1/25 WSAJ-1340 Grove City, PA 0200-0300 EST. Will use tones, code ID's, sweep tones, march music and voice ID's for the rarest DX catch in the USA. Power is 100 watts into a longwire antenna—this station has been broadcasting since 4/26/20 and normally operates only 4 hours per week during the school season at Grove City College. Reports to: Tom Langeyer, WSAJ Radio, Grove City College, Grove City, PA 16127. Prepaid calls ONLY will be accepted at (412) 458 9352. NO COLLECT CALLS. Arranged by Jerry Starr/NRC.

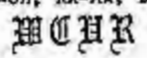

2 arrested in incidents at Texas radio stations

A man, apparently upset by President Reagan's economic policies, stormed into a Killbeek radio station, punched a female business manager, look off his clothes and then threatened Reagan's life. Another man, who said he was working for Satan, commandeered a gospel radio station in Plano, knocking it off the air.

Both men in the two unrelated Texas incidents were arrested. The first was charged with indecent exposure and assault; the second was put in a hospital for observation.

Steve Anderson, the music director at the Killbeek station, said the 31-year-old "just sort of broke out. He just stopped his car in the street and started demanding a gas in Bill Reagan." Killbeek is about 40 miles southwest of Waco.

Anderson said the man apparently blamed Reagan for his economic troubles.

The gospel station in Plano was off the air about 45 minutes after the wddie-wielding Dallas man commandeered the building and said he was taking possession for Satan. Plano is a Dallas suburb.

"He said, 'What do you work for?' and his eyes just flashed at me," Bob Wilson, station manager, said of the man. "I said, 'I work for KKKV' and the Lord," because this is a gospel station.

"He said, 'Well, you better get out of here because this is Satan's station,' and he started swinging at me."

Wilson said the 31-year-old man came to the station ostensibly for a job interview.

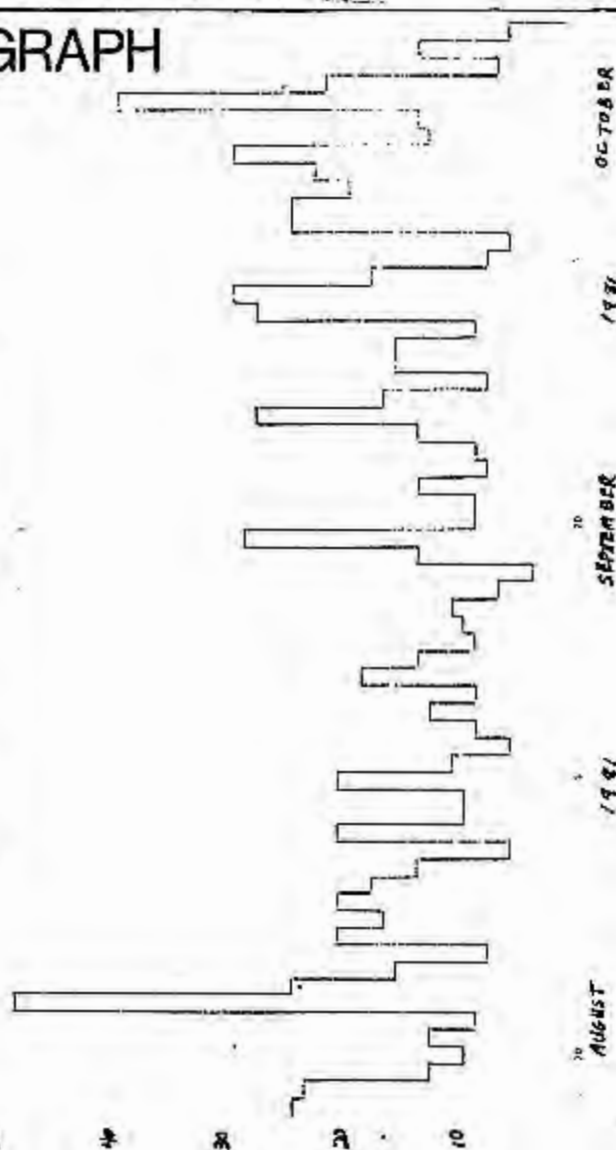

This graph shows the fully unsmoothed activity in the call's message book. High values likely indicate that the graph from the South and from local stations predominates due to the absence of the more northerly bands. Low values over a period of time indicate a likelihood of more activity on the higher bands. More, and more northerly, bands and more activity on the lower bands following higher values are needed for conditions to return to "normal" due to the possibility of several low values. It is less than necessary to use the possibility of good high values, conditions throughout the entire AFR band, although this is not the only consideration.  I spent the Thanksgiving weekend at my daughter's house in the Lincoln Park section of Chicago. Of course I had my trusty Panasonic along. These are some of my impressions. First, the three share-time stations on 1240 kc/s. If I'm not mistaken, this is the only remaining sharetime situation involving as many as three stations. What is probably more remarkable is that these same three stations, WEDC, WCRW & WSBC were listed as sharing time (on 1210 then) in the December 1930 edition of RADEX. And on one morning at 10am, WSBC came on the air before WEDC had signed off, thus creating some horrendous QRM for about a minute, with WSBC on top, as WEDC was about four miles distant, but WSBC was only a mile away. I was also impressed by the large number of ethnic AM radio stations in Chicago. I counted about a dozen. The daytime DX was rather interesting to me, since in Philadelphia we are lucky to reach beyond NYC and the Washington area. I noticed WILL-580, WKZD-590, WKI-600, all quite good at noon. And CFCO, topping 630, w/WXOK behind. And on 640, WOI, with, I guess, WELD, behind. Altogether there were at least seven states and one province in the daytime. At sunset WBEZ, WCAU, WOW & KOA were all clear. The latter was a surprise, since in the East, 850 is covered by WBEU, WEDH, & others all evening. On Friday night I noted WNEW & WGN atop their frequencies, although usually KWKH dominated 1130 evenings (WISN days). KSL popped in as soon as WJJD signed off. More surprises! KPI dominating 640 after 10pm CST, & KNX in quite well an hour later. One thing I did not find. Any signs of TA's. However, there haven't been many of them here in the East, either. Also, poor-to-fair reception of "KNF"-1210 kHz, announcing location as Ventura County (20-50 miles W of Los Angeles). This guy sounded fairly pro, complete w/T-40, WX for Ventura, & "More Mx" jx. Modulation was pretty low, and the signal couldn't have been more than 50 watts or so. Peding thought: With all the fulltime CPs hitting the air these days, how about a Pattern Book updater? I'll be glad to gather up KTYM, KUTY charts, or whoever else jumps on the bandwagon in So. Cal. GUY'S A "PERCENTAGE" DXER

 Unfortunately, due to a lack of sustained interest (don't ask me why) (Why not?? -ERC), the DX has only been trickling in this season. Only six new stations have been heard since I last Mused: KBEE, KLIQ (been tough logging this one), KPQP (at s/off, w/KMPS), KVIN (I've been trying for a long time for this one. It's always been buried w/KWJJ), KBBJ (with an ad for a tire store in Nampa) and KMTX (at 153, Helena). In an effort to generate a little interest in DX, I set down the other night and compiled some statistics from my log book. Just in case any other Wcers are interested, I've included some of those stats here! Equipment in use - Radio Shack modified PGU-7, QP-1 Audio Filter, DA-7 amplified ferrite core loop, Radio Shack modified DX-160, 440' LW, modified TRP & a 12" Select-A-Tenna Loop. Years in the hobby: 11. Total stations heard from this location: 302. Oregon stations made up 20.5% of the total. Washington made up 12.3%, Cal. 27.2%, Idaho 3.3%, Hawaii 1.9%. Canadian stations made up 13.2%. I've logged 74.7% of all of Oregon's stations. 38.1% of Washington's, 28.0% of California's, 23.1% of Idaho's, & 23.1% of Hawaii's. The record for most stations from one state goes to California - 82. Furthest Easterly U.S. station from this location: WCAU, Philadelphia. Furthest Northerly station: KPQD, Anchorage. Furthest Westerly: Five stations from Honolulu, one from Lehaina. Nearest unlogged station: KRNB, Roseburg, OR. (It seems that one should be easy, don't it - it's only 60 miles or so). Furthest unlogged station in the state: KVWR, Enterprise (300+ miles). Total states heard: 28. Most productive frequencies: 1230 held 2.6% of all stations logged, 1240 had 2.3%, 910, 960, 1360, 1410 & 1430 each held 1.9%. 7.6% of all my stations were logged at a power of 250 watts or less. 500w stations accounted for 3.0%, 1,000w stations accounted for 24.5%, 5,000w stations accounted for 28.1%, 10,000w stations accounted for 12.3%. 50,000 watts or more - 20.5. Local frequencies made up 9.6% of my total. Regional stations comprised 49%. Clear channels made up 19.2%. The other 22.2% were made up of various clear channel frequencies. Good DX!

Fair Radio Sales (sorry, I don't have the address) is a mail order house specializing in military surplus and they might have some that were originally made for it. It might pay to try a matching transformer. Most, if not all military rigs from WW-II had a 400-800 ohm output at about 1-2 watts. I'm not surprised at the reaction from both DXers and broadcasters on the breakup of the clear channels. When I first heard of the FCC wanting to set up more AM stations, I thought the FM broadcasters had taken over. The only advantage MW has over FM is long distance coverage. Cutting back on this is ridiculous. All these new stations will do is lead to more satellite feed "networks", more radio preachers. After all, competition drives down airtime rates and less programming variety. However, the FCC is a political agency & in my opinion these rule changes were done to approve "minority" broadcasters. As long as we're talking politics, the situation with Cuba is going wild. Castro has the same attitude toward the U.S. that a TV preacher has toward the Devil - he hates it and will do anything to irritate it. If running the 500kw XRs causes power shortages, then the people will just have to suffer. I'm sorry if the talk of politics is boring, but broadcasting and politics are seemingly inseparable. Both were (and still are) identified on the air as Wave - pronounced like the word. So, Benson searched for a similar call, but found WAIV, for example, already in use. So, he sought for something which sounded similar, came up with WAVG. So now, IDs throughout the hour are for Wave-970, with the call WAVG used quickly on the hour. The printed logo incorporates the G and 9 into one unit, so it comes out WAV970. Personally, I think it's too bad, WAVE has been on the air for over 49 years as WAVE, or W-A-V-E. ANYONE KNOW OF ANY WEIRD TRANSMITTING ANTENNAS?

 ----- Greetings. In answer to JIM ROLLINS' Musing in the 12/14/81 DX NEWS, p. 17, the FCC files on WUST-1120 list the antenna as 130/173 RTG, which stands for "Roof Top Ground". In other words, the tower itself is 130' tall, but is 173' above the ground, indicating that it is mounted on a 43-foot-tall building, either way it doesn't qualify for the sub-hundred category in Tower Trivia. A Franklin antenna is a tower with an insulator in the middle which is fed at the center point, sort of a vertical dipole. As for BA systems with towers of various sizes (and designs) there are literally dozens of these. Some examples that I can recall from having seen them include WFBL, WAKR, WJAS, WOYL, WGBU, WKY, WHX, KOB, WGAR, WKPA & our own WHOT. If any members know of other antenna oddities, please forward the info to me as there will be a follow up article in the near future. By the way, does any member have a good photo or slide of the KXA-770 rooftop installation? I would like to obtain a duplicate for my files before it disappears. DX is limited so far with KM 12/7 a total loss as far as new stations, WHEO TEST was heard, but un. 12/14 produced WHEO-1320 during listed r/c period w/some TT, TX, and OC, several AM/FM IDs, 12:47-12:57. WCVS-1450 ET/TT w/ID @ 1:52, often heard on their r/c, WWWE-1100 noted off & OC for the fourth straight MM (a few 1100 daytimers would make good TESTs if this continues). JACK COMPARES THE SUPERADIO TO A 35-YEAR-OLD SET

JACK WOODS - 4073 N.E. Morning Street - Corvallis, OR - 97330 Dec. 15, 1981
----- During the Autumn of 1945, the months immediately following the end of WW-II, there was a scramble by U.S. manufacturers to start producing consumer goods which hadn't been available to the public for several years; particularly radios and automobiles. Dealers made up lists of would-be buyers and usually arranged some sort of preference for the people being released by the millions from the military services. Some time during early 1946 I was able to buy a shiny new six-tube Philco table model 6CB radio, model 46-421. This was not an inexpensive item. It cost nearly a week's wages. The wood cabinet (very sturdy) was machined in the style known as "streamlined", with no sharp edges and few flat surfaces. The same styling philosophy applied to automobiles was typified by the 1948 Packard - which later came to be known in automotive circles as "inverted bathtub". A loop antenna was mounted on the back of the chassis. It is a wood frame box loop about 6" high and 10" wide, with about 25 turns of fine wire. The tubes are mostly the lock-in types previously used in military equipment. At present this set is connected to a timer and has been my wake-up radio for the past several years. Tubes and a few capacitors have been replaced but no modifications have been made. Recently I made a performance comparison with my Superadio; the two placed side-by-side in my kitchen, using their built-in antennas. This was a daytime test. The signal from KOAC-550 (towers about two miles distant) was about 10 kHz wider on the Philco than on the GE. From 590 through about 1560 every station audible on the GE was audible on the Philco. Local KFLY appeared near 1580 on the Philco but not on the GE. The Philco gives slightly better nulls. The GE has a reasonably useful logging scale, and the Philco has none. Tuning crispness is good on both and about equal. To summarize, the GE has an edge as a DX machine but not my much. In terms of durability, who knows? Comparing real cost in terms of 1946 dollars vs. 1981 dollars the Philco cost maybe five times as much. Some present-day electronic products are remarkably good bargains.
