Canadian Broadcasting: Brief Summary and Outlook for 1957

WITH some fifty-four percent of Canadian households now equipped with television receiving sets and practically 96 percent of all households having radio sets as at the end of 1956, according to latest official government census, the Canadian radio and television industry experienced favorable results during 1956. Outlook for the year 1957 is reported good from almost all aspects.



Further television broadcasting stations came into operation in the past year but at same time, radio broadcasters also showed growth, and demonstrated that they have now "learned to live with television." As a matter of fact, radio broadcasters point out that radio set sales in Canada have shown continued and sustained increase as compared with sales of television sets, which tended to ease off considerably in 1956. Increased radio set sales, it was pointed out by radio broadcasters, showed definitely the sustained high level of radio listening audiences.

Radio broadcasters, in order to continue to attract sponsors, have adapted their programming to obtain best audience results. More and more, radio broadcasting is slanted towards busy housewives during earlier housework hours, and during early morning hours for the motoring and night-time workers. As far as television time is concerned there is gradual increase in operating time. But advertising time continues "hard to obtain", especially for periods considered most favorable.



Radio broadcasters generally report satisfactory operating results. Schedules have been altered, operators admit. The biggest change, it is gathered, has been in program sponsorship. There has been a tendency for shows, especially the major ones, to be sponsored by a number of advertisers. Spot announcement also has become more widespread. Radio broadcasters have drawn special attention to advertisers of service that can be rendered on a local basis and this has proved very satisfactory and has meant that radio operators have been able to maintain revenues in the face of television competition.

Probably the biggest thing that occurred in Canada's radio and television broadcasting industry in the past year was the extensive investigation made by the Royal

Commission on Broadcasting headed by R. M. Fowler of Montreal. The commission heard hundreds of briefs, at a number of sittings both in Canada and the United States. The commission report is expected to have a strong effect on the future of the industry.



Further progress is being made on 4,000-mile microwave radio relay network—from Sydney, Nova Scotia, to Victoria, B.C. The Toronto-North Bay-Winnipeg section has been completed, as well as part of the Maritime Provinces section. The entire network is scheduled to go into operation in 1958. When the network is complete, it will afford simultaneous network television for 28 cities from the east to the west.

Official government figures indicate that television set sales in Canada in 1956 amounted to 598,149 units, or down 22 per cent from the record year, 1955. Value of sales slipped from \$234,800,000 to \$179,900,000. Radio set sales, on the other hand recorded sharp advance to 709,416 units up 16 per cent from 609,993 sold in year before. Radios sets sales were valued at \$46,311,633 compared to \$491,907,208.




The Canadian Association of Radio and Television Broadcasters, comprised of private operators across Canada, increased its membership during the past year and a report, issued by the association in the latter part of January said that CARTB membership to date totalled 145 radio broadcasting stations, 28 television broadcasting stations, and 54 associate members.

As far as CBC is concerned, high officials of the corporation reported early this year that considerable progress had been recorded both in television and radio and that the outlook remained very bright. At the turn of the year, A. Davidson Dunton, chairman of the Board of Governors of CBC pointed out in a progress report that there were 38 television stations in Canada which could attain some 80 percent of the population and that Canadian broadcasting is second to none in the world.

Even a phony professor can spot a real dollar

"You Canadians may have no culture, no flag and no president, but you sure do have a dollar. . . . Your dollar is strong; people want it."
