,mutter) "Territorio libre" (mutter). Semi-cl background to ID. Unid sig caused an SAH-like quick fading up and down, clobbering a few of the words. Is hrd almost nightly after KBOI s/off. (Hardy)
- 705 -HONDURAS? 12/2 a carrier here by 1016, so the Olanco (?) reported last time may have an early s/on; must be low powered; cf 710. (Hauser) This one noted here one evening this past week w/very poor signals, mx readable but almost nothing during the anmts. We need some strong auroral condx to ID this. (ED)
- 710 -HONDURAS La Voz de Occidente, ID, 12/2 1013, followed by same type of electronic ripple sound heard before on 705; u/OC, mixing others, but readable. (No, Olanco sounds nothing like Occidente). (Hauser)
- MEXICO Unid, believe XERK, Tepic, Nay. hrd briefly, 0115-0118 11/28 w/ranchera mx, a local ad, and one for a furniture store in Guadalajara, which said "visit us next time you are in the city". (Gleason)
- 750 -ALASKA KFQD Anchorage 11/11 0740-0800 w/pop mx, call letters 0740 and 0750, wx w/temp "5 to 15 above", and faded up for beautiful "This is KFQD, Anchorage, Alaska" live ID before mx at 0800. Automatic time tone, believed to be KFQD's, hrd 15 sec after ID. Good sig; slight QRM from Japan during KFQD fades; WSB off. (Hardy) / (Hauser)
- 770 -JAPAN JOUB Akita must be the JJ mx 11/30 1329 mixing w/KOB at a 1.1 hz SAH.
- MEXICO "XEBB, R. Frisco" ID 12/1 1306 o/u/KOB; wow cart. (Hauser)
- 830 -VENEZUELA YVLT R. Sensacion loud w/ID following mx 0548 12/2 battling second SS. YV #30 here. (DeLorenzo)
- 840 -ST LUCIA Radio Caribbean, Castries very loud during auroral condx 2245 11/20 w/man in PF, pop vocals. (De Lorenzo)
- 845 -MEXICO XENL's occasional spur down to here, dashing hopes for Peking; 12/1 1227 SS mx, 1229 CST, Diario de Monterrey ad // 860 w/KOAM; this frequency wavers slightly. (Hauser) ** My unid on 846, plus a new one on 874 are all spurs of XENL. Heard 12/1 1220 w/definite // on all three. (Gleason)
- 854 -PERU R. Nacionl, Lima 11/27, 0025-0046, w/US rock and some SS mx, clear ID at 0043. 90% readable w/severe fading at times. (Long)
- 870 -MEXICO XELY Morelia, Mich. 12/2 0120-0130 w/ranchera mx, jingle ID as "El gallito, el favorito". This should be a limited daytimer, w/s/off at 1900 local time. (Gleason)
- 875 -MEXICO XENL spur to match 845, slightly weaker, 12/1 1230. (Hauser, Gleason)
- 899 -ITALY Milan good at 1920 w/mx announced in Ii. (Calkin)
- 910 -VENEZUELA YVRQ Maiqueta in on top of freq 11/4, hrd w/R. Aeropuerto ID 0715. First time heard in several years. (Levintow)

- 920 -MEXICO XEQD Chihuahua, Chih. hrd 11/28 1132-1150 w/SS rock and lots of ~~III~~. This indicates a new s/on time. Uses "La Divertida" as name in jingles, as well as call letters. Also plays US rock on occasion. Time was 5 min fast.
- 930 -ALASKA KTKN Ketchikan 11/24 1001 in quite well in CJCA null / (Gleason) after strange progressive rock mx, w/recorded s/off (sounded like manager speaking) mentioning Midnight Sun Broadcasting and sister stns KENI, KINY and KFAR and NBC and ABC, announced s/on "7:45 AM" (1545Z), then inst SSB, which faded near end. S/off was in so well I expected it to be KHJ! But KHJ not hrd till after KTKN off. Note that Sat. nite (Sun AM) w/off is 2 AM in Ketchikan as they are on PLT. (Hardy)
- 1000 -COLOMBIA HJAC Cartagena good atop channel 2300 11/27; RCN ID, beer ad, then local ID "La Voz de Cartagena". (DeLorenzo)
-MEXICO XEOY R. Mil, Mexico, DF 10/14 0758 easy w/KOMO off this MM (KOMO has TT alternate MM's). S/off started. "R. Mil. XEOY. XEOI. Ondas larga y corta desde la Ciudad de Mexico" then mentioned radio associations, mentioned end of transmission, then string like mx background to SS anmt about mx, prizes and entertainment. Mx up till 0759, then whistled 4 note IS and "Radio Mil" jingle (to the tune of the old Fifth Avenue candy bar jingle) that are heard between every record between 0700 and 0800 alternate MM's during DST. The s/off w/XEOY call and reference to Mexico City is a much better specific ID, obviously. (Hardy)
-U S VIRGIN ISLANDS WWVI Charlotte Amalie, seemed SSB 0458, lost to CKEW GSQ 0458½, faded back 0500 for call-location-power-frequency, etc. Gone 0500½ to CKEW. Nice tape. (Boyd)
- 1010 -MEXICO XEKD Ciudad Acuna, Soah. 12/1 0039-0040 w/local ads and mention of city and state. First time heard, XE #7 on freq, 2 more to go. (Gleason)
- 1020 -TONGA A3Z Nuku'alofa 10/23 0830 in well w/YL anncg Carole ~~III~~ songs, then "The time at station A 3 Zed is 9:30, and it's time for Brave New World". Then into Brave New World rock mx show w/male British type ancr. Fair sig w/no trace of KDKA. (Hardy)
-VENEZUELA The cuckoo stn is R. Margarita, per clear ID 12/2 0743, giving TC in AST for 3:45; the 3 cuckoos follow time checks. Fighting KGBS turned out to be more productive than fighting KDKA modulation other nights. However, the ID taped at 0730 sounded a lot more like "Radio Paraguesa". This one's so weak compared to R. Calendario that I wonder if it's directional away from Maracaibo, and to some extent, us. (Hauser)
- 1025 -ISRAEL IBA. Pretty sure this was the stn hrd 0725-0730 12/2. Man and woman alternating in what sounded like Hebrew. At 0730 hrd the first few bars of the "Lone Ranger" theme, followed by 4 or 5 pips in rapid succession, then woman announcing. Faded rapidly after this point. Must be super power since other TAs in midband had faded to point of unreadability at time of tune in. (Levintow) * Virtually impossible that this was Israel. Time would have been 3 hours after their sunrise on this date. If a TA, EAJ8 most likely. (ED)
- 1030 -ARGENTINA Radio del Plata ID o/u/XEQR w/5 hz SAH, 12/2 0832, mentioning Buenos Aires; 2 alternating announcers w/wx, patter. (Hauser)
- 1040 -UNID looking for Shanghai, SM 12/1, 1235 hrd only some romantic inst mx, 1241 believe SS anmt, so probably residual Cuban; by 1254 a SAH appeared, but too much splash from KCTA. (Hauser)
- 1041 -COLOMBIA HJAI R. Tropical, Barranquilla joins the elite club of 1041 stns, on 12/2 at 0748 w/Cuban-sounding mx; 0750 ID as "R. Tropical, la emisora de importancia para un publico importante..." (Hauser)
-MEXICO XECC-960 moved its spur up to here 12/1 1258 cut on, s/on w/Cielito, giving 250w, Ciudad Camargo, Chih; 1300 many cuckoos, 7 en punto TC (at least their clock's right!); "E double C, en el 960 de su radio"; uva, Salinas y Rocha ads. Not on 960 in my radio, where there's KGM... (Hauser)
- 1050 -MEXICO XEG R. Melodia ID, TC, tropical mx mixing w/domestics, 12/1 1242, This is the daytime version of XEG. Already in its SS R. Melodia format as early as 1002 12/2, but w/Laboratorios Mayo ads which don't meet its daytime advertising standards. (Hauser)
- 1061 -UNID Mess of weak audios here 0720 12/2, dominant seemed to be in a Romance language (Portuguese?) (Levintow)
- 1088 -ENGLAND BBC badly hitting semi-local WBAI 0015 on 11/14. (Levintow)
- 1100 -COLOMBIA? This freq sounds almost like a graveyard. Somebody surged up 12/2 at 0925 w/4:29 TC "en la madrugada". (Hauser)
- 1106 -EGYPT/DUBAI Cairo in EE daily from 1600-1700 at good level in Kabul. QRM from co-channel Dubai also in EE. (Calkin)
- 1110 -MEXICO XERCN Mexico, DF hrd w/Radio Cadena Nacional ID 0145 11/18, usual WET weak in strange auroral condx at time. (Levintow) / (Calkin)
- 1120 -INDIA R. Kashmir w/AIR mx in EE at 1730, followed by local ID and s/off 1735.
-MEXICO XETR Ciudad Valles, SLP, R. Ritmos, s/off 0200 11/28 very readable. Gave call, slogan, and freq and said s/on at 1155. (Gleason)
- 1133 -KUWAIT R. Kuwait ending EE news at 1745. Good. (Calkin)
- 1160 -MEXICO XEWW Acambaro, Gto. 11/27 1210-1250 w/all ranchera mx, many local ads (including ones for nearby Celaya) and dedications after all records. KSL in talk show made it rough, but still possible. (Gleason)
- 1178 -RUKYU ISLANDS To satisfy Godwin's projection, I hear on 11/30 1334, strong KK, level w/some domestic on 1180; before 1330, of course, nothing at all. At 1359 clear VOA Okinawa ID, and signal drops out. (Hauser) * W/EE ID prior to s/off at 1700. Good. (Calkin)
- 1180 -COLOMBIA HJOV Neiva 11/4 0821 male ancr: "Hora Surcolombiana: 3:23". YL voice: "Aqui esta la (radio?) Cultura Surcolombiana". Then promo by same YL w/mx, mentioning "Surcolombiana" a third time. Accent on third syllable of "cultura" so I doubt that the word would be "cultural" (accent on last syllable) as WRTH lists it. Average sig w/WHAM mullied. (Hardy)
- 1187 -INTERNATIONAL WATERS (Don't know current name) heard fair w/fading and some splash from WOWO 0010 11/14 w/rr and English accented ancr. (Levintow)
-UNID IA 11/29 1210-1230 w/ranchera mx, one 2 voice local spot. Sort of hard w/local KRDS, plus quite weak. (Gleason) Tis R. Sonora, Guatemala. (ED)
- 1190 -SOUTH KOREA HLLX Team Radio, Seoul ending RR religious program w/ID in RR at 1400. Good level. (Calkin)
- 1200 -VENEZUELA R. Tiempo 12/2 0758 SS ballad, sometimes losing out to Cuban and its lickety-split SAH, 0759 back w/ID. (Hauser)
- 1200V -UNID Santana jammer; good nightly 1730-1930. Probably directed against clandestine Voice of Iraqi Kurdistan. (Calkin)
- 1210 -CHINA R. Peking in EE to S. Asia 1800-1830. Excellent. (Calkin)
-VENEZUELA "La Nueva Radio Coro" ID after Bible verses 12/2 0959. So they've been born again?? (Hauser)
- 1214 -GREAT BRITAIN BBC Radio One almost as strong as WCAU at 0005 11/14 w/BBC pop mx program. (Levintow)
- 1232 -CYPRUS Radio Monte Carlo relay, Cape Greco FF/AA announced pop mx program 1600-1900 nightly. (Calkin)
- 1286 -UNID Presumably Prague, heard w/good sig 11/14 at 0020 w/orchestral mx and no anmts. (Levintow) Believe Prague off after 0000, CSEB sked to 0100. (ED)
- 1348 -MEXICO XELBL San Luis Rio Colorado, Son. 11/30 s/off 0101 w/name of "Radio Centro" and announced call, power (500 W) and frequency. (Gleason)
- 1399.2 -MEXICO XESH Sabinas Hidalgo, N.L., 12/2 1210-1220 w/ranchera mx, ID as "Radio Alegria". (Gleason)
- 1439 -LUXEMBOURG R. Luxembourg overpowering 1440 domestics at 0010 w/usual rr and EE speaking ancr. (Levintow) * Excellent many nights 2000-2300 in EE. (Calkin)
- 1480 -DUBAI Commercial stn, mx, ads, radio plays, etc. Excellent 1800. (Calkin)
- 1484 -UNID A pretty solid carrier (S4) here 12/2 at 0145 but only very weak audio hrd, bits and pieces of instrumental mx. Couldn't tell whether the carrier was modulated or whether it was an OC and the mx was underneath. Frequency analysis equipment would be very helpful in such situations. (Levintow)
- 1500 -MEXICO XERH and XESM-1470, Mexico, DF. Have confirmed through listening that the call letters remain the same, only the names have been changed. On 1470 I have heard an ID as XESM, R. Tricolor w/ranchera mx. 1500 is R. Fiesta, 100% tropical. (Gleason)
- 1502 -POLAND Warsaw fair w/woman apparently in Polish 0631-0639 12/2. Somewhat jumpy signal, active SAH. (DeLorenzo)
-SPAIN The SS graveyard at best level ever hrd 0140 12/2, much stronger than 1500 domestics. Didn't stick around to wait for ID's (R. Sevilla previously IDed on this freq last year. (Levintow) I presume the correct time for this should be 0640 GMT. (ED)
- 1511 -UNID Probably E. Germany, based on strength and loop bearing-strong het but very little audio at 0005 11/14, against mess of 1510 domestics and TVI. (Levintow) The HI more likely, see last week. I think E. Germany signs off earlier than this. (ED)

- 1525 -CHINA Urumchi fair to very good sig hrd for first time between 2345-2358 11/13. Man and woman alternating in RR. Clear "Govorit Peking" ID by man at 2350. Several songs hrd, including what sounded like Red Army chorus (male/female chorus) and one w/woman singing in CC. S/off 2358 after unid song left weak jammer/TVI and traces of 2nd stn. Have tape for anybody who wants to hear this. (Levintow)
- 1529 -UNID (2) Weak around 0640 12/2, the dominant w/instrumental mx, the other very weak in unid language. What would be operating at this hour? (Levintow)
- 1538 -WEST GERMANY No doubt Mainflingen, the mx audible at 0640 12/2. (Hauser) *Local like sig 2350 11/13 w/GG talk and pop orchestral mx. (Levintow)
- 1550 -AUSTRALIA 4QD Emerald, Qsld. 11/25 1300 six pips, fanfare, "Here is the latest in news from the ABC, read by ..." Fair sig over WOKJ. I didn't hear anything other than possible mx before the six pips, unless they just happened to fade up in time for the first pip. First Aussie here, and wouldn't be possible if KKHI were NSP. (Hardy)
- 1554 -FRANCE Nice 2 in well w/FF talk, MoR from 0615-0700 12/2. Male and female ancrs noted. Better than 1550 domestics at times. (Roberts)
- 1562 -SWITZERLAND SBC Beromunster fair w/lively accordian mx and pop inst 0620-0630 12/2, YL in GG between selections; I&C at 0650 re-check again with accordian mx. (DeLorenzo) * Excellent signal w/woman in GG, pop musical arrangements 12/2 at 0650. (Levintow) This stn is using 500 kw at times and is experimenting with a horizontal antenna. (ED)
- 1570 -SOUTH KOREA HIDA Cheju Island w/religious programs in several languages from fade in 1200 to past 1500. (Calkin)
- 1578 -ITALY RAI Genova fair to good w/cl mx 0558 12/2; pips on hour then man in II w/nx to 0611 tune out. (DeLorenzo)
- 1580 -THAILAND VOA Ban Pachi w/EE news 1500. (Calkin)
- 1586 -WEST GERMANY No doubt Langenburg, the mx noted 12/2 0620; carrier still in at 0700. Would you believe this is my first TA of the season? 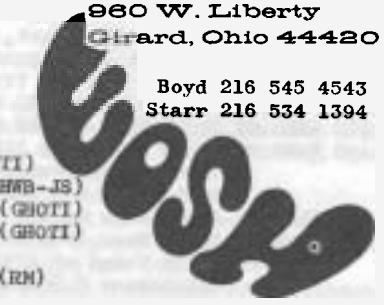

The Dubious Sound of 13-Q

When they talk of the new sound of 13-Q, they aren't kidding. The reason the music sounds different on 13-Q than on other AM stations in town is because the station changes the sound of a record before it puts it on the air.

The records programmed by the station are speeded up, so when 13-Q plays a 45 rpm record, it actually is being played at 48, 49, 50 rpms — and possibly faster.

So if a record sounds different on 13-Q than on other stations, don't think your ears are playing a trick on you. It's 13-Q that's playing the trick on you.

Why does the station punch up its records? It's not so that deejays can play more music in an hour than other AM stations (which they can) and insert more commercials between singles. Apparently the reason is that when listeners hear the same tune on other stations, it sounds lethargic, bland, awkward. So they often turn back to 13-Q where

they can hear the peppier version.

A deejay at WDVE-FM told us recently: "Often someone will call and ask, 'Hey, how come you play your records so slow?' And we tell them that we're playing the record the way it's supposed to be played — not the way some program director thinks it should be played."

Is it illegal to do this? A Federal Communications Commission spokesman said the practice is not illegal. Other sources said many major market stations punch up their records.

Over the last several months, we asked many artists performing here on tours what they thought of the practice. Many said they were upset that their music was being "distorted." Others said it didn't bother them.

Some were surprised that it was even being done — like Kiki Dee, the British singer who opened for Elton John here recently. Billy Swan of

"I Can Help" fame said he didn't like the idea, but "there's not much I can do about it, is there?"

A NATIONAL record company executive said he couldn't care less if a station speeded up one of his label's records: "I don't give a damn if they played a 45 at 78 — just so they play the record."

Engineers within the record industry said stations that speed up records also change other things — like bringing up certain parts of tunes, making the vocals stronger — actually, re-producing the records. I have noticed that this also is being done by the people at 13-Q.

If a station feels a tune should be faster before it will play it, or that it should be re-produced, then it shouldn't play it at all. The practice hurts the record buyer because he might hear a single on 13-Q, buy it and end up not liking the way it sounds on his machine at home. And he may end up with a record he may never have bought, had he not heard it on 13-Q.

But, perhaps that's one of the prices he must pay for getting used to "the new sound of 13-Q."

CLIPPING CORNER

New FCC rulemaking suggests allowing expanded power for existing AM's

FCC has proposed amending its rules to permit day and nighttime power increases for existing AM's, if changes can be accomplished on station's present frequency without weakening rules prohibiting interference. While rulemaking excludes specific proposals for allocation of new daytime-only stations, new unlimited time stations, or changes in frequency or nighttime operation by existing daytimers, FCC said parties could submit comments in regard to those issues.

If rulemaking results in less stringent acceptability standards for daytime power increases, commission noted, continuation of its suburban policy — which requires suburban station whose 5mV/m daytime contour (signal strength FCC considers necessary to provide good primary signal over city) penetrates much larger community to prove they are not intending to serve larger city — may need to be modified.

Impetus for new look into AM power increases was prompted by outward growth of cities that stretch beyond present signal contours.

Comments, due at FCC Jan. 31, should address AM assignment standards and whether suburban policy should be maintained in present form as it applies to major changes at existing stations. Reply comments are due March 4.

John B. Gambling Dead at 77; Conducted Early Radio Shows

John B. Gambling, a pioneer of early-morning chatter-type radio, died yesterday at his home in Palm Beach, Fla. He was 77 years old.

Mr. Gambling had been active in radio from 1923 until his retirement in 1954 when the program was taken over by his son, John A. The elderly

Mr. Gambling was widely known as the "human alarm clock," a play on words based on his program, "Gambling's Musical Clock," a mixture of banter, news and other announcements, along with light and cheerful music, which he once described as "middle-brow music, no boogie-woogie and no opera, either."

He got into his lifetime career quite by accident. In 1925, on the urging of his bride, he applied for a job at WOR, and was taken on as a probationary engineer at \$30 a week. Once, when the announcer for the 6:30 A.M. physical-culture show failed to show up, Mr. Gambling found himself in front of the microphone, ad-libbing an hour-long program. He did so well that the program was turned over to him.

On Job Nine Years

He stayed on the job for nine years, when a survey disclosed that the interest in physical culture was declining, and the setting-up exercises gradually were abandoned.

Over the years a small orchestra was added to the program, which became known as "Gambling's Musical Clock," on the air from 7:15 to 8 A.M.

Another program, "Rambling With Gambling," was begun in an afternoon time slot in 1942 and was moved in 1948 to the 6 to 7 A.M. period.

There was no doubt of the program's popularity. In 1955, when Mr. Gambling marked his

30th year on the job with a party in Madison Square Garden, no fewer than 27,000 followers of his five-day 45-minute program showed up to wish him well.

He liked the job, and lived with it. In the late nineties, when he was operated on for a hernia, he conducted his program from a bed in St. Luke's Hospital.

John Bradley Gambling was born in Norwich, England, on April 9, 1897, and was brought up in Cambridge, where his father was a civil engineer for the municipality.

He attended the Cambridge Country School for Boys until 1910, when he was 13, and left to learn horticulture. His father had built him a nursery, but gardening was to be an avocation rather than a full-time career.

The sinking of the Titanic in 1912 fired the young man with the ambition to be a wireless operator. He entered the British College of Wireless Telegraphy in London and completed its one-year course in eight months.

In World War I, Mr. Gambling, then only 17, gave his age as 18 and entered the Royal Navy, he spent the war years as a wireless operator and a chief petty officer and

then became a radio operator on various tankers, freighters and passenger ships.

It was his marriage to Rita Graubart, an Albany girl whom he met as a passenger on the Morgan liner Creole in February, 1925, that led to his radio career. She persuaded him to look for a life ashore, and that led him to WOR.

In addition to his wife he leaves his son, who now conducts "Rambling With Gambling," and three grandchildren.

Postal rates to rise in July

WASHINGTON — U.S. postal rates will rise next summer and the Postal Service expects a deficit in the current fiscal year approaching \$900 million, Postmaster General Elmer T. Klassen said Thursday.

While Klassen and other Postal Service officials said it is too early to predict what would be included in the rate boost, because costs are not certain, an increase in first class service from 10 cents to either 12 or 13 cents is thought likely.

Answering questions after an address at the National Press Club, Klassen said the Postal Service will file a rate increase next March, to

take effect in July. "There is no question we'll need a price increase," he asserted, pointing to soaring fuel, materials and labor costs.

"Somebody has to pay for delivering the mail," said Klassen, "and if prices aren't to be raised then Congress must boost its subsidies."

In the fiscal year ended last June 30, he noted the semi-private Postal Service had a net loss of \$438 million, on revenues of \$10.9 billion. "Frankly, for 1975, it will be twice that much," he said. "That doesn't mean we're going broke, but meeting unusual requirements" not faced by any other service, he contended.

Under rate provisions of the postal

reorganization, which saw a transformation of the former Post Office Department to the Postal Service in 1971, requests for higher mail charges must be approved by the independent Postal Rate Commission and the Postal Service's board of governors. Rate decisions can be appealed to the U.S. Court of Appeals, but only by persons taking part in commission hearings on rate proposals.

Since last March, the Postal Service has been charging 10 cents for first class service on a temporary basis and without final authority. First class service cost 6 cents from January 1963 until May 1971 when the rate was boosted to 8 cents.

Usually it's heard just above the background noise & Cuba & is difficult copy. They may have tightened their null towards WQXR. Today, 90% of the reports stations get are totally useless & unprofessional & it's obviously what makes stations not answer any reports at all any more. I found this year the lowpower GY catches were fairly good verifiers, evidently because they get only a handful of reports a year & those from good DXers. The 12-year-old kids don't report so much to these small stations, & haven't ruined it for everyone else with their poor reports. As a result all I report are unusual GY catches, a few foreign & DX Specials, & that hasn't been a problem here - not a single Special logged here so far. I send 20 reports a year, & that's a lot.
