## MORE FCC CONFUSION

After a period of relative calm, the FCC has again suffered from botched paperwork while processing Tennessee renewals and cancelled the licenses of three more stations which are still operating. The stations are:

1090 WJKM TN Hartsville  
1110 WUAT TN Pikeville  
1310 WDXI TN Jackson

The stations all intend to remain on the air although they technically are unlicensed until the FCC gets things corrected.

The license for WPFDF Fairview, TN was also cancelled. We believe this station is still operating but have not confirmed that.

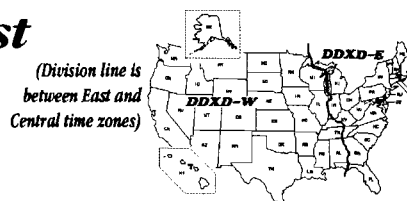

- Reporters' comments: "The Wyoming was a surprise and does keep the DXjuices flowing. Nice to hear something new NOT on the x-band! hi!" and "Things are picking up! NO LUCK ON TESTS tho I had 2 radios going and taping!" - JJR-WI; "Have put together 6 slinkys together, hope to have them up someplace to test out. They have a length of about 480 ft (that I have been told) compressed into about 50ft." - FA-ID; "Several west coast listeners have reported hearing VOA transmissions on 1710 AM. I checked with 2 sources at the VOA and they state it is not them. One source did indicate that they were aware of pirate activity on this frequency that is rebroadcasting VOA and other SW stations." - PG-CO; "Anyone who needs KHPN (ex-KLOV) 1570 Loveland, Colorado might look for them at night now. They have been louder than I have ever heard them at night. From what everyone tells me they are still running night power 42 watts, but it doesn't sound like they are turning the power down. Even at 0200 EDT last night they were the strongest station on 1570, and I have never heard that before. And it has been like that ever since they changed their call letters. They have C&W music and lots of IDs. They call themselves the "High Plains Network". - CB-CO

- 770 KNWX WA Seattle - 10/16 1048 - Noticed KNWX, which has been news radio for a long time is now calling themselves *The Business Station*, with Bloomberg Business Updates. (AK-WA)

- 1020 KVCS OK Perry - 10/7 0003 - Continuous Country . . . on 10-20 AM KVCS, so hasn't changed to KOKP yet. (JW-CO)
- 1190 KUCB CO Boulder - Here's the latest on (this station). The new sign-on target date is 11/4/98. This is the station that was donated to the University of Colorado by Jacor so that Jacor could buy KTCL-FM and still remain legal under the '8 stations per market' limit. The station has been 'dark' since early this year. John Carter, Chair of KUCB AIRBoard says: "It is going to be a college format radio station. Specialty shows (punk, metal, Hip-Hop, etc) will be during the evenings. Sunday will be our 'Sunday paper' format. We'll have lots of talk shows, some specialty shows (reggae, ambient and the like). The idea will be to have a radio show corresponding to each of the sections in the Sunday newspaper." (PG-CO)
- 1300 CJME SK Regina - 10/16 0658 - You're listening to Art Bell on CJME, Regina's Talk Station, so apparently ex-OLD format. (JW-CO)
- 1560 KCJJ IA Iowa City - 10/12 - "Will sign off from 1560 kHz for good sometime after 2:00 Central Time tomorrow afternoon (Oct 13th). It will sign on at 1630 kHz Wednesday morning, probably before 6:00 Central. This per station manager 'Captain' Steve Bridges." (RD-IA)
- 1630 KCJJ IA Iowa City - 10/13 2249 - Very good signal, with open carrier and then at 2300 ID's several times as 16-30 KCJJ Iowa City Coralville and Cedar Rapids. Re-check on 10/14 at 0220 on the air with AC music and lots of local ads. ID as *The new 16-30 KCJJ Eastern Iowa's Most Powerful radio Station.* (SA-MB) [Evidently they are unaware of KXEL? - Ed.]
- 1630 KCJJ IA Iowa City - 10/14 0000 - Was in here with a great signal and full programming. They were giving frequent IDs and in 45 minutes of listening every ID I heard was different. The music was a mix of old and new, modern pop. (PG-CO)
- 1630 KCJJ IA Iowa City - 10/14 0523 - Very good, out of Iowa City ad cluster, with Eastern Iowa's 1630 KCJJ. Het from presumed pirate in background . . . maybe he should move, hi! (JJR-WI)
- 1630 KCJJ IA Iowa City - 10/15 0100 - With very good signal, some deep fades at times. Rock music with female announcer on *All hits 1630, KCJJ.* (FA-ID)
- 1630 KCJJ IA Iowa City - 10/15 0144 - Great signal, almost equal to my local 1620. Playing oldies. No trace 15-minutes earlier. Some slop from the two 1640's but none from 1620 which has a terrible signal from 20-miles away. Thanks to Rick Dau with the e-mail tip. (BC-WA)
- 1630 KCJJ IA Iowa City - 10/15 0200 - On now, into Denver with a Huge signal, at least an S-10 on the 2010. By far the strongest x-band signal here right now. (CB-CO)
- 1630 KXJJ IA Iowa City - 10/15 2030 - Loud and clear. ID as *Iowa City's 1630 KXJJ*, with rock music format. (JT-MO)
- 1630 KCJJ IA Iowa City - 10/15 2208 - After Hours syndicated music program. Several long local ad blocs throughout the hour, and several call IDs. Very good signal with no QRM and no fading. IA #37. (JW-CO) [A note on this one . . . we've received reports with two different calls, yet the FCC has this as KCJK - Ed.]
- 1660 WQSN MI Kalamazoo - various times - This punches through KXOL once in awhile. Have noted twice talking about Sports Radio 1510 and ????. Assume the network feed is talking about another station on the net. No ID yet. KXOL is by far my loudest X-band station with a stereo signal almost every night when I check on the truck radio. So far I haven't been able to knock Brigham City down far enough for a good copy on WQSN. (BC-WA)
- 1680 WBHD MI Ada - 10/14 1900 - Very good signals with rap and hip hop music. 16-80 JAMS non-IDs. (SA-MD)

- 1530 KSCX? ?? - 10/15 2000 - Obscure album music, pop or jazz, top-of-hour ID sounding like KSCX, AM 15-30, then music continued. Not very strong, and disappeared after 2015. Loops N-S. (JW-CO)

- 1450 WFRA- PA Franklin - 10/12 0003-0017 - Nothing heard that resembled march or polka music or Morse code. Used MFJ-1026mw to null out local KEST, just got noise. (BK-CA)  
- 0001-0100 - Nothing heard in the mess that sounded like a test. Local KIOV was absolutely buried the noise. (FA-ID)

1500 WTKJ354 CA Folsom - 10/10 1515 - Strong, with local events. (GJ-CA)  
1700 TIS CA ??? - 10/7 0700 - Highway Advisory Radio, 1700. Mention of a test. No ID or location given. (GJ-CA)

#### MIDNIGHT TO 0800 HOURS ELT

- 670 KLTT CO Commerce City - 10/5 0230-0305 - Noted equal with KBOI, with Christian music, occasional mentions of . . . *this is not a test* (oh really?), spots just before the hour, then clear call letter ID on the hour. Must've been running day power. Not heard any night thereafter. New for me. (RT-CA)
- 680 WCTT KY Corbin - 10/14 0650 - Poor, over others, with WCTT Trading Post after C&W tune. (JJR-WI)
- 730 WFMW KY Madisonville - 10/14 0730 - Poor, thru 2-3 others, with calls. (JJR-WI)
- 790 KBME TX Houston - 10/6 0750 - Call ID with NOS music. Call was changed from KKBQ per DX news. New here. (JR-OK)
- 960 CFFX ON Kingston - 10/14 0635 - Fair, over WSBT, with end of newscast and 960-GTO slogans. Live in AM drive! (JJR-WI)
- 1010 KNWZ CA Thousand Palms - 10/5 0200 - No sign of local KIQI; just CBR and an Art Bell station. Waited for top of hour ID. Good signal in CBR null. New, last logged as KCMJ Palm Springs back in the 80s. (RT-CA)
- 1070 KNX CA Los Angeles - 10/7 0741 - Call ID with traffic reports and news. In phase null of KFDI-KS. (JR-OK)
- 1210 KREW WA Sunnyside - 10/12 0049-0056 - NOS Music e.g. *There's a Place for Us* from West Side Story; *Linda* from about the 1940s? New for me because it is 1 kW at night. I have heard KREW in the evening when they were using 10 kW day power, and the same when they did a DX Test years ago using 10 kW. (BK-CA)
- 1210 KLDI WY Laramie - 10/11 0245 - Fair at times, with non-stop oldies. Local ads, and *News, Weather and Sports Station* . . . More oldies to full ID at 0300 into CBS news! Worth the wait! 1 kw! WPHT nulled. NEW! (JJR-WI)
- 1220 KBPA CA Palo Alto - 10/12 0037-0043 & 0059-0100 - With legal VID: . . . *KBPA Personal Achievement Radio*. Although at this time they were broadcasting a sports news show. (BK-CA)
- 1230 WAUD AL Auburn - 10/12 0106 - *Rapid Now back to 1-on-1 Sports on total sports, WAUD*. (GB-FL)
- 1230 WSOK GA Savannah - 10/12 0112 - Weak, audible in graveyard morass, as *playing nothing but the very finest in gospel, 12-30 WSOK*. (GB-FL)
- 1230 WMLR TN Hohenwald - 10/12 0035 - Fade up with ID for WMLR, AM 12-30 then to C&W music. Nice peak on signal for that ID. (GB-FL)
- 1270 WKBF IL Rock Island - 10/9 0745 - NOS music with ID *Great memories WKBF*, then I lost the signal in QRM. (JR-OK)
- 1350 KRNT IA Des Moines - 10/14 0707 - Fair, in fade-up, with news on KRNT. Not common, despite closeness to my QTH. (JJR-WI)
- 1350 CKDO ON Oshawa - 10/14 0705 - Good, dominating the frequency, with end of news on *Magic 94.9*. Unusual to hear FM// from this one! (JJR-WI)
- 1440 WJL NY Niagara Falls - 10/14 0701 - Good with *Light My Fire/Doors*, multi-city ID, news. Nice surprise! (JJR-WI)



- 1450 WSTU FL Stuart - 10/12 0059 - With call only, not CoL at ToH, WSTU. Sounded like three stations announced their calls simultaneously, on the TU was clear on fade up. Dropped off immediately. (GB-FL)
- 1450 KFLS OR Klamath Falls - 12/12 0000 - Heard ID in the mess while waiting for WFRA TEST. Is new! (FA-ID)
- 1450 WGNS TN Murfreesboro - 10/12 0032 - End of jingle on WGNS, then to studio announcer with weather, *tonight, clear*. It's autumn in the south, not much more to say than that, really. (GB-FL)

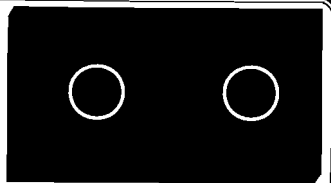

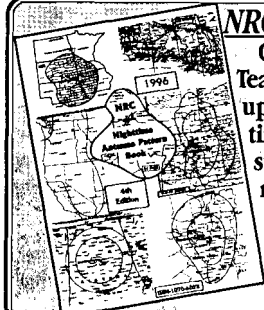

*Bruce speaks:* "To borrow a term Mark Connelly used to describe DX at the start of the Newfoundland DXpedition, "ordinary" best describes a revisit to the Camden Hills State Park in Maine for a parallel DXpedition effort over the Columbus Day weekend. The campground was essentially empty with only a few hardy souls willing to brave the typically cold and wet weather of mid-coast Maine this time of year. And wet it was, with continuous rain Saturday through Monday morning. News reports indicated that 10 or more inches fell on the region over the weekend. So although I couldn't make it to Newfoundland this year, the rain and 30 mph east winds made it feel like I was there. After a thorough soaking while installing antenna wires and setting up the tent, I was ready for some DXing. Solar conditions were quiet according to the latest WWV forecast, unfortunately so was the DX. With the exception of a couple of glimpses of Brazil, only the usual Latin American stations were heard, albeit stronger than what would've been possible at home. It seemed that there was a limited window of opportunity for receiving Brazil, between 2230-2400. Pre-dawn DX proved fruitless with only Colombia and Venezuela logged, rather than sought after signals from Suriname, French Guiana, Guyana, or Trinidad and Tobago. Spain dominated transatlantic reception as has been the case so far this DX season. There was a brief run on France during transmitter site dawn. I tried for the Faroe Islands on 531 at sign-on, but only a weak het was heard, most likely the remains of Spain. Norway-1314 was a no-show, so any chance of logging the Faroes was slim anyway. The bright stars were Jordan on 1494 and catching the new Business Radio from the Netherlands on 1395."

#### NEWFOUNDLAND PARALLELS

On Sunday 11 OCT 1998, I did a brief DX stop at the Town Landing site off Route 28 just north of Tar Kiln Road in Orleans, MA (Cape Cod). It was the fourth consecutive cool, rainy, windy day: hardly ideal for the planned activities. I still wanted to do a bit of sunset-period listening so I'd have some notes to compare to NF DX logs covering the same time period. A second outing is anticipated for 13 or 14 OCT - most likely to Rockport, MA.

Conditions on Sunday afternoon seemed short-skip dominated. TA DX was better on the high end of the dial than lower. Spain, not surprisingly, provided the strongest and most numerous signals. Northern Europe was poor with the UK only represented by a substandard Talk Radio 1089 signal. I did pull up a pretty good signal from AFN Azores on 1503 and I found the crazy jammer on 1542.2 that I'd noted last week in Cappahayden. The earliest fade-in was Saudi Arabia - 1521 with a het against WGAM/WWKB at 2045 UTC / 4.45 p.m. local. It produced good audio a bit later.

- As the logs show, the mouth of the Mediterranean was the "hot spot" ... not uncommon during mediocre conditions. By 2315 UTC, the rain and wind were getting a bit extreme, so I ended the effort and drove home.
- Full detail logs of this effort and the anticipated midweek outing will be issued later. Also, before long, I'll have selected NF DX logs in the E-mail pipeline.

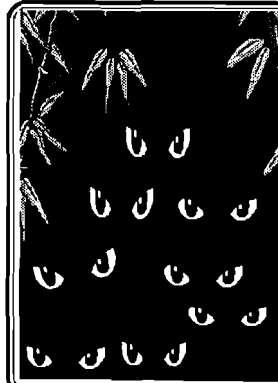
