WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

Howard Stern and his employer, Infinity Broadcasting, have after several week of rumors finally been subjected to a firm wrist-slapping by the FCC. The Commission assessed \$6,000 in fines to Infinity over a Christmastime 1988 skit broadcast on WXRK New York, WYSP Philadelphia and WJFK Manassas VA (Washington). Stern's routine, according the FCC, "reflects a dwelling on sexual matters, including sexual intercourse, orgasm, masturbation, lesbianism, homosexuality, breasts, nudity, and male and female genitalia." Infinity is widely expected to appeal the fines through the court system, and Inside Radio reports that Stern has also tweaked FCC Commissioners on the air regarding overseas junkets and has filed Freedom of Information Act requests to obtain itineraries and bills for the trips. The \$6,000 in fines represents well under an hour of average billings on Stern's morning show - or an amount recoverable by Infinity in one morning with new, higher rates that could be charged to advertisers as a result of all the publicity surrounding the case.

The FCC has announced that it will relax its technical standards for operation of radio frequency devices without individual licenses - specifically, the emission limits for low power AM communications systems such as carrier current stations and so-called "leaky cable" AM radio systems often used for highway advisory broadcasts, campuses, drive-in theatres, etc. In its decision, the FCC for the first time acknowledged that such systems "provide valuable services not easily provided through other means" and that older, more lenient emission standards were adequate to protect other communications users. The decision also for the first time treats leaky cable systems in the same manner as carrier current, holding the cable systems to the more lenient standards used for carrier current rather than the standards of on-air broadcast stations.

WTHZ Tallahassee FL has been assessed a Notice of Apparent Liability for \$18,000, and given a conditional, short-term license renewal, because of the station's repeated failure to comply with EEO rules. The license renewal for WTHZ extends only through February 1, 1992...Keymarket Communications has been fined \$10,000 by the FCC for "willful and repeated violations of the Commission's affirmative action provisions" committed while Keymarket operated WTCB-106.7 Orangeburg SC. Keymarket has claimed that there was no basis for the FCC's conclusion that EEO efforts were only made in the months immediately preceding license renewal...Also this week, Congaree Broadcasters, owners of WSCQ West Columbia SC, was denied reconsideration of a ruling that assessed \$10,000 in fines and a short-term renewal for its EEO violations.

This week the FCC upheld: the grant of a new AM station to Heritage Communications at Yountville CA (despite its filing and subsequent withdrawal of amendments that would have been fatal to the application), denying the competing application of Alegria I, Inc. for a new AM at Marina CA...a staff action that dismissed a petition, filed six months after the published deadline for counterproposals, to allot channel 95.5 A to Pinewood SC...a Review Board decision granting the application of Progressive Communications for a new FM in Temple TX...and a Review Board decision that in turn upheld an ALJ's dismissal of South Star Communications, Inc.'s application for a new FM in Key West FL. The Commission found that while the Review Board had relied on an "inappropriate statement" in its Key West decision, the application was still properly dismissed for failure to prosecute and for lacking a transmitter site.

The FCC has denied review of a Review Board ruling that effectively dismissed the previously granted application of Fresno FM, LP, for a new FM in Fresno. And, finally, the FCC dismissed the appeal by Welch Communications, Inc., of an ALJ

ruling ordering that documents be produced in a new FM proceeding in Swanton OH.

KSEA-100.7 Seattle was reprimanded by the FCC this week for failing to tell listeners they could be disqualified from a \$10,000 contest for sending in duplicate entries. The station had hoped the complaint would be dismissed because it had begun broadcasting contest rules more fully a week after the contest began. Also admonished was WJTA-91.7, Kosciusko MS, for violating rules regarding advertising on noncommercial stations.

In separate actions, the FCC has suspended the licenses of two radio operators previously fined for running unlicensed "pirate" broadcast facilities. The licenses of Frederick K. Stark and Joseph A. Della Barba of New York state have been indefinitely suspended following allegations that the two continued to operate pirate stations on AM and shortwave frequencies, respectively.

ELSEWHERE

Drake-Chenault has concluded a three-week test broadcast of satellite-delivered formats to the United Kingdom, and is planning another test broadcast in early 1991. According to Drake-Chenault's T. J. Lambert, reaction to the test was excellent and the company expects to begin sustaining service to part time affiliates in early 1991. U.K. rules currently prohibit full time satellite operation. Drake has also announced that its easy listening format is now available through satellite distribution.

The move this week of KLIF's news-talk format in Dallas from 1190 to 570 KHz begins the six-month waiver period in which Susquehanna Radio Corp. may jointly operate the two AM facilities. Susquehanna reached agreement three weeks ago to sell the 1190 outlet to Greystone Broadcasting, and after a week of simulcasting the two stations will begin running the CNN Headline News format Greystone planned to implement after assuming ownership.

The National Association of Broadcasters has unveiled its logo for next Spring's 1991 NAB Convention, and you see it here first... 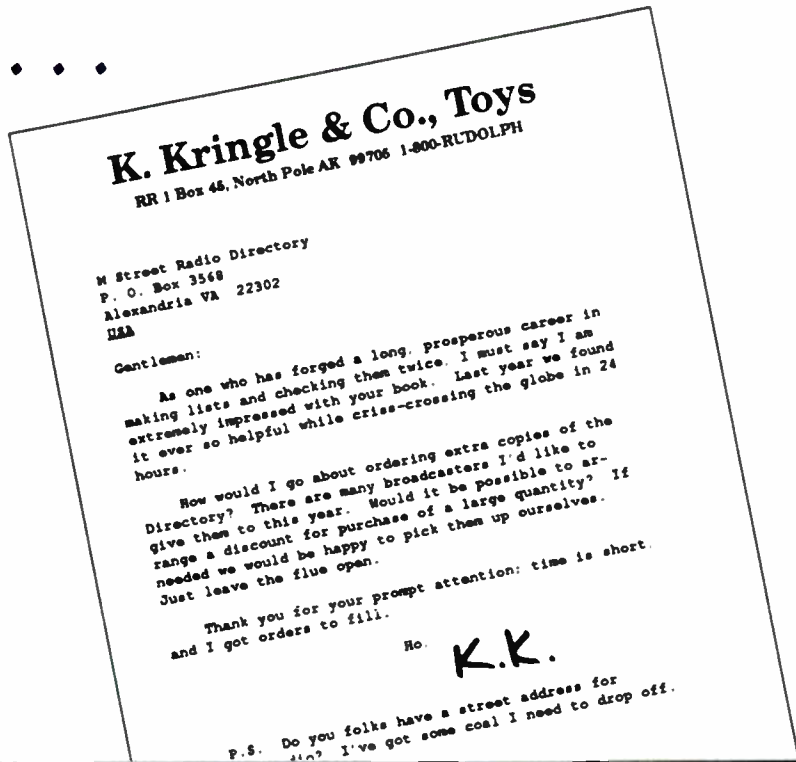

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The NAB has filed a series of further comments with the FCC urging the Commission to adopt a comprehensive DAB (direct audio broadcasting) policy and opposing all

uses of satellite-delivered DAB systems, either alone or in combination with land-based systems. In advocating rejection of a proposal by Satellite CD Radio, Inc., the NAB claims that "...a land-based DAB system is preferable because a satellite-based system would threaten the concept of localism...the Satellite CD proposal would ultimately deprive communities of the local news, information and public affairs programming provided by more than 12,000 radio stations across the country ...the new technology should be introduced as an 'enhancement' to existing radio stations." The NAB, of course, was one of the main proponents of last decade's deregulation of station sale and programming rules - changes that have allowed many of those 12,000 stations to drop most or all of their news, information, public affairs and/or non-satellite-originated programming...

The NAB's Science & Technology Department has also filed DAB comments, suggesting that the current FM coverage charts and assumptions used by the FCC are not applicable and should be revised before the FCC considers establishing a DAB-based table of allocations.

The lone FCC appeal decision this week was the dismissal of a petition for reconsideration of a previous return of an allocation upgrade for WXLQ Hinesville GA.

The FCC's totals do not include as-yet-unlicensed construction permits or new stations; hence, these are lower than the totals in M Street's U.S. database. We do not know the source of the NAB's estimate of 12,000 U.S. stations.

ELSEWHERE

Satellite Production Network's "Spots From Space" has unveiled a new production service that may well revolutionize local commercials in the same way satellite services have changed the face of radio programming. SPN takes faxed specs for local clients, copy points & other instructions, submits copy for approval and produces the spot, which is sent back to the station via satellite. Major market production library, facilities and talent on any size station. For more info, contact Satellite Production Network at (415) 673-0737.

Another innovative new service introduced in three major markets last year is now up for expansion. "PromoFone" is a free interactive telephone movieguide, similar to weather and ski lines used in many markets, that ties in promotionally with one radio and one television station in each market. The system has logged over 3.1 million calls in its first 18 months in Los Angeles, New York and San Francisco; by Spring of 1991 the system will also be in place in Miami, Boston, Atlanta, Detroit and Chicago, and the service is actively looking for exclusive radio vehicles in other major markets.

Harris/Allied has merged its two sales forces. Since Harris acquired Allied, the companies have maintained separate sales departments. The new sales force will be divided into outside sales and a telephone sales group based in Richmond, Indiana.

In a follow-up to our Nov. 26 comments on radio's handling of flooding in Western Washington last month, Tacoma WA broadcaster and subscriber Hank Perozzo looked up the emergency officials in Pierce County to ask why the area's EBS system was never activated. He was told that the situation was not serious enough to warrant EBS use. Damage estimates from the flooding, which displaced thousands of people, run to at least double the cost of any previous natural disaster in the state's history. M Street wonders: while Nero fiddled and Rome burned, was Radio Italia running a guaranteed forty minute music sweep?

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

Within 60 days, the FCC has announced that it will implement new rules limiting settlement payments among applicants for new station construction permits and station modifications to reimbursement of "legitimate and prudent out-of-pocket expenses up to the point that the trial phase of the hearing commences." After that point, payments will be prohibited.

The change is the most sweeping thus far in the FCC's ongoing effort to discourage abuse of its application process. Permitting applicants to settle before the trial phase of a hearing, according to the FCC, will "encourage bonafide applicants to apply because they will be able to recoup expenses up to a point at which they can make a realistic assessment of their probability of success...In the interest of expediting the delivery of new service to the public, the Commission is encouraging settlement as soon as possible after the voluntary settlement conference is held, or after discovery is completed if no settlement conference is held." Parties seeking approval of a settlement must submit: 1) certifications that they have not received and will not receive any money or other considerations in excess of expenses; 2) the exact nature and amount of any consideration paid or

promised; 3) an itemized accounting of expenses for which they seek reimbursement; and 4) the terms of any oral agreement relating to the dismissal or amendment of the application. Applicants dismissing or withdrawing after the start of the trial phase must certify that they have received no consideration. Principals of applicants are not entitled to reimbursement for services performed on behalf of the applicant.

The new rules will apply to all applications, including those currently pending. However, because of Paperwork Reduction Act regulations requiring OMB approval, the effective date will be delayed beyond the normal 30 days from rule publication (Dec. 13). The FCC estimates the rules will take effect within 60 days. The changes impact all of the approximately 450 contested new station or amended facility proceedings that **M Street** records show as now being active.

The FCC has extended to January 17 the date for filing reply comments in the proceeding involving a review of the technical assignment criteria for AM radio.

People Wireless, Inc., owner of KDKO-1510 Littleton CO, has been issued a Notice of Apparent Liability by the FCC for repeated rule violations. Violations include failure to cease operations within three hours after a malfunction in the remote system was detected; use of an unlicensed studio to transmitter link (STL); and repeated failure to change from its daytime to nighttime power and DA patterns.

ELSEWHERE

At least one of Money Radio Network's remaining three programming affiliates has been notified that MRN will cease operations as of January 1. At press time, MRN had not confirmed the report or reports that flagship station KMNY-1600 Pomona CA may also be in financial trouble. MRN's business news and talk programming peaked early this year with fewer than a dozen affiliates, many of which have dropped the network in recent months. Contributing to network woes was an FCC reprimand last summer for taking payments from financial experts interviewed on MRN talk shows.

The Radio Advertising Bureau (RAB) has released figures showing October 1990 radio advertising revenue to be significantly up over 1989 figures. Overall sales were up 14.9% - 13% for local ad sales, 20.9% for national sales. Local revenue figures, according to the RAB, were consistently high across all regions of the country except for the Midwest (up "only" 7.2%). The Southwest showed the strongest gain, with a 30% increase over 1989 figures. RAB predicts radio revenues will exceed \$9 billion in 1991, up from 1990's estimated \$8.8 billion.

The RAB's annual Managing Sales Conference is also fast approaching. The event will be held January 24-26, 1991, at the Opryland Hotel in Nashville. For more information on seminars, exhibits and registration, call the RAB at 301-468-3210. And if you're there, look for M Street - we'll be holding forth at the RRN booth.

The new loophole in FCC duopoly regulations is fast becoming the wave of the future. Capstar Communications, which has already engineered lease agreements for its stations in Austin TX and Jackson MS, announced this week that in January it will sell talk-formatted WSIX-980 in Nashville and move that station's programming and sales staff to the now-silent WTSN-FM-99.7, an FM licensed to Manchester TN with a CP that will upgrade its coverage to include Nashville. New WTSN-FM owner American General Media retains managerial control, but programming and sale will be run from Capstar's WSIX-FM. Additionally, two pairs of medium market FM stations announced co-management agreements this week. In Tyler TX, newly CHR KISX-107.3 is moving in with and being managed by country KNUE-101.5. In Colorado Springs, KKFM-96.5 has moved into the studios of KKMG-98.9, and KKMG has signed an agreement to be represented in local sales by KKFM. Each of the three arrangements allow one local sales staff to represent two stations that are not co-owned, while maintaining separate programming departments to protect the integrity of their licenses.

Four new representatives have been elected to Arbitron's Radio Advisory Council, effective January 1991. They are: Jim Connor (WEAT AM/FM West Palm Beach); Michael Disney (WFLC Miami); Owen Weber (WXYV Baltimore); and Dick Williams (WIL-FM St. Louis). John Cravens (WHYT Detroit) was elected Council chairman for 1991.

It's a nice gig if you can get it: former New York mayor Edward Koch has signed a new, long-term contract to continue his political commentaries on WNEW-1130. Koch will earn about \$55,000 a year to provide one five minute commentary from his home each morning. WNEW plans to rebroadcast Koch's comments in afternoon drive.

Thought for the week, provided by "The Breneman Review," an industry record report: "Bette Midler said recently business associates had warned her that using the word 'God' in her record 'From A Distance' would severely hamper its acceptance, that radio would not play it for fear of turning off their audience...Guess what? Radio found no problem at all with it. Neither did the audience. M. C. Hammer had no problem with his hit 'Pray'...it seems we're all too ready to take someone else's idea of what the audience wants or will accept rather than listening to the audience. And listening to them is hard because for the most part, they tend not to answer until asked. Don't let someone else tell you what your audience/community wants or will accept. Find out first hand - lest one day you find them - gone."

Willhight Radio research has released listener survey results for the metro area of North Pole, AK. The most listened to station for 55+ males is news-talk KFAR-660 Fairbanks. With 10,000 watts on a clear channel, Santa can pick up current news and weather for a long way...

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

An FCC decision in rural Missouri has apparently given the first official FCC ratification to the recent spate of station leasing and co-program agreements. The Commission found that rules would not be violated by a "network affiliation" agreement whereby KWPM, Inc. (license of KWPM/KSPQ West Plains MO) would provide KUKU-FM (Willow Springs MO) with "between 12 and 24 hours of KWPM(AM)'s programming per day." KUKU(AM) apparently will remain locally programmed. The stations involved comprise four of the six stations currently on air in Howell County MO.

A waiver has been granted to Scripps-Howard Broadcasting, owners of (among others) WBSB-104.3 Baltimore, to purchase WMAR TV 2 in Baltimore. The waiver was granted within the guidelines of allowing cross-ownership in top 25 markets.

The FCC has denied Pinewood Broadcasting Partnership review of dismissal of its petition to allot Channel 238A (95.7) to Pinewood SC; and dismissed a reconsideration petition and granted an upgrade to the facilities of WSTT-FM Thomasville GA.

Another new FCC form is on its way! FCC Rules Section 74.1283(c)(1) will require FM translator stations whose station identification is made by the primary station to furnish current information on the translator's call sign and location. The information will be kept in the primary station's files and used to contact the translator licensee in the event of malfunction of the translator.

ELSEWHERE

Billboard is reporting that CBS will begin charging large market stations a fee to carry major league baseball and football coverage, beginning in 1991. The fees are reported to be as high as \$15,000 for one sports or \$25,000 for both.

Keith Spicer has resigned after less than a year as chair of the CRTC (Canadian Radio-Television Commission). Spicer was pulled from the post by Canadian Prime Minister Brian Mulroney to serve on the "National Unity Committee" to examine the future (if any) of Canada. Commission member David Colville has been nominated as Spicer's replacement.

Also in Canada, the CBC has begun testing for two new FM outlets in Ottawa Ont., on 90.7 and 91.5 MHz. The stations are expected to replace CBC AM stations CBO-920 (on 91.5) and CBOF-1250 (90.7). The 920 station is scheduled to go off the air permanently on March 26, 1991; no sign-off date has been announced for CBOF-1250. The new facilities, and the expansive new CBC studios nearing completion in Toronto, come at the same time the CBC is administering massive across-the-board budget cuts that include laying off 10% of its work force.

Arbitron has announced the opening of a new radio station services sales office in Laurel, MD. The new office will serve stations in Maryland, Virginia, West Virginia, Delaware, Washington DC and southern Pennsylvania. Regional Sales Manager for the Laurel office will be Michael Henderson, who comes to Arbitron from the Blackburn & Co. Media Brokerage and Blackburn Capital Markets.
